VIRGINIA-NOTRE DAME SERIES

- Playing as ACC rivals for the first time, Virginia and Notre Dame have met just five times previously.
- UVa holds a 3-2 edge in the all-time series, which started in 1991.
- The teams last played in the 1996 NCAA South I Regional in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. Notre Dame won the tournament opener, 12-1, on May 23 before UVa bounced the Fighting Irish from the tourney with a 7-1 victory.

O'CONNOR RETURNS TO SOUTH BEND

- UVa head coach Brian O'Connor was an assistant on then-head coach Paul Mainieri's staff at Notre Dame for nine seasons from 1994-2003; he was an assistant coach from 1994-2001 and associate head coach from 2001-03.
- During O'Connor's nine years at Notre Dame, the Irish compiled an overall record of 399-160-1 (.713), won six conference championships and made six trips to the NCAA tournament, including a 2002 berth in the College World Series.
- While at Notre Dame, O'Connor worked with the Fighting Irish pitchers and served as the program's recruiting coordinator.
- He was named the 2001 National Assistant Coach of the Year by the ABCA and Baseball America and was 2003 AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year.

LINEUP DOMINATED BY FRESHMEN

- Virginia has put at least three freshmen in each starting lineup, including eight games with five rookies and three contests with six.
- Ernie Clement (CF/2B), Adam Haseley (RF/CF) and Pavin Smith (1B/LF) have started all 23 games while Justin Novak (2B/C) has played in 22 of 23 games, making 21 starts.
- UVa has had first-years in all three outfield positions in eight games.
- Fifteen of UVa's 31 players are freshmen.

WALKS WILL HAUNT

- Virginia's pitching staff struggled with its command against Florida State, walking 34 batters in the three-game series (14 came around to score).
- It marked by far the most walks in a three-game series during Brian O'Connor's tenure – the previous high was 21 in a 2007 series vs NC State.
- The 15 walks Sunday marked the most in a game by a UVa pitching staff in the last 20 years.
- The Cavaliers also walked 12 batters Saturday.
- UVa ranked No. 1 nationally in walks/hits per nine innings (WHIP) at 1.03 last year and were tops in the ACC in fewest walks per nine innings (2.88).

ODDS AND ENDS

- Virginia is playing its first-ever games in the state of Indiana.
- UVa has started 16 different lineups through the first 23 games.
- Matt Thaiss has thrown out nine of 19 baserunners attempting to steal against him (47.4%).
- Six of Virginia's eight defeats have come by two runs or fewer.
- UVa is 5-1 in doubleheaders this year (two sweeps, one split).

CAVALIERS ADD PAIR FROM CLUB TEAM

- With injuries causing some major depth issues early this season, Virginia has added a pair of players to the roster. Both were members of the UVA club team.
- Catcher Ben Cassillo, a freshman, is wearing No. 41, while senior infielder Kevin Radford sports No. 5.
- Cassillo is a native of Latham, N.J., while Radford is from Norfolk, Va. (Maury HS).

DOHERTY GIVES CAVALIERS ANOTHER OPTION

- Junior Kevin Doherty has given Virginia a boost, both on the mound at the plate.

- He has been one of UVA's top left-handed options out of the bullpen (1-0, 2.11 ERA, 21.1 IP, 20 K, .151 BAA).
- Doherty has stepped up of late at the plate and has been in the lineup in each of the last seven games. In 10 games total, he is batting .296 with six RBI.
- He has spent time in the outfield in the last six games (four in left field, two in right).

THAISS PROVIDES THUNDER IN UVA LINEUP

- Sophomore catcher Matt Thaiss has given the Cavaliers' lineup a jolt of power this season.
- He has blasted seven home runs, putting him in a tie for ninth nationally and fourth in the ACC.

- Thaiss hit his seventh homer in UVA's 18th game of the season last Friday vs FSU; last season it took Mike Papi 42 games to hit his seventh long ball and become the first Cavalier to reach that mark.
- Thaiss also leads the team in batting (.345) and is second in RBI (22) after driving in six runs during the Florida State series. He is batting .357 in ACC games.
- Thaiss did not homer in 72 plate appearances during his 26 games (15 starts) last season.

ROTATION ANCHORS PITCHING STAFF

- The weekend rotation of Nathan Kirby, Connor Jones and Brandon Waddell has been strong, going 8-3 with a 2.45 ERA.
- They have combined to pitch into at least the sixth inning in 12 of their 18 starts this season.
- The threesome is averaging 10.6 strikeouts per nine innings.

KIRBY AIMS FOR ANOTHER QUALITY START

- Nathan Kirby has a penchant for earning quality starts during his two years as a starter.
- In the last two seasons, Kirby has recorded 19 quality starts in 24 attempts (quality start = at least six IP and three runs or fewer allowed).
- He has four quality starts in six starts this year after recording 15 in 18 starts in 2014.
- Kirby currently leads the ACC in strikeouts (54) and ranks third in ERA (1.14).
- He also ranks sixth nationally in strikeouts.

WEATHER WREAKS HAVOC ON HOME SCHEDULE

- Inclement weather has forced UVA to postpone three midweek games and relocate three weekend series.
- In all, Virginia has had 13 home games altered because of inclement weather.
- UVA was forced to shift its series with Marist (Feb. 20-22) to Charleston, S.C., and its round-robin tournament with Hartford and Seton Hall to Myrtle Beach.
- UVA played its first home game March 11 (but not until after a two-hour rain delay). UVA's midweek games with VCU and GW have yet to be rescheduled.

FRESHMEN PROVIDE BOOST

- Virginia's freshmen have played a key role in the early going this season.
- UVA's first-year players have combined to record 50.7 percent of the position player starts as well as 46 percent of the hits and runs.

TOWNS STEPS UP TO MAN CLEANUP SPOT

- Senior Kenny Towns has been UVA's top run producer out of the cleanup spot with a team-high 24 RBI.
- He is batting .337 (second on team) and also leads the team in hits (31) and doubles (10)
- Towns's streak of reaching base safely in 36 straight games came to an end in the first game of the March 7 doubleheader against Pitt.
- He reached base safely in the first 13 games this season after finishing the 2014 season by reaching safely in 26 straight games.
- His 36-game streak ranked fourth in Division I baseball and tops amongst ACC players.

INJURIES FORCE CAVALIERS TO JUGGLE LINEUP

- Virginia has been forced to alter its lineup after injuries have hampered three of its returning starters.
- The Cavaliers already have trotted out 16 different starting lineups in the first 23 games.
- Kenny Towns (3B) and Daniel Pinero (SS) are the lone Cavaliers to start every game at the same position.
- Two-year starting OF Joe McCarthy had back surgery in late January and is slated to miss approximately 12 weeks.
- Catcher Robbie Coman injured his knee on Feb. 21 and missed eight games, although he still is unavailable to catch.
- John La Prise is currently out with a hip injury that has limited him to four games this season.
- Freshmen Jack Gerstenmaier (hamstring) and Riley Wilson (shoulder) also have been sidelined by injuries and have not played this season.

JONES SETTLES INTO STARTING ROLE

- In his first season in the UVa rotation, Connor Jones has been solid, with a 4-1 record and 3.00 ERA.
- He is tied for third in the ACC with four wins.
- In 33 innings, Jones is limiting opponents to a .212 batting average, but he has walked 19 batters.
- He is 17th in the ACC in ERA.

SBORZ TAKES OVER AS CLOSER

- Josh Sborz moved into the bullpen and the closer role this season and has recorded five saves (tied for second in ACC).
- He went 6-4 with a 2.92 ERA in 17 games (15 starts) during the 2014 season, primarily as the Saturday starter.
- Sborz took over for All-American Nick Howard, who saved an ACC-record 20 games last year and was taken 19th overall by the Cincinnati Reds in the MLB Draft.
- UVa closers own 155 saves in the 12 seasons under the current coaching staff (13.5 saves per season).
- Six of the seven closers since 2004 have been selected in the MLB Draft, including five in the top 10 rounds.

UVA STARTS SEASON 10-0 FOR FOURTH TIME

- Virginia recorded a 10-0 start for the fourth time in program history – all during Brian O'Connor's 12 seasons as head coach. All 10 games were away from home (three road, seven neutral).
- UVa won 19 consecutive games to begin the 2009 season. That remains the longest win streak at any point in program history.
- UVa won 11 straight to open the 2008 season and 14 straight to begin the 2013 campaign.
- The Cavaliers were one of the last two unbeaten teams in the nation, joining Texas A&M.

CAVALIERS CAPTURE 18-INNING MARATHON

- Virginia defeated Marist 5-4 in 18 innings on Feb. 22 in Charleston, S.C. It is the longest game by innings in program history.
- The previous high was a 17-inning game, ironically also in Charleston, in 2006 against College of Charleston.
- It is believed to be the second-longest game by time (5:08), behind the 2006 CofC game, which lasted 5:19.
- Virginia shut out Marist over the final 11 innings.
- Freshman Christian Lowry's first college hit, a one-out single in the 18th, scored Matt Thaiss with the winning run.

CAVALIERS TAKE FIRST-EVER FOREIGN TOUR

- Virginia went on an eight-day international tour to Central America from Dec. 17-24, marking the baseball program's first-ever foreign tour.
- UVa traveled to Panama and Costa Rica.
- The foreign tour enabled the young squad to gel through extra practice time, an exhibition game in Panama City and team-building events.
- In its exhibition contest, UVa scored a 9-1 win over Panama Metro on Dec. 18 at Rod Carew National Stadium, a 27,000-seat stadium which hosted games in the 2013 World Baseball Classic.
- During its travels through Panama, the Cavaliers had the opportunity to tour the Miraflores Locks at the Panama Canal, canoe down the Tigris River and visit the indigenous Embera Village, where the team toured and learned about the village's customs.
- While in Costa Rica, the team toured the Doka Coffee Plantation, zip-lined through the rainforest, hiked through the Arenal Volcano National Park and went white-water rafting on the Savegre River.

PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

- Three Cavaliers were named preseason All-Americans: LHP Nathan Kirby, OF Joe McCarthy and LHP Brandon Waddell.
- Kirby was a unanimous first-team All-America selection, while McCarthy and Waddell each were named to various teams.

MCCARTHY OUT FOLLOWING BACK SURGERY

- Junior OF Joe McCarthy is scheduled to miss approximately 12 weeks after undergoing back surgery on Jan. 29.
- A 2015 Preseason All-American, McCarthy started all 69 games last season, batting .301 with six home runs and 49 RBI. He led the team with 16 doubles and 11 stolen bases and was one off the team lead with 77 hits.
- During his two seasons at UVa, McCarthy is a .317 batter with 152 hits in 129 games.

KIRBY, WADDELL ON GOLDEN SPIKES WATCH LIST

- Virginia left-handed pitchers Nathan Kirby and Brandon Waddell each were named to the preseason Golden Spikes Award watch list.
- The list consists of 50 players in amateur baseball.
- Virginia is one of seven schools who have multiple players on the list, joining Cal State Fullerton, Florida, Miami, TCU, UCLA and Vanderbilt.
- A preseason First-Team All-American, Kirby was a semifinalist for the 2014 Golden Spikes Award.

VIRGINIA LANDS NO. 2 RECRUITING CLASS

- Virginia reeled in the No. 2-ranked recruiting class for 2014 according to Baseball America, behind only LSU. It marked the best recruiting ranking in program history.
- The class is comprised of 13 student-athletes.
- Three were selected in the 2014 MLB Draft: RHP Derek Casey (22nd round, St. Louis), 1B/LHP Pavin Smith (32nd round, Colorado) and RHP Tommy Doyle (35th round, Washington).

WHO'S GONE?

- Virginia has plenty of holes to fill after losing five position players and three key members of its bullpen to the 2014 MLB Draft.
- Virginia had three first-round picks, just the seventh program in the last 20 years to do so in one year: RHP Nick Howard (No. 19), OF Derek Fisher (No. 37) and OF Mike Papi (No. 38).
- UVa also lost OF Brandon Downes (7th round), INF Branden Cogswell (7th), RHP Artie Lewicki (8th), RHP Whit Mayberry (21st) and C Nate Irving (34th).
- With eight players drafted, UVa tied for the second most picks of any school in 2014 (Ole Miss, 9).
- UVa had six players taken in the top 10 rounds – most of any school.

O'CONNOR LEADS ACTIVE COACHES IN WIN PCT., 13TH ALL-TIME

- Virginia head coach Brian O'Connor is 529-185-2 (.742) in his 12th season in charge of the Cavaliers' program.
- O'Connor's 74.3 percent winning percentage entering the season ranked No. 1 among active Division I head coaches.
- O'Connor also ranks 13th all-time in career winning percentage among all coaches with at least 10 years of head coaching experience.
- Virginia has won at least 39 games in all 11 of O'Connor's seasons, including nine 40-win seasons and four 50-win campaigns.

UVA BREAKS SCHOOL ATTENDANCE RECORDS

- Virginia broke the school records for season and average attendances last season.
- UVa ranked 11th nationally in total attendance (142,496) and average attendance (3,749).
- Both totals ranked third among ACC programs.
- UVa crushed its previous records for average (3,298 in 2011) and total attendance (125,959 in 2010).
- More than 110,000 fans have attended Virginia games each of the past five seasons as UVa has ranked among the top 20 programs nationally in attendance every year.

MOST WINS SINCE 2009

- With 313 victories since the start of the 2009 season, Virginia owns the most wins of any team in the nation in that span.
- The Cavaliers have won 50 games or more four times in the last five seasons.
