## FOR OPENERS

-The Virginia-Virginia Tech game is part of the Commonwealth Clash presented by Virginia529, which is a head-to-head, points-based competition between the athletic teams of the Cavaliers and Hokies. - UVA currently is riding an 11-game winning streak this season and also has a seven-game winning streak against Virginia Tech.

- As of Jan. 3, UVA ranks sixth nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.77), eighth in scoring defense ( 59.6 ppg ), 11th in field goal percentage (50.5\%), 13th in turnover margin (4.5) and 3-point field goal percentage ( $41.1 \%$ ), 15th in free throw percentage ( $75.8 \%$ ) and 19th in scoring margin (19.1).


## MORE ON THE COMMONWEALTH CLASH

-The Commonwealth Clash encourages a friendly, statewide rivalry between the two schools across all school-sponsored sports with 21 individual event points on the line.
-The school that accumulates 11 points or more will be crowned the winner and take home the Virginia529 Commonwealth Clash trophy. -The UVA-VT game is worth a half point in the Clash.

- The score for this year's Clash is Virginia 3.5 and Virginia Tech 1.5.
- UVA claimed the inaugural Commonwealth Clash 15-7 last season.


## ALL-TIME AGAINST VIRGINIA TECH

- Virginia is 88 -53 all-time vs. Virginia Tech in the series that dates back to 1914-15.
- UVA has won seven straight games against Virginia Tech, including two wins last season, and nine of the last 10 contests in the series.
- The Cavaliers are 20-28, including a $7-14$ mark at Cassell Coliseum, against the Hokies in Blacksburg.
- Virginia has a four-game road winning streak against the Hokies. - Head coach Tony Bennett is 9-3 all-time vs. Virginia Tech.
- Malcolm Brogdon is Virginia's current career leading scorer against the Hokies, averaging 14 points in six career games.
- Anthony Gill has averaged 10 points and 5.3 rebounds in six career games vs. the Hokies.

## LAST TIME VS. VIRGINIA TECH

- Malcolm Brogdon tallied 19 points and Anthony Gill and Darion added 16 points apiece as then-No. 2 Virginia topped Virginia Tech 69-57 in ACC action on Feb. 28, 2015.
- The Cavaliers clinched a share of their second consecutive ACC regular season title.
- London Perrantes added 11 points and six assists after missing the previous game at Wake Forest due to injury.
- Virginia shot 51.1 percent and went 6-13 from 3-point range.
-The Cavaliers limited the Hokies to 38.3 percent shooting.
- Adam Smith led Virginia Tech with 19 points and Ahmed Hill added 10 points.


## LAST TIME OUT

- Malcolm Brogdon scored 24 points and Anthony Gill added 21 as No. 5 Virginia won its eighth straight ACC opener in a $77-66$ win over Notre Dame on Jan. 2.
- Mike Tobey added 15 points and six rebounds off the bench and UVA outscored Notre Dame 38-22 in the paint.
- UVA held a 30-25 rebounding advantage.
- The Cavaliers shot 57.1 percent and committed just seven turnovers. - Demetrius Jackson led the Fighting lrish with 18 points and six assists.
- Steve Vasturia and Bonzie Colson added 14 points apiece, while V.J. Beachem tallied 10 points.


## ALL-TIME VS. THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA

- Since the 1999-2000 season, Virginia has a $58-13$ record ( $2-0$ in 2015-16) against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia. - UVA posted wins over George Mason (83-66) and William \& Mary (67-52) this season.
- UVA has a 12 -game winning streak against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia with its last loss coming against VCU on Nov. 12, 2013 ( $59-56$ at JPJ).

## VIRGINIA'S RANKED NO. 5 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 5 in the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls for the second straight week.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in five consecutive polls after falling out the top 10 on Nov. 23 for the first time since Feb. 24, 2014. - UVA had been ranked in the top 10 in 25 consecutive AP polls since March 3, 2014, its longest span since 49 straight from 1980-83.
- The Cavaliers' No. 6 preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.
-Virginia has been ranked in the preseason top-10 in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1981-82 and 1982-83.
- UVA has finished in the top 10 ( $N o .3$ in 2014 \& No. 6 in 2015) in the final AP rankings in back-to-back seasons for the first time since three straight seasons from 1981-83.


## VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett sports a 148-65 mark in seven seasons at Virginia and 217-98 career mark in 10 seasons.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett was also named ACC Coach of the Year, NABC District 2 Coach of the Year and USBWA District 3 Coach of the Year for the second consecutive year.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to four consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014 and 2015, and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett-coached teams are 76-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 10-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 \& 2014-15), and finished in the top five nationally in six of nine seasons.
- Bennett is one of 26 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 79-24 (.767) in non-conference action and 92-20 (.821) at home under Tony Bennett.


## VIRGINIA BASKETBALL GETTING OFFENSIVE

- Virginia is averaging 75.7 points per game, its most since 76.8 ppg in 2007-08.
- As of Jan. 3, UVA ranks Nos. 1 and 3 in the KenPom.com adjusted and overall offensive efficiency ratings, respectively.
- UVA is shooting 50.5 percent from the field (best since $50.3 \%$ in 1983-84), 41.1 percent from 3-point range (best in school history) and 75.8 percent from the free throw line (best since $76.2 \%$ in 1978-79).
- Virginia has scored 80 or more points in six games, its most since 11 in 2007-08.
- UVA's 86 points against Villanova were its most scored against a top-25 opponent since tallying 87 in a road win at Minnesota in 2010-11.
- UVA has shot 55 percent or better in six games in 2015-16 after achieving the feat three times in 34 games in 2014-15 and four times in 37 games in 2013-14.
- The Cavaliers scored 82 or more points in three straight games (Nov. 19-22 at Charleston Classic) for the first time since the first three games of the 2001-02 season.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better from 3-point range in five games.


## 'HOO ARE THESE WAHOOS?

- Senior All-America candidate Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA in scoring for the third consecutive season at a career-best 16.8 points per game, while All-ACC performer Anthony Gill is averaging a career high 15.2 points.
- Brogdon has six 20-point efforts, including a career-high 28 at George Washington, and Gill has reached double figures in scoring in all 13 games.

## ALL-AMERICAN BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Preseason co-ACC Player of the Year Malcolm Brogdon is aiming to become the first UVA player since Sean Singletary (2006-08) to lead UVA in scoring for three straight seasons.
- Brogdon's 16.8 scoring average is the highest for UVA since Mike Scott's 18.0 ppg in 2011-12.
- Brogdon was named a preseason All-American by The Sporting News (1st team), Blue Ribbon Yearbook (1st team), CBSSports.com (2nd team), NBCSports.com (2nd team), Bleacher Report (2nd team), USA Today (3rd team) and Collegelnsider.com.
- In 2014-15, Brogdon averaged 14.0 points and 3.9 rebounds en route to All-America second-team and All-ACC first-team accolades.
- The two-time All-ACC performer, who was a John Wooden Award finalist last season, ranks 25th on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,352 points in 112 career games ( 12.1 career ppg).
- Brogdon ranks second on UVA's career free-throw percentage list at 85.7\% (324-for-378).
- Brogdon is a candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award and Wooden Citizen Cup Award.
- Brogdon helped Team USA to a bronze medal at the 2015 Pan American Games in Toronto.
- The redshirt senior earned a degree in history and is pursuing a master's degree in public policy from the Frank Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy


## LONDON CALLING THE SHOTS

- Junior point guard London Perrantes is enjoying a breakout season in 2015-16.
- Perrantes has hit double figures in scoring in six of his last nine games, including a season-high 19 points vs. Villanova.
- He tallied his second career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 11 assists against George Mason en route to MVP honors at the Charleston Classic
- Perrantes is shooting a career-best 55 percent (22-40) from 3-point range and has a career 3.2 assist-to-turnover ratio (339 assists, 107 turnovers) in 80 career games.
- He missed the Ohio State and William \& Mary contests due to an appendectomy.
- Perrantes averaged 6.4 points and 4.6 assists en route to honorable mention All-ACC honors last season.
- He set career highs in points (26) and 3-pointers (5) at Miami (1/3/15).

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett, the visiting head coach and two Virginia student-athletes will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game, followed by the visiting head coach and two Virginia student-athletes. Other Virginia players will be available upon request in the Courtside Club after the Virginia student-athletes' press conference.

## RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.
