### VIRGINIA-DUKE SERIES

- Virginia holds a 94-54-1 edge in its all-time series with Duke.
- UVa is 27-8 against Duke under the current coaching staff (since 2004) and has won 16 of the last 18 contests against the Blue Devils dating to 2009.
- Since 2009 UVa has won its last six series against Duke.
- The Cavaliers have won eight straight home series against Duke; the Blue Devils split an abbreviated series in Charlottesville in 1997.

### SENIOR DAY CEREMONIES SUNDAY

- Virginia will conduct Senior Day ceremonies Sunday prior to the series finale.
- Fourth-years Kevin Radford, Kenny Towns and Thomas Woodruff each will be feted with their families.
- Radford (economics), Towns (history) and Woodruff (mechanical engineering) are slated to graduate next week, as is junior Brandon Waddell (economics), who is on track to graduate in three years.

### FINAL FOUR HOME GAMES ON TAP

- Virginia is slated for its final four home games of the regular season in the next week.
- Because of the wacky weather year, Virginia has played just 17 home games, which is fourth fewest among teams in the top 40 in the RPI (Bradley 12, Iowa 14, Missouri State 16).
- Virginia has played at least 30 home games in each of the last 11 seasons. UVa is on track to finish with just 21 home games – fewest since 1984 (20).

### THAISS LOOKS TO CONTINUE STRONG STRETCH

- Matt Thaiss had perhaps his best week in a Virginia uniform in UVa's last full week, going 11-for-23 (.478) with four doubles, a homer and 11 RBI in five games from April 21-26. He was then tabbed ACC Player of the Week.
- He had seven hits in the NC State series, including a four-hit day on April 26 during the doubleheader with the Wolfpack.
- He reached base safely in over half his plate appearances, (.538 OBP).
- Thaiss now leads the team in batting at .333 (12th in the ACC).

### PLAYING IT CLOSE

- Twelve of Virginia's 18 defeats have come by two runs or fewer, including seven games by one run. UVa is 4-9 in ACC games decided by two or fewer.
- UVa's final five losses in April all were by two runs or fewer.

### ODDS AND ENDS

- UVa is 5-6 in its first game back following the exam break under Brian O'Connor.
- UVa is No. 33 in the latest NCAA RPI (Duke is No. 53).
- In the final six games leading to the break, UVa's starting pitchers went 3-1 with a 2.70 ERA and .221 opponent batting average.
- UVa ranks 15th nationally in average home attendance (3,424/game).
- Virginia owns the fifth-most wins away from home (road/neutral) in Division I (19).

### COMAN TAKES HOT STREAK INTO BREAK

- Robbie Coman is batting .426 (20-for-50) over his last 13 games. He leads the team in on-base percentage (.481) and hits during that span.
- He has raised his batting average nearly 80 points in that stretch – he was batting .208 heading into the Georgia Tech series and now is hitting .287.
- He was 5-for-10 with three walks in the NC State series.
- Coman's career-best eight-game hit streak was snapped at ODU.

### LINEUP DOMINATED BY FRESHMEN

- Virginia has put at least four freshmen in 41 of the 45 starting lineups this year, including eight games with five rookies and three contests with six.
- Adam Haseley (RF/CF) and Pavin Smith (1B/LF) have started every game.
- UVA has had first-years in all three outfield positions in eight games.
- Fourteen of UVA's 30 players are freshmen.

### INJURIES FORCE CAVALIERS TO JUGGLE LINEUP

- Virginia has been forced to alter its lineup as injuries have hampered three of its returning starters.
- The Cavaliers have trotted out 27 different starting lineups in 45 games, including each of the last seven.
- Kenny Towns (3B) is the lone Cavalier to start every game at the same position, while freshmen Pavin Smith and Adam Haseley also have started every game.

### THE WALKING WOUNDED

- Virginia position players have combined to miss 129 games because of injuries this season.
- Three returning starters have missed significant time:
  - OF Joe McCarthy had back surgery in late January and missed 11 weeks (35 games) prior to his return April 15.
  - C Robbie Coman injured his knee on Feb. 21 and missed eight games. He missed the April 1 game vs. VMI after taking a grounder to the eye in batting practice.
  - INF/OF John La Prise is out for the season with a hip injury that limited him to four games early this season.
- 2B/OF Ernie Clement missed seven games recently with a hamstring injury.
- Matt Thaiss suffered an ankle injury April 12 but missed only one game. Daniel Pinero was hit in the chin with a pitch April 21 and missed the next game.
- INF Jack Gerstenmaier (hamstring) made his season debut April 15 after undergoing hamstring surgery in late September (missed 35 games).

### KIRBY, CASEY SIDELINED BY INJURIES

- In addition to the position player injuries, starting pitchers Nathan Kirby and Derek Casey each have gone down recently with injuries.
- A 2014 First-Team All-American and ACC Co-Pitcher of the Year, Kirby exited after three innings April 17 against Miami with a strained left lat muscle and will miss approximately 6-8 weeks.
- Casey left after 2 2/3 innings in his April 21 start against Longwood with an undisclosed injury. His status is unknown at this time.
- Pitcher Riley Wilson (shoulder) also has been sidelined and has not played this season.

### MCCARTHY, GERSTENMAIER ADD SPARK TO LINEUP

- Junior OF Joe McCarthy and freshman INF Jack Gerstenmaier returned to the Cavaliers' lineup April 15 against William & Mary after missing the first 35 games with injuries.
- McCarthy missed 11 weeks following back surgery on Jan. 29, while Gerstenmaier was out since late September following hamstring surgery.
- McCarthy has started all 10 games since returning, while Gerstenmaier has started at second base in six games..
- A two-time All-ACC selection, McCarthy has now reached base safely in 132 of his 139 career games, including all 10 this season.

### JONES SETTLES INTO NO. 1 ROLE

- In his first season in the UVa rotation, Connor Jones has been solid, with a 5-2 record and 3.53 ERA.
- In 66 1/3 innings, Jones is limiting opponents to a .230 batting average, but he has walked 33 batters.
- Jones matched a career best by working 7 2/3 innings in the Game 2 win last Saturday against then-No. 9 Miami. He also struck out a career-high 11 batters.
- He has worked five innings or more in nine of his 10 starts.

### TOWNS STEPS UP TO MAN CLEANUP SPOT

- Senior Kenny Towns has been UVa's top run producer out of the cleanup spot with a team-high 46 RBI. He ranks sixth in the ACC in RBI, already setting a career high for RBI.
- Towns is batting .294 and also leads the team in doubles (13) and ranks third in hits (53).
- He owns 14 multiple-hit games and a team-leading 13 multiple-RBI games.
- His streak of reaching base safely in 36 straight games came to an end in the first game of the March 7 double-header against Pitt; it ranked fourth in Division I baseball and tops amongst ACC players at the time.

### WEATHER WREAKS HAVOC ON HOME SCHEDULE

- Inclement weather has forced UVa to postpone or cancel four midweek games and relocate three weekend series.
- In all, Virginia has had 14 home games altered because of inclement weather.
- UVa was forced to shift its series with Marist (Feb. 20-22) to Charleston, S.C., and its round-robin tournament with Hartford and Seton Hall to Myrtle Beach.
- UVa played its first home game March 11 (but not until after a two-hour rain delay). UVa's midweek games with VCU, GW and Radford were cancelled.

### HASELEY REBOUNDS FROM SLOW START

- After a slow start at the plate, freshman Adam Haseley has been solid while primarily batting leadoff.
- He hit .169 over his first 15 games, but is batting .299 (38-for-127) in the last 30 games.
- Haseley is batting .288 in 31 games with a .382 on-base percentage as the Cavaliers' leadoff hitter.
- He went 13-for-23 during UVa's five-game road swing from March 25-31, including 7-for-13 (.538) in the Notre Dame series.

### THAISS PROVIDES THUNDER IN UVA LINEUP

- Sophomore catcher Matt Thaiss has given the Cavaliers' lineup a jolt of power this season. He has blasted eight home runs (11th in the ACC).
- Thaiss leads the team in batting (.333), on base percentage (.437) and slugging (.552).
- Thaiss is batting .337 in ACC games (second on team, 17th in ACC).

## HOME RUN TRACKER

- Virginia has hit 27 home runs through 45 games, with nine players going deep thus far.
- This mirrors the uptick in home runs across the country this season. The NCAA reported recently that home runs are up 39 percent this year.
- UVa home runs are up 31 percent compared to this point last season. The Cavaliers hit 18 home runs through 41 games and finished with 33 long balls in 69 games in 2014.
- In contrast, UVa pitchers gave up 23 home runs last year and have surrendered 26 this year.

## DOHERTY GIVES CAVALIERS ANOTHER OPTION

- Junior Kevin Doherty has given Virginia a boost this season, both on the mound at the plate.
- He has been one of UVa's top left-handed options out of the bullpen, pitching in 14 games, which is third most on the team (1-1, 3.16 ERA, 2 saves, 31.1 IP, 24 K, .187 BAA).
- Doherty also has stepped this year at the plate. He has batted in 27 games, including 24 starts.
- He has reached base safely in 22 of his 27 games this season and is batting .253 with 15 RBI.

## VETERAN WADDELL SLATED FOR 46TH START

- Brandon Waddell has been a consistent presence in UVa's rotation in his three seasons. This marks his 38th straight regular-season weekend start, dating to opening day in 2013.
- Waddell is scheduled to make his 46th career start Saturday. That is fifth most in program history.
- Waddell has an 18-10 career record and needs a pair of wins to reach the top 10 in UVa history.

- He ranks ninth in program history with 258 1/3 career innings and with 5 1/3 innings will match eighth-place Jeff Kamrath (2001-03, 2005).
- The veteran is on track to graduate in three years from UVa next week with a degree in economics.

## WALKS WILL HAUNT

- Virginia's pitching staff has been plagued at times by walks this year. UVa has walked six or more batters in 13 games (UVa is 3-10 in those games).
- UVa walked 34 batters in the three-game series with Florida State and 22 in the series at Georgia Tech.
- Those two series featured the most walks in a three-game series during Brian O'Connor's tenure – the previous high was 21 in a 2007 series vs NC State.
- UVa ranked No. 1 nationally in walks/hits per nine innings (WHIP) at 1.03 last year and was tops in the ACC in fewest walks per nine innings (2.88).

## FRESHMEN PROVIDE BOOST

- Virginia's freshmen have played a key role this year.
- UVa's first-year players have combined to record 47.6 percent of the position player starts and 48.6 percent of the at bats.
- The first-years also are responsible for 45 percent of the hits and 43.7 percent of the runs scored.

## SBORZ PUTS HIS STAMP ON CLOSER ROLE

- Josh Sborz moved into the bullpen and the closer role this season and has recorded an ACC-best 12 saves.
- Sborz is limiting opponents to a .145 batting average and has been named to the Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List.
- He went 6-4 with a 2.92 ERA in 17 games (15 starts) during the 2014 season, primarily as the Saturday starter.
- Sborz took over for All-American Nick Howard, who saved an ACC-record 20 games last year and was taken 19th overall by the Cincinnati Reds in the MLB Draft.
- UVa closers own 155 saves in the 12 seasons under the current coaching staff (13.5 saves per season).
- Six of the seven closers since 2004 have been selected in the MLB Draft, including five in the top 10 rounds.

## LA PRISE OUT FOR SEASON

- Virginia INF/OF John La Prise had hip surgery on April 1 and will miss the remainder of the season.
- His scheduled recovery period is approximately six months.
- La Prise was slated to be the Cavaliers' starting center fielder heading into the year but played in just four games early this season while battling the injury.
- La Prise batted .348 with 10 doubles and 17 RBI in 2014. He was fifth on the team with 62 hits and had the second-most hits of any returning Cavalier this year.

## CAVALIERS ADD PAIR FROM CLUB TEAM

- With injuries causing some major depth issues early this season, Virginia added a pair of players to the roster. Both were members of the UVa club team.
- Catcher Ben Cassillo, a freshman, is wearing No. 41, while senior infielder Kevin Radford sports No. 5.
- Cassillo is a native of Latham, N.Y., while Radford hails from Norfolk, Va. (Maury HS).

## UVA STARTS SEASON 10-0 FOR FOURTH TIME

- Virginia recorded a 10-0 start for the fourth time in program history – all during Brian O'Connor's 12 seasons as head coach. All 10 games were away from home (three road, seven neutral).
- UVa won 19 consecutive games to begin the 2009 season. That remains the longest win streak at any point in program history.
- UVa won 11 straight to open the 2008 season and 14 straight to begin the 2013 campaign.
- The Cavaliers were one of the last two unbeaten teams in the nation, joining Texas A&M.

## CAVALIERS CAPTURE 18-INNING MARATHON

- Virginia defeated Marist 5-4 in 18 innings on Feb. 22 in Charleston, S.C. It is the longest game by innings in program history.
- The previous high was a 17-inning game, ironically also in Charleston, in 2006 against College of Charleston.
- It is believed to be the second-longest game by time (5:08), behind the 2006 CofC game, which lasted 5:19.
- Virginia shut out Marist over the final 11 innings.
- Freshman Christian Lowry's first college hit, a one-out single in the 18th, scored Matt Thaiss with the winning run.

### PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

- Three Cavaliers were named preseason All-Americans: LHP Nathan Kirby, OF Joe McCarthy and LHP Brandon Waddell.
- Kirby was a unanimous first-team All-America selection, while McCarthy and Waddell each were named to various teams.

### KIRBY, WADDELL ON GOLDEN SPIKES WATCH LIST

- Virginia left-handed pitchers Nathan Kirby and Brandon Waddell each were named to the preseason Golden Spikes Award watch list.
- The list consists of 50 players in amateur baseball.
- Virginia is one of seven schools who have multiple players on the list, joining Cal State Fullerton, Florida, Miami, TCU, UCLA and Vanderbilt.
- A preseason First-Team All-American, Kirby was a semifinalist for the 2014 Golden Spikes Award.

### VIRGINIA LANDS NO. 2 RECRUITING CLASS

- Virginia reeled in the No. 2-ranked recruiting class for 2014 according to Baseball America, behind only LSU. It marked the best recruiting ranking in program history.
- The class is comprised of 13 student-athletes.
- Three were selected in the 2014 MLB Draft: RHP Derek Casey (22nd round, St. Louis), 1B/LHP Pavin Smith (32nd round, Colorado) and RHP Tommy Doyle (35th round, Washington).

### WHO'S GONE?

- Virginia has plenty of holes to fill after losing five position players and three key members of its bullpen to the 2014 MLB Draft.
- Virginia had three first-round picks, just the seventh program in the last 20 years to do so in one year: RHP Nick Howard (No. 19), OF Derek Fisher (No. 37) and OF Mike Papi (No. 38).
- UVa also lost OF Brandon Downes (7th round), INF Branden Cogswell (7th), RHP Artie Lewicki (8th), RHP Whit Mayberry (21st) and C Nate Irving (34th).
- With eight players drafted, UVa tied for the second most picks of any school in 2014 (Ole Miss, 9).
- UVa had six players taken in the top 10 rounds – most of any school.

### O'CONNOR LEADS ACTIVE COACHES IN WIN PCT., 13TH ALL-TIME

- Virginia head coach Brian O'Connor is 541-195-2 (.733) in his 12th season in charge of the Cavaliers' program.
- O'Connor's 74.3 percent winning percentage entering the season ranked No. 1 among active Division I head coaches.
- O'Connor also ranks 13th all-time in career winning percentage among all coaches with at least 10 years of head coaching experience.
- Virginia has won at least 39 games in all 11 of O'Connor's seasons, including nine 40-win seasons and four 50-win campaigns.

- With 325 victories since the start of the 2009 season, Virginia owns the most wins of any team in the nation in that span.
- The Cavaliers have won 50 games or more four times in the last five seasons.
