### FOR OPENERS

- No. 10 Virginia is 9-6 in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- The Cavaliers meet Ohio State for the first time since three-time National and ACC Player of the Year Ralph Sampson's epic performance vs. the Buckeyes on national television in 1981.
- Virginia has scored 80 or more points in four consecutive games for the first time under Tony Bennett and for the first time since totaling 80 or more in the first four games of the 2006-07 season.
- All-American Malcolm Brogdon has recorded back-to-back 20-point games and leads UVA in scoring for the third straight season at a career-best 16.7 points per game.
- The Cavaliers' five wins each have come by 17 points or more.

### UVA ALL-TIME IN THE BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE

- The Cavaliers have a 9-6 record, including a 4-4 road mark, in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- Virginia defeated former ACC rival Maryland 76-65 in College Park in the Challenge last season.
- UVA has won its last three road games in the event, winning at Minnesota (2010), Wisconsin (2012) and Maryland (2014).
- The ACC leads the Big Ten in the Challenge 10-4-2 in 16 years of competition between the two conferences.
- The Big Ten captured the Commissioner's Cup last season, winning eight of the 14 matchups.
- The ACC looks for its first win in the Challenge since winning 10 straight from 1999-2008.

### ALL-TIME VS. OHIO STATE

- Virginia and Ohio State will meet for the first time in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge and fifth time overall.
- UVA and OSU last met in 1981 when Ralph Sampson poured in 40 points and grabbed 16 rebounds in UVA's 89-73 win over Ohio State.
- The Buckeyes own a 3-1 advantage, including a 2-0 mark in Columbus, over the Cavaliers in the all-time series that dates back to 1931-32.

### AGAINST THE BIG TEN CONFERENCE

- UVA is 99-129 all-time vs. current Big Ten Conference opponents.
- The Cavaliers are 5-5 against Big Ten opponents under head coach Tony Bennett, including wins against Maryland, Minnesota, Michigan, Wisconsin and Rutgers.
- In 2014-15, UVA defeated Rutgers (45-26) and Maryland (76-65) and lost to Michigan State (60-54) for the second consecutive season in the NCAA Tournament.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Malcolm Brogdon tallied 23 points to lead then-No. 12 Virginia to an 80-54 win over Lehigh in non-conference action on Nov. 25.
- Darius Thompson (12 points), Marial Shayok (11 points) and Anthony Gill (10 points) also reached double figures as UVA reached 80 points for the fourth straight game.
- London Perrantes dished out a game-high eight assists and UVA out-rebounded the Mountain Hawks 37-29.
- UVA shot 50 percent or better from the field for the fourth straight game, hitting 34-65 attempts for 52.3 percent.

### BACK TO THE FUTURE

- Virginia's 81.0 points per game average is its highest under Tony Bennett and highest since averaging 85.0 points in 2000-01.
- UVA has tallied 80 or more points in five of six games this season, including four straight, after recording 80 or more points in two of 34 games in 2014-15.
- The last time UVA scored 80 or more points in five straight games was a seven-game stretch from Jan. 16-Feb. 7, 2001.
- The Cavaliers scored 82 or more points in three straight games (Nov. 19-22 at Charleston Classic) for the first time since the first three games of the 2001-02 season.

### BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE PLAYER NOTES

- Malcolm Brogdon had a game-high 18 points in last year's ACC/Big Ten Challenge and is averaging 13 points in three Challenge games.
- Anthony Gill is averaging 8.5 points and 6.0 rebounds in a pair of Challenge games.

**VIRGINIA'S RANKED NO. 12 IN LATEST POLLS**

- UVA is ranked No. 10 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls.
- UVA was ranked No. 12 in both polls last week, falling out the top 10 for the first time since Feb. 24, 2014.
- UVA had been ranked in the top 10 in 25 consecutive AP polls since March 3, 2014, its longest span since 49 consecutive polls from 1980-83.
- The Cavaliers' No. 6 preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.
- Virginia has been ranked in the preseason top-10 in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1981-82 and 1982-83.
- UVA has finished in the top 10 (No. 3 in 2014 & No. 6 in 2015) in the final AP rankings in back-to-back seasons for the first time since three straight seasons from 1981-83.

**VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Head coach Tony Bennett sports a 141-65 mark in seven seasons at Virginia and 210-98 career mark in 10 seasons.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett was also named ACC Coach of the Year, NABC District 2 Coach of the Year and USBWA District 3 Coach of the Year for the second consecutive year.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to four consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014 and 2015, and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett-coached teams are 76-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 10-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top five nationally in six of nine seasons.
- Bennett is one of 26 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 73-24 (.753) in non-conference action under Bennett.

**HOOW ARE THESE WAHOOS?**

- UVA is averaging 81.0 points per game and yielding 58.3 ppg (most since 62.4 ppg in 2010-11).
- Senior All-America candidate Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA in scoring for the third consecutive season at a career-best 16.7 points per game, while All-ACC performer Anthony Gill is averaging 12.5 points and 5.2 rebounds.
- Brogdon has a trio 20-point efforts, including a career-high 28 at George Washington) and Gill has reached double figures in scoring in all six games.
- London Perrantes is averaging career highs in points (10.0), assists (5.3) and assist-to-turnover ratio (4.57).
- Mike Tobey, who was replaced in the starting lineup by Jack Salt vs.

- George Mason, leads the team in rebounding at 5.5 per game.
- Marial Shayok has reached double figures in scoring in three of the last four games, including a career-high 17 vs. Long Beach State, since joining the starting lineup.
- UVA has out-rebounded its opponents in each of its five wins and has a +10.2 rebounding margin overall.
- Nine players are averaging 10 or more minutes per game.
- The Cavaliers have shot 50 percent or better in each of their last four games for the first time since a four-game stretch last season (Dec. 3-21, 2014).
- UVA is shooting 51.7 percent from the field, 38.7 percent from 3-point range and 75.5 percent from the free throw line.

**ALL-AMERICAN BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION**

- Preseason co-ACC Player of the Year Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA into action this season.
- Brogdon is averaging a team-leading 16.7 points and 4.5 rebounds per game in 2015-16.
- Brogdon was named a preseason All-American by The Sporting News (1st team), Blue Ribbon Yearbook (1st team), CBSSports.com (2nd team), NBCSports.com (2nd team), Bleacher Report (2nd team), USA Today (3rd team) and CollegeInsider.com.
- In 2014-15, Brogdon averaged 14.0 points and 3.9 rebounds en route to All-America second-team and All-ACC first-team accolades.
- The two-time All-ACC performer, who was a John Wooden Award finalist last season, ranks 31st on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,234 points in 105 career games (11.8 career ppg).
- Brogdon ranks second on UVA's career free-throw percentage list at 85.5% (296-for-346).
- Brogdon, who is a candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award and Wooden Citizen Cup Award, was named to the 2014 Allstate NABC Good Works Team.
- Brogdon helped Team USA to a bronze medal at the 2015 Pan American Games in Toronto.
- The redshirt senior earned a degree in history and is pursuing a master's degree in public policy from the Frank Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy.

**LONDON CALLING THE SHOTS**

- Junior point guard London Perrantes is enjoying a breakout season in 2015-16.
- Perrantes has hit double figures in scoring in three of the last four games, including a season-high 16 points vs. George Mason.
- He tallied his second career double-double with 16 points and career-high 11 assists against George Mason en route to MVP honors at the Charleston Classic.
- Perrantes is shooting a career-best 47.8 percent (11-23) from 3-point range.
- Perrantes has a career 3.3 assist-to turnover ratio (320 assists, 96 turnovers) in 75 career games.
- Perrantes averaged 6.4 points and 4.6 assists en route to honorable mention All-ACC honors last season.
- He set career highs in points (26) and 3-pointers (5) at Miami (1/3/15).
- Perrantes earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.

## HIGH POINT MAN TO THE GILLS

- Preseason All-ACC second-team selection Anthony Gill, who is averaging 12.5 points and 5.2 rebounds, is Virginia's top frontcourt offensive player.
- Gill, a High Point, N.C., native, averaged 11.6 points and 6.5 rebounds en route to All-ACC third-team (media) honors in 2014-15.
- Gill's team-leading 29 steals helped earn him a spot on the coaches' All-ACC Defensive Team in 2014-15.
- Gill, who has led UVA in field goal percentage in each of the past two seasons, is shooting 58.2 percent during his UVA career.
- Gill earned MVP honors at the 2014 Barclays Center Classic and ranked 13th in the ACC in rebounding.
- Gill has amassed 1,024 career points in three seasons at UVA and one at South Carolina.

## GETTING SALTY

- Redshirt freshman center Jack Salt earned a starting role in each of his last two games because of his defensive presence.
- Salt has averaged 3.5 points and 1.8 rebounds in 10.8 minutes.
- Salt has converted 62.5 percent from the field, has three blocked three shots and one steal.
- Salt played at the same high school as former All-Big 10 player and current New Zealand pro basketball player Kirk Penney, whom Tony Bennett coached while an assistant at Wisconsin.

## HALL OF A SPARK OFF THE BENCH

- Redshirt sophomore guard Devon Hall has earned increased playing time this season for UVA.
- Hall has played in all six games this season and is averaging 17.5 minutes after averaging 10.6 minutes in 23 contests last season.
- Hall netted a career-high 13 points vs. Morgan State and drained a career-best four 3-pointers for 12 points vs. Long Beach State.

## DT SHOWING HIS VERSATILITY

- Darius Thompson has averaged 7.0 points, 2.7 rebounds, 1.6 assists and 1.0 steals in 20.2 minutes in his first season at UVA.
- Thompson sat out as a transfer last season after averaging 2.6 points and 2.4 assists in 37 games at Tennessee in 2013-14.

- Malcolm Brogdon is one of 20 players on the preseason Jerry West Award Watch List, honoring the nation's top shooting guard.
- Brogdon was a candidate for the 2015 Jerry West Award after leading UVA in scoring at 14 points per game.

## VIRGINIA PICKED 2ND IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish second in the ACC preseason poll.
- The second-place preseason selection is UVA's highest since being selected first in 1982-83.
