#### **FOR OPENERS**

- Virginia (12-0) is off to its best start since the 1981-82 season and seeks its first 13-0 start since 1980-81.
- The Cavaliers are 6-0 in their last six ACC openers.
- UVa ranks second in the nation in scoring defense at 48.3 points per game.

#### **ACC OPENERS**

- Virginia opens its 62nd season of ACC action.
- The Cavaliers are 5-0 in ACC openers under head coach Tony Bennett and 26-35 all-time.
- Virginia looks to win its seventh consecutive ACC opener.
- The Cavaliers defeated Florida State 62-50 in last year's ACC season opener in Tallahassee, Fla.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

- Virginia is 6-10 all-time vs. Miami in the series that dates back to 1965-66.
- The Cavaliers are 0-6 vs. the Hurricanes in Coral Gables, including a 54-50 loss in the 2012-13 season.
- The Cavaliers defeated Miami 65-40 in the last meeting between the teams in Charlottesville on Feb. 26, 2014.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 3-4 all-time against Miami.

#### **SUNSHINE STATE NOT SO SUNNY FOR VIRGINIA**

- UVa is 1-17 in its last 18 games in the state of Florida (1-10 at Florida State, 0-5 at Miami, 0-1 at South Florida and 0-1 in the ACC Tournament in Tampa).
- The Cavaliers snapped their 17-game losing streak in the Sunshine State with a 62-50 win at Florida State in the 2014 ACC opener.
- Virginia's last win in the Sunshine State prior to last year's win at Florida State was a 69-66 decision at FSU on Feb. 17, 2001.

#### **UVA RANKED IN TOP 10 FOR NINE STRAIGHT WEEKS**

- UVa is ranked No. 3 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today coaches polls.
- The Cavaliers have been ranked in the top 10 for the first nine weeks

of the season for the first time since 1982-83.

• The No. 9 AP preseason ranking was UVa's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Anthony Gill set career highs in points (25) and rebounds (13) for his second career double-double as Virginia rallied for an 83-72 win over Davidson on Dec. 30.
- Virginia trailed by 12 points in the first half, but outscored Davidson 51-36 in the second stanza to record its 12th-straight win.
- Darion Atkins tallied his first career double-double with a seasonhigh 13 points and 10 rebounds.
- Malcolm Brogdon added 16 points and a 12-12 effort from the charity stripe in the win.
- Justin Anderson tallied 14 points, including four 3-pointers, for UVa.

#### **LAST TIME VS. MIAMI**

- London Perrantes had a career-high 15 points on 5-of-5 shooting, including a career-best 4-of-4 from 3-point range, to lead Virginia to a 65-40 win over Miami on Feb. 26, 2014.
- Malcolm Brogdon added 15 points and Joe Harris had 11 for UVa, which improved to 10-1 when holding opponents under 50 points.
- Erik Swoope had 13 points and Rion Brown added 12 for Miami.
- The Cavaliers held Miami to 26.3 percent shooting from the field, including 0-for-12 on 3-pointers.
- Akil Mitchell had a game-high nine rebounds as UVa outrebounded the Hurricanes 37-30.
- The Cavaliers shot 56.3 percent from 3-point range (9-of-16) as four players (Harris, Brogdon, Justin Anderson and Evan Nolte) each hit from long distance.

#### **VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Sixth-year head coach Tony Bennett sports a 118-60 mark at Virginia and 187-93 mark in nine seasons overall.
- Bennett was named 2014 ACC Coach of the Year after guiding the Cavaliers to their first ACC Tournament championship since 1976.
- In 2013-14, he guided UVa to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has guided the Cavaliers to three consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012 and 2014 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett has increased UVa's win total in each of the last five seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12, 23 in 2013-13 and 30 in 2013-14).
- Bennett-coached teams are 66-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his nine-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have finished in the top five nationally in scoring defense in five of eight seasons (first in 2008-09 and 2013-14, second in 2007-08 and 2011-12, and fifth in 2012-13).
- Bennett is one of 24 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

#### **EMBRACE THE PACE**

- Virginia is averaging 70.6 points and allowing 48.3 points (second in the nation), marking its best averages under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVa has shot 49.3 percent from the field (18th nationally) and 38.6 percent from 3-point range, while limiting its opponents to 32.7 percent from the field (2nd nationally) and 29.2 percent from 3-point range.
- As of Jan. 2, the Cavaliers rank in the top five nationally in 11 defensive categories: rebounds per game (1st), defensive rebounds per game (1st), field goal percentage (2nd), points per game (2nd), rebound percentage (3rd), points per possession (3rd), true shooting percentage (3rd), effective shooting percentage (4th), possessions per 40 minutes (4th), offensive rebound percentage (5th) and assists per game (5th).
- As of Jan. 2, the Cavaliers rank in the top 10 nationally in four offensive categories: rebound percentage (2nd), defensive rebound percentage (5th), defensive rebounds per game (8th) and points per possession (9th).
- The Cavaliers have held 36 straight opponents and 37 straight ACC opponents under 50 percent shooting from the field.
- UVa has limited its opponents to 20 fast break points.

#### THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- The Cavaliers have held their opponents scoreless for five or more minutes 11 times this season.
- Virginia held Tennessee State scoreless for 10:23 and Cleveland State scoreless for 10:03 during the non-conference season.
- Virginia has also limited its opponents without a field goal for eight or more minutes seven times, highlighted by Harvard for 19:53 on Dec. 21.

#### **NON-CONFERENCE RECAP**

- Virginia recorded its fourth undefeated non-conference regular season since joining the ACC in 1953-54 (1978, 1982 and 2001).
- The Cavaliers captured the Barclays Center Classic with wins over Rutgers, La Salle, Tennessee State and Norfolk State.
- Virginia posted road wins at then-No. 21 Maryland and VCU.
- The Cavaliers won 11 of their 12 non-conference games by 11 or more points.
- Virginia outrebounded each of its 12 opponents and limited each of its 12 foes to less than 50 percent field goal shooting.
- Virginia held five opponents to 42 points or less (George Washington, Norfolk State, Tennessee State, Harvard and Rutgers).
- The Cavaliers limited Harvard and Rutgers to 27 points and 26 points, respectively, marking the first and second fewest points allowed by the Cavaliers in the shot clock era.
- Virginia is the first NCAA Division I team to hold two Division I opponents under 30 points (Rutgers and Harvard) in a season since Bucknell in 2004.
- The Cavallers limited Rutgers to eight points in the second half and Harvard to eight points in the first half.
- UVa set a school and ACC record by limiting Harvard to just 16 percent (8-50) field goal shooting.
- Harvard's one first-half field goal tied the NCAA record for fewest made field goals in a half in the shot clock era (Savannah State, one second-half field goal at Kansas State on Jan. 7, 2008).

#### **BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION**

- Preseason All-ACC performer Malcolm Brogdon leads UVa into action this season.
- Brogdon ranks second on the team at 13.3 points per game and had a a season-high 20 points against La Salle and added 18 at Maryland.
- He ranks third in the ACC in free throw percentage (82.1%) and 20th in scoring.

#### 2014-15 Opponents in Bold

- Brogdon has 10 or more points in nine games.
- In 2013-14, Brogdon averaged a career-high 12.7 points and 5.4 rebounds en route to All-ACC honors.
- Brogdon scored a career-best 23 points in the 2014 ACC Tournament final win against Duke.

#### **SIXTH MAN NO MORE**

- 2014 ACC Sixth Man of the Year Justin Anderson has started and led the team in scoring in nine games this season.
- He was named the USBWA's Oscar Robertson National Player of the Week and ACC Co-Player of the Week on Dec. 9 after averaging 18.5 points and seven rebounds in wins at Maryland and VCU.
- Anderson tallied a season-high 21 points at VCU and had 20 against Tennessee State.
- He is averaging career highs in points (15.0), rebounds (4.8), field goal percentage (56.8%), 3-point percentage (60.9%) and free-throw percentage (78.8%).
- He ranks first in the ACC in 3-point percentage, third in 3-pointers per game (2.33), ninth in field goal percentage and 10th in scoring.
- Anderson tied a career high with five 3-pointers on 5-5 shooting from distance against Tennessee State.
- Anderson was named 2014 ACC Sixth Man of the Year after averaging 7.8 points and 3.2 rebounds off the bench.
- In 2013-14, Anderson led the team in scoring in five games and had several game-changing defensive plays to ignite UVa.

#### HIGH POINT MAN IN THE PAINT

- Anthony Gill, a High Point, N.C., native, is averaging career highs in points (13.2) and rebounds (7.2) this season.
- He recorded career highs in points (25) and rebounds (13) against Davidson for his second career double-double.
- Gill tallied his first career double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds en route to MVP honors at the Barclays Center Classic.
- Gill hit doubles figures in six straight games from Nov. 25-Dec. 18, averaging 14.5 points during that span.
- Gill leads the team in field goal percentage (62.4%) and has improved his free-throw shooting to a career-best 71.2 percent.

#### **LONDON CALLING**

- Sophomore point quard London Perrantes ranks third in the ACC in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.1) and tied for sixth in assists (4.2 apg).
- Perrantes is averaging 3.1 points, 1.7 rebounds and 4.2 assists in 11 games overall.
- Perrantes averaged 5.5 points and 3.8 assists and ranked sixth nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.5) to earn All-ACC Freshman Team honors last season.

#### **NOLTE KNOWS SHOOTING**

- Junior forward Evan Nolte, who is one of Virginia's top 3-point shooting threats, has averaged 6.3 points in his last three games.

#### PRESS CREDENTIALS

Media members interested in obtaining season or game credentials should contact Erich Bacher via email at bacher@virginia. edu, office phone (434) 982-5530 or cell phone (720) 318-5538. We would like to receive credential requests no later than seven (7) days prior to the game. Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

#### **PHOTO CREDENTIALS**

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

#### **PRESS PARKING**

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

#### **INTERVIEWS**

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

#### **POSTGAME INTERVIEWS**

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the visiting coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basket-ball locker room after Coach Bennett is done with his postgame press conference.

#### <u>radio</u>

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.

#### **GAME SERVICES**
