FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets Iowa for the third time and first since the Hawkeyes posted a 75-64 win over Virginia in the NIT quarterfinals on March 27, 2013.
- The Cavaliers rank first in the nation in scoring defense at 38.8 points per game.
- UVA is the first team in Division I to hold three straight opponents (St. Francis Brooklyn, Yale and Grambling State) to fewer than 40 points in the last 20 years.
- UVA is also the first team in ACC history (1953-present) to hold three straight opponents to fewer than 40 points.
- UVA is seeking its fourth straight regular-season tournament championships, posting titles in Corpus Christi (2013), Brooklyn (2014) and Charleston (2015).
- The Cavaliers have a two-game losing streak in the state of Florida and are 2-19 if their last 21 games in the Sunshine State.

ALL-TIME VS. IOWA

- UVA is 0-2 all-time against Iowa, with both games coming during tournament play, in the series that dates back to the 1996-97 season.
- In addition to the 2013 NIT quarterfinal contest, Iowa defeated Virginia 73-60 in the first round of the 1997 NCAA Tournament in Salt Lake City, Utah.

HOO ARE THESE WAHOOS?

- Virginia is led by senior point guard London Perrantes, who is a Wooden and Naismith Player of the Year and ACC Player of the Year candidate.
- Perrantes is averaging 8.0 points, 4.3 assists and 2.8 rebounds.
- Marial Shayok leads UVA in scoring at 12.5 points per game and has scored in double figures in three games off the bench.
- Newcomer Kyle Guy is averaging 11.0 points on 70 percent shooting, while Isaiah Wilkins leads UVA in rebounding at 5.8 per game.
- Darius Thompson is averaging 9.8 points and Mamadi Diakite is averaging 7.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.6 blocked shots, respectively.

LAST TIME OUT

- Kyle Guy tallied a career-high 20 points in only 13 minutes to lead No. 7 UVA to a 90-34 win over Grambling State on Tuesday, Nov. 22.
- The Cavaliers (4-0) made quick work of the undermanned Tigers, running off 26 consecutive points to end the first half leading 49-9.
- The final score marked the 17th time in Bennett's career at Virginia that the Cavaliers held an opponent below 40 points - and the third game in a row.
- Marial Shayok and Darius Thompson added 12 points apiece and all 13 players who played scored for Virginia.
- Grambling's nine halftime points were the lowest scored in a first half of any Division I game in 2016-17.

LAST TIME VS. THE HAWKEYES

- Roy Devyn Marble scored 24 points and Iowa ended Virginia's 19-game home winning streak with a 75-64 victory in the NIT quarterfinals on March 27, 2013.
- Marble's 3-pointer with 13:02 to play gave Iowa a 42-41 lead and sparked a 19-5 run that also featured six points inside from Adam Woodbury and 3-pointers by Josh Oglesby and Zach McCabe.
- Justin Anderson scored a career-high 24 points to lead Virginia (23-12).

AGAINST THE BIG TEN CONFERENCE

- UVA is 100-129 all-time vs. current Big Ten Conference opponents.
- The Cavaliers meet their first Big Ten opponent since defeating Ohio State 64-58 during last season's B1G/ACC Challenge.
- The Cavaliers are 6-5 against Big Ten opponents under head coach Tony Bennett, including wins against Maryland, Minnesota, Michigan, Ohio State, Rutgers and Wisconsin.
- In addition to Iowa, UVA meets Ohio State in the ACC/B1G Challenge on Wednesday, Nov. 30.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 169-72 mark in eight seasons at Virginia and 238-105 career mark in 11 seasons overall.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top five nationally in seven of 10 seasons.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to five consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2016, and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led Virginia to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament, first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 and 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2013-2014) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett-coached teams are 83-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 11-year coaching career.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 103-20 (.837) in eight seasons at JPY under Bennett.

UVA RANKED NO. 7/6 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 7 in the latest Associated Press and No. 6 in the USA Today Coaches' polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in 10 consecutive AP polls and 11 consecutive coaches' polls dating back to last season.
- The Cavaliers were ranked in top 10 in the preseason rankings (No. 8/7) for the third straight season, matching a school-best from 1981-83.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in 40 of the last 44 AP polls.
- UVA has finished in the top 10 (No. 3 in 2014 & No. 6 in 2015 and No. 4 in 2016) in the final AP rankings in three consecutive seasons for the first time since 1981-83.

FLORIDA NOT SO SUNNY FOR UVA

- UVA has a two-game losing streak in the state of Florida and is 2-19 in its last 21 contests in the Sunshine State. (1-11 at Florida State, 1-6 at Miami, 0-1 at South Florida and 0-1 in the ACC Tournament in Tampa).
- UVA dropped ACC road contests at Florida State (69-62) and Miami (64-61) in 2015-16.
- The Cavaliers ended a 17-game losing skid in Florida with a 62-50 win at Florida State in 2014 and followed it up with an 89-80 double overtime win at Miami in 2015.

UVA IN KEN POM EFFICIENCY RATINGS

- As of Nov. 23, UVA ranks Nos. 1, 5 and 13 in the KenPom.com adjusted defense, overall and adjusted offense efficiency ratings, respectively.
- UVA is shooting 51.4 percent from the field, 35.0 percent from 3-point range and 77.2 percent from the free throw line.
- UVA has scored 70 or more points in three of four games, including a Tony Bennett era high 90-point effort against Grambling State.

HOOS WATCHING ME?

- London Perrantes is one of 50 players named to the watch list for the 2017 John R. Wooden Award for national player of the year.
- Perrantes is also one of 50 players named to the 2017 Naismith Men's College Player of the Year watch list.
- Perrantes was one of 20 players named to the watch list for the 2017 Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award.
- Perrantes led the ACC in 3-point shooting at a career-best 48.8 percent and averaged 11 points and 4.4 assists in 2015-16.

GOING ON A RUN

- Virginia has had scoring runs of 16 or more consecutive points in each of its first four games this season.
- UVA went on a 26-0 run to close the first half against Grambling State, tallied a 22-0 run at UCG spanning halftime, posted a 20-0 first-half run against St. Francis and added a 16-0 run vs. Yale.

- Virginia has limited its opponents to six scoring droughts of six or more minutes through four games.
- The Cavaliers held UCG scoreless for 11:19 spanning halftime and St. Francis Brooklyn went scoreless for 10:11 in the first half.
- UVA held Grambling State scoreless for 9:46 spanning halftime and Yale went scoreless for 8:48.

DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense at 38.8 points game.
- As of Nov. 22, the Cavaliers ranked seventh in field-goal percentage defense, 11th in rebounding margin and 15th in assist/turnover ratio.
- UVA has limited its opponents to 25.3 percent 3-point shooting.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 141-36 (.796) in 11 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA owns the nation's sixth longest current home-winning streak at 23 games.
- The 23-game home-winning streak is also a JPY record.
- The Cavaliers finished undefeated at home (15-0) in 2015-16 for the first time since 1981-82 (12-0).
- UVA is 103-20 (.837), including a 68-5 (.932) mark the past five seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 35-1 in ACC home games over the past four seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for seven straight seasons.

ABOUT THE 2016-17 SCHEDULE

- Seven of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the latest AP poll (Villanova, North Carolina, Duke, Louisville, Syracuse, West Virginia and Florida State, while five (Cal, Miami, Virginia Tech, Notre Dame and Ohio State) received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 13 games against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, North Carolina, West Virginia, Miami, Pitt and Yale; road contests at Villanova, North Carolina, Syracuse, California, Pitt and Notre Dame; and a neutral-site tilt against Iowa in the Emerald Coast Classic in Niceville, Fla.
- Four opponents (Florida State, Georgia Tech, Ohio State and Virginia Tech) participated in the 2016 National Invitation Tournament.

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- Virginia is 22-23 against ranked opponents, including a 2-6 mark vs. top-5 foes, in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVA is 137-319 vs. ranked opponents, including a 25-119 mark against top-5 foes, since 1953-54.
- The Cavaliers are 1-26 vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).
- UVA was 8-2 vs. ranked opponents in 2015-16, tying a school record for most ranked wins in a season set in 1980-81.

LONDON CALLING

- Preseason All-ACC first-team selection and ACC Player of the Year candidate London Perrantes leads UVA into action this season.
- Perrantes is averaging 8.0 points, 4.3 assists and 2.8 rebounds in 2016-17.
- He enjoyed a breakout season in 2015-16, averaging career highs in points (11), field goal percentage (43.9%) and ACC-leading 3-point field goal percentage (48.8%).
- Perrantes has led UVA in assists in each of the last three seasons and has a career 2.9 assist-to-turnover ratio (458 assists, 157 turnovers) in 107 games (103 starts).
- Perrantes needs 20 wins to become UVA's all-time winningest player (112 by Mike Tobey, Evan Nolte, Caid Kirven).
- He was named All-ACC Honorable Mention in each of the past two seasons and earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.
- Perrantes ranks seventh all-time at UVA with 458 career assists.

CAVALIERS IN THE NBA

- Justin Anderson (Dallas), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn) and Mike Scott (Atlanta) are former Cavaliers who are playing in the NBA this season.
