FOR OPENERS

- Virginia opens its 65th season of ACC action.
- UVA was picked to finish sixth in the ACC preseason poll, while Boston College was picked to finish 14th.
- Tony Bennett is one win shy of becoming the fourth UVA men's basketball head coach to win 200 games at the school, joining Terry Holland (326), Henry Lannigan (254) and Gus Tebell (241).
- Bennett would be the third fastest to achieve the mark in 284 games. Lannigan achieved the 200-win mark in 261 games followed by Holland (283) and Tebell (360).
- As of Dec. 29, the Cavaliers rank first nationally in scoring defense (52.3 ppg), second in field goal percentage defense (35.9%), third in turnovers per game (9.3), 10th in fouls per game (14.8), 12th in scoring margin (19.8), 14th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.53), 18th in turnover margin (4.8) and 27th in free throw percentage (76.4%).

ACC OPENERS

- The Cavaliers have a nine-game winning streak in ACC openers and are 8-0 in ACC openers under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 29-35 all-time in ACC openers.
- The Cavaliers posted a 61-53 win at Louisville in last year's ACC season opener.

ALL-TIME AGAINST THE EAGLES

- Virginia is 13-7 all-time vs. Boston College, including a 10-7 ACC mark, in the series that dates back to 1971-72.
- The Cavaliers have a four-game winning streak against the Eagles and have won six of the last seven games in the series.
- UVA is 7-2 against Boston College in Charlottesville, including a 61-47 win in the last meeting between the teams at John Paul Jones Arena during the 2015-16 season.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 7-4 all-time against Boston College.

UVA IN KEN POM EFFICIENCY RATINGS

- As of Dec. 29, UVA ranks Nos. 1, 3 and 28 in the KenPom.com adjusted defense, overall and adjusted offense efficiency ratings.
- UVA is shooting 48.4 percent, 39.2 percent from 3-point range (2nd best in school history) and school-best 76.4 percent from the free throw line.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better in seven games.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE EAGLES

- Devon Hall tallied 13 points and Isaiah Wilkins chipped in 11 points and a team-high nine rebounds then-No. 16 Virginia's 71-54 win at Boston College on Jan. 18, 2017.
- UVA broke the game open with a 15-0 first-half run and held the Eagles scoreless for 5:25 during the run.
- Darius Thompson and Kyle Guy added 12 and eight points off the bench, respectively.
- The Cavaliers had 22 assists on their 27 made field goals.
- UVA committed just five turnovers in the win.

LAST TIME OUT

- Kyle Guy had 15 points, DeAndre Hunter scored 14 and Ty Jerome added 10 as No. 13 Virginia wrapped up its nonconference schedule with an 82-48 victory over Hampton on Dec. 22.
- The Cavaliers (11-1) held Hampton to 20.6 percent from the field in the second half and bounced back from a cold start on the offensive end.
- UVA trailed for eight minutes in the first half before 3-pointers from Jerome and Nigel Johnson, along with a dunk by Isaiah Wilkins, pulled them even.
- The Cavaliers went on a 34-10 run wrapped around the halftime break to take control.
- Virginia shot 51.5 percent in the second half and outscored Hampton (5-9) 34-10 in the paint.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA has limited its foes to 52.3 points per game (2nd best in school history) and has held six of its opponents to fewer than 50 points (UNCG, Austin Peay, Vanderbilt, Wisconsin, Savannah State and Hampton).
- UVA has held each of its 12 foes to less than 50 percent shooting.
- The Cavaliers are 70-2 when limiting their opponents to fewer than 50 points under head coach Tony Bennett.
- In 2016-17, Virginia led the nation in scoring defense (56.4 ppg) for the third time under Bennett.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense four times (2008-09, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2016-17) and finished in the top-five nationally in eight of 11 seasons.
- Bennett-coached teams are 95-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 12-year coaching career.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 199-84 (.703) mark in nine seasons at Virginia and 267-117 (.695) career mark in 12 seasons overall.
- Bennett has guided UVA to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances and has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to six consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 111-34 (.765) in non-conference action, 88-50 (.638) in ACC play and 120-24 (.832) at home under Tony Bennett.

ABOUT THE CAVALIERS

- UVA is led by tri-captains Devon Hall, Isaiah Wilkins and Jack Salt.
- The announcement of Hall, Wilkins and Salt marked the first time in Bennett's 12-year head coaching career where he officially named team captains.
- UVA has averaged 72.1 points per game (most under Bennett) on offense, while yielding a nation-leading 52.3 ppg (second lowest in school history) on defense.
- UVA has started Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, Hall, Wilkins and Salt in each of its 12 games.
- Guy leads the team in scoring at 16.1 points per game and has scored 13 or more points in 10 games, including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) and 21 vs. Lehigh (12/2/17).
- Hall has averaged 12.4 points on 49 percent shooting and team-leading 93.5 percent (29 of 31) from the charity stripe and 47.4 percent (18 of 38) from 3-point range.
- Wilkins, who has averaged 7.3 points and a team-high 6.9 rebounds, 14 blocked shots and 16 steals.
- Jerome is averaging 7.9 points and Salt is averaging a career-best 4.3 rebounds.
- Graduate transfer Nigel Johnson is averaging 6.9 points after averaging 11.3 points for Rutgers last season. Johnson has reached double figures in three contests off the bench.
- Mamadi Diakite (6.6 ppg & 4.0 rpg) and redshirt freshmen De'Andre Hunter (6.5 ppg) and Jay Huff (4.6 ppg) are key role players.
- Marco Anthony provides depth and fellow rookie Francesco Badocchi is expected to redshirt the 2017-18 season.

UVA RANKED NO. 9 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 9 in the latest AP and USA Today Coaches' polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for five straight weeks and returns to the top 10 for the first time since Jan. 30, 2017.
- The Cavaliers received votes in the first three AP polls, snapping a streak of 64 consecutive weeks in the AP rankings since Feb. 3, 2014.
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in each of the past three seasons (2014-16).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 158-40 (.798), including an 8-0 mark in 2017-18, in 12 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA has a 10-game home win streak dating back to last year.
- The Cavaliers finished undefeated at home (15-0) in 2015-16.
- UVA is 119-24 (.832), including an 84-9 (.903) mark the past six seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 41-4 in ACC home games over the past five seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for eight straight seasons.

ZAY PAVES THE WAY

- Senior forward Isaiah Wilkins is one of the top utility players in college basketball.
- Wilkins has averaged 7.3 points, 6.9 rebounds, 1.9 assists, 1.2 blocked shots and 1.3 steals in 2017-18.
- Wilkins was named the MVP of the NIT Season Tip-Off after scoring a career-high 19 points against Rhode Island (11/24/17) and blocking four shots and scoring eight points against Vanderbilt (11/23/17).
- He tallied eight points, eight rebounds, two assists, one steal and took a team-high three charges at VCU (11/17/17).
- Wilkins added 14 points, six rebounds and three steals vs. Lehigh (12/2/17).
- Wilkins ranks eighth at UVA with 106 career blocked shots.
- In 2016-17, the All-ACC Defensive team honoree led the team in rebounding (6.0 rpg), blocked shots (43) and steals (33), becoming the first Cavalier since Travis Watson in 2002-03 to lead the team in those three categories.
- Wilkins recorded a pair of double-doubles in 2016-17 (13 points, 11 rebounds and career-high tying five blocks vs. Louisville and 10 points, 10 rebounds and four steals vs. Miami).

HALL OF A PLAYER

- Redshirt senior Devon Hall is averaging a career-best 12.4 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.8 assists.
- Hall is shooting 49 percent from the floor, 47.4 percent from 3-point range and 93.5 percent from the free throw line.
- He scored a career-high 20 points vs. Davidson and 19 points against UNCG (11/10/17) and West Virginia (12/5/17).
- Hall, who has started 66 consecutive games dating back to 2015-16, has scored in double figures in 26 career games including seven games this season.
- In 2016-17, Hall averaged 8.4 points and 4.4 rebounds in 27.4 minutes per game.
- He was named to the 2016-17 All-ACC Academic Team after earning his degree in media studies and is currently enrolled in the Professional Development Program at the Curry School of Education.

THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- Sophomore Kyle Guy is having a breakout season for Virginia.
- Guy leads Virginia in scoring (16.1 ppg) and made 3-pointers per game (2.83).
- Guy's career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) were the most for a Virginia player since Joe Harris' 36 points vs. Duke in 2012-13.
- Guy has led the Cavaliers in scoring in seven contests and has scored 13 or more points in 10 games this season.
- Guy is shooting 47.8 percent (85 of 178) from 3-point range during his two-year career and has made five or more 3-pointers in six games.
- Guy needs 15 more 3-pointers to qualify for UVA's career 3-point percentage record set at 42.1 percent set by Keith Freeland (107 3-pointers from 2000-01).
- Guy's 7.5 points per game average in his rookie season under head coach Tony Bennett ranked higher than former UVA standouts Malcolm Brogdon (6.7 ppg) and London Perrantes (5.5 ppg).
- Guy has scored 10+ points in 20 career games, including a pair of 20-point efforts last season against Pitt and Grambling State.

THE ELECTRIC 70s AND AWESOME 80s

- Virginia has scored 70 or more points in eight games and is 103-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and is 96-78 when scoring under 70 points under Bennett.
- UVA has scored 80 or more points in three games and is 26-1 under Bennett when scoring 80 or more. UVA's lone loss under Bennett when scoring 80 or more was a 93-81 loss at UNC in 2012-13.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia is 70-2 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era (6-0 in 2017-18).
- Bennett-coached teams are 95-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA held Wisconsin under 40 points and is 19-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

GUY AND WILKINS AMONG ACC LEADERS

- As of Dec. 29, Kyle Guy ranks third in the ACC in 3-pointers per game (2.83), fifth in 3-point percentage (45.3%) and 11th in scoring (16.1 ppg).
- Isaiah Wilkins ranks 15th in the ACC in rebounding (6.9 rpg).

- Four opponents (Clemson, Georgia Tech, Monmouth, UNC Greensboro and Syracuse) participated in the 2017 National Invitation Tournament.

- Virginia signed guards Kihei Clark (Woodland Hills, Calif./Taft Charter High School) and Kody Stattmann (Bentley Park, Queensland, Australia/St. Augustine's College) to National Letters of Intent.
- The 5-9, 155-pound Clark averaged 18.9 points, 7.1 assists and 4.2 rebounds for Taft Charter High School as a junior in 2016-17.
- The 6-7, 178-pound Stattmann averaged 31 points to lead the Australian U17 Emus Men's Basketball Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Oceania Championships in Guam.

- Perrantes signed a two-way contract with Cleveland and made his NBA debut vs. Atlanta on Dec. 12.
- In addition, Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle is a Virginia alum who helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984. Carlisle gained his 700th NBA victory on Dec. 2.
