FOR OPENERS

- The Virginia-Virginia Tech game is part of the Commonwealth Clash presented by Virginia529, which is a head-to-head, points-based competition between the athletic teams of the Cavaliers and Hokies.
- UVA currently is riding an 11-game winning streak this season and also has a seven-game winning streak against Virginia Tech.
- As of Jan. 3, UVA ranks sixth nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.77), eighth in scoring defense (59.6 ppg), 11th in field goal percentage (50.5%), 13th in turnover margin (4.5) and 3-point field goal percentage (41.1%), 15th in free throw percentage (75.8%) and 19th in scoring margin (19.1).

MORE ON THE COMMONWEALTH CLASH

- The Commonwealth Clash encourages a friendly, statewide rivalry between the two schools across all school-sponsored sports with 21 individual event points on the line.
- The school that accumulates 11 points or more will be crowned the winner and take home the Virginia529 Commonwealth Clash trophy.
- The UVA-VT game is worth a half point in the Clash.
- The score for this year's Clash is Virginia 3.5 and Virginia Tech 1.5.
- UVA claimed the inaugural Commonwealth Clash 15-7 last season.

ALL-TIME AGAINST VIRGINIA TECH

- Virginia is 88-53 all-time vs. Virginia Tech in the series that dates back to 1914-15.
- UVA has won seven straight games against Virginia Tech, including two wins last season, and nine of the last 10 contests in the series.
- The Cavaliers are 20-28, including a 7-14 mark at Cassell Coliseum, against the Hokies in Blacksburg.
- Virginia has a four-game road winning streak against the Hokies.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 9-3 all-time vs. Virginia Tech.
- Malcolm Brogdon is Virginia's current career leading scorer against the Hokies, averaging 14 points in six career games.
- Anthony Gill has averaged 10 points and 5.3 rebounds in six career games vs. the Hokies.

LAST TIME VS. VIRGINIA TECH

- Malcolm Brogdon tallied 19 points and Anthony Gill and Darion added 16 points apiece as then-No. 2 Virginia topped Virginia Tech 69-57 in ACC action on Feb. 28, 2015.
- The Cavaliers clinched a share of their second consecutive ACC regular season title.
- London Perrantes added 11 points and six assists after missing the previous game at Wake Forest due to injury.
- Virginia shot 51.1 percent and went 6-13 from 3-point range.
- The Cavaliers limited the Hokies to 38.3 percent shooting.
- Adam Smith led Virginia Tech with 19 points and Ahmed Hill added 10 points.

LAST TIME OUT

- Malcolm Brogdon scored 24 points and Anthony Gill added 21 as No. 5 Virginia won its eighth straight ACC opener in a 77-66 win over Notre Dame on Jan. 2.
- Mike Tobey added 15 points and six rebounds off the bench and UVA outscored Notre Dame 38-22 in the paint.
- UVA held a 30-25 rebounding advantage.
- The Cavaliers shot 57.1 percent and committed just seven turnovers.
- Demetrius Jackson led the Fighting Irish with 18 points and six assists.
- Steve Vasturia and Bonzie Colson added 14 points apiece, while V.J. Beachem tallied 10 points.

ALL-TIME VS. THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA

- Since the 1999-2000 season, Virginia has a 58-13 record (2-0 in 2015-16) against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- UVA posted wins over George Mason (83-66) and William & Mary (67-52) this season.
- UVA has a 12-game winning streak against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia with its last loss coming against VCU on Nov. 12, 2013 (59-56 at JPJ).

VIRGINIA'S RANKED NO. 5 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 5 in the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls for the second straight week.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in five consecutive polls after falling out the top 10 on Nov. 23 for the first time since Feb. 24, 2014.
- UVA had been ranked in the top 10 in 25 consecutive AP polls since March 3, 2014, its longest span since 49 straight from 1980-83.
- The Cavaliers' No. 6 preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.
- Virginia has been ranked in the preseason top-10 in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1981-82 and 1982-83.
- UVA has finished in the top 10 (No. 3 in 2014 & No. 6 in 2015) in the final AP rankings in back-to-back seasons for the first time since three straight seasons from 1981-83.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett sports a 148-65 mark in seven seasons at Virginia and 217-98 career mark in 10 seasons.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett was also named ACC Coach of the Year, NABC District 2 Coach of the Year and USBWA District 3 Coach of the Year for the second consecutive year.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to four consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014 and 2015, and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett-coached teams are 76-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 10-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top five nationally in six of nine seasons.
- Bennett is one of 26 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 79-24 (.767) in non-conference action and 92-20 (.821) at home under Tony Bennett.

VIRGINIA BASKETBALL GETTING OFFENSIVE

- Virginia is averaging 75.7 points per game, its most since 76.8 ppg in 2007-08.
- As of Jan. 3, UVA ranks Nos. 1 and 3 in the KenPom.com adjusted and overall offensive efficiency ratings, respectively.
- UVA is shooting 50.5 percent from the field (best since 50.3% in 1983-84), 41.1 percent from 3-point range (best in school history) and 75.8 percent from the free throw line (best since 76.2% in 1978-79)
- Virginia has scored 80 or more points in six games, its most since 11 in 2007-08.
- UVA's 86 points against Villanova were its most scored against a top-25 opponent since tallying 87 in a road win at Minnesota in 2010-11.
- UVA has shot 55 percent or better in six games in 2015-16 after achieving the feat three times in 34 games in 2014-15 and four times in 37 games in 2013-14.
- The Cavaliers scored 82 or more points in three straight games (Nov. 19-22 at Charleston Classic) for the first time since the first three games of the 2001-02 season.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better from 3-point range in five games.

'HOO ARE THESE WAHOOS?

- Senior All-America candidate Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA in scoring for the third consecutive season at a career-best 16.8 points per game, while All-ACC performer Anthony Gill is averaging a career high 15.2 points.
- Brogdon has six 20-point efforts, including a career-high 28 at George Washington, and Gill has reached double figures in scoring in all 13 games.

- London Perrantes is averaging career highs in points (10.4), field goal percentage (49.4%) and 3-point field goal percentage (55%).
- UVA has out-rebounded its opponents in nine of its 12 wins.
- Nine players are averaging nine or more minutes per game.
- Eight players have each scored 11 or more points in a game.

ALL-AMERICAN BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Preseason co-ACC Player of the Year Malcolm Brogdon is aiming to become the first UVA player since Sean Singletary (2006–08) to lead UVA in scoring for three straight seasons.
- Brogdon's 16.8 scoring average is the highest for UVA since Mike Scott's 18.0 ppg in 2011-12.
- Brogdon was named a preseason All-American by The Sporting News (1st team), Blue Ribbon Yearbook (1st team), CBSSports.com (2nd team), NBCSports.com (2nd team), Bleacher Report (2nd team), USA Today (3rd team) and CollegeInsider.com.
- In 2014-15, Brogdon averaged 14.0 points and 3.9 rebounds en route to All-America second-team and All-ACC first-team accolades.
- The two-time All-ACC performer, who was a John Wooden Award finalist last season, ranks 25th on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,352 points in 112 career games (12.1 career ppg).
- Brogdon ranks second on UVA's career free-throw percentage list at 85.7% (324-for-378).
- Brogdon is a candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award and Wooden Citizen Cup Award.
- Brogdon helped Team USA to a bronze medal at the 2015 Pan American Games in Toronto.
- The redshirt senior earned a degree in history and is pursuing a master's degree in public policy from the Frank Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy.

LONDON CALLING THE SHOTS

- Junior point guard London Perrantes is enjoying a breakout season in 2015-16.
- Perrantes has hit double figures in scoring in six of his last nine games, including a season-high 19 points vs. Villanova.
- He tallied his second career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 11 assists against George Mason en route to MVP honors at the Charleston Classic.
- Perrantes is shooting a career-best 55 percent (22-40) from 3-point range and has a career 3.2 assist-to-turnover ratio (339 assists, 107 turnovers) in 80 career games.
- \bullet He missed the Ohio State and William & Mary contests due to an appendectomy.
- Perrantes averaged 6.4 points and 4.6 assists en route to honorable mention All-ACC honors last season.
- He set career highs in points (26) and 3-pointers (5) at Miami (1/3/15).
- Perrantes earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.

DARIUS SHOWING VARIOUS SKILLS

- Darius Thompson has averaged 8.1 points, 2.2 rebounds, 1.9 assists and a team-leading 1.3 steals in his first season at UVA.
- Thompson is shooting 40 percent (10-25) from 3-point range after shooting 19.5 percent (8-41) from downtown at Tennessee in 2013-14.

2015-16 Opponents in Bold

- He had a five-game double figure scoring streak from Nov. 25-Dec. 19, and tallied 12 points in four of 11 games.
- Thompson sat out as a transfer last season after averaging 2.6 points and 2.4 assists in 37 games at Tennessee in 2013-14.
- Thompson had 12 points, six rebounds, four assists and three steals in his UVA debut as a starter vs. Morgan State.

GILL THRILLS

- Preseason All-ACC second-team selection Anthony Gill is averaging career highs in points (15.2), field goal percentage (59.5%) and free throw percentage (76.9%).
- Gill leads UVA in rebounding (6.3 rpg) and field goal percentage (59.5%).
- Gill has led UVA in scoring in six games, including the last five of the last six.
- Gill is first UVA player to score in double figures in first 13 games of a season since Sean Singletary scored 10 or more points in all 33 games during 2007-08.
- Gill earned ACC Player of the Week honors after tallying 20 points and 12 rebounds vs. West Virginia for his fourth career doubledouble.
- Gill averaged 11.6 points and 6.5 rebounds en route to All-ACC third-team (media) honors in 2014-15.
- Gill's team-leading 29 steals helped earn him a spot on the coaches' All-ACC Defensive Team in 2014-15.
- Gill, who has led UVA in field goal percentage in each of the past two seasons, is shooting 58.7 percent during his UVA career.
- Gill has amassed 1,147 career points in three seasons at UVA and one at South Carolina.

HALL OF A SPARK OFF THE BENCH

- Redshirt sophomore guard Devon Hall has earned increased playing time this season for UVA.
- Hall has played in all 13 games this season and is averaging 18.4 minutes after averaging 10.6 minutes in 23 contests last season.
- Hall netted a career-high 13 points vs. Morgan State and drained a career-best four 3-pointers for 12 points vs. Long Beach State.
- Hall had five points, four assists and three rebounds in a solid allaround outing against Notre Dame.

BROGDON AND GILL ON WOODEN AWARD WATCH LIST

- Malcolm Brogdon and Anthony Gill are among 50 players on the preseason 2016 John R. Wooden Award Watch List, honoring the nation's top player.
- Gill earns his first preseason Wooden Award Watch List honor, while Brogdon was a Wooden Award All-American and finalist last season.
