FOR OPENERS

- Virginia has a five-game winning streak vs. NC State.
- UVA is first in the ACC at 4-0 and NC State is tied for eighth at 2-2.
- The Cavaliers are riding a seven-game winning streak and are 4-0 in the ACC for the first time since starting 7-0 in 2014-15.
- UVA defeated NC State head coach Kevin Keatts' former team, UNC Wilmington, in the first round of the NCAA Tournament last season.
- As of Jan. 14, UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense (53 ppg) and turnovers per game (9), second in field goal percentage defense (36.1%), sixth in fouls per game (14.5), seventh in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.59) and turnover margin (5.2), 10th in scoring margin (17.7) and 19th in 3-point field goal percentage defense (30.2%).

ALL-TIME VS. NC STATE

- Virginia is 64-82 all-time vs. NC State in the series that dates back to 1912-13.
- The Cavaliers are 10-0 in their last 10 regular-season games against NC State and 10-2 in their last 12 games including a pair of losses in the ACC Tournament.
- UVA posted a 70-55 win against NC State last season and has limited the Wolfpack to 55 or fewer points in each game during its five-game winning streak in the series.
- UVA has a seven-game winning streak against NC State at John Paul Jones Arena.
- Tony Bennett is 10-2 vs. NC State as head coach at Virginia.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE WOLFPACK

- London Perrantes tallied his third career double-double with 16 points and 10 assists as then-No. 18 Virginia ended a four-game losing streak with a 70-55 win at NC State on Feb. 25, 2017.
- Devon Hall added 18 points and matched a career best with nine rebounds.
- Kyle Guy chipped in 19 points (5-7 3FG) as UVA shot a season-high 68.8 percent (11 of 16) from 3-point range.
- UVA used a 15-0 run to gain a 35-21 halftime lead.
- Ty Jerome started in place of Isaiah Wilkins (illness) and had a career-high four steals.
- UVA held Wolfpack leading scorer and current Dallas Maverick point guard Dennis Smith Jr. to 13 points and forced the talented guard into five turnovers.

UVA RANKED NO. 3 IN LATEST NATIONAL POLLS

- UVA is ranked a season-high No. 3 in the latest national polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for seven straight weeks and has been ranked in the top 10 in each of the past two polls.
- The No. 3 ranking is UVA's highest since Feb. 22, 2016 (No. 3).
- Virginia is the fifth team in ACC history to move from unranked in preseason to the top 3, joining Miami (2012-13), Georgia Tech (2003-04), Wake Forest (1980-81) and North Carolina (1972-73).
- UVA is the lone ACC team to be ranked in the top 3 in four of the past five seasons.
- The Cavaliers received votes in the first three AP polls, snapping a streak of 64 consecutive weeks in the AP rankings since Feb. 3, 2014.
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in the preseason polls from 2014-16.

LAST TIME OUT

- Kyle Guy scored 22 points, De'Andre Hunter added 15 and No. 3 Virginia beat Syracuse 68-61 on Jan. 9.
- Guy made five 3-pointers as UVA (15-1, 4-0 ACC) attempted a season-high 27 3s and made nine.
- Devon Hall added 13 points, eight assists and seven rebounds for the Cavaliers.
- Frank Howard scored 18 points to lead the Orange (12-5, 1-3), while Oshae Brissett added 16 points and Paschal Chukwu scored nine points and grabbed 16 rebounds.
- The Orange shot under 40 percent against the nation's top scoring defense and managed just three assists on 23 baskets.
- Virginia led 29-26 at halftime and pushed the lead to 44-35 when Ty Jerome made three 3-pointers in a span of two minutes and Guy made his fourth with 12:17 left. Virginia eventually led by as many as 14 and won its seventh in a row.

UVA IN KEN POM EFFICIENCY RATINGS

- As of Jan. 14, UVA ranks Nos. 1, 3 and 31 in the KenPom.com adjusted defense, overall and adjusted offense efficiency ratings.
- UVA is shooting 47 percent, 39.2 percent from 3-point range (2nd best in school history) and 75.9 percent from the free throw line (2nd best in school history).
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better in seven games and limited its opponents to less than 50 percent shooting in all 16 games.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 203-84 (.707) mark in nine seasons at Virginia and 272-117 (.699) career mark in 12 seasons overall.
- Bennett has guided UVA to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances and has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014–16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981–83.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to six consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 111-34 (.765) in non-conference action, 92-50 (.645) in ACC play and 123-24 (.836) at home under Tony Bennett.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA has limited its foes to 53 points per game (2nd best in school history) and has held seven opponents to fewer than 50 points (UNCG, Austin Peay, Vanderbilt, Wisconsin, Savannah State, Hampton and North Carolina).
- UVA has held 13 opponents to 60 or fewer points.
- UVA has held 13 foes to less than 43 percent shooting.
- The Cavaliers have held nine opponents to less than 30 percent shooting from 3-point range.
- The Cavaliers are 71-2 when limiting their opponents to fewer than 50 points under head coach Tony Bennett (7-0 in 2017-18).
- Bennett-coached teams are 96-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 12-year coaching career.
- In 2016-17, Virginia led the nation in scoring defense (56.4 ppg) for the third time under Bennett.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense four times (2008-09, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2016-17) and finished in the top-five nationally in eight of 11 seasons.

ABOUT THE CAVALIERS

- UVA is led by tri-captains Devon Hall, Isaiah Wilkins and Jack Salt.
- The announcement of Hall, Wilkins and Salt marked the first time in Bennett's 12-year head coaching career where he officially named team captains.
- UVA has averaged 70.7 points per game (second most under Bennett) on offense, while yielding a nation-leading 53 ppg (second lowest in school history) on defense.
- UVA has started Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, Hall, Wilkins and Salt in each of its 16 games.
- Guy leads the team in scoring at 15.4 points per game and has reached double figures in 13 games, including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17), 22 vs. Syracuse (1/9/18) and 21 vs. Lehigh (12/2/17)
- Hall has averaged 11.9 points, which is 3.5 points higher than last year's average of 8.4 points.
- Wilkins is averaging 6.7 points and team-highs in rebounds (7.4), blocked shots (1.6) and steals (1.4).
- Jerome is averaging 9.8 points and Salt has chipped in 3.9 rebounds per game.
- Redshirt freshman De'Andre Hunter (7.3 ppg) has reached double figures in three consecutive games, including a team-high 14 points at Virginia Tech (1/3/18).
- Graduate transfer Nigel Johnson is averaging 6.1 points and Mamadi Diakite has added 6.1 ppg & 3.6 rpg.
- Jay Huff (3.7 ppg) and Marco Anthony provide depth and fellow rookie Francesco Badocchi is expected to redshirt the 2017-18 season.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 161-40 (.801), including an 11-0 mark in 2017-18, in 12 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA has a 13-game home win streak dating back to last year.
- The Cavaliers finished undefeated at home (15-0) in 2015-16.
- UVA is 123-24 (.836), including an 87-9 (.906) mark the past six seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 44-4 in ACC home games over the past six seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for nine straight seasons.

ZAY PAVES THE WAY

- Senior forward Isaiah Wilkins is one of the top utility players in college basketball.
- Wilkins has averaged 6.7 points, 7.4 rebounds, 1.8 assists, 1.6 blocked shots and 1.4 steals in 2017-18.
- Wilkins was named the MVP of the NIT Season Tip-Off after scoring a career-high 19 points against Rhode Island (11/24/17) and blocking four shots and scoring eight points against Vanderbilt (11/23/17).
- He took a team-high three charges at VCU (11/17/17) and tallied a career-high 14 rebounds vs. Boston College (12/30/17).
- Wilkins, who has blocked three or more shots in four games this season, ranks fifth at UVA with 117 career blocked shots.
- In 2016-17, the All-ACC Defensive team honoree led the team in rebounding (6.0 rpg), blocked shots (43) and steals (33), becoming the first Cavalier since Travis Watson in 2002-03 to lead the team in those three categories. He leads UVA in all three categories this season.

HALL OF A PLAYER

- Redshirt senior Devon Hall is averaging a career-best 11.9 points, 4.2 rebounds and 3.4 assists.
- Hall is shooting 46.4 percent from the floor, 44.6 percent from 3-point range and 90.5 percent from the free throw line.
- He scored a career-high 20 points vs. Davidson and 19 points against UNCG (11/10/17) and West Virginia (12/5/17).
- Hall, who has started 70 consecutive games dating back to 2015-16, has scored in double figures in 29 career games.
- In 2016-17, Hall averaged 8.4 points and 4.4 rebounds.
- He was named to the 2016-17 All-ACC Academic Team after earning his degree in media studies and is currently enrolled in the Professional Development Program at the Curry School of Education.

THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- Sophomore Kyle Guy is having a breakout season for Virginia.
- Guy leads UVA in scoring (15.4 ppg) and 3FG per game (2.83).
- Guy has scored 20 or more points in five career games (3 in 2017-18), inIcluding a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17).
- Guy has led the Cavaliers in scoring in eight contests.
- Guy has made at least one 3-pointer in all 16 games in 2017-18.
- Guy has scored 11 or more points in 13 games this season.
- Guy is shooting 46.9 percent (97 of 207) from 3-point range during his career and has made five or more 3-pointers in seven games.
- Guy needs three more 3-pointers to qualify for UVA's career 3-point percentage record set at 42.1 percent set by Keith Freel (107 3 pointers from 2000-01).
- Guy has scored 10+ points in 23 of 50 career games.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia is 71-2 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era (7-0 in 2017-18).
- Bennett-coached teams are 96-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA held Wisconsin under 40 points and is 19-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

ABOUT THE 2017-18 SCHEDULE

- Six of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the latest AP Top-25 poll (West Virginia, Duke, Miami, Clemson, North Carolina and Florida State), while Notre Dame and Rhode Island received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 17 games against 2017 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against North Carolina, Notre Dame, Louisville, Virginia Tech and Wisconsin; road contests at Duke, North Carolina, West Virginia, Louisville, Florida State, Wake Forest and VCU; and neutral-site tilts against Vanderbilt and either Seton Hall or Rhode Island in the NIT Season Tip-Off in Brooklyn, N.Y.
- Four opponents (Clemson, Georgia Tech, Monmouth, UNC Greensboro and Syracuse) participated in the 2017 National Invitation Tournament.

RECORDS WATCH

- Senior forward Isaiah Wilkins ranks fifth on UVA's career blocked shots list with 117.
- Wilkins needs 10 blocked shots to pass Kris Hunter (126 blocks, 1997-99) for fourth on the list.

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 27-31 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era, including a 1-1 record this season (61-49 win vs. No. 12 North Carolina and 68-61 loss at then-No. 18 West Virginia).
- The Cavaliers are 142-327 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA is 1-29 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

GUY AND WILKINS AMONG ACC LEADERS

- As of Jan. 14, Kyle Guy ranks first in the ACC in 3-pointers per game (2.88), third in 3-point percentage (44.2%) and 14th in scoring (15.4 ppg).
- Isaiah Wilkins ranks 12th in the ACC in rebounding (7.4 rpg).

VIRGINIA PICKED 6TH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish sixth in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked third and finished tied for fifth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in eight of the last nine seasons.
- Duke was the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Notre Dame, Miami, Louisville, Virginia, Virginia Tech, Florida State, Georgia Tech, Syracuse, Wake Forest, NC State, Clemson, Boston College and Pittsburgh.

CAVALIERS IN THE NBA

- Justin Anderson (Philadelphia), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn), Mike Scott (Washington) and London Perrantes (Cleveland) are former Cavaliers playing in the NBA this season.
- Brodgon earned 2017 NBA Rookie of the Year honors.
- Scott is in his sixth season (first with Washington) and Harris is in his fourth NBA season (second with Brooklyn), while Anderson is in his third season (second with Philadelphia).
- Perrantes signed a two-way contract with Cleveland and made his NBA debut vs. Atlanta on Dec. 12.
- In addition, Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle is a Virginia alum who helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984. Carlisle gained his 700th NBA victory on Dec. 2, 2017.

CAVALIERS INK CLARK AND STATTMANN

- Virginia signed guards Kihei Clark (Woodland Hills, Calif./Taft Charter High School) and Kody Stattmann (Bentley Park, Queensland, Australia/St. Augustine's College) to National Letters of Intent.
- The 5-9, 155-pound Clark averaged 18.9 points, 7.1 assists and 4.2 rebounds for Taft Charter High School as a junior in 2016-17.
- The 6-7, 178-pound Stattmann averaged 31 points to lead the Australian U17 Emus Men's Basketball Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Oceania Championships in Guam.
