MIAMI HURRICANES (8-6-1, 3-6-1 ACC)

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The Cavaliers begin a three-match homestand to conclude the regular season
- Virginia looks to set a school record with its 17th straight win
- UVa enters the game 258 fans away from the school record for season attendance of 18,435 set in 2011

SERIES HISTORY:

- Virginia leads 8-1-1 overall (UVa leads 5-0-0 in Charlottesville)
- UVa has won the last five meetings, including 3-0 last year in Coral Gables
- The Cavaliers have won all five previous meetings at Klöckner by shutout

LOOK HOOS NO. 1:

- Virginia remained at No. 1 in all four major polls for the sixth straight week
- The only previous time UVa was No. 1 was in 1990 (three weeks)
- Only one current Cavalier was alive the last time UVa was No. 1, Morgan Stith, who was born during the last week UVa was No. 1 (Oct. 15-21, 1990)

ON A WINNING STREAK:

- UVa is currently on a 16-game win streak, which ties the school record
- The first school record 16-game win streak was set in 1990
- The Cavaliers are the nation's only unbeaten and untied team this season
- It is the longest win streak in the ACC since UNC's 17-game streak in 2007-08



LAST TIME OUT:

- Virginia tied a school record with its 16th straight win, downing No. 4 North Carolina 2-0 in Chapel Hill
- Brittany Ratcliffe and Makenzy Doniak scored for UVa
- The Cavaliers became the first team to win at Fetzer Field three straight years
- It was only UNC's second multi-goal loss since 1986 (span of 690 games)
- It tied UVa's highest ranked road win (also won at No. 4 Portland in 1999)

GOALS, GOALS, GOALS!!!:

- Virginia leads the nation in scoring at 3.25 goals per game, scoring a national-best 52 goals
- UVa also leads the nation in assists and points per game
- The Cavaliers scored at least three goals in each of the first seven games of the season, the longest streak of scoring 3+ goals in school history
- Of the 52 goals scored, the Cavaliers have 12 different goal scorers

SCORING STREAK:

- Virginia is one of nine schools nationally to have scored a goal in every game this season
- Dating back to last year, UVa has scored in 24 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the nation

ACC SUCCESS:

- Dating back to last season, UVa has won 15 of its last 16 games against ACC opponents (only loss vs. Duke in NCAA Tournament)
- UVa has won its last eight road games at ACC foes, the longest streak in school history
- The Cavaliers have won a school-record 12 straight ACC regular season games, breaking the previous record of seven set in 2004-05
- UVa's 12-game ACC regular season win streak is the longest in the conference since North Carolina's 16-game streak in 2008-09

PACK THE HOUSE:

- Virginia had a record women's soccer crowd of 2,838 for the Notre Dame game on Oct. 10
- It broke the previous record of 2,540 set 11 days earlier during the win over Maryland
- UVa's last three home games have produced three of the top 10 crowds in school history
- UVa enters the game 258 fans away from the school record for season attendance of 18,435 set in 2011

COMEBACK CAVALIERS:

- Virginia rallied from a deficit to win at BC, Pitt and Duke, the first time in school history with three consecutive come-from-behind wins
- UVa has four come-from-behind wins this season, tied for the most in school history for an entire season (1997 and 1998)
- The win at Duke marked the sixth time in school history that UVa rallied to win when trailing by two goals (first time since at PSU in 2009 NCAA 2nd rd)



DOMINATING PERFORMANCES:

- The Cavaliers have a +43 goal differential this season, approaching the school record
- +49 goal differential set in 2004
- Virginia leads the nation in goal differential this season

CAVALIERS SHINE IN NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULE:

- The Cavaliers went undefeated (6-0-0) in non-conference play, outscoring opponents 25-3
- It marked Virginia's first undefeated non-conference slate since 2004 (9-0-0)

SWANSON REACHES PAIR OF MILESTONES:

- Virginia head coach Steve Swanson earned his 300th career win on Sept. 19 with the 2-1 victory at Boston College
- Swanson became the 16th Division I coach to join the 300 win club, and the 11th to accululate 300 wins at the Division I level
- He became the 31st NCAA coach (all divisions) to reach the milestone
- On Oct. 6, he posted his 200th win at Virginia with the 3-0 win over Clemson

HIGH SCORING HOOS:

- Morgan Brian (29 pts), Makenzy Doniak (29 pts) and Brittany Ratcliffe (23 pts) all rank among the top six scorers in the ACC
- Virginia is the only team in the nation to have three of the top 75 scorers in the country

RATCLIFFE NAMED ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

- Brittany Ratcliffe was named ACC Player of the Week on Oct. 22
- The previous week she had two goals at NC State and the GWG at UNC
- It was her first career ACC Player of the Week award

BRIAN DOES DOUBLE DUTY WITH VIRGINIA & USWNT:

- Morgan Brian has earned three caps with the United States Women's National Team this year, as she has played for both UVa and the USWNT this fall
- She has made appearances against South Korea (June 15), Mexico (Sept. 3) and Australia (Oct. 20)
- She scored her first goal for the USWNT on Sept. 3 in the 7-0 victory over Mexico in Washington, D.C.
- She became the first active collegian to score for the USWNT since Alex Morgan in 2010 (as a senior at Cal)
- At age 20, Brian is the youngest USWNT goal-scorer since Christine Nairn (at age 18) scored for the team in 2009
- She is one of three current collegians to have earned a cap with the USWNT (North Carolina's Crystal Dunn, Santa Clara's Julie Johnston)

BRIAN HONORED:

- Junior midfielder Morgan Brian was named ACC Co-Player of the Week on Oct. 15 after leading UVa to wins over No. 5 Notre Dame and No. 11 Wake
- Brian had the golden goal in the 101st minute against Notre Dame
- It was her second career ACC Player of the Week honor (both this season)

- Morgan Brian leads the ACC lead in assists (11)
- She is sixth nationally in assists/game (0.73)
- Brian's 26 career assists already rank T-5th in school history
- Her 0.49 assts/gm over her career is the fourth best active mark nationally

20-20-20 VISION WITH BRIAN, DOUGLAS & DONIAK:

- Virginia has three players with at least 20 career goals in Morgan Brian (24), Gloria Douglas (22) and Makenzy Doniak (22)
- It is the first time UVa has had three active 20-goal scorers since 1991

RATCLIFFE, THE SUPER SUB:

- Brittany Ratcliffe has 11 goals this season, 10 of which have come off the bench
- Her 10 goals off the bench is a school record for goals as a substitute for a season, breaking the previous record of six

STEARNS SHINES IN GOAL:

- Morgan Stearns is the first true-freshman goalkeeper to start multiple games in a season for Virginia since Jodi Clugston made 11 starts in 2000
- She ranks among the ACC leaders in GAA (3rd) and save percentage (2nd)

MENCHEL STEPS UP WHEN IT COUNTS:

- Defender Molly Menchel has scored 11 career goals, the most career goals by a Cavalier defender
- Seven of her 11 career goals have been game-winning goals, including three this season (VCU, Richmond, BC)

UP NEXT:

- UVa continues the homestand Sunday against No. 3 Florida State
- Game time at Klöckner Stadium is 2 p.m.
- It is the first top-three matchup in Klöckner Stadium history
