## TODAY'S GAME

- Virginia hosts Duke in the round of 16 of the NCAA Tournament
- The Cavaliers are looking to reach the quarterfinals for the seventh time (' $90,{ }^{\prime} 91,{ }^{\prime} 92$, '01, $05,{ }^{\prime} 11$ ), and the first time in consecutive seasons since the early 90 s


## NCAA TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- Virginia is participating in its 19th consecutive NCAA Tournament and 25th NCAA Tournament overall
- Only North Carolina and Notre Dame have longer active consecutive NCAA streaks
- Since the tournament expanded to 64 teams in 2001, UVa is one of five schools to advance from the 1st round every year (North Carolina, Portland, Texas A\&M, UCLA, UVa)
- UVa has made eight consecutive NCAA round of 16 s (T-2nd longest active streak)
- Virginia has a 27-22-4 all-time NCAA Tournament record
- Under Steve Swanson, the Cavaliers have a 24-11-3 NCAA Tournament record
- UVa is 2-7 against ACC Teams in the NCAA Tournament (0-2 vs. UNC, 0-4 vs. Duke, $1-0$ vs. WF, 1-0 vs. VT, 0-1 vs. FSU)


## AT HOME IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- Virginia is hosting NCAA Tournament play for the 19th year
- At home, Virginia is 21-11-3 in NCAA Tournament play
- UVa is 19-3-2 at home in NCAA play since 2000
- Virginia is $1-3 \mathrm{vs}$. ACC Teams at home in the NCAA Tournament ( $0-3 \mathrm{vs}$. Duke)


## SERIES HISTORY

- Virginia leads the series 18-11-7 (UVa leads 9-4-3 in Charlottesville)
- UVa is 7-0-2 against Duke in the regular season since 2004, but the Blue Devils have won the two NCAA meetings during that span (2004 2nd Rd, 2008 3rd Rd)
- Duke has won all four previous NCAA meetings
- Virginia won the regular season meeting 1-0 on Sept. 30 at Klöckner Stadium as Makenzy Doniak scored the game's lone goal in the 88th minute

## ACC CHAMPIONS

- Virginia won the 2012 ACC Tournament, its second ACC title
-The Cavaliers defeated North Carolina, Florida State and Maryland to win the title
- UVa joins North Carolina as the only multiple-time ACC Champions
- Virginia's 4-0 win over Maryland was the most lopsided ACC final since UNC's 6-0 win over Clemson in 2001


## LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia downed Rutgers 6-1 in the NCAA 2nd Round on Friday
- The Cavaliers scored six unanswered goals after falling behind 1-0 in the 8th min.
- Caroline Miller led UVa with two goals and an assist
- Danielle Colaprico had a goal and two assists
- The six goals matched Virginia's high for an NCAA Tournament game


## HIGH SCORING HOOS

- Virginia ranked sixth nationally in scoring at 2.68 goals per game (as of Nov. 12)
- The Cavaliers' 65 goals this season are the most in school history, breaking the previous record of 62 goals scored during the 2004 season
- UVa has scored multiple goals in 16 of 23 games

## MILLER NAMED ACC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

- Caroline Miller was named the 2012 ACC Offensive Player of the Year
- She is the second Cavalier to win the award (Sinead Farrelly-2010) and the seventh

Virginia player to be recognized as an ACC Player of the Year

- Miller led the ACC with 10 goals and 23 points during conference play
- Her 10 goals were the most in ACC play since UNC's Casey Nogueira had 13 goals during the 2008 conference season
- She had four multi-goal games in conference play, no one else in the ACC had more than two this season
- It is the second straight season she has led the league in goals in conference games (T-1st with FSU's Tiffany McCarty with 7 goals in 2011)

- Caroline Miller enters the game with 44 career goals, 2nd in school history
- Of her 44 career goals, 22 have come against ACC opponents

## MILLER: EN FUEGO

- Caroline Miller has scored in each of the past seven games, setting a school record for consecutive games with a goal, breaking the mark of six straight games with a goal set by Angela Hucles in 1997
- Six of the seven games Miller has scored in during her streak have come against ranked opponents (three of Hucles' six games came against ranked opponents)


## ITS MILLERTIME

- Caroline Miller had her fifth multi-goal game of the season vs. Rutgers (11/16)
- Four of her five multi-goal games this season have come in ACC play

- Caroline Miller was honored as ACC Player of the Week on Oct. 30 after her one goal, one assist performance in the 5-1 win over Boston College
- It was her second straight honor as she was ACC Co-Player of the Week on Oct. 23
- Her five career ACC Player of the Week honors are the most in school history


## MILLER SHINES AS CAVALIERS ROAST THE HOKIES

- Caroline Miller tied a school record with seven points $(3 G, 1 A)$ in the $5-0$ win at Virginia Tech on Oct. 21
- It was her second career hat trick and just the third by a Cavalier against an ACC foe


## MILLER HONORED

- Caroline Miller was named NSCAA National Player of the Week on Sept. 19
- Miller had two goals against both NC State and North Carolina the previous week
- She became the first Cavalier since Angela Hucles in 1996 to score twice in consecutive ACC games


## CAROLINE MILLER: CAROLINA KILLER

- Caroline Miller scored in Virginia's 1-0 win at North Carolina in the ACC Quarterfinals
- She also had the goal in UVa's 1-0 win at UNC in 2011, the Cavaliers' first-ever win over the Tar Heels

## MAK ON THE ATTACK

- Makenzy Doniak is second on the team with 25 points
- She is the first Virginia player to score in each of the first five games of a season

- Her streak of scoring in the first five games of her career was the longest by an ACC player since Kim Patrick of North Carolina scored in her first seven games in 1999


## DONIAK HONORED

- Makenzy Doniak was the TopDrawerSoccer.com National Player of the Week on Aug. 27
- She scored three goals in the wins over Liberty (two goals) and UNCW (GWG)
- She was also named to the Soccer America Team of the Week


## WORLD CHAMPIONS

- Head coach Steve Swanson and sophomore midfielder Morgan Brian returned to the team on Sept. 13 after missing the first eight games due to duty with the United States at the FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup in Japan
- The USA won the championship with a 1-0 win over Germany on Saturday
- Brian started all six games of the tournament and scored the game-winning goal in the 2-0 semifinal win over Nigeria


## SWANSON RECOGNIZED BY FIFA

- Head coach Steve Swanson was named to the shortlist for the FIFA World Coach of the Year in Women's Football on Oct. 25
- He is one of 10 coaches named to the list
- FIFA will announce the three finalists in November and the winner in January
