I guess they are really No. 1," Virginia Coach George Blackburn said of Purdue ~~immediately~~ immediately after the Boilermakers had opening the campaign with a resounding 44-7 victory against his club.

"However, I thought our Cavaliers were extremely gallant," Blackburn said of his own charges. "Purdue is just as good on offense as it is on defense," Blackburn continued, "and the Boilermakers can run or pass on offense equally well. They just seem to have everything."

Virginia's mentor had particularly kind words for Purdue quarterback Mike Phipps and reserve fullback John Bullock who is only a sophomore. Blackburn thought Phipps pin-point passing left little to be desired on the part of Purdue.

"When we scouted Purdue last spring," Blackburn related, "we came back thinking that Bullock is actually a better ball carrier than Williams (Purdue's first-string fullback, Perry). Now Williams is a complete ball player---a really great blocker and everything else. But that Bullock runs with the speed and agility of a halfback and the power of a fullback."

Blackburn thought that Purdue's second unit "was really out to show Mollenkopf that they deserve a starting assignment." They actually played better than Purdue's first unit at times, according to Blackburn.

Making no excuses, Blackburn thought his club played admirably in the first half. "But when Purdue came back, it came back furiously," the headman of the Cavaliers testified.

COACHES' QUOTES ON DUKE-VIRGINIA:

George Blackburn:

"We think we controlled the game with our running attack and we knew we had to going into the game.

"I think it's obvious that we have three fine running backs in Quayle, Anderson and Arnette. You saw what happened when they keyed on Quayle, Anderson or Arnette break for good yardage.

"If there was a key to the game--as far as we're concerned--I think it was Paul Reede's interception of Harp's bomb in the end zone. It appeared he actually took the ball away from the Duke receiver (Chesson) in mid-air. If Duke had gotten that touchdown, they would have been back in the game because it was 28-14 at the time.

"That Hart can really throw the football. He's a real fine football player and if they had had Courtillet, it would almost have been impossible to cover him. Duke did an outstanding job throwing the football.

"The reason Quayle didn't play too much in the second half was because he had severe cramps in his thighs. I think Quayle is a complete football player. He's great inside and out and can run, catch the football and he tells me he can pass. Maybe we'll let him do just that. The real key to Quayle is his tremendous acceleration.

After Blackburn-Virginia completely outmanned Duke, Blackburn looked at the questioner and stated, "I'm sorry...my mother didn't raise any stupid children."

Tom Harp:

To replay remark of Blackburn that "football is a great game."

"It's a great game, George, if you're going to enjoy weeks like last week you're going to have to endure games like this.

"They boomed our defense pretty effectively. They executed well. I'm disappointed that we weren't able to contain them better.

"We weren't supposed to beat anybody but we pulled a couple surprises and a lot of people got excited. The loss of Courtillet hurt us but we felt going into the game that Virginia had the stronger team.

"However, our approach this season has been that you don't have to have the best team to win.

"We didn't go into the game with the idea that they were going to beat us. They have an excellent team--they played well, we not as well.

To question about pass in end zone ruled Virginia interception: "If our boy (Chesson) didn't know if he had it, he didn't have it.

"We decided to put Chesson at flanker last Saturday night. I thought we moved the ball well but we always have the length of the field to move it in. We've got to play better defense. We're still 2-2 and (facetiously) we might win one more game and we might finish out of the cellar and it might as well not be as bad..."

EARLE EDWARDS

"We are delighted to win this one. We had a great deal of concern about Virginia and their ability. It's ironic that our first shutout in a few years came against a good offensive team like Virginia. Maybe this kind of day helped us.

We ~~are~~^{were} pleased with our defense against their rush. We have had a weakness against the rush all year. We did well today. It was hard to pass on a day like today.

Our offense did a pretty good job. I was disappointed that we always had fourth and ones in the second half. But we fired out well and had some good blocking. Virginia deals a lot and it is hard to pick up. Our offensive line deserves a lot of credit. Bill Sultz (offensive line coach) has worked hard with them. At the beginning ^{of the year} we were ~~amazed~~ concerned about the defensive secondary and the offensive line. The offensive line had taken a lot of pride in their work and they deserve it. They have worked hard with a good attitude.

We have played together better the last couple of weeks after that bad effort at Dallas. We were all embarrassed about that. WE, the players and coaches, got together and decided to play like we can. We had to stop all that foolishness.

Our kicking game was good. Some of our men just have played better. Solonoski, Hudson, Follweiler ~~and~~ in addition to Carpenter and Capuano. We haven't had Mike Hikka the last two games and Pete Bailey deserves a lot of credit for his play. We had good linebacking today. It was pretty much of a relief.

We hit out hard the first half. There was no reason for letting down with a ten point lead.

We were afraid of Quayle. He is a fine football player. They have others also. We went ahead with our regular defense. We had to stop their wide play. If they get outside, it ~~will~~ eliminates a good bit of the defense and makes it one-on-one. We did well in this area today.

George Blackburn:

"There's no way you can explain away defeat--we just got licked. They out-footballed us. Football's a ^{crazy} ~~easy~~ game. It's how it unfolds and it unfolded against us.

"When a team jumps out in front like State did today on a day like this it's hard to catch them.

"We have no excuses because of the weather--both teams have to play in it--they just beat us with good solid football.

"The footing didn't bother their backs so it shouldn't have affected Quayle or Anderson.

"The fumble in the first quarter hurts us. We're in scoring range around their 30 with a 7-0 deficit. It certainly didn't help us, but that's football.

"We of course knew about Warren, and his two field goals put it further out of range. Later on we have to gamble to get back in the ball game and they intercept and carry it in to take us out of it completely.

"But we still think we're in the ACC championship picture. State still ~~had~~ ^{has} a few toughies. We're not giving up.

COACHES POST-GAME REMARKS

COACH BLACKBURN: "All I can say is that South Carolina played one helluva football game. Those two sneak passes to Galloway really broke our backs. We made a lot of mistakes and they took advantage of them. I thought our kids played courageously if not well. It's one of those games you just dread."

COACH DIETZEL: "We have been waiting all season to put it all together. We had a great defensive effort against Georgia and great offense against Florida State, but today we put the offense and the defense together. We still have some tough spots, like allowing Virginia to score three times on fourth down, but we intercepted five passes and Wally Orrel must have made 20 tackles. He had a great day and so did our big sophomore tackle, Rusty Ganas. Zeigler was fantastic. We weren't trying to score again throwing to him in the last series. He had caught 11 passes to tie our school record and we just wanted to get the ball to him one more time so he could set the record. Suggs gets better each week. He set an ACC and school record with five TD passes. Virginia is a fine football team and Grayle is a great football player. We contained him rather well, except that one time he broke loose on that pass, which is a tribute to our defense."

COACHES QUOTES

George Blackburn: "I held our kids on the bus before we went into the dressing room and told them not to get off the bus if they didn't want to play football in the rain. They all got off. I also told them while they were on the bus that the coaching staff knew they had the tools and to play football. We were conservative playing State under the same condition that prevailed today and I take full blame for that.

The margin of victory really surprised me. I thought the football game would be much closer. It proved that we can play in the rain.

After our first touchdown I told the offense that the score was still 0-0 because the score came too easy.

Carolin's defense was conducive to the dive and spit-out option play and we got great blocking from our front wall. It all fell into place.

Our defense was embarrassed from last week. They really played well. Our four interceptions show that although they had to begin to throw when they got behind. As the game unfolded it went real well for us.

I thought Rick Brand played real well for us and probably had his best game this year. The game balls were given to two seniors, Rick Constantine, defensive tackle and Paul Rogers, offensive tackle.

The coaching staff was sitting last night listening to the weather report and they said that it would be 56 degrees with wind 10-15 and zero precipitation. It was just the reverse as it turned out but we played good football in it.

It hurt to be taken out of the championship picture last week but we play every game as if it was one for the title. That's the only way to play football.

COACH BILL DOONEY: "We caught Virginia on the rebound and took a bad licking. I congratulate the Virginia team. They certainly had an awful good day.

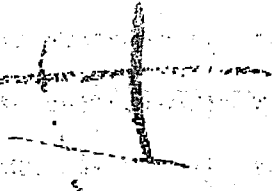
"It was a very poor game for us, and I take the blame for it. If we can't go into a game with a better mental attitude than that and execute better than we did, then it's my fault as the coach. I told my squad that I was going to do a better job from now on and I'm going to count on them to do a better job on the field.

"We made entirely too many mistakes to win any football game. It certainly was one of our poorest performances of the season. Again, however, I want to emphasize that Virginia played well and deserves a lot of credit.

COACHES REMARKS

COACH GEORGE BLACKBURN: "We've had some track meets this year but this tops them all. It seemed we couldn't make any mistakes offensively. A lot of credit has to be given to the Tulane ball club, lesser ball clubs could easily have folded. I thought that Arnette, Anderson and Quayle were outstanding. This win may have really launched Virginia football;; we are assured of our first winning season since 1952. This win has finally broken our psychological barrier about .500 football. The scoring in this game must be some kind of record, 110 points is a lot to put on the scoreboard. Despite our 63 points this was our closest game of the year."
Note: The ball players carried Mr. Blackburn off the field at the games end.

COACH JIM PITTMAN:

"That was a helluva defensive battle. Sure, Virginia has a fine offensive team-- anytime som ebody scores 63 points against you you have to admit they have a pretty fine offense. Quayle had a great game, and I was particularly impressed with Arnette, especially the way he could get the ball to Quayle when it was important. Wayne Francingues did a tremendous job scrambling for us. Next year's game in New Orleans, well, I guess people who like to see a lot of scoring should come out."
