#### TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Virginia looks for its second consecutive 20-win season
- The Cavaliers are looking for their 10th-straight NCAA round of 16 appearance (T-2nd longest active streak nationally with Florida State, behind UNC)

#### SERIES HISTORY:

- Series tied 3-3-0 (UVa leads 3-0-0 in Charlottesville)
- Virginia has won the last three meetings in the series
- UVa won the only previous NCAA meeting, a 6-1 win in the 2012 2nd round
- Virginia won last year's regular season game 6-0 at Klöckner
- Rutgers last beat Virginia in 1988, a 1-0 result in Fort Belvoir, Va.

#### NCAA TOURNAMENT HISTORY:

- Virginia is participating in its 21st consecutive NCAA Tournament and 27th NCAA Tournament overall
- Only UNC and Notre Dame have longer active consecutive NCAA streaks
- Since the tournament expanded to 64 teams in 2001, UVa is one of four schools to advance from the 1st round every year (UNC, Texas A&M, UCLA, UVa)
- Virginia has a 32-23-5 all-time NCAA Tournament record
- Under Steve Swanson, the UVa has a 29-12-4 NCAA Tournament record

#### AT HOME IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT:

- Virginia is hosting NCAA Tournament play for the 21st year
- At home, Virginia is 26-12-3 in NCAA Tournament play
- UVa is 24-4-2 at home in NCAA play since 2000

#### AGAINST THE BIG TEN:

- UVa is 8-12-1 all-time against Big Ten opponents (won last two)
- Virginia is 2-2 in NCAA Games vs. Big Ten (last: 2-1 win vs. Michigan in '13 QF)

**HIGH SCORING HOOS:**

- The Cavaliers lead the ACC and tied for first nationally in scoring offense at 3.48 goals per game
- Virginia led the nation in scoring in 2013 at 3.00 goals per game
- UVa has 16 different goal scorers this season, including 12 players with multiple goals and seven players with at least four goals
- Virginia has scored at least two goals in 19 of 21 games this season
- The Cavaliers are averaging 4.67 goals a game at home this season

**KLÖCK-WORK AT HOME:**

- Virginia has won a school-record 30 consecutive home games (longest active streak in the nation)
- It is the eighth-longest streak in NCAA Division I women's soccer history (chart on pg. 3)
- This year's senior class is 55-4-2 at Klöckner over their career

**ACC-OLADES:**

- Virginia led all schools with three first-team All-ACC selections (Morgan Brian, Danielle Colaprico and Makenzy Doniak)
- Brian becomes the fourth Cavalier to be a four-time 1st Team selection (Amanda Cromwell, Angela Hucles, Sinead Farrelly)
- Emily Sonnett (2nd Team) and Brittany Ratcliffe (3rd Team) were also honored
- Colaprico was the inaugural recipient of the ACC Midfielder of the Year award

**THE ERA OF OFFENSE:**

- Since this year's senior class arrived at Virginia in 2011, the Cavaliers have led the nation in goals
- Virginia has scored 276 goals over the past four seasons, including 78 last season to lead the nation

**SCORING FROM THE BACK:**

- Virginia has 14 goals from defenders this season (Cox-4, McNabb-4, Sonnett-3, Iordanou-2, Reid), breaking the school record of nine set last year

**BENCH PRODUCTION:**

- Virginia has recorded 18 goals and 13 assists this season from substitutes
- The Cavaliers have gotten a goal off the bench in 13 of 21 games this year
- The UVa bench has scored more goals this season than 60 Division I teams
- Against High Point, UVa had four goals from substitutes, most since five in a 9-1 win over Liberty in 2011

**FIVE FOR 20:**

- Virginia is the only team in the nation to have five 20-point scorers this season (Doniak-38, Colaprico-28, Brian-24, Ratcliffe-22, Reuther-20)
- The five 20-point scorers is a school record (previous: four in 2013)

**GOALS GALORE:**

- Virginia found the back of the net 12 times in wins over BC & NCSU
- First time since 2008 a team scored at least six goals in consecutive ACC games
- UVa was the first Power 5 Conference team (ACC, Big 12, Big Ten, Pac-12, SEC) to score at least six goals in consecutive games since 2011

**BRIAN TIES NCAA TOURNAMENT ASSIST RECORD**

- Morgan Brian tied the NCAA Tournament single-game assist record with five in the 8-0 win over High Point (playing just 33 minutes)
- It tied the record set by Kacey White of UNC in a 6-0 win over Pepperdine in 2005

**AND SOME VIRGINIA RECORDS FROM THE HIGH POINT GAME**

- Most goals by Virginia in an NCAA Tournament game (8)
- Tied most first-half goals by Virginia in any game (7)
- Tied most single-game points by a Cavalier (Morgan Brian - 7)
- Tied most single-game goals by a Cavalier (Morgan Reuther - 3)
- Most single-game assists by a Cavalier (Morgan Brian - 5)
- Fastest two goals by the same Cavalier (Morgan Reuther - 0:40)
- Fastest two goals by Virginia in the postseason (0:40)

**COLAPRICO SETS SINGLE-SEASON ASSIST MARK**

- Danielle Colaprico leads the ACC with 16 assists this season, setting a school record for assists in a season
- Her 41 career assists ranks 2nd in school history
- She had a point in seven straight games earlier this season, the longest streak of her career and tied for the fifth-longest streak in Cavalier history

**BRIAN HELPS UNITED STATES SECURE WORLD CUP BERTH:**

- Morgan Brian has returned to UVa after missing eight games this season due to international duty with the United States Women's National Team, including missing five games for CONCACAF World Cup Qualifying
- Brian made her first appearance in qualifying on Oct. 20, entering as a substitute in the 63rd minute and scoring a goal in the 82nd minute in the 6-0 win over Haiti at RFK Stadium in Washington
- She played 23 minutes as a substitute on Oct. 24 in the 3-0 semifinal win over Mexico in Philadelphia as the team clinched a Women's World Cup berth
- She started the championship game, a 6-0 win over Costa Rica, playing 50 minutes and assisting on Abby Wambach's goal in the fourth minute
- Brian has 16 appearances for the USWNT and three international goals since her debut in June 2013
- She was the only collegian on the 20-player USWNT qualifying roster

**SWANSON ASSISTING USWNT:**

- Head Coach Steve Swanson also assisted the United States Women's National Team as it competed in CONCACAF World Cup Qualifying
- He worked with both teams this fall, but his schedule minimized the number of Virginia games he missed (only one: Old Dominion)

**DONIAK RISING UP THE UVA RECORD BOOK:**

- Makenzy Doniak, only a junior, has entered several UVA career top 10 lists
- She ranks T-2nd in goals (45), 3rd in points (112) and T-5th in GWG (13)

**BRIAN AND DONIAK REACH 100 POINT MARK:**

- Morgan Brian became the fifth player in school history to record 100 career points (38G, 39A - 115pts) on Sept. 25
- Makenzy Doniak became the sixth player in school history to record 100 career points (45G, 22A - 112pts) on Oct. 12
- Virginia is the first ACC team to have two active 100-point scorers since North Carolina had three in 2005 (Lindsay Tarpley, Heather O'Reilly and Kacey White)

**BRIAN JOINS 30-30 CLUB:**

- Morgan Brian became the second Cavalier to join the 30-30 club, currently having 38 goals and 39 assists in her career
- Andrea Rubio (1989-92) is UVA's other member (36G, 30A)
- Rachel Tejada of Illinois State, Daphne Corboz of Georgetown and Sam Mewis of UCLA are the only other active members of the club
- If she records two goals and one assist during the remainder of the NCAA Tournament, Brian would become just the 45th player in NCAA Division I history to join the 40-40 club

**CAVALIERS HAVE TWO IN 30-20 CLUB:**

- Only 16 active players nationally have posted at least 30 goals and at least 20 assists in their career, and Virginia has two of them
- Morgan Brian (38G, 39A) and Makenzy Doniak (45G, 22A) are both members of the club
- Doniak is one of two juniors on the list

**UP NEXT:**

- The Virginia-Rutgers winner will play the Kentucky-Arizona State winner in the third round on Nov. 23
- Game time for Sunday's contest is 5 p.m. (the UVA men play at 1 p.m.)
