FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets Ohio State for the second straight season in the ACC/ Big Ten Challenge as the Cavaliers defeated the Buckeyes 64-58 in the 2015 Challenge in Columbus.
- The Cavaliers rank first in the nation in scoring defense at 41.3 points per game and has held each of its six opponents to 52 or fewer points.
- UVA captured the Emerald Coast Classic championship on Nov. 26 for its fourth straight regular-season tournament championship (2013 Corpus Christi, 2014 Barclays Center and 2015 Charleston).
- UVA is 1-0 against the Big Ten in 2016-17, defeating lowa 74-41 at the Emerald Coast Classic in Florida on Nov. 25.

UVA ALL-TIME IN THE ACC/B1G CHALLENGE

- The Cavaliers have a 10-6 record, including a 5-2 home mark, in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.
- Virginia has a two-game winning streak in the Challenge, defeating Maryland (2014) and Ohio State (2015).
- UVA dropped a 45-38 decision to Wisconsin it last home game of the Challenge in 2013.
- The ACC leads the Big Ten in the Challenge 10-5-2 in 17 years of competition between the two conferences.
- The Big Ten captured the its second consecutive Commissioner's Cup last season, winning eight of the 14 matchups.
- The ACC looks for its first win in the Challenge since winning 10 straight from 1999-2008.

ALL-TIME VS. OHIO STATE

11

- Virginia and Ohio State will meet for the second time in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge and sixth time overall.
- The Buckeyes own a 3-2 advantage, including a 1-1 mark in Charlottesville, over the Cavaliers in the all-time series that dates back to 1931-32.
- UVA and OSU meet for the first time in Charlottesville since 1981 when Ralph Sampson poured in 40 points and grabbed 16 rebounds in UVA's 89-73 win over Ohio State.
- OSU defeated UVA 30-26 in the inaugural meeting between the teams in Charlottesville on Feb. 6, 1932.

LAST TIME OUT

- Tournament MVP London Perrantes tallied 11 points, a career-high eight rebounds and five assists to lead then-No. 7 Virginia to a 63-52 win over Providence in the Emerald Coast Classic championship game on Nov. 26.
- Mamadi Diakite scored a career-best 10 points and blocked three shots and Jack Salt had career highs in points (8) and rebounds (6).
- Darius Thompson added 11 points and Isaiah Wilkins had nine points, three steals and two blocked shots.
- UVA shot 59.5 percent and committed just seven turnovers en route to its fourth straight regular-season tournament championship.
- Jalen Lindsey led Providence with 18 points and Rodney Bullock added 16.

LAST TIME VS. THE BUCKEYES

- Former UVA All-American Malcolm Brogdon had a game-high 22 points to send then-No. 10 Virginia to a 64–58 win over Ohio State in a Big Ten/ACC Challenge game on Dec. 1, 2015.
- Darius Thompson had 12 points and six assists in place of London Perrantes (appendectomy) and Anthony Gill added 10 points.
- Marc Loving led Ohio State with 19 points as the Buckeyes shot 50 percent from the field.
- UVA shot 50 percent (8-16) from 3-point range in the win.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 141-36 (.796) in 11 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA owns the nation's sixth longest current home-winning streak at 23 games.
- The 23-game home-winning streak is also a JPJ record.
- The Cavaliers finished undefeated at home (15-0) in 2015-16 for the first time since 1981-82 (12-0).
- \bullet UVA is 103-20 (.837), including a 68-5 (.932) mark the past five seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 35-1 in ACC home games over the past four seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for seven straight seasons.
- Duke dealt UVA its last home loss on Jan. 31, 2015 (69-63).

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 171-72 (.704) mark in eight seasons at Virginia and 240-105 (.696) career mark in 11 seasons overall.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top-five nationally in seven of 10 seasons.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to five consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2016, and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett-coached teams are 84-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 11-year coaching career.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 103-20 (.837) in eight seasons at JPJ under Bennett.

HOO ARE THESE WAHOOS?

- Virginia is led by senior point guard London Perrantes, who is a Wooden and Naismith Player of the Year and ACC Player of the Year candidate
- Perrantes is averaging 9.2 points, 4.3 assists and 3.7 rebounds.
- Darius Thompson leads UVA in scoring at 10 points per game, while Marial Shayok is averaging 9.5 points off the bench.
- Newcomer Kyle Guy is averaging 8.5 points, while Jarred Reuter leads UVA in rebounding at 5.2 per game.
- Mamadi Diakite is averaging 7.2 points, 3.8 rebounds and 2.6 blocked shots in 16.2 minutes per game.

AGAINST THE BIG TEN CONFERENCE

- UVA is 101-129 all-time vs. current Big Ten Conference opponents.
- The Cavaliers meet their second Big Ten opponent this season after defeating lowa 74-41 during the Emerald Coast Classic on Nov. 25.
- The Cavaliers are 7-5 against Big Ten opponents under head coach Tony Bennett, including wins against lowa, Maryland, Minnesota, Michigan, Ohio State, Rutgers and Wisconsin.

UVA IN KEN POM EFFICIENCY RATINGS

- As of Nov. 28, UVA ranks Nos. 1, 2 and 10 in the KenPom.com adjusted defense, overall and adjusted offense efficiency ratings, respectively.
- UVA is averaging 72.8 points and allowing 41.3 points per game.
- UVA is shooting 51.9 percent from the field, 38.3 percent from 3-point range and 69.8 percent from the free throw line.
- UVA scored a Tony Bennett era high 90 points vs. Grambling State.

UVA RANKED NO. 6 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 6 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in 11 consecutive AP polls and 12 consecutive coaches' polls dating back to last season.
- The Cavaliers were ranked in top 10 in the preseason rankings (No. 8/7) for the third straight season, matching a school-best from 1981-83.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in 41 of the last 45 AP polls.
- UVA has finished in the top 10 (No. 3 in 2014 & No. 6 in 2015 and No. 4 in 2016) in the final AP rankings in three consecutive seasons for the first time since 1981-83.

IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- As of Nov. 28, UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense (41.3 ppg), second in field goal percentage defense (30.5%), second in scoring margin (+31.5), third in turnover ratio (+2.04), eighth in field goal percentage (51.9%) and 11th in rebound margin (+11.2) and turnover margin (+6.3).
- UVA was the first team in Division I to hold three straight opponents (St. Francis Brooklyn, Yale and Grambling State) to fewer than 40 points in the last 20 years.
- UVA was also the first team in ACC history (1953-present) to hold three straight opponents to fewer than 40 points.

GOING ON A RUN

- Virginia has had scoring runs of 11 or more consecutive points in five of its six games this season.
- UVA went on a 26-0 run to close the first half against Grambling State, tallied a 22-0 run at UNCG spanning halftime, posted a 20-0 first-half run against St. Francis and added a 16-0 run vs. Yale.

ABOUT THE 2016-17 SCHEDULE

- Six of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the lastest AP poll (Villanova, North Carolina, Duke, Louisville, Syracuse and West Virginia), while five (Notre Dame, Ohio State, Florida State, California and Virginia Tech) received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 13 games against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, North Carolina, West Virginia, Miami, Pitt and Yale; road contests at Villanova, North Carolina, Syracuse, California, Pitt and Notre Dame; and a neutral-site tilt against lowa in the Emerald Coast Classic in Niceville, Fla.
- Four opponents (Florida State, Georgia Tech, Ohio State and Virginia Tech) participated in the 2016 National Invitation Tournament.

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- Virginia is 22-23 against ranked opponents, including a 2-6 mark vs. top-5 foes, in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVA is 137-319 vs. ranked opponents, including a 25-119 mark against top-5 foes, since 1953-54.
- The Cavaliers are 1-26 vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).
- UVA was 8-2 vs. ranked opponents in 2015-16, tying a school record for most ranked wins in a season set in 1980-81.

HOOS WATCHING ME?

- London Perrantes is one of 50 players named to the watch list for the 2017 John R. Wooden Award for national player of the year.
- Perrantes is also one of 50 players named to the 2017 Naismith Men's College Player of the Year watch list.
- Perrantes was one of 20 players named to the watch list for the 2017 Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award.
- Perrantes led the ACC in 3-point shooting at a career-best 48.8 percent and averaged 11 points and 4.4 assists in 2015-16.

LONDON CALLING

- Preseason All-ACC first-team selection and ACC Player of the Year candidate London Perrantes leads UVA into action this season.
- Perrantes is averaging 9.2 points, 4.3 assists and 3.7 rebounds in 2016-17.
- He enjoyed a breakout season in 2015-16, averaging career highs in points (11), field goal percentage (43.9%) and ACC-leading 3-point field goal percentage (48.8%).
- Perrantes has led UVA in assists in each of the last three seasons and

- has a career 2.9 assist-to-turnover ratio (467 assists, 159 turnovers) in 109 games (105 starts).
- Perrantes needs 18 wins to become UVA's all-time winningest player (112 by Mike Tobey, Evan Nolte, Caid Kirven).
- He was named All-ACC Honorable Mention in each of the past two seasons and earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.
- Perrantes ranks seventh all-time at UVA with 467 career assists.

SUPER MARIAL HOT OFF THE BENCH

- Sixth man Marial Shayok ranks second on the team in scoring at a career-best 9.5 points per game.
- Shayok led UVA in scoring in two games, tallying 15 points against UNCG and Yale.
- Shayok is shooting 47.9 percent from the field and 10-for-11 (90.9%) from the charity stripe.

ZAY PAVES THE WAY

- Junior Isaiah Wilkins is UVA's top returning frontcourt player after leading the Cavaliers with 31 blocked shots and adding 28 steals in 2015-16.
- Wilkins tallied 10 points and a game-high nine rebounds in the season opener at UNCG (11/11/16).
- Wilkins is averaging 7.2 points and 4.7 rebounds with a teamleading 11 steals and eight blocked shots in 2016-17.

'HOO ARE THE NEW GUY(S)?

- Virginia welcomes freshmen Kyle Guy, Ty Jerome, Jay Huff and De'Andre Hunter to this year's team.
- Guy averaged 23.5 points, 5.6 rebounds and 3.7 assists en route to Mr. Basketball for Indiana and McDonald's All-America honors in 2015, 16
- Jerome talled 24.7 points, 8 rebounds and 5 assists per game before season-ending hip surgery last season.
- Huff averaged 16.3 points, 10.1 rebounds and 5.5 assists in 2015-16, while Hunter recorded 23.5 points and 9.8 rebounds per game
- UVA head coach Tony Bennett announced on Nov. 11 he plans to redshirt Huff and Hunter.
