TODAY'S GAME

- Virginia plays its first true road game of the season as it visits Oregon
- The Cavaliers look to start a season 9-1 for the first time since 2003-04
- UVa seeks its first seven-game win streak since 2009-10 (eight-game win streak)
- It is the Cavaliers' first trip to the state of Oregon

SERIES HISTORY

- Virginia leads 1-0
- The only previous meeting was a 63-48 Cavalier win last season in Charlottesville
- Tony Bennett has a 7-2 record vs. Oregon (6-2 at Washington State, 1-0 at UVA), winning the last seven meetings
- Bennett's seven wins over the Ducks are his most against any opponent

AGAINST THE PAC-12

- Today's game is the only regular season game this season for UVA against the Pac-12
- UVA was 1-2 last season against the conference, defeating Oregon at home, losing at Stanford and falling to Washington in Maui
- Virginia has a 10-11 all-time record against Pac-12 opponents (doesn't include a 1-1 record vs. Utah prior to its entry to the Pac-12)
(3-2 vs. Arizona, 1-0 vs. Arizona State, 1-0 vs. Oregon, 1-7 vs. Stanford, 0-1 vs. UCLA, 1-0 vs. USC, 1-1 vs. Washington, 2-0 vs. Washington State)
- Oregon is just the third Pac-12 school UVA has visited (1-1 at Arizona, 0-4 at Stanford)

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia defeated George Mason 68-48 on Dec. 6 at John Paul Jones Arena
- It was the fifth time UVA held an opponent under 50 points this season
- Sammy Zeglinski led Virginia with 18 points
- Mike Scott, Jontel Evans and Joe Harris each had 11 points

2011-12 Opponents in Bold

CAVALIERS GET DEFENSIVE

- Virginia is second in the nation in scoring defense at 47.9 ppg (as of 12/16)
- UVa ranks second nationally in points allowed per possession (0.77) and 16th nationally in field goal percentage defense (36.6%)
- The Cavaliers have held each of their first nine opponents under 60 points, the first time they have held nine straight opponents under 60 points since 1948-49
- UVa held five of its first nine opponents to under 50 points, a feat it has done 12 times in the Tony Bennett era
- Virginia held Drexel to 35 points, the second lowest scoring total by a UVa opponent in the shot clock era
- South Carolina State's 25.5% shooting (13-51) was the lowest percentage allowed by UVa since Liberty shot 22.6% percent (12-53) against UVa in the 2005-06 season opener
- Virginia has held two opponents under 30% shooting this season (only accomplished the feat twice in the previous three seasons combined)
- It is the first time UVa has held multiple opponents under 30% shooting in the same season since 2005-06 (three times)
- Seven of nine Cavalier opponents this season have scored their season-low against Virginia

OPPONENTS UNDER 60

- Virginia has held all nine opponents this season to under 60 points
- It is the longest streak to start a season by a Cavalier team since 1948-49
- It is tied for the third longest streak in ACC history (the longest by an ACC team since Wake Forest's nine-game streak in 1996-97)
- Virginia and Wyoming are the only schools in the nation to hold every opponent this season under 60 points
- It is the longest streak by a Tony Bennett coached squad and tied for the longest Division I streak by a Bennett coached men's team, tying the nine-game streak by the 1994-95 team at Green Bay coached by his father, Dick

ONE AND DONE...

- Virginia leads the nation in defensive rebounding percentage at 78.5%
- The Cavaliers have allowed points on just 38.7 percent of their opponents' possessions this season (leads the nation)
- Opponents are averaging 5.6 second chance points a game this season
- UVa has held five of nine opponents to five second chance points or fewer

HOT SHOOTING

- Virginia has shot over 50 percent from the field in four of its last five games
- UVa shot a season-high 60.5% (26-43) against George Mason on Dec. 6
- The last time the Cavaliers shot at least 50 percent in four of five games was during the 1999-00 season (Loyola [Md.] to Dartmouth)

FREE THROW PRODUCTION

- Virginia leads the ACC and ranks 33rd nationally with a 74.2 free throw percentage
- UVa has scored 26.8 percent of its points this season from the free throw line
- The Cavaliers are going to the line 7.5 more times a game this season and scoring 6.4 more points from the line per game this season

THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- UVa set a school record by going 19-for-19 from the free throw line against Winthrop
- The previous school record was 16-for-16 against South Carolina on Jan. 8, 1965
- It was the best free throw performance by an ACC team since Wake Forest shot an ACC-record 32-for-32 against North Carolina in 2005

70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 21-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 18-30 over the past three seasons when scoring under 70 points

BALANCED MINUTES

- Virginia has eight players averaging over 18 minutes per game, but none averaging 30 minutes per game
- UVa is the only ACC team without a player averaging at least 30 minutes/game

SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball
- He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP

- Mike Scott enters the game with 27 career double-doubles (4th in UVa history)
- He had six double-doubles in his 10 games last season before suffering a season-ending injury
- His 27 career double-doubles leads all active ACC players
- Scott had his first double-double of the season against Drexel (21 pts, 10 rebs)
- It was his fifth "20-10" game of his career (at least 20 points and 10 rebounds)

SCOTT LEADS THE ACC

- Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (1,101), rebounds (761) and double-doubles (27)

SCOTT JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB

- Mike Scott became the 43rd Cavalier to score 1,000 career points, reaching the milestone against TCU in the Virgin Islands
- He enters the game with 1,101 career points, 39th in Virginia history

RETURN TO SENE-DER

- Assane Sene ranks seventh in school history with 104 career blocks
- He led the Cavaliers last season with 39 blocks

ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE

- Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 155 career 3-pointers, which ranks 10th in school history

EVANS SHINES AGAINST WINTHROP

- Jontel Evans scored a career-high 17 points against Winthrop
- He was 5-6 from the field, made a career-high two 3-pointers, and went 5-5 from the free throw line
- His previous career high was 11 points

JESPERSON TO REDSHIRT

- Freshman guard Paul Jespersen is expected to redshirt this season
- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett indicated that after Virginia's game with South Carolina State on Nov. 13

ACC LEADERS

- Mike Scott leads the ACC in field goal percentage (.584)
- Scott ranks third in rebounding (9.1) and eighth in scoring (15.3)
- Joe Harris ranks third in free throw percentage (.906) and 16th in scoring (12.4)
- Sammy Zeglinski ranks fifth in 3-point percentage (.412) and third in steals (2.1)
- Jontel Evans ranks T-eighth in assists (3.0) and eighth in steals (1.4)

CAVALIER DEBUTS

- Malcolm Brogdon and James Johnson, along with walk-ons Rob Vozenilek and Angus Mitchell made their collegiate debuts in the season opener vs. SC State
- Brogdon had nine points, four assists and two rebounds in his debut
- Johnson had six points (6-8 FT) and three rebounds in his debut

FIRST TRIP TO OREGON

- Today's game is the Cavaliers' first trip to the state of Oregon, the 38th different state in which Virginia has played a game
- After today, the states that the Cavaliers have never played in will be Colorado, Kansas, Maine, Mississippi, Montana, Nebraska, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Vermont, and Wyoming

'HOOS BACK

- 10 players return from last season's team that went 16-15 (7-9 ACC)
- The Cavaliers return 69.0% of scoring and 79.4% of rebounding from last season

EXPERIENCE COUNTS

- Virginia opened the season with the roster having 256 career starts, which is the most among ACC schools
- The Cavaliers had seven players who made a start in their career prior to this season (Mike Scott-74, Sammy Zeglinski-55, Assane Sene-48, Jontel Evans-38, Joe Harris-25, KT Harrell-15, Akil Mitchell-1)

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 66-28 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers went 11-6 at home last season
- Virginia is 6-0 at home this season

CAVALIERS TOP MICHIGAN

- UVa's 70-58 win over No. 14 Michigan was its highest ranked win of the Bennett era
- It was the Cavaliers' first double-digit win over a top-15 opponent since a 72-58 win over No. 11 Boston College on Feb. 21, 2006 at University Hall

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was the highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVa has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons
- North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College

FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA

- UVa signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class
- The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.

ON THE AIR

- Virginia will have almost every game this season broadcast either on television or online
- All 16 ACC games and all 16 home games will be broadcast
- 13 games will be televised nationally by ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU or FSN

McKAY PARTICIPATING IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

- Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay is participating in "Shots from the Heart", a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease
- College basketball coaches are competing against one another in a free throw shooting tournament, which benefits the American Heart Association
- The event also pays tribute to the late Skip Prosser who passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack
- Last year, McKay reached the quarterfinals of the assistant coach bracket in the inaugural event
- McKay defeated Ricky Yahn of Longwood in the first round of this year's tournament and will play Adam Caporn of St. Mary's in the round of 32

UP NEXT

- Virginia will visit Seattle on Wednesday (Dec. 21) in the second game of its trip to the Pacific Northwest
- Game time at KeyArena is 10:00 p.m. (ET) and the game will be televised by ROOT Sports Northwest
- The Redhawks won the only previous meeting, 59-53, last season at John Paul Jones Arena

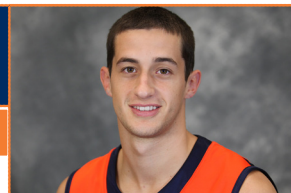
