TONIGHT'S GAME

- Virginia continues a stretch of three games in six days as it visits NC State
- The Cavaliers look for their fifth true road win of the season, a feat they haven't accomplished since the 2000-01 season
- UVa looks for its fourth consecutive win over NC State

SERIES HISTORY

- NCSU leads 80-57 (NCSU leads 41-19 in Raleigh, including 7-3 at the RBC Center)
- The Cavaliers have won six of the last eight meetings, including the last three
- Virginia won the only meeting last season, 69-58, in Charlottesville
- The last meeting in Raleigh was a 70-62 Cavalier win in 2009-10 in Tony Bennett's ACC debut

STRONG START TO THE SEASON

- The Cavaliers' 16-3 record is their best start to a season since going 27-3 to open the 1982-83 season
- Virginia won 13 non-conference regular-season games this season, its most since winning 14 non-conference regular-season games in 1990-91

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia defeated Boston College 66-49 on Thursday night at JPJA
- With their 16th win of the season the Cavaliers matched last season's win total
- UVa shot 50.9% (27-53) from the floor, its seventh game this season 50% or better
- Mike Scott had 18 points, while Jontel Evans and Akil Mitchell each had 10 points

SHOOT TO WIN

- Virginia has shot under 40% from the field in each of its three losses this season
- The Cavaliers are 13-0 this season when shooting over 40% from the field
- Dating back to last season, UVa has won 16 straight games when shooting over 40% from the floor

2011-12 Opponents in Bold

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- The Cavaliers have held their last three opponents under 50 points, marking the first time in the shot clock era (second overall) an ACC team has held three consecutive conference opponents under 50 points (UNC accomplished the feat in the '82 ACC Tournament)
- Virginia has held nine opponents this season under 50 points
- It has accomplished the feat 16 times in the Tony Bennett era
- The nine games of holding opponents under 50 points are the most for the Cavaliers in a season since holding nine opponents under 50 points in 1981-82

'HOOS RANKED

- Virginia is ranked No. 19 this week in The Associated Press Top 25
- It marks the first time Virginia has been in the AP poll in six consecutive weeks since the 2001-02 season
- Virginia's No. 15 AP ranking on Jan. 16 was its highest since Feb. 11, 2002 (No. 15)
- UVa is ranked No. 21 this week in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll

CLOSE LOSSES

- All three of Virginia's losses this season have been by a single possession, and in two of the games the Cavaliers had the final shot to win or tie
- Virginia's 2.3 point average margin of loss ranks second nationally (Kentucky-1.0)
- In the 57-55 loss to TCU in the Paradise Jam, Joe Harris' 3-pointer to win the game missed as time expired
- In the 61-58 loss at Duke, Mike Scott and Jontel Evans each had opportunities from 3-point range in the closing seconds to force overtime

CAVALIERS GET DEFENSIVE

- Virginia is second in the nation in scoring defense at 50.1 ppg (as of 1/27)
- UVa is second in the nation in points allowed per possession (0.83) and is 20th nationally in field goal percentage defense (38.7%)
- Virginia leads the nation in fewest assists/game allowed (7.1) and ranks third nationally in opponents' assist-to-turnover ratio (0.53)
- The Cavaliers held each of their first 10 opponents under 60 points, their longest streak since 17 straight games from the end of the 1947-48 season (last eight games) to the start of the 1948-49 season (first nine games)
- It is the third-longest streak in ACC history (longest in the shot clock era)
- Virginia held Drexel to 35 points, the second lowest scoring total by a UVa opponent in the shot clock era
- South Carolina State's 25.5% shooting (13-51) was the lowest percentage allowed by UVa since Liberty shot 22.6% (12-53) against UVa in the 2005-06 season opener
- Virginia has held four opponents under 30% shooting this season (only accomplished the feat twice in the previous three seasons combined)
- It is the first time UVa has held multiple opponents under 30% shooting in the same season since 2005-06 (three times)

ONE AND DONE...

- Virginia leads the nation in defensive rebounding percentage at 77.5%
- The Cavaliers have allowed points on just 42.0 percent of their opponents' possessions this season (second nationally)
- Opponents are averaging 6.1 second chance points a game this season
- UVa has held 17 of 19 opponents to single digit second chance points
- Virginia has held two opponents (Longwood, Virginia Tech!) to zero second chance points

70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 23-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 24-32 over the past three seasons when scoring under 70 points

ROAD WARRIORS

- Virginia is 4-1 this season in true road games
- Dating back to last season, UVa has won six of its last seven true road games
- With a win tonight, the Cavaliers will have won five road games in a season for the first time since 2000-01

THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- UVa set a school record by going 19-for-19 from the free throw line against Winthrop
- The previous school record was 16-for-16 against South Carolina on Jan. 8, 1965
- It was the best free throw performance by an ACC team since Wake Forest shot an ACC-record 32-for-32 against North Carolina in 2005
- Virginia also went perfect from the line (8-8) vs. Boston College
- It is the first time since 1987-88 that UVa has had two perfect games from the line in the same season

SCOTT ON WOODEN AWARD MIDSEASON LIST

- Mike Scott is one of 25 players on the Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 List
- He is the first Cavalier to be named to the list since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

SCOTT NAMED ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK THREE TIMES

- Mike Scott leads the league with three ACC Player of the Week awards this season
- He joins Barry Parkhill (1971-72), Ralph Sampson (1982-83), Bryant Stith (1989-90) and Norman Nolan (1997-98) as the only Cavaliers to be named ACC Player of the Week three times in a season
- Scott was named ACC Player of the Week on Dec. 19, Dec. 26 and Jan. 9
- With his awards on Dec. 19 and Dec. 26 he became the first Cavalier to be honored in consecutive weeks since Sean Singletary in January 2007

MIKE SCOTT DOMINATES IN SEATTLE

- Mike Scott had a career-high 33 points (12-14 FG), along with 14 rebounds, in Virginia's 83-77 win at Seattle University on Dec. 21
- Scott's 33 points were the most by a Cavalier since Sean Singletary scored 41 points at Miami on Mar. 1, 2008
- Scott's 33 points are the most by an ACC player this season
- Scott is the first ACC player with at least 33 pts and at least 14 rebs in a game since Florida State's Al Thornton (37 pts, 15 rebs) at Duke on Feb. 4, 2006
- Scott's 19 points in the first half were the most in a half by a Cavalier since Sylvan Landesberg had 26 second half points vs. Boston College (Feb. 4, 2009) and the most in a first half since Sean Singletary had 23 first half points vs. Virginia Tech (Jan. 26, 2008)

SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball
- He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP

- Mike Scott enters the game with 29 career double-doubles (T-3rd in UVa history)
- He has five double-doubles this season
- His 29 career double-doubles lead all active ACC players
- Scott has two "20-10" games this season (six in his career)

SCOTT LEADS THE ACC

- Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (1,279), rebounds (839) and double-doubles (29)

ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE

- Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 176 career 3-pointers, which ranks sixth in school history
- He has made at least three 3-pointers in seven games this season, including four games with four 3-pointers
- Zeglinski is fourth in the ACC in 3-point percentage at 36.8%

EVANS DISHES IT OUT

- Jontel Evans ranks fifth in the ACC at 3.6 assists/game
- Evans has had seven games this season with at least five assists

EVANS SHINES AGAINST WINTHROP

- Jontel Evans scored a career-high 17 points against Winthrop
- He was 5-6 from the field, made a career-high two 3-pointers, and went 5-5 from the free throw line
- His previous career high was 11 points

SENE INJURED

- Assane Sene injured his right ankle during the Jan. 19 game at Georgia Tech
- X-rays showed a fracture and he underwent surgery on Jan. 20
- He is expected to be out approximately six weeks

RETURN TO SENE-DER

- Assane Sene ranks T-6th in school history with 108 career blocks
- He leads the Cavaliers with 15 blocks this season

ACC LEADERS

- Mike Scott leads the ACC in field goal percentage (.581)
- Scott ranks fourth in scoring (16.6) and sixth in rebounding (8.4)
- Joe Harris ranks 20th in scoring (12.3)
- Sammy Zeglinski ranks fourth in 3-point percentage (.368) and fifth in steals (1.6)
- Jontel Evans ranks fifth in assists (3.6) and fourth in steals (1.8)

COMEBACK CAVS

- Virginia rallied from halftime deficits to win at both Oregon and Seattle
- It marked the first time the Cavaliers won consecutive games when trailing at the half since 2009-10 (at NC State, vs. Georgia Tech)
- It marked the first time Virginia won consecutive games (both on the road) when trailing at the half since 1990-91 (at Minnesota, at Marquette)

NOTABLE WIN IN ATLANTA

- Virginia's 70-38 win at Georgia Tech on Jan. 19 was notable for several reasons
- The 32-point margin of victory was UVa's largest in an ACC game since a 104-72 win over NC State on Jan. 29, 1991 at University Hall
- It was the Cavaliers' largest margin of victory in an ACC road game since a 33-point win (107-74) at Wake Forest on Mar. 2, 1983
- The Yellow Jackets' 38 points were the fewest allowed by UVa in an ACC game since a 61-37 win over Clemson on Jan. 11, 1995 at University Hall
- Georgia Tech shot 29.2% (14-48) from the floor, the first time UVa held an ACC opponent under 30% since Wake Forest (29.0%, 20-69) on Feb. 24, 1996

CAVALIERS TOP MICHIGAN

- UVa's 70-58 win over No. 14 Michigan was its highest ranked win of the Bennett era
- It was the Cavaliers' first double-digit win over a top-15 opponent since a 72-58 win over No. 11 Boston College on Feb. 21, 2006 at University Hall

HARRELL AND JOHNSON DECIDE TO TRANSFER

- Sophomore guard KT Harrell (Dec. 23) and redshirt freshman forward James Johnson (Dec. 24) announced they were transferring
- Harrell appeared in 11 games (starting five) and averaged 4.7 ppg this season
- Johnson appeared in six games and averaged 1.5 ppg this season

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was the highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVa has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons
- North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College

FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA

- UVa signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class
- The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.

JONES JOINS CAVALIERS

- Teven Jones, who signed with Virginia in November, enrolled at UVa for the start of the spring semester
- Jones, who was attending Fishburne Military Academy, will practice with the Cavaliers for the remainder of the season, but will not play in games
- He will still have four years of eligibility at Virginia beginning with the 2012-13 season

UP NEXT

- Virginia returns home to host Clemson on Tuesday (Jan. 31)
- Game time at JPJA is 7 p.m., and the game will be televised on ESPN2
