### FOR OPENERS

- The Cavaliers have a six-game winning streak against George Washington.
- Virginia won each of its first three games by at least 20 points for the first time since 2001-02.
- Virginia has a 13-game home winning streak (12 of the 13 victories during the streak have been by double digits).
- The Cavaliers rank third in the nation in field goal percentage defense at 28.4 percent, holding each of their opponents under 33 percent.
- UVA has outrebounded each of its opponents and has a +13.7 rebounding margin.
- Justin Anderson has led or tied for the team lead in scoring in each of the first three games and is averaging a career-high 15.3 points.
- Anderson and Darion Atkins will compete against former high school teammates. Anderson was a teammate of Kevin Larsen at Montrose Christian, while Atkins and Joe McDonald were teammates at The Landon School.

### SERIES HISTORY

- UVA is 25-23 all-time against George Washington in the series that dates back to the 1906-07 season.
- The Cavaliers meet the Colonials for the first time since March 17, 2004, when Virginia beat George Washington 79-66 in the first round of the NIT in Charlottesville.
- Virginia holds a 15-10 advantage over George Washington in 25 contests in Charlottesville.

### LAST TIME VS. GEORGE WASHINGTON

- Todd Billett pumped in 19 points and J.R. Reynolds added 17 as Virginia defeated George Washington, 79-66, in the first round of the 2004 NIT at University Hall in Charlottesville.
- Billett canned five 3-pointers as UVA connected on 50 percent (13-26) of its long-range attempts in the win.
- T.J. Bannister added 11 points and five assists for UVA.
- J.R. Pinnock had 19 points for George Washington and Pops Mensah-Bonsu added 13 points and eight rebounds.

### VIRGINIA REMAINS NO. 9 IN LATEST ASSOCIATED PRESS POLL

- UVA is ranked No. 9 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today coaches' polls.
- The Cavaliers were ranked No. 9/8 in the AP and USA Today preseason coaches' polls.
- The No. 9 AP preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.
- UVA's No. 3 final AP ranking last season marked its highest final ranking since 1982.

### ALL-TIME AGAINST THE ATLANTIC 10

- George Washington is one of four Atlantic 10 Conference opponents on UVA's 2014-15 schedule (Davidson, La Salle and VCU).
- Virginia is 112-79 all-time against current Atlantic 10 members (11-4 vs. Davidson, 2-0 vs. Dayton, 0-3 vs. Fordham, 7-1 vs. George Mason, 25-23 vs. George Washington, 0-2 vs. LaSalle, 2-0 vs. UMass, 1-1 vs. Rhode Island, 52-36 vs. Richmond, 2-6 vs. Saint Joseph's, 0-1 vs. Saint Louis and 10-2 vs. VCU).
- UVA went 1-1 vs. current Atlantic 10 members last season (59-56 loss to VCU and 70-57 win over Davidson).

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Justin Anderson and Malcolm Brogdon scored 17 points apiece to lead Virginia to a 75-55 non-conference win over South Carolina State on Tuesday, Nov. 18.
- Anthony Gill added 11 points and tied for the team-high with rookie Isaiah Wilkins with eight rebounds, and Mike Tobey added 10 points and five rebounds.
- UVa out-rebounded the Bulldogs, 46-26, and outscored SCSU, 40-14, in the paint.
- The Cavaliers were 15-18 from the free-throw line, improving their season percentage to 75 percent after shooting 67 percent from the line last year.
- UVa led 41-20 at the half and has led by 18 or more points at intermission in each of its three games.

**VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Sixth-year UVa head coach Tony Bennett sports a 109-60 mark in Charlottesville and 178-93 record in nine seasons.
- Bennett was named 2014 ACC Coach of the Year after guiding the Cavaliers to their first ACC Tournament championship since 1976.
- In 2013-14, he guided UVa to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has guided the Cavaliers to three consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012 and 2014 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett has increased UVa's win total in each of the last five seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12, 23 in 2013-13 and 30 in 2013-14).
- Bennett-coached teams are 62-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his nine-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have finished in the top five nationally in scoring defense in five of eight seasons (first in 2008-09; second in 2007-08 and 2011-12, fifth in 2012-13 and first in 2013-14).
- Bennett is one of 24 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

**EMBRACE THE PACE**

- Virginia is averaging 73.7 points and allowing 48.3 points in 2014-15.
- UVa has shot 49.4 percent from the field and 47.7 percent from 3-point range, while limiting its opponents to 28.4 percent from the field and 35.4 percent from 3-point range.
- The Cavaliers have held 27 straight opponents and 37 straight ACC opponents under 50 percent shooting from the field.
- UVa has limited its opponents to four fast break points.
- In 2014-15, the Cavaliers rank in the top 10 nationally in three defensive categories: field goal percentage (3rd), points per game (8th) and defensive rebounds per game (10th).

**BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION**

- Preseason All-ACC performer Malcolm Brogdon leads UVa into action this season.
- Brogdon ranks second on the team at 12.3 points per game and had a season-high 17 points against South Carolina State.
- Brogdon has scored in double figures in 25 of the last 27 games dating back to last season.
- In 2013-14, Brogdon averaged a career-high 12.7 points and 5.4 rebounds en route to All-ACC honors.
- Brogdon scored a career-best 23 points in the 2014 ACC Tournament final win against Duke.

**SIXTH MAN NO MORE**

- Junior guard Justin Anderson has started and led or tied for the team lead in scoring in each of the first three games.
- Anderson had 18 points at James Madison, 11 points against Norfolk State and 17 points vs. South Carolina State.
- He is averaging 15.3 points and shooting a career-high 48.1 percent from the field, including 62.5 percent (10-15) from 3-point range.
- Anderson was named 2014 ACC Sixth Man of the Year after averaging 7.8 points and 3.2 rebounds off the bench.
- In 2013-14, Anderson led the team in scoring in five games and had several game-changing defensive plays to ignite UVa.

**HIGH POINT MAN IN THE PAINT**

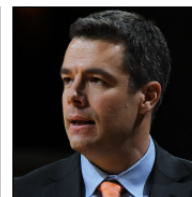
- Anthony Gill, a High Point, N.C., native, is averaging career highs in points (11.7) and rebounds (5.7) this season.
- Gill has hit doubles figures in two games, tallying a season-high 15 in the season-opener at James Madison.
- Gill is shooting a career-best 90 percent (9-10) from the free-throw line after shooting 62.7 percent last season and 64.6 percent at South Carolina in 2011-12.

**LONDON CALLING**

- Sophomore point guard London Perrantes returned to the lineup against Norfolk State and tallied seven points, four assists and no turnovers.
- Perrantes averaged 5.5 points and 3.8 assists to earn All-ACC Freshman Team honors last season.
- He ranked sixth nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.5.
- Perrantes (140 assists) became the fourth UVa freshman to record 100 assists in a season, joining Cory Alexander (144 in 1991-92), Jeff Jones (136 in 1978-79) and Sean Singletary (113 in 2004-05).

**NOLTE KNOWS SHOOTING**

- Junior forward Evan Nolte is one of Virginia's top 3-point shooting threats.
- Nolte, who keyed UVa's rally with a pair of 3-pointers against Coastal Carolina in the 2014 NCAA Tournament, has shot 36.8 percent from 3-point range during his career.
- Nolte returned to the lineup against Norfolk State and had five points, two rebounds and one steal.

## ROOKIES OFF TO GOOD START

- Redshirt freshman Devon Hall and true freshmen Isaiah Wilkins and Marial Shayok have made strong impressions in 2014-15.
- Hall had five points and five steals in a starting role in place of London Perrantes at James Madison.
- Wilkins chipped in eight points, five rebounds, three assists, two steals and two blocks at James Madison.
- Freshman B.J. Stith has seen limited action in all three games.
- Wilkins averaged 18.2 points, 10.3 rebounds and 3.4 blocks en route to Georgia Gatorade Player of the Year honors for Greater Atlanta Christian last season, while Shayok averaged 15 points and 6 rebounds per game for Blair Academy.
- Stith averaged 12.4 points and 4.3 rebounds for national runner-up Oak Hill Academy.
- Wilkins is the stepson of NBA Hall of Famer Dominique Wilkins, and Stith is the son of UVa all-time leading scorer Bryant Stith.

## PAINT IT ORANGE AND BLUE

- Virginia has outscored its opponents 98-32 in the paint after three games.
- Frontcourt players Anthony Gill, Mike Tobey, Darion Atkins and Isaiah Wilkins have combined to shoot 56.9 percent (37-65) from the field and are averaging 23 rebounds as a unit.
- The foursome have led the team to a +13.7 rebounding margin as UVa is averaging 41.7 rebounds.
- Gill, Tobey, Atkins and Wilkins have combined for 18 blocked shots in three games.

## ABOUT THE 2014-15 SCHEDULE

- Five of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the latest AP poll (Duke, North Carolina, Louisville, VCU and Syracuse), while six (Pittsburgh, Notre Dame, NC State, Florida State, George Washington and Maryland) received votes.
- Nine opponents (Duke, Louisville, Pittsburgh, NC State, George Washington, Harvard, North Carolina, Syracuse and VCU) played in the 2014 NCAA Tournament, while three (Clemson, Davidson and Florida State) participated in the National Invitation Tournament and two (Norfolk State and Cleveland State) in the Collegiansider.com Tournament.

## VIRGINIA PICKED 4TH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball for the second consecutive season.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked fourth and finished first last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in each of the last five seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Louisville, Virginia, Syracuse, Pitt, Notre Dame, Florida State, NC State, Miami, Clemson, Wake Forest, Georgia Tech, Boston College and Virginia Tech.

## BROGDON NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Malcolm Brogdon is one of five players named Preseason All-ACC.
- Joining Brogdon on the preseason All-ACC team were Marcus Paige (North Carolina), Montrezl Harrell (Louisville), Jahliel Okafor (Duke) and Jerian Grant (Notre Dame).
- Paige was the pick for Preseason ACC Player of the Year and Okafor was named Preseason ACC Rookie of the Year.

### INTERVIEWS
