• All-American Malcolm Brogdon has recorded back-to-back 20-point games and leads UVA in scoring for the third straight season at a career-best 16.7 points per game.

• The Cavaliers' five wins each have come by 17 points or more.

• The ACC leads the Big Ten in the Challenge 10-4-2 in 16 years of competition between the two conferences.

• The Big Ten captured the Commissioner's Cup last season, winning eight of the 14 matchups.

• The ACC looks for its first win in the Challenge since winning 10 straight from 1999-2008.

• Virginia and Ohio State will meet for the first time in the Big Ten/ ACC Challenge and fifth time overall.

•UVA and OSU last met in 1981 when Ralph Sampson poured in 40 points and grabbed 16 rebounds in UVA's 89-73 win over Ohio State. • The Buckeyes own a 3-1 advantage, including a 2-0 mark in Columbus, over the Cavaliers in the all-time series that dates back to 1931-32.

• UVA is 99-129 all-time vs. current Big Ten Conference opponents. • The Cavaliers are 5-5 against Big Ten opponents under head coach Tony Bennett, including wins against Maryland, Minnesota, Michigan, Wisconsin and Rutgers.

• In 2014-15, UVA defeated Rutgers (45-26) and Maryland (76-65) and lost to Michigan State (60-54) for the second consecutive season in the NCAA Tournament.

LAST TIME OUT

• Malcolm Brogdon tallied 23 points to lead then-No. 12 Virginia to an 80-54 win over Lehigh in non-conference action on Nov. 25.

• Darius Thompson (12 points), Marial Shayok (11 points) and Anthony Gill (10 points) also reached double figures as UVA reached 80 points for the fourth straight game.

• London Perrantes dished out a game-high eight assists and UVA out-rebounded the Mountain Hawks 37-29.

• UVA shot 50 percent or better from the field for the fourth straight game, hitting 34-65 attempts for 52.3 percent.

BACK TO THE FUTURE

Virginia's 81.0 points per game average is its highest under Tony Bennett and highest since averaging 85.0 points in 2000-01.
UVA has tallied 80 or more points in five of six games this season, including four straight, after recording 80 or more points in two of 34 games in 2014-15.

• The last time UVA scored 80 or more points in five straight games was a seven-game stretch from Jan. 16-Feb. 7, 2001.

• The Cavaliers scored 82 or more points in three straight games (Nov. 19-22 at Charleston Classic) for the first time since the first three games of the 2001-02 season.

 UVA is ranked No. 10 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls.

• UVA was ranked No. 12 in both polls last week, falling out the top 10 for the first time since Feb. 24, 2014.

• UVA had been ranked in the top 10 in 25 consecutive AP polls since March 3, 2014, its longest span since 49 consecutive polls from 1980-83.

• The Cavaliers' No. 6 preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.

• Virginia has been ranked in the preseason top-10 in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1981-82 and 1982-83.

• UVA has finished in the top 10 (No. 3 in 2014 & No. 6 in 2015) in the final AP rankings in back-to-back seasons for the first time since three straight seasons from 1981-83.

VRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

• Head coach Tony Bennett sports a 141-65 mark in seven seasons at Virginia and 210-98 career mark in 10 seasons.

 Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.

• Bennett was also named ACC Coach of the Year, NABC District 2 Coach of the Year and USBWA District 3 Coach of the Year for the second consecutive year.

• Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.

• In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVa to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season for the first time in school history.

• Bennett has led the Cavaliers to four consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014 and 2015, and NIT in 2013).

• Bennett-coached teams are 76-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 10-year coaching career.

• Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top five nationally in six of nine seasons.

Bennett is one of 26 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
 UVA is 73-24 (.753) in non-conference action under Bennett.

HALL OF A SPARK OFF THE BENCH

Redshirt sophomore guard Devon Hall has earned increased playing time this season for UVA.

Hall has played in all six games this season and is averaging 17.5 minutes after averaging 10.6 minutes in 23 contests last season.
Hall netted a career-high 13 points vs. Morgan State and drained a career-best four 3-pointers for 12 points vs. Long Beach State.
