FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets NC State for the lone regular-season meeting between the teams.
- UVA has a three-game winning streak vs. the Wolfpack.
- Virginia has a 17-game home winning streak, including a 12-0 mark at John Paul Jones Arena this season.
- As of Feb. 14, UVA is tied for third in the ACC at 9-4 and NC State is tied for 12th at 3-9.
- As of Feb. 14, UVA ranks third nationally in scoring defense (59.8 ppg), eighth in field goal shooting (49.5%), 12th in 3-point field goal shooting (39.8%) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.54) and 16th in free throw shooting (75.3%).

VIRGINIA RANKED NO. 7 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 7 in the latest AP and USA Today Coaches' polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in the AP poll on three different occasions this season (10 weeks overall).
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in 25 consecutive AP polls from March 3, 2014 to Nov. 16, 2015, its longest span since 49 straight from 1980-83.
- The Cavaliers' No. 6 preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.

ALL-TIME AGAINST NC STATE

- Virginia is 62-82 all-time vs. NC State in the series that dates back to 1912-13.
- The Cavaliers are 8-0 in their last eight regular-season games against NC State and 8-2 in their last 10 overall including a pair of losses in the ACC Tournament.
- UVA posted a pair of wins vs. NC State last season (61-51 win in Charlottesville and 51-47 in Raleigh).
- UVA has a six-game winning streak against NC State at JPY.
- Tony Bennett is 8-2 vs. NC State as head coach at Virginia.
- Malcolm Brogdon is Virginia's current career leading scorer against NC State, averaging 12.3 points in four career games.
- Mike Tobey is averaging 11.3 points and 6.2 rebounds in five games against the Wolfpack, while Anthony Gill has averaged 8.3 points and 6.7 rebounds in three contests.

LAST TIME VS. THE WOLFPACK

- Malcolm Brogdon scored 15 points to lead then-No. 2 Virginia to a 51-47 road win at NC State on Feb. 11, 2015.
- Mike Tobey (11 points, 9 rebounds) and Anthony Gill (9 points and 11 rebounds) combined for 20 points and 20 rebounds as Virginia posted its eighth straight regular-season win against the Wolfpack.
- Evan Nolte started in place of Justin Anderson and contributed three points, one assist, one blocked shot and one steal.
- Trevor Lacey led the Wolfpack with 14 points and Cat Barber added 11 points.
- UVA shot 37.3 percent from the floor and out-rebounded NC State 43-28.

LAST TIME OUT

- Grayson Allen banked in the game-winner at the buzzer to send Duke to a 63-62 win over No. 7 Virginia on Saturday, Feb. 13.
- Malcolm Brogdon's (18 points) reverse layup with nine seconds remaining gave UVA a 62-61 lead before Allen's game-winner.
- Brandon Ingram tallied a game-high 25 points, including 18 straight Duke points over a 5:37 span.
- Duke outrebounded UVA 34-26 and made eight 3-pointers.
- UVA's reserves tallied 14 points, led by Mike Tobey's eight.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 135-36 (.789) in 10 seasons, including a 12-0 mark in 2015-16, at John Paul Jones Arena.
- As of Feb. 14, UVA owns the nation's eighth longest current home-winning streak at 17 games.
- UVA is 97-20 (.829), including a 62-5 (.925) mark the past four seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 32-1 in ACC home games over the past four seasons, which ties the second best mark in ACC history with one loss (Duke 33-1 from 1962-64 and Duke 32-1 from 1997-2000).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for seven straight seasons.
- UVA's 21-game home winning streak from Dec. 21, 2013-Jan. 22, 2015 set a JPY record.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett sports a 156-69 mark in seven seasons at Virginia and 225-102 career mark in 10 seasons overall.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett was also named ACC Coach of the Year, NABC District 2 Coach of the Year and USBWA District 3 Coach of the Year for the second consecutive year.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to four consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014 and 2015, and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett-coached teams are 79-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 10-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top five nationally in six of nine seasons.
- Bennett is one of 26 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 79-24 (.767) in non-conference action and 97-20 (.829) at home under Tony Bennett.

VIRGINIA BASKETBALL GETTING OFFENSIVE

- UVA is averaging 71.0 points, its most since 76.8 ppg in 2007-08.
- As of Feb. 14, UVA ranks Nos. 2, 9 and 12 in the KenPom.com overall, adjusted defense and adjusted offensive efficiency ratings, respectively.
- UVA is shooting 49.5 percent from the field (best since 49.6% in 1986-87), 39.8 percent from 3-point range (best in school history) and 75.3 percent from the free throw line (best since 76.2% in 1978-79).
- UVA has scored 80 or more points in six games, its most since 11 in 2007-08.
- UVA's 86 points against Villanova were its most scored against a top-25 opponent since tallying 87 in a road win at Minnesota in 2010-11.
- UVA has shot 55 percent or better in eight games in 2015-16, its most since accomplishing the feat eight times in 1984-85.
- The Cavaliers scored 82 or more points in three straight games (Nov. 19-22 at Charleston Classic) for the first time since the first three games of the 2001-02 season.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better from the field in 12 games and 50 percent or better from 3-point range in eight games.
- UVA is 13-4 when committing nine or fewer turnovers.

SECONDS ANYONE?

- Virginia has played its best basketball during the second half of games this season.
- The Cavaliers have scored more points in the second half than the first half in 21 of 25 games.
- UVA is averaging 39.3 points in the second half and 31.3 points in the first stanza.
- UVA is shooting 54.4 percent on its second-half shots, including 47.2 percent from 3-point range, but only 44.8 percent on its first-half shots and 32.2 percent from 3-point range.

SENIORS IN ELITE COMPANY AT UVA

- The 2016 UVA senior class of Malcolm Brogdon, Anthony Gill, Mike Tobey, Evan Nolte and Caid Kirven ranks fourth in school history with 103 career wins.
- The UVA Class of 1983 led by three-time National and ACC Player of the Year Ralph Sampson has a school-record 112 wins.
- Brogdon, Gill, Tobey, Nolte and Kirven have helped UVA capture two ACC regular-season titles and one ACC Tournament championship.
- The UVA Class of 2016 has participated in two NCAA tournaments and one NIT.
- All five seniors will have earned their undergraduate degrees by May of 2016.

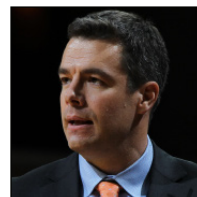

ALL-AMERICAN BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Preseason co-ACC Player of the Year Malcolm Brogdon is aiming to become the first UVA player since Sean Singletary (2006-08) to lead UVA in scoring for three straight seasons.
- Brogdon is also bidding to be UVA's first three-time All-ACC first-team selection since Singletary (2006-08).
- Brogdon's 17.7 scoring average is the highest for UVA since Mike Scott's 18.0 ppg in 2011-12.
- Brogdon's 19.1 scoring average in ACC action is the highest for UVA since Scott's 19.6 ppg in 2011-12.
- Brogdon has 12 20-point efforts, including a career-high 28 at George Washington and Wake Forest, marking the most by a UVA player in a season since Sylvan Landesberg had 12 20-point games in 2008-09.
- Brogdon has made 29 consecutive free throws and is 20 shy of breaking Jeff Lamp's school-record of 48 in 1979-80.
- Brogdon was named a preseason All-American by The Sporting News (1st team), Blue Ribbon Yearbook (1st team), CBSsports.com (2nd team), NBCsports.com (2nd team), Bleacher Report (2nd team), USA Today (3rd team) and Collegelinsider.com.
- Brogdon and Gonzaga's Kyle Wiltjer are the first consensus All-Americans to return as fifth-year seniors since Vanderbilt's Billy McCaffrey in 1993-94.
- In 2014-15, Brogdon averaged 14.0 points and 3.9 rebounds en route to All-America second-team and All-ACC first-team accolades.
- The two-time All-ACC performer is 15th on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,576 points in 124 career games (12.7 career ppg).
- Brogdon ranks second on UVA's career free-throw percentage list at 86.8% (374-for-431).
- Brogdon is a Wooden Award candidate and West Award finalist for the second straight season, and candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award and Wooden Citizen Cup Award.
- Brogdon helped Team USA to a bronze medal at the 2015 Pan American Games in Toronto.
- He earned a degree in history and is pursuing a master's degree from the Frank Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy.

GILL THRILLS

- Preseason All-ACC second-team selection Anthony Gill is averaging a career-high 14.2 points.
- Gill leads UVA in rebounding (5.8 rpg) and has led UVA in scoring in eight games.
- Gill was the first UVA player to score in double figures in the first 22 games of a season since Sean Singletary scored 10 or more points in all 33 games during 2007-08.
- Gill has reached double figures in scoring in 27 of 28 games dating back to last season.
- Gill earned ACC Player of the Week honors after tallying 20 points and 12 rebounds vs. West Virginia for his fourth career double-double.
- Gill averaged 11.6 points and 6.5 rebounds en route to All-ACC third-team (media) honors in 2014-15.
- Gill was named to the coaches' All-ACC Defensive Team in 2014-15.

• Gill, who has led UVA in field goal percentage in each of the past two seasons, is shooting 58.2 percent during his UVA career.
• Gill has amassed 1,303 career points in three seasons at UVA and one at South Carolina (1,067 at UVA).

LONDON CALLING THE SHOTS

• Guard London Parrantes is enjoying a breakout season in 2015-16, averaging career highs in points (11.0), field goal percentage (46.7%) and 3-point field goal percentage (53.4%).
• Parrantes has hit double figures in scoring in 12 games, including a season-high 22 points (career-best seven 3-pointers) at Virginia Tech.
• Parrantes leads the ACC in 3-point shooting at a career-best 53.4 percent and has a career 3.0 assist-to-turnover ratio (384 assists, 131 turnovers) in 90 games.
• He tallied his second career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 11 assists against George Mason en route to MVP honors at the Charleston Classic.
• Parrantes also tallied 19 points against Villanova and Florida State.
• He missed the Ohio State and William & Mary contests due to an appendectomy.
• Parrantes averaged 6.4 points and 4.6 assists en route to honorable mention All-ACC honors last season.
• He had a career-high 26 points, including five 3-pointers, at Miami (1/3/15).
• Parrantes earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.

HALL OF A SPARK

• Devon Hall has played in all 25 games this season and is averaging 20.3 minutes after averaging 10.6 minutes in 23 contests last season.
• Hall, who has started the last nine games, had career highs in assists (5) and blocked shots (3) vs. Virginia Tech (2/9/16).
• Hall scored an ACC-high 11 points against Clemson.
• Hall netted a career-high 13 points vs. Morgan State and drained a career-best four 3-pointers for 12 points vs. Long Beach State.
• Hall had five points, four assists and three rebounds in a solid all-around outing against Notre Dame.
• Hall made his first start of the season at Florida State, scoring six points and matching a season high with 26 minutes.

• Darius Thompson has averaged 5.1 points, 1.6 rebounds and 1.8 assists, and is second on the team with 22 steals in his first year at UVA.
• Thompson is shooting 34.4 percent (11-32) from 3-point range after shooting 19.5 percent (8-41) from downtown at Tennessee in 2013-14.

• Thompson banked in the game-winning 3-pointer at Wake Forest.
• He had a five-game double figure scoring streak from Nov. 25-Dec. 19, and tallied 12 points in four games.
• Thompson sat out as a transfer last season after averaging 2.6 points and 2.4 assists in 37 games at Tennessee in 2013-14.
