TONIGHT'S GAME

- Virginia opens a season-long four-game homestand by hosting Green Bay
- It marks the first time Tony Bennett will coach against his alma mater

SERIES HISTORY

- First all-time meeting between Virginia and Green Bay
- Green Bay is the fourth and final first-time opponent on Virginia's 2011-12 schedule (South Carolina State, TCU, Drake, Green Bay)

AGAINST THE HORIZON LEAGUE

- Green Bay is the only Horizon League opponent for Virginia this season
- The Cavaliers are 2-0 all-time against the Horizon League (1-0 vs. Cleveland State, 1-0 vs. Loyola-Chicago)
- UVa last played a HL team in 2009-10, a 76-65 win over Cleveland State in Cancun

BENNETT FACES ALMA MATER

- Tony Bennett is coaching against his alma mater, Green Bay, for the first time
- Bennett is still the school's all-time leading scorer with 2,285 career points
- His 49.7% career 3-point percentage is still the NCAA record
- The 1992 graduate led the Phoenix to the school's first NCAA Division I Tournament in 1991

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia downed Drake 60-52 in its final game at the Paradise Jam
- The Cavaliers went 2-1 in the tournament at the University of the Virgin Islands
- Joe Harris led Virginia with 18 points against Drake
- Mike Scott had 14 points and nine rebounds against the Bulldogs and was named to the Paradise Jam All-Tournament team

2011-12 Opponents in Bold

CAVALIERS GET DEFENSIVE

- Virginia is fourth in the nation in scoring defense at 46.0 ppg (as of 11/23)
- The Cavaliers have held each of their first five opponents under 60 points, the first time they have done that to open a season since 1948-49
- Virginia has held opponents under 20 points in a half three times this season, once more than all last season (two) and tying the entire 2009-10 season (three)
- UVa held three of its first five opponents to under 50 points, a feat it has done 10 times in the Tony Bennett era
- Virginia held Drexel to 35 points, the second lowest scoring total by a UVa opponent in the shot clock era
- South Carolina State's 25.5% shooting (13-51) was the lowest percentage allowed by UVa since Liberty shot 22.6% percent (12-53) against UVa in the 2005-06 season opener
- Virginia has held two opponents under 30% shooting this season (only accomplished the feat twice in the previous three seasons combined)
- It is the first time UVa has held multiple opponents under 30% shooting in the same season since 2005-06 (three times)

THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- UVa set a school record by going 19-for-19 from the free throw line against Winthrop
- The previous school record was 16-for-16 against South Carolina on Jan. 8, 1965
- It was the best free throw performance by an ACC team since Wake Forest shot an ACC-record 32-for-32 against North Carolina in 2005
- The Cavaliers lead the ACC in free throw shooting at 80.9% this season

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVa has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons
- North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College

SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball
- He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

EXPERIENCE COUNTS

- Virginia opened the season with the roster having 256 career starts, which is the most among ACC schools
- The Cavaliers had seven players who made a start in their career prior to this season (Mike Scott-74, Sammy Zeglinski-55, Assane Sene-48, Jontel Evans-38, Joe Harris-25, KT Harrell-15, Akil Mitchell-1)

70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 19-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 16-30 over the past three seasons when scoring under 70 points

'HOOS BACK

- 10 players return from last season's team that went 16-15 (7-9 ACC)
- The Cavaliers return 69.0% of scoring and 79.4% of rebounding from last season

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 62-28 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers went 11-6 at home last season

CAVALIER DEBUTS

- Malcolm Brogdon and James Johnson, along with walk-ons Rob Vozenilek and Angus Mitchell made their collegiate debuts in the season opener vs. SC State
- Brogdon had nine points, four assists and two rebounds in his debut
- Johnson had six points (6-8 FT) and three rebounds in his debut

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP

- Mike Scott enters the game with 25 career double-doubles (T-5th in UVa history)
- He had six double-doubles in his 10 games last season before suffering a season-ending injury
- His 25 career doubles leads all active ACC players
- Scott had his first double-double of the season against Drexel (21 pts, 10 rebs)
- It was his fifth "20-10" game of his career (at least 20 points and 10 rebounds)

SCOTT LEADS THE ACC

- Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (1,037), rebounds (729) and double-doubles (25)

SCOTT JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB

- Mike Scott became the 43rd Cavalier to score 1,000 career points, reaching the milestone against TCU in the Virgin Islands
- He enters the game with 1,037 career points, 40th in Virginia history

RETURN TO SENE-DER

- Assane Sene ranks seventh in school history with 98 career blocks
- He led the Cavaliers last season with 39 blocks

ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE

- Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 144 career 3-pointers, which ranks 10th in school history

EVANS SHINES AGAINST WINTHROP

- Jontel Evans scored a career-high 17 points against Winthrop
- He was 5-6 from the field, made a career-high two 3-pointers, and went 5-5 from the free throw line
- His previous career high was 11 points

JESPERSON TO REDSHIRT

- Freshman guard Paul Jespersen is expected to redshirt this season
- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett indicated that after Virginia's game with South Carolina State on Nov. 13

FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA

- UVa signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class
- The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.

- All 16 ACC games and all 16 home games will be broadcast
- 13 games will be televised nationally by ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU or FSN

McKAY PARTICIPATING IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

- Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay is participating in "Shots from the Heart", a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease
- College basketball coaches are competing against one another in a free throw shooting tournament, which benefits the American Heart Association
- The event also pays tribute to the late Skip Prosser who passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack
- Last year, McKay reached the quarterfinals of the assistant coach bracket in the inaugural event
- McKay faces Ricky Yahn of Longwood in the round of 64 of this year's event

UP NEXT

- Virginia will host Michigan on Tuesday as part of the Big Ten/ACC Challenge
- Game time at John Paul Jones Arena is 7 p.m. and the game will be televised by ESPN2
- The Cavaliers haven't faced Michigan since a 102-65 loss to the eventual-NCAA Champion Wolverines in the Elite Eight of the 1989 NCAA Tournament
- Virginia is 6-5 all-time in the Challenge, including an 87-79 win at No. 15 Minnesota last season
