### FOR OPENERS

- The Virginia-Virginia Tech game is part of the Commonwealth Clash presented by Virginia529, which is a head-to-head, points-based competition between the athletic teams of the Cavaliers and Hokies.
- UVA is 8-2 at home and has won eight of the last nine games against Virginia Tech.
- The Cavaliers rank first nationally in scoring defense (53.7 ppg) and second in turnovers per game (9.7).
- London Perrantes leads UVA in scoring at 11.9 points per game, marking the lowest scoring average to lead any UVA team in a single season (Malcolm Brogdon 12.7 ppg in 2013-14).
- Ty Jerome is averaging 11.5 points and 19 minutes the past two games. Jerome had a career-best 15 points at Villanova (1/29/17).
- UVA has the eighth-toughest remaining schedule according to ESPN's College Basketball Power Index.

### MORE ON THE COMMONWEALTH CLASH

- The Commonwealth Clash encourages a friendly, statewide rivalry between the two schools across all school-sponsored sports with 22 individual event points on the line.
- The school that accumulates 11.5 points or more will be crowned the winner and take home the Virginia529 Commonwealth Clash trophy.
- The UVA-VT game is worth a half point in the Clash and the Cavaliers lead this year's Clash 5-4-5.
- UVA has captured the Clash in each of the past two seasons.

### ALL-TIME VS. VIRGINIA TECH

- Virginia is 89-54 all-time vs. Virginia Tech in the series that dates back to 1914-15.
- UVA and VT split two meetings last season as the Hokies defeated the Cavaliers 70-68 in Blacksburg before Virginia posted a 67-49 win over Virginia Tech in Charlottesville.
- The Cavaliers are 37-12 against Virginia Tech in Charlottesville, including a 7-3 mark at JPJ.
- UVA has a four-game winning streak against Virginia Tech at JPJ.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 10-4 all-time vs. Virginia Tech.
- London Perrantes has averaged 10 points in six career games against the Hokies, including 14 ppg in two games in 2015-16.

### IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- As of Jan. 30, UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense (53.7 ppg), second in turnovers per game (9.7), seventh in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.55), 10th in field goal percentage (49.6%) and scoring margin (+15.5), 12th in field goal percentage defense (38.7%), 16th in 3-point field goal percentage (40%) and turnover margin (+3.8) and 18th in fouls per game (16).
- UVA has held four opponents to fewer than 40 points and was the first team in Division I to hold three straight opponents (St. Francis Brooklyn, Yale and Grambling State) to fewer than 40 points in the last 20 years.
- UVA was also the first team in ACC history (1953-present) to hold three straight opponents to fewer than 40 points.
- The Cavaliers have held 13 of their opponents to 54 or fewer points and six opponents to 50 or fewer points.

### UVA RANKED NO. 9/11 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 9 in the latest AP poll and No. 11 in USA Today Coaches' poll.
- UVA has ranked in the top 15 in 56 of the last 58 AP polls.
- UVA was ranked in top 10 in the preseason rankings (No. 8/7) for the third straight season, matching a school-best from 1981-83.
- UVA has been ranked in 59 consecutive AP polls since Feb. 3, 2014.
- UVA has finished in the top 10 (No. 3 in 2014 & No. 6 in 2015 and No. 4 in 2016) in the final AP rankings in three consecutive seasons for the first time since 1981-83.

### LAST TIME AGAINST THE HOKIES

- Anthony Gill tallied 16 points and Isaiah Wilkins chipped in a career-high 14 points to lead then-No. 7 Virginia to a 67-49 win over in-state rival Virginia Tech at John Paul Jones Arena on Feb. 9, 2016.
- Two-time All-American Malcolm Brogdon added 12 points and Mike Tobey had 10 points.
- Justin Robinson led the Hokies with 16 points, while Chris Clarke had 11 in his first action for the Hokies since breaking his right foot in late December of 2015.
- Virginia Tech's top two scorers, Zach LeDay and Seth Allen, were limited to seven and six points, respectively, as the pair combined to make only 4 of 16 shots from the field.
- The Cavaliers scored 21 points off of 15 Virginia Tech turnovers.
- UVA limited the Hokies to 35.6 percent field goal shooting.

**VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 181-76 (.704) mark in eight seasons at Virginia and 250-109 (.696) career mark in 11 seasons overall.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top-five nationally in seven of 10 seasons.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to five consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2016, and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett-coached teams are 86-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 11-year coaching career.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Donte DiVincenzo's tip-in at the buzzer gave then-No. 1 Villanova a 61-59 win over then-No. 12 Virginia at Wells Fargo Center in Philadelphia on Jan. 29.
- Ty Jerome led the Cavaliers with a career-high 15 points, including a game-tying runner with 15 seconds left before DiVincenzo's tip-in of a Josh Hart missed layup.
- Jalen Brunson and Mikal Bridges each scored 15 points for the Wildcats.
- UVA held Villanova stars Hart and Kris Jenkins to 12 and eight points, respectively.
- Marial Shayok tallied 14 points and Isaiah Wilkins added 12 points and a game-high eight rebounds.
- Villanova out-rebounded Virginia 25-24 and made 20 of 24 free throws compared to 3 of 3 for the Cavaliers.
- UVA shot 50 percent from the field and suffered its first loss since Dec. 7, 2013 (at Green Bay) when shooting 50 percent or better.

**UVA IN KEN POM EFFICIENCY RATINGS**

- As of Jan. 30, UVA ranks Nos. 2, 4 and 14 in the KenPom.com overall, adjusted defense and adjusted offense efficiency ratings, respectively.
- UVA is shooting 49.6 percent from the field (best since 50.1% in 1985-86), 40 percent from 3-point range (2nd best in school history) and 70.6 percent from the free throw line.
- UVA scored a Tony Bennett era high 90 points vs. Grambling State.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better in nine games.

**THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME**

- Virginia is 146-38 (.793), including an 8-2 mark in 2016-17, in 11 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- West Virginia ended UVA's JPJ-record, 24-game home winning streak on Dec. 3, 2015.
- The Cavaliers finished undefeated at home (15-0) in 2015-16 for the first time since 1981-82 (12-0).
- UVA is 108-22 (.831), including a 73-7 (.913) mark the past five seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 37-2 in ACC home games over the past five seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for seven straight seasons.

**UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS**

- Virginia is 2-3 vs. ranked opponents, including wins against then-No. 6 Louisville and then-No. 14 Notre Dame.
- UVA's 61-53 road win at then-No. 6 Louisville marked the Cavaliers' first top-10 road win since the 2002-03 season (86-78 vs. then-No. 8 Maryland).
- UVA is 24-26 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVA is 139-322 vs. ranked opponents, including a 25-120 mark against top-5 foes, since 1953-54.
- UVA is 1-29 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).
- UVA tied a school mark with eight wins vs. ranked foes in 2015-16.

**HOO ARE THESE WAHOOS?**

- UVA is led by senior point guard London Perrantes, who is averaging team highs in points (11.9 ppg) and assists (3.9 apg).
- Isaiah Wilkins (7.1 ppg & 5.9 rpg) leads the team in rebounding, blocked shots (26) and steals (25).
- Devon Hall is averaging 8.2 points and 4.2 rebounds, while Darius Thompson has added 7.0 points per game.
- Marial Shayok is averaging 10.2 points and Kyle Guy is averaging 7.8 points to top all UVA rookies.
- Jack Salt is averaging 4.2 points and 3.8 rebounds in 19.6 minutes per game after averaging 1.6 points and 1.1 rebounds in 6.6 minutes per game last season.
- Ty Jerome is averaging 11.5 points on 69.2 percent shooting, including 55.5 percent (5-9) from 3-point range, the past two games.
- Mamadi Diakite and Jarred Reuter are role players off the bench.

- Seven of UVA's opponents are ranked in the latest AP poll (Villanova, Louisville, West Virginia, North Carolina, Florida State, Notre Dame and Duke), while one opponent (Virginia Tech) received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 13 games against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, North Carolina, West Virginia, Miami, Pitt and Yale; road contests at Villanova, North Carolina, Syracuse, California, Pitt and Notre Dame; and a neutral-site tilt against Iowa in the Emerald Coast Classic in Niceville, Fla.

## HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia is 61-2 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 86-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA has held four opponents (St. Francis Brooklyn, Yale, Grambling State and Robert Morris) under 40 points this season and is 18-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

## THE ELECTRIC 70s

- Virginia is 90-5 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and 91-71 when scoring under 70 points.

## 60 IS THE NEW 70

- UVA is 157-33 when scoring at least 60 points under Tony Bennett and 24-43 when scoring fewer than 60 points.

## LEAVING ITS BENCH(MARK)

- UVA has outscored its opponents 577-264 off the bench this season.
- The Cavaliers are averaging 28.9 points off the bench, while opponents are averaging 13.2 bench points.
- UVA scored a season-high 61 points off the bench against Grambling and had a 20-0 advantage over Providence off the bench.
- West Virginia (27-20) and Clemson (26-16) are the lone opponents to outscore UVA off the bench in 2016-17.

## HALL OF A YEAR SO FAR

- Redshirt junior Devon Hall is enjoying his best season at UVA, averaging career highs in points (8.2), rebounds (4.2), field goal percentage (44.7%), 3-point percentage (40.4%), free throw percentage (83.9%) and minutes (25.8).
- Hall, who has started 40 consecutive games dating back to last season, tallied career highs in points (15) and rebounds (9) at Pitt (1/4/17).
- Hall is averaging 11.5 points and 5.4 rebounds during ACC play.
- Hall has scored 10+ points in eight of the last 11 games.
- Hall has 35 assists and just 15 turnovers.

- He enjoyed a breakout season in 2015-16, averaging career highs in points (11), field goal percentage (43.9%) and ACC-leading 3-point field goal percentage (48.8%).

- Virginia welcomes freshmen Kyle Guy, Ty Jerome, Jay Huff and De'Andre Hunter to this year's team.
- Guy averaged 23.5 points, 5.6 rebounds and 3.7 assists en route to Mr. Basketball for Indiana and McDonald's All-America honors in 2015-16.
- Jerome tallied 24.7 points, 8 rebounds and 5 assists per game before season-ending hip surgery last season.
- Huff averaged 16.3 points, 10.1 rebounds and 5.5 assists in 2015-16, while Hunter recorded 23.5 points and 9.8 rebounds per game.
- UVA head coach Tony Bennett announced on Nov. 11 he plans to redshirt Huff and Hunter.

- Virginia will retire Malcolm Brogdon's No. 15 on Monday, Feb. 20 when the Cavaliers host Miami at John Paul Jones Arena.
- Brogdon finished his career ranked ninth on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,809 points. He also ranks first in free throw percentage (87.6%), second in games played (136), fifth in minutes played (4,157), sixth in 3-point field goal percentage (36.5%), seventh in 3-pointers (185) and ninth in free throws (422).
- Brogdon earned consensus first-team All-America and NABC Defensive Player of the Year honors in 2016 after becoming the first player to be named ACC Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year in the same season. The three-time All-ACC first-team performer earned consensus second-team All-America honors in 2015.
- He helped Virginia to 111 wins, four NCAA tournaments, two ACC regular-season titles and one ACC Tournament championship during his career.
- The other former Virginia men's basketball players whose numbers have been retired are Jeff Lamp (3), Barry Parkhill (40), Ralph Sampson (50), Sean Singletary (44), Bryant Stith (20), Wally Walker (41), and Buzzy Wilkinson (14).
- Brogdon, who is averaging 9.2 points and 4.2 assists for the NBA's Milwaukee Bucks, will compete in the BBVA Compass Rising Stars Challenge at All-Star Weekend on Feb. 17 in New Orleans.
