FOR OPENERS

- UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense at 49.9 points per game, which is the third lowest average in the shot clock era (since 1986).
- Virginia is first in the ACC at 14-1, while Virginia Tech is 14th at 2-13.
- Virginia's 26-1 record ties its best 27-game start in school history (26-1 start in 1981-82).
- The Cavaliers have won 23 or more games in three consecutive seasons for the first time since 1981-83.
- Virginia has 14 or more ACC wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.
- UVA has held its opponents to fewer than 50 points in five of the last six games.
- UVA junior guard Justin Anderson fractured a finger on his left hand on Feb. 7 and is out 4-6 weeks.
- Sophomore guard London Perrantes, who missed the Wake Forest game, remains day-to-day after suffering a broken nose and mild concussion vs. Florida State on Feb. 22.

A WIN VS. VIRGINIA TECH:

- Would tie UVA's best start in school history at 27-1 (1981-82).
- Would clinch at least a share of Virgini's second consecutive ACC regular season title.
- Would give UVA a seven-game winning streak against the Hokies.
- Would give UVA an eight-game winning streak.
- Would give UVA 15 or more home wins in three consecutive seasons for the first time in school history.
- Would give Tony Bennett 202 career wins and 133 wins at Virginia.
- Would give UVA 80 wins during a three-year span, its most since winning 80 games from 1982-84.

LAST TIME OUT

- Anthony Gill had 11 points and Darion Atkins added 10 as No. 2 Virginia posted a 70-34 road win at Wake Forest on Feb. 25.
- All 11 Cavaliers who saw action scored, including Rob Vozenilek (3 points) and Maleek Frazier, who scored his first career points.
- UVA shot 50 percent (28-56) from the field and held the Demon Deacons to 21.8 percent (12-55).
- The Cavaliers owned a 45-29 advantage on the glass, led by Isaiah Wilkins' season-high nine rebounds.
- Virginia had a commanding 46-14 advantage on points in paint.

COMMONWEALTH CLASH

- The Virginia-Virginia Tech game is part of the Virginia 529 Commonwealth Clash, which is a head-to-head, points-based competition between the athletic teams of the Hoos and Hokies.
- The competition includes the 21 sports in which the two schools compete against each other, plus one fan-decided point.
- Today's game is sponsored by Virginia529, the official college savings plan of University of Virginia Athletics.
- The UVA-VT game is worth a half point in the Virginia529 Commonwealth Clash.
- The Cavaliers entered the week with a 7-2.5 lead in the Clash.

ALL-TIME AGAINST VIRGINIA TECH

- Virginia is 87-53 all-time vs. Virginia Tech in the series that dates back to 1914-15.
- The Cavaliers have won six straight games against Virginia Tech, including a 50-47 decision on Jan. 25 in Blacksburg, and eight of the last nine contests in the series.
- The Cavaliers are 35-12, including a 5-3 mark at John Paul Jones Arena, against the Hokies in Charlottesville.
- Virginia has a two-game home winning streak against the Hokies.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 8-3 all-time vs. Virginia Tech.

LAST TIME VS. VIRGINIA TECH

- Justin Anderson scored eight of his 12 points during a late 12-0 run to send No. 2 Virginia to a 50-47 victory at Virginia Tech on Jan. 25.
- Virginia Tech went on a 16-0 run after Malcolm Brogdon (8 points) opened the second half with a 3-pointer for the Cavaliers, who have won five straight games against the Hokies in Blacksburg.
- Darion Atkins chipped in nine points, and Anthony Gill added eight points and seven rebounds for Virginia.
- London Perrantes had a game-high seven assists for Virginia, which outrebounded Virginia Tech 33-21.
- Adam Smith led the Hokies with 15 points.

UVA RANKED NO. 2/3 IN THE LATEST NATIONAL POLLS

- UVA is ranked Nos. 2 and 3 in the AP and USA Today coaches' polls.
- The Cavaliers were ranked No. 2 in both polls from Jan. 12-Feb. 1.
- Prior to this year, the Cavaliers achieved their last No. 2 ranking on March 8, 1983.
- Virginia has delivered three of the 14 home losses by teams currently ranked in the top 17 of this week's AP poll (Notre Dame, North Carolina, Maryland) and the Cavaliers' four road wins over current top 25 teams lead the nation.
- The Cavaliers have been ranked in the top 10 for the first 17 weeks of the season for the first time since 1982-83.
- The No. 9 AP preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.
- UVA is one of three teams (Duke and Arizona) that have been ranked in the top 10 for 19 straight weeks dating back to last season.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Sixth-year head coach Tony Bennett sports a 132-61 mark at Virginia and 201-94 mark in nine seasons overall.
- Bennett was named 2014 ACC Coach of the Year after guiding the Cavaliers to their first ACC Tournament championship since 1976.
- In 2013-14, he guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has guided the Cavaliers to three consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012 and 2014 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett has increased UVA's win total in each of the last five seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12, 23 in 2013-13 and 30 in 2013-14).
- Bennett-coached teams are 74-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his nine-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have finished in the top five nationally in scoring defense in five of eight seasons (first in 2008-09 and 2013-14, second in 2007-08 and 2011-12, and fifth in 2012-13).
- Bennett is one of 24 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- Bennett is the only active coach to have wins over the five active Hall of Fame coaches (Jim Boeheim, Larry Brown, Mike Krzyzewski, Rick Pitino, Roy Williams).
- Bennett became the 15th coach in NCAA Division I history to reach the 200 career-win mark in nine seasons or less on Feb. 22, 2015.

EMBRACE THE PACE

- Virginia is averaging 66 points and yielding a nation-leading and school-record (modern era) 49.9 points (third best defensive average in shot clock era).
- UVA has shot 46.1 percent from the field and 35.6 percent from 3-point range, while limiting its opponents to 35.1 percent from the field (2nd nationally) and 29.6 percent from 3-point range.
- As of Feb. 26, the Cavaliers rank in the top five nationally in eight defensive categories: points per game (1st), field goal percentage (2nd), points per possession (2nd), true shooting percentage (2nd), effective shooting percentage (3rd), rebounds per game (3rd), possessions per 40 minutes (4th) and offensive rebound percentage (5th).
- As of Feb. 26, the Cavaliers rank in the top 10 nationally in two offensive categories: defensive rebound percentage (5th) and assist-to-turnover ratio (7th).
- UVA has limited its opponents to 63 fast break points, but allowed a season-high 14 in its loss to Duke.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- Virginia has held their opponents scoreless for five or more minutes 25 times.
- Virginia held Louisville scoreless for 12:06, Tennessee State scoreless for 10:23 and Cleveland State scoreless for 10:03 this season.
- Virginia has also limited its opponents without a field goal for eight or more minutes 11 times, highlighted by Harvard for 19:53 on Dec. 21.

TWENTY-SOMETHINGS:

- NCAA Division I teams have been held under 30 points seven times this season, and Virginia is responsible for three of them (Rutgers-26, Harvard-27, Georgia Tech-28).
- Virginia is the first Division I team to hold multiple opponents under 30 in a season since Bucknell did it twice in 2003-04.
- The last Division I team to hold three opponents under 30 in a season was NC State in 1996-97 (Winthrop, Arkansas-Pine Bluff, Texas-Pan American).
- The last time Virginia held at least three opponents under 30 points in a season was in 1945-46 (five times).
- Georgia Tech's 28 points on Jan. 22 marked the lowest point total ever in an ACC regular season game.
- Virginia has held six opponents under 40 points this season, twice as many as any other team in the nation.

- UVa is responsible for three of the top five defensive performances for fewest points in a game by Power 5 conference teams this season (ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac 12, SEC).

START YOUR ENGINES

- Virginia enjoyed its second-best start in school history at 19-0.
- UVa started 7-0 in ACC play for the first time since 1980-81 (12-0).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- UVa is 122-36 (.772) in nine seasons, including a 14-1 mark in 2014-15, at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVa won 11 or more home games for six straight seasons.
- UVa's 21-game home winning streak from Dec. 21, 2013-Jan. 22, 2015 set a JPI record.
- UVa is 84-20 (.808) at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia has sold out home contests vs. Harvard, Davidson, Duke, Louisville, Wake Forest, Pitt, Florida State and Virginia Tech (2/28).
- Virginia enjoyed a school-best, 21-game ACC home winning streak from Jan. 6, 2013-Jan. 22, 2015, marking the longest in the ACC since Duke's 22-game ACC home winning streak from 2002-04.

VIRGINIA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- Virginia is 14-18 against ranked opponents, including a 2-6 mark vs. top-5 foes, in the Tony Bennett era.
- Virginia is 129-313 vs. ranked opponents, including a 25-119 mark against top-5 foes, since 1953-54.
- The Cavaliers are 1-26 vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).
- UVa is 4-1 against ranked opponents this season, defeating Maryland, Notre Dame, North Carolina and Louisville.

THE ELECTRIC 70s

- Virginia is 61-4 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and 71-57 when scoring under 70 points.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia is 48-2 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era.
- Virginia is 13-0 this season and 32-1 over the last three seasons when holding opponents under 50 points.

60 IS THE NEW 70

- UVa is 85-10 when scoring at least 60 points and 15-20 when scoring fewer than 60 points over the past four seasons.

PAINT IT ORANGE AND BLUE

- Virginia is averaging 30.9 points in the paint, while limiting its opponents to 20.1 points per game in the paint.

- Anthony Gill, Mike Tobey and Darion Atkins are each shooting 51.2 percent or better from the field.
- UVa has outrebounded its opponent in 22 of 27 games, and is second in the ACC with a +8.6 rebounding margin.

- Six of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the latest AP poll (Duke, Notre Dame, Maryland, North Carolina, Louisville and VCU).

- The Cavaliers are 12-0 away from home this season.
- Virginia is 14-2 in ACC road games over the past two seasons, the most road wins in the conference over that period.
- The Cavaliers have four true road wins over teams currently ranked in the AP poll, most in the nation.
- UVa's current 10-game road winning streak is tied for first nationally with Gonzaga.

MALCOLM IN THE MIDDLE

- Preseason All-ACC performer Malcolm Brogdon leads UVa in scoring for the second straight season at 13.5 points per game.
- Brogdon had a season-high 20 points against Boston College and La Salle, and has scored 10 or more points in 20 games.
- He ranks second in the ACC in free throw percentage (86.3%).
- Brogdon was named to the 2015 Allstate NABC Good Works Team® and Naismith Trophy Midseason 30 list, and is a Naismith Jerry West Award (best shooting guard) and USBWA Oscar Robertson Player of the Year Award finalist.
- In 2013-14, Brogdon averaged a career-high 12.7 points and 5.4 rebounds en route to All-ACC honors.
- Brogdon scored a career-best 23 points in the 2014 ACC Tournament final win against Duke.

HIGH POINT MAN IN THE PAINT

- Anthony Gill, a High Point, N.C., native, is averaging career highs in points (11.3) and rebounds (6.8) this season.
- Gill, who was named to the USBWA Oscar Robertson Trophy Midseason Watch List, has a team-leading three double-doubles.
- Gill recorded career highs in points (25) and rebounds (13) against Davidson for his second career double-double.
- Gill tallied his first career double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds en route to MVP honors at the Barclays Center Classic.
- Gill leads the team in field goal percentage (57.3%) and ranks 13th in the ACC in rebounding.

CARRY ON DARION

- Senior Darion Atkins is enjoying his final season at UVa, averaging career highs in points (7.3), rebounds (5.8) and a team-leading 28 blocked shots and 20 steals.
- Atkins has grabbed 10 or more rebounds in four games this season, including a career-high 12 at Miami (1/3/15).
- Atkins had a career-high four steals vs. Florida State (2/22/15) and a season-high four blocked shots vs. Pitt (2/16/15).
- He is the only ACC player to lead his team in blocks and steals this season.
- Atkins is the first player to lead UVa in blocks and steals since Travis Watson in 2002-03.

SIXTH MAN NO MORE

- 2014 ACC Sixth Man of the Year Justin Anderson, who has missed five games after fracturing a finger on Feb. 7, has started 22 games and led the team in scoring in 10 games.
- He was named to midseason watch lists for the the Wooden Award, USBWA Oscar Robertson Trophy and Naismith Trophy, and is a Naismith Julius Erving Award (best small forward) finalist.
- Anderson was named the USBWA's Oscar Robertson National Player of the Week and ACC Co-Player of the Week on Dec. 9 after averaging 18.5 points and seven rebounds in wins at Maryland and VCU.
- Anderson tallied a season-high 21 points at VCU and had 20 against Tennessee State.
- He is averaging career highs in points (13.4), rebounds (4.3), field goal percentage (48%), 3-point percentage (48.4%) and minutes (29.4).
- He ranks first in the ACC in 3-point percentage, ninth in 3-pointers per game (2.1) and 19th in scoring.
- Anderson was named 2014 ACC Sixth Man of the Year after averaging 7.8 points and 3.2 rebounds off the bench.

LONDON CALLING

- Sophomore point guard London Perrantes ranks second in the ACC in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.1) and sixth in assists (4.4 apg).
- Perrantes is averaging 5.9 points, 2.3 rebounds and 4.4 assists.
- Perrantes had 11 points against Wake Forest (2/14/15) and 10 vs. Pitt (2/16/15), recording 10 or more points in the back-to-back games for the first time in his career.
- He set career highs in points (26) and 3-pointers (5) at Miami.
- Perrantes had 15 points and six assists at North Carolina.
- He averaged 5.5 points and 3.8 assists and ranked sixth nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.5) to earn All-ACC Freshman Team honors last season.

ROOKIES ARE FINDING THEIR WAY ON GROUNDS

- True freshmen Isaiah Wilkins and Marial Shayok and redshirt freshman Devon Hall have made solid contributions in 2014-15.
- Shayok had seven points, five rebounds and four assists in his first collegiate start at Wake Forest in place of London Perrantes, and had a season-high nine points at Maryland and Miami.
- Wilkins has been in the rotation the past 12 contests, and had seven points and five rebounds in 14 minutes vs. Duke and a season-high nine rebounds at Wake Forest.
- Hall had a season-high nine points at Wake Forest, and had five points and five steals in a starting role at James Madison.
- Wilkins is the stepson of NBA Hall of Famer Dominique Wilkins, and B.J. Stith is the son of UVa all-time leading scorer Bryant Stith.

BROGDON NAMED TO ALLSTATE NABC GOOD WORKS TEAM®

- Malcolm Brogdon was one of 10 players named to the 2015 Allstate NABC Good Works Team® on Feb. 10.
- The award pays tribute to college basketball players at all levels for their impressive commitment to giving back to their communities and positively impacting the lives of those around them.
- Brogdon has volunteered as a reader and mentor to fifth grade students at Broadus Elementary School in Charlottesville and served as a mentor at the Charlottesville Boys and Girls Club.
- He is a dual-degree student in the Accelerated Bachelor/MPP Program in the Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy, and has made mission trips to South Africa and Malawi, and Ghana.
- Brogdon served as a mentor in both the W.E.B. DuBois Society and Norcross Elementary school in Georgia, and was also a counselor at the East Lake YMCA summer camp in Atlanta.

CAVALIERS IN THE NBA

- Mike Scott (Atlanta) and Joe Harris (Cleveland) are former Cavaliers who have played in the NBA this season.
- Scott is in his third season and has averaged 7.5 points in 55 games, while Harris has averaged 2.8 points in 41 games during his rookie season.

ANDERSON NAMED USBWA NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Justin Anderson earned USBWA's Oscar Robertson National Player of the Week honors on Dec. 8.
- Anderson averaged 18.5 points and seven rebounds as Virginia posted road wins at then-No. 21 Maryland (76-65) and VCU (74-57).
- In the two wins, Anderson shot 68.8 percent (11-16) from the field and 84.6 percent (11-13) from the free-throw line.
- Anderson shared ACC Player of the Week honors with Notre Dame's Jerian Grant.

VIRGINIA INKS POWER FORWARD JARRED REUTER

- Brewster Academy power forward Jarred Reuter (Marion, Mass.) inked a National Letter of Intent with the Cavaliers on Nov. 12.
- In 2013-14, the 6-8, 250-pound Reuter averaged 13 points and nine rebounds and shot 57.5 percent from the floor, helping Brewster to a 33-2 record and New England Preparatory School Athletic Council (NEPSAC) Class AAA championship and National Prep title.
- In 2012-13, Reuter was named the NEPSAC Class A Player of the Year after averaging 23 points and 12 rebounds for Tabor Academy.

BROGDON NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Malcolm Brogdon was one of five players named Preseason All-ACC.
- Joining Brogdon on the preseason All-ACC team were Marcus Paige (North Carolina), Montrezl Harrell (Louisville), Jahliil Okafor (Duke) and Jerian Grant (Notre Dame).
- Paige was the pick for Preseason ACC Player of the Year and Okafor was named Preseason ACC Rookie of the Year.

BROGDON ON WOODEN AWARD AND NAISMITH WATCH LISTS

- Malcolm Brogdon was one of 50 players on the preseason John Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy watch lists.
- Both awards honor the nation's top player.
- Brogdon is averaging a career-best 13.5 points, 3.9 rebounds and 2.7 assists this season.
- Brogdon was named All-ACC last season after helping Virginia to a 30-7 mark last season by averaging a team-best 12.7 points.

PERRANTES ON EARLY SEASON COUSY WATCH LIST

- London Perrantes was one of 36 players on the preseason Bob Cousy Award Watch List, honoring the nation's top point guard.
- Perrantes ranks second in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.1) and sixth in assists (4.4 apg) among ACC players this season.

HAND DELIVERED LEGEND

- Former Virginia guard Donald Hand is the Cavaliers' 2015 ACC Men's Basketball Tournament Legend.
- Hand, who starred at Virginia from 1998-2001, was the UVa player to serve as a team captain three consecutive years.
- He was a second-team All-ACC selection as a junior in 2000, and set the Virginia sophomore record for points in a game with 41 against NC State in 1999.
- Hand closed out his career with the Cavaliers just short of the 1,500-point career scoring mark (1,486), averaging 12.4 points per game to rank 18th all-time among Virginia players.

BARCLAYS CENTER CLASSIC RECAP

- The Cavaliers' Barclays Center title on Nov. 29 marked their third tournament championship in the Tony Bennett era (2014 ACC Tournament and Corpus Christi Challenge).
- Virginia defeated Norfolk State (67-39), Tennessee State (79-36), La Salle (64-56) and Rutgers (45-26) en route to the title.
