### FOR OPENERS

- Virginia has a three-game winning streak and plays its first ranked opponent of the season.
- Virginia is 5-12 vs. ranked opponents during the four-year Tony Bennett era.
- The Cavaliers rank second nationally in scoring defense at 51.1 points per game as of Jan. 28.
- The Cavaliers have won 11 consecutive games at John Paul Jones Arena and a win vs. NC State would tie Virginia's longest winning streak of 12 games at the arena set from Jan. 16-Nov. 27, 2007.
- Virginia is 4-1 in its last five games vs. NC State.
- Junior guard Joe Harris leads the ACC in 3-point shooting accuracy at a career-best 46.7 percent.
- The Cavaliers are tied for third in the ACC at 4-2, while NC State is second at 5-2 as of Jan. 28.

### ALL-TIME VS. NC STATE

- NC State holds an 81-58 advantage over Virginia in a series that dates back to 1912-13.
- Virginia is 35-23 against the Wolfpack in Charlottesville, including a 4-0 mark at JPJA.
- Uva and NC State split two games last season as the Cavaliers beat the Wolfpack, 61-60, on Jan. 28, 2012, at JPJA, and NC State beat Uva, 67-64, in the ACC Tournament on March 9, 2012.
- NC State is the only winless ACC team at JPJA.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Uva beat Boston College, 65-51, on Saturday, Jan. 26.
- Justin Anderson scored a career-high 16 points and Akil Mitchell added 16 points and six rebounds to lead the Cavaliers in the win.
- Paul Jespersen added a career-high seven rebounds and Jontel Evans added six assists.
- Virginia shot 77.3% from the floor in the second half, marking a season high for a half and highest since shooting 78.3% (18-of-23) in second half vs. Georgia Tech on Feb. 7, 1984

### EMBRACE THE PACE

- The Cavaliers rank in the top nine nationally in seven defensive categories: points per game (2nd), assists per game (3rd), points per possession (4th), possessions per 40 minutes (4th), field goal percentage (7th), effective field goal percentage (9th) and true shooting percentage (9th).

- Virginia has held seven opponents under 50 points this season.

- The Cavaliers have held four opponents (Tennessee, Mississippi Valley State, Wofford and Florida State) under 40 points this season.

- UVa has held its opponent under 43 percent shooting from the field in 15 of 19 games.

### ALL-TIME VS. ACC OPPONENTS

- Virginia is 504- 678 all-time against current ACC members (9-6 vs. Boston College, 68-52 vs. Clemson, 83-53 vs. Virginia Tech, 48-115 vs. Duke, 18-21 vs. Florida State, 34-38 vs. Georgia Tech, 71-106 vs. Maryland, 5-9 vs. Miami, 50-127 vs. UNC, 58-81 vs. NC State and 60-70 vs. Wake Forest.)

### ACC INDIVIDUAL RANKINGS (AS OF JAN. 28)

- Joe Harris ranks first in the ACC in 3-point shooting accuracy (46.7%), fifth in made 3-point field goals per game (2.2) and seventh in scoring (14.8 ppg).

- Akil Mitchell ranks fourth in rebounding (8.8 rpg) and defensive rebounds per game (6.1), seventh in offensive rebounds per game (2.8) and 25th in scoring (12.3).

- Darion Atkins ranks eighth in blocked shots per game (1.6).

### ACC TEAM NOTES

- The Cavaliers lead the ACC in 3-point field goal accuracy defense at 29.2 percent and rank third in 3-point field goal percentage at 36.8 percent.

- Virginia is shooting 65.8 percent from the free throw in ACC play, compared to 72.3 percent in nonconference action.

- A different UVa player has led the team in scoring in each of the last three games (Harris 17 vs. FSU, Nolte 18 at VT and Mitchell and Anderson 16 each vs. BC)

### HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has posted a 67-46 mark in four seasons at UVa.

- Bennett has a 136-79 career record in seven seasons of collegiate coaching, including a 25-29 mark in ACC action.

- Bennett is 4-1 vs. NC State as head coach of Virginia.

- Duke is the only ACC opponent that Bennett hasn't defeated at UVa.

- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to their first NCAA Tournament since 2007 last season with a 22-10 record, and UVa's 22 wins were the most since 25 in 1994-95.

- UVa's nine ACC wins in 2011-12 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.

- Bennett is one of 18 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

### NO ORDINARY JOE

- Joe Harris is averaging a career-high 14.8 points, 4.1 rebounds and 2.4 assists per game.

- Harris has led UVa in scoring 11 times (19 points at George Mason, 15 points vs. Fairfield, 20 vs. Delaware, 17 vs. Lamar, a season-high 22 at Wisconsin, 20 vs. Green Bay, 13 vs. Tennessee, 18 vs. Old Dominion, 19 vs. North Carolina, 14 at Clemson and 17 vs. Florida State).

- Harris needs 33 points to become the 42nd Cavalier to reach 1,000 career points.

- Harris has led UVa in scoring 23 times and scored in double figures 52 times in 82 career games at Virginia.

- Harris second all-time at UVa in career 3-point shooting accuracy at 41.6 percent.

• Harris is tied for ninth on UVa's career 3-pointer list with 156.

#### **AKIL HAS A FEEL**

- Akil Mitchell is averaging career highs in points (12.3) and rebounds (8.8).
- Mitchell has six double-doubles this season (15-13 vs. Delaware, 14-16 vs. Seattle, 11-10 at Wisconsin, 13-12 vs. Tennessee, 15-12 vs. Morgan State and 10-10 at Wake Forest).
- Mitchell has scored in double figures in 14 of 19 games.
- Mitchell has scored a career-high 20 points two times.
- Mitchell has led UVa in rebounds in 13 games.

#### **CARRYING ON WITHOUT DARION**

- Sophomore forward Darion Atkins has missed the past three games and is out indefinitely with a right leg injury.
- Atkins has started 12 games and is averaging a career-best 6.9 points, 4.3 rebounds and 1.6 blocked shots per game.
- He scored a career-best 17 points vs. Morgan State (12/19/12) and grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds vs. Green Bay (12/1/12).
- UVa is 9-3 with Atkins in the starting lineup.
- Atkins led UVa with 19 blocked shots last season and already has a team-leading 25 this season.

#### **FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**

- Five Virginia freshmen (Justin Anderson, Taylor Barnette, Teven Jones, Evan Nolte and Mike Tobey) have started at least one game this season.
- Nolte leads the newcomers in scoring at 7.2 points per game, followed by Tobey (6.4), Anderson (6.1), Jones (3.5) and Barnette (2.0).
- Anderson is averaging 11.7 points per game and Nolte 9.7 ppg during the last three games.
- UVa freshmen are averaging 23.7 points per game, which marks the most since Cavalier freshmen averaged 27.3 ppg in 2003-04.
- Three different freshmen has led UVa in scoring six times:
  - Mike Tobey (17) vs. Seattle, Nov. 17, 2012
  - Justin Anderson (14) vs. North Texas, Nov. 20, 2012
  - Mike Tobey (19) vs. Wofford, Dec. 30, 2012
  - Mike Tobey (14) at Wake Forest, Jan. 9, 2013
  - Evan Nolte (18) at Virginia Tech, Jan. 24, 2013
  - Justin Anderson (16) vs. Boston College, Jan. 26, 2013
- A freshman has led UVa in rebounding three times:
  - Justin Anderson (9) vs. North Texas, Nov. 20, 2012
  - Mike Tobey (6) and Evan Nolte (6) vs. Wofford, Dec. 30, 2012
  - Evan Nolte (7) vs. Florida State, Jan. 19, 2013
- UVa started three freshmen (Anderson, Tobey and Barnette) in a game vs. George Mason for the first time in school history.

#### **RECORDS WATCH**

- Jontel Evans needs 34 assists to move into ninth on UVa's career list.
- Evans needs 24 steals to tie for 10th on UVa's career list.
- Joe Harris needs three 3-pointers to rank eighth on UVa's career list.
- Harris needs 33 points to become the 42nd member of Virginia's 1,000 point club.

#### **HOLDING FOES UNDER 50**

- Virginia is 7-0 this season when holding opponents under 50 points.
- Virginia is 24-1 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era.
- Last season, Virginia set an ACC record during the shot clock era by holding 11 opponents under 50 points last season.
- The 11 games of holding opponents under 50 points were the most for the Cavaliers in a season since holding 16 opponents under 50 points in 1945-46.

## **THE ELECTRIC 70s**

- Virginia is 30-2 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett.
- The Cavaliers are 34-44 over the past four seasons when scoring under 70 points.

## **60 IS THE NEW 70**

- UVa is 11-1 when scoring at least 60 points and 3-4 when scoring under 60 points.
- Last season, Virginia was 18-2 when scoring at least 60 points and 4-8 when scoring under 60 points.

## **NOT SO FAST BREAK**

- Virginia has held 18 of its 19 opponents under 10 for fast break points.
- The Cavaliers held Wisconsin, Mississippi Valley State, Wake Forest, Clemson and Florida State without a fast break point.

## **CLEANING THE GLASS**

- Virginia, which is averaging 32.8 rebounds per game, has outrebounded its opponent in 14 of 19 games and is 11-3 in those games.
- The Cavaliers have grabbed eight or more offensive rebounds in 11 games.
- Akil Mitchell leads Virginia in offensive rebounds (53), defensive rebounds (115) and total rebounds (168).

## **THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME AT JPJ**

- Virginia is 84-32 (.724) in seven seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- The Cavs are 12-1 this season at JPJ after posting a 13-3 record last season.
- Virginia is 47-16 (.746) at home under head coach Tony Bennett.

## **NOTE WORTHY**

- Virginia reserves have scored 10 or more points off the bench in 18 of 19 games.
- UVa has used seven different starting lineups this season.
- Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell have started every game.
- Virginia has used the starting lineup of Teven Jones, Joe Harris, Paul Jespersen, Akil Mitchell and Darion Atkins in nine games.
- UVa is 9-2 when shooting 70 percent or better from the free throw line.
- The Cavs are 14-3 when limiting opponents to less than 50 percent shooting from the field.
- The 84 combined points in the Virginia-Tennessee game tied for the lowest total in UVa history during the shot-clock era.
- UVa allowed under 40 points for two straight games (vs. Tennessee and Mississippi Valley State) for the first time since 1948-49 (38 by Langley Field, 39 by Richmond Royals).
- The Cavaliers held Florida State to 36 points, tying a school record for least points allowed to an ACC opponent (NC State, 36, Feb. 10, 1982)

## **LONG RANGE BOMBERS**

- Virginia made a season-high 11 3-pointers, including a season-best eight in the first half, at Virginia Tech (1/24/13).
- Virginia has made six or more 3-pointers in 11 games.
- Virginia has shot 50 percent or better from 3-point range in five games (North Texas, Green Bay, Wofford, North Carolina and Florida State).
- Evan Nolte made a career-high five 3-pointers at Virginia Tech.
- Joe Harris has made four 3-pointers in a game four times this season.
- The Cavaliers set a John Paul Jones Arena team record for 3-point shooting percentage in a game by drilling 8-of-11 (72.7%) shots beyond the arc vs. North Texas (11/20/12).

## **VIRGINIA PICKED 7TH IN THE ACC**

- Virginia was selected seventh in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked fourth and finished fourth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in each of the last four seasons.
- NC State is the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, North Carolina, Florida State, Miami, Maryland, Virginia, Clemson, Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College.

### **PHOTO CREDENTIALS**

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day, preferably longer, to arrange an interview.

### **POSTGAME INTERVIEWS**

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. The first coach will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the second coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after home games.

### **RADIO**

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.

### **GAME SERVICES**

Information packets are available before each game at John Paul Jones Arena, and a full statistical summary and play-by-play sheets are distributed at halftime and after the game. Quotes from both coaches and two or three players from each team will be available at the conclusion of the game. A pregame meal is served for working members of the media in the press room on the event level of John Paul Jones Arena.

**INSIDE THE EIGHT-GAME WINNING STREAK**

- UVA's eight-game winning streak was its best since last year's 11-game winning streak from Nov. 19, 2011-Jan. 7, 2012.
- UVA shot 48 percent from the floor, 39.8 percent from the 3-point line and 75.7 percent from the free-throw line during the streak.
- UVA averaged 67.6 points per game and allowed 48.8 points per game during the streak.
- The Cavaliers limited opponents to 32.2 percent shooting from the floor and 24.4 percent from the three-point line during the streak.
- Akil Mitchell led UVA in scoring during the streak at 13.9 points per game.

**NONCONFERENCE NOT A PROBLEM**

- UVA is 10-3 in nonconference action this season and 42-17 in nonconference play in four years under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVA has posted nonconference wins vs. Fairfield (54-45), Seattle (83-43), Lamar (63-44), North Texas (80-64), Wisconsin (60-54), Green Bay (67-51), Tennessee (46-38), Mississippi Valley State (67-39), Morgan State (75-57) and Wofford (74-39).

**BROGDON TO REDSHIRT THIS SEASON**

- Sophomore guard Malcolm Brogdon will redshirt the 2012-13 season while recovering from successful foot surgery performed on March 7.
- Brogdon averaged 6.7 points and 2.8 rebounds per game in 28 games last season.

**PERRANTES AND HALL SIGN WITH VIRGINIA**

- Virginia signed standout guards London Perrantes (Woodland Hills, Calif.) and Devon Hall (Virginia Beach, Va.) to National Letters of Intent on Nov. 14.
- Perrantes is ranked No. 86 on ESPN's Top 100 recruiting list for 2013, while Hall is ranked No. 77 on Rivals.com's Prospect Ranking list.

**ABOUT THE 2012-13 SCHEDULE**

- Three of Virginia's opponents are ranked in this week's national polls (No. 5/5 Duke, No. 14/15 Miami, Fla., and No. 19/19 NC State, while one is receiving votes (Wisconsin).
- Six opponents earned 2012 NCAA Tournament berths, while three participated in the College Basketball Invitational and two in the National Invitation Tournament.

**EUROPEAN TOUR RECAP**

- The Cavaliers posted a 2-3 mark during their five-game European Tour this past August.
- UVA competed against teams from the Netherlands, Belgium and France. Joe Harris led Virginia in scoring in Europe, averaging 15.6 points per game, while Akil Mitchell averaged 13.4 ppg, Mike Tobey 11.2 ppg and Jontel Evans 9.6 ppg.
- Evans averaged 7.8 assists per game, while Mitchell was UVA's top rebounder, pulling down 50 boards in the five games.


