VIRGINIA WELCOMES NOTRE DAME TO CHARLOTTESVILLE

- Virginia and Notre Dame are playing in Charlottesville for the first time as ACC rivals. ND played in Charlottesville in a three game series March 22-24, 1991.
- UVA holds a 6-3 edge in the all-time series, including 3-1 as ACC foes.
- The teams played in the 1996 NCAA South I Regional in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. Notre Dame won the tournament opener, 12-1, on May 23 before UVA bounced the Fighting Irish from the tourney with a 7-1 victory.
- UVA head coach Brian O'Connor was an assistant at Notre Dame in 1996.

O'CONNOR-NOTRE DAME CONNECTIONS

- UVA head coach Brian O'Connor was an assistant on then-head coach Paul Mainieri's staff at Notre Dame for nine seasons from 1994-2003.
- During O'Connor's nine years at Notre Dame, the Irish compiled an overall record of 399-160-1 (.713), won six conference championships and made five trips to the NCAA tournament, including a 2002 berth in the College World Series.
- While at Notre Dame, O'Connor worked with the Fighting Irish pitchers and served as the program's recruiting coordinator.
- He was named the National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2001 and 2003.

HOME RUNS GALORE

- UVA has hit 45 home runs, which already is third most in the Brian O'Connor era.
- The top two home run seasons under O'Connor: 2010 (61) and 2009 (59), both of which came with the old bats.
- The Cavaliers hit 42 home runs in 2016 (60 games).
- Eleven Cavaliers have gone deep this year, and UVA is fourth in the ACC in homers.
- Adam Haseley is sixth in the ACC with 11 HR, while Pavin Smith is 11th (10).
- UVA has a streak of 10 straight games with at least one home run snapped Wednesday (longest since 11-game stretch from Feb. 28-March 15, 1998).

RUN, RUN AND RUN SOME MORE

- Virginia has stolen an ACC-high 69 bases this year (in 80 attempts), its most since swiping 72 in 2012.
- UVA ranks 10th nationally in stolen bases.
- Four Cavaliers already have at least seven stolen bases. UVA's leader in 2016 was Ernie Clement with six.
- Jake McCarthy has an ACC-best 25 steals in 26 tries. He ranks third nationally.
- It marks the fourth-most steals in a season for a UVA player and the most since Greg Midlat had 30 in 2008.
- UVA stole 27 bases in 60 games last year, its fewest stolen bases during the Brian O'Connor era.

THINGS TO KNOW

- In four career games vs. Notre Dame, Adam Haseley is 7-for-15 (.467) and Pavin Smith is 7-for-17 (.412).
- UVA is No. 11 in the latest RPI (ND is No. 101).
- Virginia ranks third nationally in hits (451).
- UVA leads the ACC in batting in all games (.324) and ACC games (.308) and is sixth nationally.
- Adam Haseley tops the ACC in batting (.411) and runs (49).
- Tommy Doyle is tied for the ACC lead and fifth nationally in saves (11).

SIMMONS HEATS UP

- Cameron Simmons had a career-high 12-game hit streak snapped Wednesday. He batted .500 (21-42) during that stretch.
- Simmons has upped his batting average to .366, which currently ranks eighth in the ACC.
- He also is batting .391 in ACC games, tops among all conference players.
- Simmons had his streak of seven straight multiple-hit games broken Tuesday. No other UVA player has more than four straight multi-hit games this year.

CAVALIERS AT HOME AT DAVENPORT

- The Cavaliers are 22-4 at home this season.
- Virginia is 399-99 (.800) at Davenport Field since 2004.
- The Cavaliers are on pace to top the 100,000 mark in attendance for the seventh time in eight years.

HASELEY CONTINUES STRONG 2017

- Adam Haseley is putting up team highs in batting (.407), extra-base hits (20) and on base percentage (.508) while hitting in the 3-hole.
- Haseley also owns a team-high 11 home runs – seven of which have gone to the opposite field.
- He leads the ACC in batting and runs, is second in hits (61), in total bases (104), OBP and slugging (.693), third in walks (31) and seventh in home runs.
- Haseley also is 5-1 with a 3.31 ERA in 54 1/3 innings on the mound. He is ninth in the ACC in innings and 16th in ERA.
- He is on the John Olerud Two-Way Player Award, National Pitcher of the Year and Golden Spikes Award watch lists.

PAVIN SMITH: NOT YOUR NORMAL POWER HITTER

- Pavin Smith has put up some big numbers in the first half of the season, hitting for power as well as contact.
- Smith ranks as the third toughest to strike out of any player in Division I, with five strikeouts in 156 official at bats (184 plate appearances).
- He is tied for 46th nationally with 10 home runs.
- Only one other player among the top 50 nationally in home runs has fewer than 15 strikeouts – UVA's Adam Haseley with 14.

TIME TO ... GO TO WORK!

- Pavin Smith and Adam Haseley are the first UVA teammates to each record at least 10 homers in a season since Phil Gosselin (11), Jarrett Parker (10) and Steven Proscia (10) in 2010.
- Haseley is seventh in the ACC in homers; Smith is 11th.
- With 25 career homers, Smith is one round-tripper from reaching the top 10 in program history. He also has cracked the top 10 in RBI at 154 (tied for ninth).

KNIGHT BOLSTERS OFFENSE

- Caleb Knight has provided a boost to UVA's lineup over the last month, starting 14 games since the Duke series.
- UVA is 13-1 in his starts.
- In those starts, Knight has gone 19-for-43 (.442) with 13 RBI and 17 runs scored. His on-base percentage is .576 in his 14 starts.
- His three homers all have come in ACC games.
- He was inserted in the lineup as a defensive replacement in the Friday, March 24, game against Duke.

NOTING THE VIRGINIA TECH SERIES

- Virginia won its first series in Blacksburg since 2011.
- Cameron Simmons was 7-for-13 (.538) with three straight multi-hit games.
- Five Cavalier starters batted at least .400 in the three-game set as UVA hit .336 in the series.
- A pair of UVA errors led to four unearned runs in the Saturday loss.

OFFENSE LOOKS TO KEEP HUMMING

- Virginia tops the ACC in batting in all games (.324) as well as ACC games (.308)
- UVA already has faced the conference's top three teams in ERA (North Carolina, Louisville, Clemson). Notre Dame is 10th in the ACC in ERA, but fifth in ACC-only games (4.18).
- In ranking 11th nationally in scoring at 7.9 runs per game, UVA is third among all Division I teams in hits (451) and sixth in batting.

WHATEVER IT TAKES

- A key part of Virginia's scoring numbers has come from execution.
- UVA is No. 1 nationally in sacrifice flies with 27 and ninth in sacrifice bunts with 36.
- UVA also has been hit by 49 pitches, which is third most in the conference and 26th nationally.

AGGRESSIVE CAVALIERS PUT BALL IN PLAY

- Virginia batters have struck out an ACC-low 148 times in 40 games (3.7 strikeouts per game).
- That total by far the fewest among ACC teams (Louisville, 209), and less than half the total of four teams.
- UVA is the only ACC team to walk more than it has struck out (163 BB).
- The Cavaliers have struck out five or fewer times in 35 of 40 games.
- Ernie Clement (second), Pavin Smith (third) and Robbie Coman (eighth) all rank among the top 10 nationally in toughest to strike out and are the three toughest in the ACC.

BIG INNINGS PLAGUE CAVALIERS

- Virginia has given up 15 innings of four or more runs this year, including 10 in ACC play.
- In six of UVA's eight ACC defeats, the Cavaliers gave up at least one inning of four-plus runs.
- UVA allowed 12 innings of four or more runs in 2016 and 16 in 2015.

HASELEY, SMITH NAMED TO MIDSEASON GOLDEN SPIKES WATCH LIST

- Virginia's junior duo of Adam Haseley and Pavin Smith were named to the 40-man midseason watch list for the Golden Spikes Award.
- UVA is one of six schools to have two players on the list.
- Haseley was named to the midseason watch list for the second year in a row.
- The semifinalists will be named May 31, with the finalists unveiled on June 14. The trophy will be presented June 29 in Los Angeles.

O'CONNOR REACHES 600 WINS

- Brian O'Connor won his 600th career game on Feb. 21 against VMI. He was the 10th coach in ACC history to reach the 600-win plateau and, in 825 games, the second-fastest in league history to hit 600 wins (Mike Martin, 802 games).
- Now with 626 career wins, O'Connor ranks ninth in league history.
- The winningest coach in program history, O'Connor also holds the UVA record for career ACC wins (254) and NCAA tournament wins (47).

IN THE POLLS

- Virginia is ranked as high as No. 11 in the latest polls (USA Today Coaches poll).
- UVA is 3-6 against ranked teams this year, all of whom currently are ranked in the top five.
- UVA has played nine games against teams currently ranked in the USA Today poll: Louisville (2), North Carolina (4) and Clemson (5).
- The Cavaliers do not play Wake Forest (17) in league play this year.

RECORDS WATCH

- Having pitched in 74 career games, RHP Alec Bettinger has tied Andrew Carraway (2006-09) for ninth in UVA history.
- With 10 career saves, he needs two saves to reach the top 10 in UVA history.
- Adam Haseley stands seventh in school history with 166 runs scored and needs nine to pass David Stone (1999-2002) and 10 to eclipse Adam Robinson (1994-97) for fifth.
- Haseley is ninth in program history with 10 triples and will move into a fifth-place tie with his next triple.
- Pavin Smith (25 HR) is one long ball shy of the top 10 at UVA and with 154 RBI is ninth in program history (needs three for eighth).
- Jake McCarthy (25 SB) is fourth in single-season stolen bases and needs one to reach the No. 3 slot. The record is 32, set by Greg Miclat in 2007.

HOOS IN THE PROS

- Virginia had seven alumni on MLB Opening Day rosters, most among ACC schools and tied for fifth most nationally.
- The three 2015 UVA draftees all have moved up: Matt Thaiss (high-A Island Empire 66ers), Connor Jones (high-A Palm Beach Cardinals) and Daniel Pinero (class-A West Michigan Whitecaps).
- Joe McCarthy opened 2017 with the double-A Montgomery Biscuits, while Stephen Bruno moved up to the triple-A Iowa Cubs.

TRIO OF PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

- Three Cavaliers were named to various All-America teams in the preseason: Ernie Clement (2B), Adam Haseley (UTL) and Pavin Smith (1B).
- Haseley and Smith also were named to the 55-man Golden Spikes Award Watch List.
- The Preseason All-America honors:
 - **Ernie Clement:** 1st team (D1Baseball), 2nd team (Baseball America)
 - **Adam Haseley:** 2nd team (Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball, D1Baseball)
 - **Pavin Smith:** 1st Team (Baseball America, Perfect Game), 2nd Team (Collegiate Baseball, D1Baseball)

O'CONNOR RANKS THIRD IN ACTIVE WIN PCT., 18TH ALL-TIME

- Virginia head coach Brian O'Connor is 626-232-2 (.729) in his 14th season as UVA's head coach.
- O'Connor surpassed Dennis Womack (594 wins, 1981-2003) as the winningest coach in program history on May 28, 2016, against Louisville.
- O'Connor's 72.7 percent winning percentage entering the season ranked No. 3 among active Division I head coaches.
- O'Connor also ranks 18th all-time in career winning percentage among all coaches with at least 10 years of head coaching experience.
- Virginia won at least 38 games in each of O'Connor's first 13 seasons, including 10 40-win seasons and four 50-win campaigns.

LONGEVITY, STABILITY IN COACHING STAFF

- Virginia's coaching trio of Brian O'Connor, Kevin McMullan and Karl Kuhn are in their 14th year together.
- No current coaching staff in Division I college baseball has been together longer.
- The staff has combined for 626 wins, an average of over 45 wins per season, and has reached the NCAA tournament in each of their first 13 seasons.

UVA SECOND NATIONALLY IN ERA SINCE 2005

- Entering the season, Virginia owned the second best ERA among all NCAA Division I teams over the past 12 seasons with a 3.17 team ERA since 2005.
- UVA finished second nationally in ERA (2.23) in 2014 and has ranked among the NCAA top 20 in nine of the 13 years under the current coaching staff.
- Virginia led the nation in ERA in 2011 (2.24) and posted No. 3 marks in 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2009.

DEFENSE TOPS ACC UNDER CURRENT STAFF

- Virginia has posted the ACC's best fielding percentage since the current coaching staff arrived in 2004.
- UVA has accrued a .973 fielding percentage over the last 13 seasons.
