FOR OPENERS

- No. 16 Virginia has a 2-0 record against Atlantic 10 opponents, posting wins against VCU (75-67) and Rhode Island (70-55).
- As of Dec. 14, the Cavaliers rank first nationally in scoring defense (52.6 ppg), seventh in turnovers per game (9.4), 11th in field goal percentage defense (36.7%), 20th in free throw percentage (78%), 21st in fouls per game (15.4) and scoring margin (16.9) and 22nd in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.46).

LAST TIME VS. THE WILDCATS

- Anthony Gill set career highs in points (25) and rebounds (13) as Virginia rallied for an 83-72 win over Davidson on Dec. 30, 2014.
- Virginia trailed by 12 points in the first half, but outscored Davidson 51-36 in the second stanza to record its 12th-straight win.
- Darion Atkins tallied his first career double-double with a season-high 13 points and 10 rebounds.
- Malcolm Brogdon added 16 points and a 12-12 effort from the charity stripe in the win.
- Justin Anderson added 14 points, including four 3-pointers.

ALL-TIME VS. DAVIDSON

- Virginia sports a 12-4 mark, including a 7-2 mark in Charlottesville, against Davidson in the series that dates back to 1920-21.
- UVA has an eight-game winning streak against the Wildcats, including victories in 2013 (70-57 win in Charlotte) and 2014 (83-72 in Charlottesville).
- Virginia has defeated Davidson by 11 or more points in each of the last four contests.

ALL-TIME VS. ATLANTIC 10 CONFERENCE OPPONENTS

- Virginia is 119-80 all-time against current Atlantic 10 members (12-4 vs. Davidson, 2-0 vs. Dayton, 0-3 vs. Fordham, 8-1 vs. George Mason, 26-24 vs. George Washington, 1-2 vs. LaSalle, 2-0 vs. UMass, 2-1 vs. Rhode Island, 52-36 vs. Richmond, 2-6 vs. Saint Joseph's, 0-1 vs. Saint Louis and 12-2 vs. VCU).
- The Cavaliers meet an A-10 opponent for the third time this season, defeating VCU on the road and Rhode Island in the NIT Season Tip-Off championship at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y.
- Tony Bennett is 9-3 all-time vs. Atlantic 10 opponents at UVA.

LAST TIME OUT

- Jevon Carter had 23 points and 10 rebounds, Lamont West scored 22 points and then-No. 18 West Virginia beat then-No. 15 Virginia 68-61 on Dec. 5, sending the Cavaliers to their first loss.
- Dexter Miles Jr. added 12 points for the Mountaineers (8-1).
- Devon Hall led Virginia (8-1) with 19 points and Kyle Guy added 18, all in the second half.
- For the second straight year, West Virginia made it difficult for the Cavaliers to get into a consistent offensive rhythm. Guy missed his first six shots, then hit six 3-pointers in the second half as Virginia overcame an eight-point deficit.
- West hit a baseline jumper and a 3-pointer 1:18 apart to break a 56-all tie and put the Mountaineers ahead to stay. After Ty Jerome sank a 3-pointer to trim Virginia's deficit to 61-59 with 2:33 left, West and Carter sealed the win with free throws.

UVA RANKED NO. 16 IN AP POLL

- UVA is ranked No. 16 in the latest AP and USA Today Coaches' polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 18 in the AP poll for three straight weeks.
- The Cavaliers received votes in the first three AP polls, snapping a streak of 64 consecutive weeks in the AP rankings since Feb. 3, 2014.
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in each of the past three seasons (2014-16).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 155-40 (.795), including a 5-0 mark in 2017-18, in 12 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA has a seven-game home win streak dating back to last year.
- The Cavaliers finished undefeated at home (15-0) in 2015-16.
- UVA is 117-24 (.830), including an 82-9 (.901) mark the past six seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 41-4 in ACC home games over the past five seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for eight straight seasons.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 196-84 (.700) mark in nine seasons at Virginia and 265-117 (.694) career mark in 12 seasons overall.
- Bennett has guided UVA to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances and has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to six consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 108-34 (.761) in non-conference action, 88-50 (.638) in ACC play and 117-24 (.830) at home under Tony Bennett.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA has limited its opponents to 52.6 points per game (2nd best in school history) and has held four of its 2017-18 foes to fewer than 50 points (UNCG, Austin Peay, Vanderbilt and Wisconsin).
- UVA has held each of its nine foes to less than 50 percent shooting.
- The Cavaliers are 68-2 when limiting their opponents to fewer than 50 points under head coach Tony Bennett.
- In 2016-17, Virginia led the nation in scoring defense (56.4 ppg) for the third time under Bennett.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense four times (2008-09, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2016-17) and finished in the top-five nationally in eight of 11 seasons.
- Bennett-coached teams are 93-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 12-year coaching career.

ABOUT THE CAVALIERS

- UVA is led by tri-captains Devon Hall, Isaiah Wilkins and Jack Salt.
- The announcement of Hall, Wilkins and Salt marked the first time in Bennett's 12-year head coaching career where he officially named team captains.
- UVA has averaged 69.4 points per game (second most under Bennett) on offense, while yielding a nation-leading 52.6 ppg (second lowest in school history) on defense.
- UVA has started Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, Hall, Wilkins and Salt in each of its first nine games.
- Guy leads the team in scoring at 16.8 points per game and has scored 13 or more points in eight of nine games, including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) and 21 vs. Lehigh (12/2/17).
- Hall has averaged 12.6 points on 52 percent shooting and a team-leading 92 percent (23 of 25) from the charity stripe.
- Wilkins, who has averaged 7.9 points and a team-high 6.6 rebounds, leads UVA in field goal percentage (61.4%) and has a team-high 11 blocked shots and 11 steals.
- Jerome is averaging 7.3 points and has a team-high 24 assists.
- Salt is averaging 2.8 points and career-best 4.7 rebounds, while graduate transfer Nigel Johnson is averaging 5.6 points after averaging 11.3 points for Rutgers last season.
- Mamadi Diakite (6.6 ppg & 4.1 rpg) and redshirt freshmen De'Andre Hunter (5.9 ppg) and Jay Huff (5.0 ppg) are contributors off the bench.
- Marco Anthony provides depth and fellow rookie Francesco Badocchi is expected to redshirt the 2017-18 season.

ZAY PAVES THE WAY

- Senior forward Isaiah Wilkins is one of the top utility players in college basketball.
- Wilkins has averaged 7.9 points, 6.6 rebounds, 1.9 assists, 1.2 blocked shots and 1.2 steals in 2017-18.

- Wilkins was named the MVP of the NIT Season Tip-Off after scoring a career-high 19 points against Rhode Island (11/24/17) and blocking four shots and scoring eight points against Vanderbilt (11/23/17).
- He tallied eight points, eight rebounds, two assists, one steal and took a team-high three charges at VCU (11/17/17).
- Wilkins added 14 points, six rebounds and three steals vs. Lehigh (12/2/17).
- Wilkins ranks eighth at UVA with 103 career blocked shots.
- In 2016-17, the All-ACC Defensive team honoree led the team in rebounding (6.0 rpg), blocked shots (43) and steals (33), becoming the first Cavalier since Travis Watson in 2002-03 to lead the team in those three categories.
- Wilkins recorded a pair of double-doubles in 2016-17 (13 points, 11 rebounds and career-high tying five blocks vs. Louisville and 10 points, 10 rebounds and four steals vs. Miami).

HALL OF A PLAYER

- Redshirt senior Devon Hall is averaging a career-best 12.6 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.6 assists in 27.3 minutes per game.
- Hall is shooting 52 percent from the floor, 42.9 percent from 3-point range and 92 percent (23 of 25) from the free throw line.
- He scored a career-high 19 points against UNCG (11/10/17) and West Virginia (12/5/17) and added 18 against Rhode Island (11/24/17).
- Hall, who has started 63 consecutive games dating back to last season, has scored in double figures in 25 career games including six games this season.
- In 2016-17, Hall averaged 8.4 points and 4.4 rebounds in 27.4 minutes per game.
- He was named to the 2016-17 All-ACC Academic Team after earning his degree in media studies and is currently enrolled in the Professional Development Program at the Curry School of Education.

THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- Sophomore Kyle Guy is having a breakout season for Virginia.
- Guy leads Virginia in scoring (16.8 ppg), steals (1.4 spg) and 3-pointers (2.9 per game).
- Guy's career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) were the most for a Virginia player since Joe Harris' 36 points vs. Duke in 2012-13.
- Guy has led the Cavaliers in scoring in six contests and has scored 13 or more points in eight games this season.
- Guy is shooting 47.6 percent (77 of 161) from 3-point range during his two-year career and has made five or more 3-pointers in six games.
- Guy needs 23 more 3-pointers to qualify for UVA's career 3-point percentage record set at 42.1 percent set by Keith Freel (107 3-pointers from 2000-01).
- Guy's 7.5 points per game average in his rookie season under head coach Tony Bennett ranked higher than former UVA standouts Malcolm Brogdon (6.7 ppg) and London Perrantes (5.5 ppg).
- Guy has scored 10+ points in 19 games, including a pair of 20-point efforts last season against Pitt and Grambling State.

THE ELECTRIC 70s

- Virginia has scored 70 or more points in five games and is 100-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett. UVA is 96-78 when scoring under 70 points under Bennett.

- Four opponents (Clemson, Georgia Tech, Monmouth, UNC Greensboro and Syracuse) participated in the 2017 National Invitation Tournament.

VIRGINIA PICKED 6TH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish sixth in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked third and finished tied for fifth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in eight of the last nine seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Notre Dame, Miami, Louisville, Virginia, Virginia Tech, Florida State, Georgia Tech, Syracuse, Wake Forest, NC State, Clemson, Boston College and Pittsburgh.

CAVALIERS IN THE NBA

- Justin Anderson (Philadelphia), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn), Mike Scott (Washington) and London Perrantes (Cleveland) are former Cavaliers playing in the NBA this season.
- Brogdon earned 2017 NBA Rookie of the Year honors.
- Scott is in his sixth season (first with Washington) and Harris is in his fourth NBA season (second with Brooklyn), while Anderson is in his third season (second with Philadelphia).
- Perrantes signed a two-way contract with Cleveland and made his NBA debut vs. Atlanta on Dec. 12.
- In addition, Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle is a Virginia alum who

helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984. Carlisle gained his 700th NBA victory on Saturday, Dec. 2.

RECORDS WATCH

- Isaiah Wilkins ranks eighth on UVA's career blocked shots list with 103.
- Wilkins needs six blocked shots to pass Steve Castellan (108 blocks, 1976-79) and Assane Sene (2009-12) for sixth on the list.
- Wilkins has blocked at least one shot in five games this season.

CAVALIERS INK CLARK AND STATTMANN

- Virginia signed guards Kihei Clark (Woodland Hills, Calif./Taft Charter High School) and Kody Statmann (Bentley Park, Queensland, Australia/St. Augustine's College) to National Letters of Intent.
- The 5-9, 155-pound Clark averaged 18.9 points, 7.1 assists and 4.2 rebounds for Taft Charter High School as a junior in 2016-17.
- The 6-7, 178-pound Statmann averaged 31 points to lead the Australian U17 Emus Men's Basketball Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Oceania Championships in Guam.

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 26-31 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era, including an 0-1 record this season (West Virginia).
- The Cavaliers are 141-327 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA will face current ranked foes Duke, Miami, North Carolina and Notre Dame later this season.
- UVA is 1-29 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).
