VIRGINIA AND GEORGIA TECH CAP THE REGULAR SEASON

- Georgia Tech holds a 71-53-2 series edge over Virginia, but UVA is 27-16-1 against the Yellow Jackets since the current coaching staff took over in 2004.
- Virginia has won five of its last seven series against Georgia Tech.
- Since 2004, 18 of the teams' 44 meetings have been decided by one run or a tie.
- UVA won two of three last year against Georgia Tech but has lost its last two series in Atlanta.

CAREER VS. GEORGIA TECH

- In seven career games, Ernie Clement is 14-for-29 (.483) against Georgia Tech, with two doubles, two triples and six runs.
- Pavin Smith is 10-for-22 (.455) with a pair of homers and six RBI in seven games vs. GT.
- Charlie Cody owns three homers and six RBI in four games against GT.
- Adam Haseley (9-for-27, 9 runs, HR, 4 RBI) and Robbie Coman (7-for-21) each are .333 career hitters against the Yellow Jackets.
- Justin Novak is 5-for-14 vs. GT and Cameron Simmons is 4-for-11.

UVA LOOKS TO FINISH STRONG

- Virginia has won its last five ACC series and is aiming for six straight conference series wins for the first time since taking nine straight in 2014.
- Since the start of April, UVA has gone 19-5, including 12-5 in ACC play and 4-2 in road games.

NOTING THE MIAMI SERIES

- Virginia rebounded from a series-opening loss to take two of three games against Miami last weekend.
- UVA scored its eighth straight series win against the Hurricanes.
- The Cavaliers were limited to 21 hits, their fewest in any series this year.
- Cameron Simmons hit a grand slam Saturday as part of a six-RBI day. He was 4-for-11 in the series, while Ernie Clement was 5-for-14.

AGGRESSIVE CAVALIERS PUT BALL IN PLAY

- UVA batters have struck out an ACC-low 189 times in 51 games (3.7 per game).
- That total by far the fewest among all power-conference teams. Oregon State has the second-fewest at 287. (Louisville second fewest in ACC with 321).
- Seven ACC teams have struck out twice as many times as Virginia.
- UVA is the only ACC team to walk more than it has struck out (222 BB).
- The Cavaliers have struck out five or fewer times in 43 of 51 games.
- Ernie Clement (1st), Pavin Smith (2nd) and Robbie Coman (10th) all rank among the top 10 nationally in toughest to strike out and are the three toughest in the ACC.

THINGS TO KNOW

- UVA owns its most regular-season wins since 2014 and is seeking its 11th 40-win season in the last 14 years.
- Virginia has clinched a .500 or better ACC record for the 14th straight year (10 prior to 2004).
- Cameron Simmons is batting a team-high .396 in ACC games (second among all league players).
- In the last 10 games, Jake McCarthy is hitting a team-leading .432 (16-37).
- Virginia ranks sixth nationally in batting (.323), 12th in OBP (.407) and 14th in hits (559).
- UVA boasts four players among the ACC's top 15 in batting.
- Adam Haseley has reached base safely in 49 of 50 games, including 32 straight (most at UVA since 2013).

CAVALIERS EYE ACC BATTING TITLE

- Virginia leads the ACC in batting at .323, 11 points ahead of Wake Forest.
- UVA is in line to lead the conference in batting for the first time since 2013.
- The Cavaliers also won ACC batting crowns in 2009 and 2010.
- UVA's 18 triples ranks ninth in program history, while the Cavaliers' 54 homers stands 10th in school history.
- UVA is averaging 7.8 runs per game, matching the 1982 and 2009 teams for fifth in the program's annals.

SIMMONS CONTINUES HOT STREAK

- After a hot April, Cameron Simmons continued his solid work at the plate in the Miami series
- He currently is batting .385 (fourth in the ACC).
- He is batting .397 in ACC games, tops among UVA players and second in the ACC to Virginia's Tech's Tim Stoffel (.407).
- He is fifth in the ACC in on-base percentage (.469) and seventh in RBI (50).
- Simmons has recorded multi-hit games in six of his last seven games and had a streak of eight straight multi-hit games earlier this year.

MCCARTHY THRIVES IN 2-HOLE

- Jake McCarthy batted a solid .291 in his first 25 games, but is batting .365 (fourth on team) in the last 26 contests.
- After batting in the 9-hole for 19 games, McCarthy moved back into the 2-slot five games ago and is batting .450 (9-20) with a pair of triples and a home run in that time.
- McCarthy is 26-for-28 in stolen bases this year, the third-most steals in one season at UVA and most since 2008.

SMITH & HASELEY LEAD D1BASEBALL'S TOP HITTERS LIST

- Pavin Smith and Adam Haseley were listed as the top two college hitters this week by D1Baseball.com.
- The list was compiled after polling scouts and coaches from across the nation.
- According to D1Baseball, the "list is geared toward ranking the college hitters with the best pure "hit tool" on the scouting scale MLB scouts use to analyze these players for the upcoming draft."

HASELEY CONTINUES STRONG 2017

- Adam Haseley is putting up team highs in batting (.392), extra-base hits (27) and on base percentage (.485) while hitting in the 3-hole.
- He is on the John Olerud Two-Way Player Award, National Pitcher of the Year and Golden Spikes Award watch lists.
- Haseley owns a team-high 13 home runs – seven of which have gone to the opposite field. He is tied for ninth in UVA single-season history in homers.
- He has reached base safely in 49 of his 50 games, including 32 straight (longest at UVA since Joe McCarthy reached in 36 straight in 2013).
- Haseley is tied for the ACC lead in runs (57), ranks second in batting and OBP, third in hits (76), slugging (.670) and total bases (130), seventh in home runs (13), ninth in RBI (48) and 10th in walks (35).
- He also is 7-1 with a 3.58 ERA in 65 1/3 innings on the mound. He is sixth in the ACC in wins and 15th in ERA.

CAVALIERS MASHING

- UVA has hit 53 home runs, which already is third most in the Brian O'Connor era.
- The top two home run seasons under O'Connor: 2010 (61) and 2009 (59), both of which came with the old bats.
- The Cavaliers hit 42 home runs in 2016 (60 games).
- Eleven Cavaliers have gone deep this year.

- **Ernie Clement:** 1st team (D1Baseball), 2nd team (Baseball America)
- **Adam Haseley:** 2nd team (Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball, D1Baseball)
- **Pavin Smith:** 1st Team (Baseball America, Perfect Game), 2nd Team (Collegiate Baseball, D1Baseball)

- Adam Haseley is seventh in the ACC with 13 home runs, while Pavin Smith has 10 homers.
- UVA had a streak of 10 straight games with at least one home run snapped on April 19 (longest since 11-game stretch from Feb. 28-March 15, 1998).

RUN, RUN AND RUN SOME MORE

- Virginia has stolen 73 bases this year (in 86 attempts), its most since swiping 90 in 2011 (68 games). UVA ranks second in the ACC to Louisville (77) in stolen bases.
- UVA ranks 24th nationally in stolen bases.
- Four Cavaliers have at least nine stolen bases. UVA's leader in 2016 was Ernie Clement with six.
- Jake McCarthy has an ACC-best 26 steals in 28 tries. He ranks seventh nationally.
- It marks the third-most steals in a season for a UVA player and the most since Greg Miclat had 30 in 2008.
- UVA stole 27 bases in 60 games last year, its fewest stolen bases during the Brian O'Connor era.

KNIGHT BOLSTERS OFFENSE

- Caleb Knight has provided a boost to UVA's lineup over the last month, starting 25 games since the Duke series. UVA is 21-4 in his starts.
- In those starts, Knight has gone 29-for-77 (.377) with 18 RBI and 25 runs scored. His on-base percentage is .533 in his 25 starts.
- His four homers all have come in ACC games.
- He was inserted in the lineup as a defensive replacement in the first game against Duke.

PAVIN SMITH: NOT YOUR NORMAL POWER HITTER

- Pavin Smith has put up some big numbers this season, hitting for power as well as contact.
- Smith has more home runs (10) than strikeouts (8).
- He ranks as the second toughest to strike out of any player in Division I, with eight strikeouts in 198 official at bats (236 plate appearances).

DOYLE NAMED TO STOPPER OF YEAR WATCH LIST

• Junior right-hander Tommy Doyle was named to the midseason Stopper of the Year Watch List.
• Doyle is 2-1 with 13 saves in 20 outings this year.
• He is second in the ACC and seventh nationally in saves. Eight of his saves have come in ACC play.
• He has struck out 32 and walked seven over 30 innings out of the bullpen.

BETTINGER HAVING BIG YEAR OUT OF PEN

• Senior right-hander Alec Bettinger has worn many hats during his career, working as a starter, reliever and closer.
• This year he primarily has worked as a long reliever. In 11 of his 17 appearances this year, he has worked more than two innings, including seven of his last eight outings.
• He is tied for the league lead with eight wins (8-0 record) and owns a 2.16 ERA in 50 innings in 2017 while limiting opponents to a .169 batting average.
• He is now 22-10 in his career (tied for fourth in wins in school history).
• Bettinger has appeared in 78 career games (eighth in school history).

TIME TO ... GO TO WORK!

• Pavin Smith and Adam Haseley are the first UVA teammates to each record at least 10 homers in a season since Phil Gosselin (11), Jarrett Parker (10) and Steven Proscia (10) in 2010.
• Haseley (13) is seventh in the ACC in HR. Smith has 10 home runs.
• With 25 career homers, Smith is one round-tripper from reaching the top 10 in program history. He is tied for fifth in career RBI at UVA with 162 (needs four to reach third).

OFFENSE LOOKS TO KEEP HUMMING

• Virginia tops the ACC in batting in all games (.323) as well as ACC games (.306)
• UVA has faced the conference's top three teams in ERA (Louisville, North Carolina, Clemson).
• In ranking 12th nationally in scoring at 7.8 runs per game, UVA is sixth among all Division I teams in batting and 12th in hits (572).

WHATEVER IT TAKES

• A key part of Virginia's scoring numbers has come from execution.
• UVA is second nationally in sacrifice flies with 34 and 17th in sacrifice bunts with 47.
• UVA also has been hit by 55 pitches, which is fifth most in the conference.

BIG INNINGS PLAGUE CAVALIERS

• Virginia has given up 17 innings of four or more runs this year, including 11 in ACC play.
• In seven of UVA's 10 ACC defeats, the Cavaliers surrendered at least one inning of four-plus runs.
• UVA allowed 12 innings of four or more runs in 2016 and 16 in 2015.

HASELEY, SMITH NAMED TO MIDSEASON GOLDEN SPIKES WATCH LIST

• Virginia's junior duo of Adam Haseley and Pavin Smith were named to the 40-man midseason watch list for the Golden Spikes Award.
• UVA is one of six schools to have two players on the list.
• Haseley was named to the midseason watch list for the second year in a row.
• The semifinalists will be named May 31, with the finalists unveiled on June 14. The trophy will be presented June 29 in Los Angeles.

O'CONNOR REACHES 600 WINS

• Brian O'Connor won his 600th career game on Feb. 21 against VMI. He was the 10th coach in ACC history to reach the 600-win plateau and, in 825 games, the second-fastest in league history to hit 600 wins (Mike Martin, 802 games).
• Now with 635 career wins, O'Connor ranks ninth in league history.
• The winningest coach in program history, O'Connor also holds the UVA record for career ACC wins (260) and NCAA tournament wins (47).

RECENT PROGRAM NOTES

- Virginia owns the most wins in the nation this decade (370).
- UVA has won 635 games since 2004 – an average of more than 45 victories per season.
- UVA has four 50-win seasons: 2010 (51), 2011 (56), 2013 (50) and 2014 (53).
- UVA has recorded at least 38 wins each of the last 14 years, including 10 40-win seasons.
- Every UVA recruiting class since 2005-06 that has completed its eligibility has played in at least one College World Series.

THE TOURNAMENT STREAK

- Virginia has qualified for 13 straight NCAA tournaments, including four CWS trips and UVA's first national championship in 2015.
- UVA is one of five programs nationally to play in each tournament since 2004 and one of three to play in six of the last eight NCAA Super Regionals.
- Virginia is one of 16 schools in Division I history to have a streak of at least 13 consecutive NCAA tournament appearances (17 occurrences).

NCAA TOURNAMENT SUCCESS

- UVA has won 41 NCAA tournament games since 2009 – second most in the nation in that span.
- Twelve of the 41 tournament wins since 2009 have come in the College World Series.
- Virginia has earned four national seeds in the NCAA Tournament, including the No. 1 overall seed in 2011.

BRINGING HOME THE HARDWARE

- Virginia has made four College World Series appearances, including two trips to the CWS Finals.
- UVA has won six NCAA Regional and four Super Regional championships since 2009.
- UVA earned the 2010 and 2011 ACC Coastal Division Championships (regular season).
- UVA has made four appearances in the ACC Championship game, including titles in 2009 and '11.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- UVA reached the No. 1 national ranking in the polls in 2010, 2011, 2014 and 2015.
- Twenty-four Cavaliers have earned All-America selections in the last 13 seasons.
- Brian O'Connor has been named National Coach of the Year on three occasions.

SUCCESS AT NEXT LEVEL

- Sixty-nine Cavaliers have been selected in the MLB Draft in the last 13 years, including three in 2016.
- UVA has had at least one first-round draft pick in each of the last three seasons.
- Under the current coaching staff, 14 former Cavaliers have reached the big leagues.

- Sean Doolittle (Oakland) and Ryan Zimmerman (Washington) each have been named MLB All-Stars.

- Virginia is ranked as high as No. 6 in the latest polls (Perfect Game). UVA is ninth USA Today Coaches poll.
- UVA is 4-6 against current ranked teams this year.
- UVA has played 10 games against teams currently ranked in the D1Baseball poll: Louisville (2), North Carolina (3), Clemson (13) and Old Dominion (25).
- The Cavaliers do not play Wake Forest (19) in league play this year.

RECORDS WATCH

- Having pitched in 78 career games, RHP **Alec Bettinger** has appeared in the eighth-most contests in school history.
- Bettinger has won 22 career games – tied for fourth in UVA history.
- **Adam Haseley** stands seventh in school history with 174 runs scored and needs one to pass David Stone (1999-2002) and two to eclipse Adam Robinson (1994-97) for fifth.
- Haseley is ninth in program history with 10 triples and will move into a fifth-place tie with his next triple.
- **Pavin Smith** (25 HR) is one long ball shy of the top 10 at UVA and with 162 RBI is tied for fifth in program history.
- Smith has 61 RBI this season – six shy of the single-season school record of 67, set by Kenny Towns (2015) and Joe Koshansky (2004).
- With 16 career saves, **Tommy Doyle** is tied for seventh in school history (would move to sixth with next save). He has 13 saves this year (seventh in UVA single-season history).
- **Jake McCarthy** (26 SB) is tied with David Stone (2002) for third in single-season stolen bases and needs four to reach the No. 2 slot (Greg Miclat, 2008). The record is 32, set by Miclat in 2007.

O'CONNOR RANKS THIRD IN ACTIVE WIN PCT., 18TH ALL-TIME

- Virginia head coach Brian O'Connor is 635-235-2 (.729) in his 14th season as UVA's head coach.
- O'Connor surpassed Dennis Womack (594 wins, 1981-2003) as the winningest coach in program history on May 28, 2016, against Louisville.
- O'Connor's 72.7 percent winning percentage entering the season ranked No. 3 among active Division I head coaches.
- O'Connor also ranks 18th all-time in career winning percentage among all coaches with at least 10 years of head coaching experience.
- Virginia won at least 38 games in each of O'Connor's 14 seasons, including 10 40-win seasons and four 50-win campaigns.

LONGEVITY, STABILITY IN COACHING STAFF

- Virginia's coaching trio of Brian O'Connor, Kevin McMullan and Karl Kuhn are in their 14th year together.
- No current coaching staff in Division I college baseball has been together longer.
- The staff has combined for 635 wins, an average of over 45 wins per season, and has reached the NCAA tournament in each of their first 13 seasons.

DEFENSE TOPS ACC UNDER CURRENT STAFF

- Virginia has posted the ACC's best fielding percentage since the current coaching staff arrived in 2004.
- UVA has accrued a .973 fielding percentage over the last 13 seasons.
- UVA owns a .975 fielding percentage this year (fifth in ACC).

CAVALIERS TOP ACC IN BATTING SINCE 2009

- Virginia owns the ACC's top offense over the past eight years with a combined .303 average and is tops again this season (.323).
- The Cavaliers led the conference in batting in 2009, 2010 and 2013 and were second in 2011, 2012 and 2014.
