UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND HEAD COACH JOE KRIVAK AND PLAYERS
FOLLOWING MARYLAND'S 17-6 WIN OVER VIRGINIA
SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 7, 1991

"I think it was pretty much what you would expect from a typical game. I don't think it was much different from what we talked about in pre-season. We thought the defense would be pretty good we played good tough defense. I didn't think we would be able to shut those two backs down. Our defensive line, our defensive group -- I think Coach Greg Williams and his staff put together a pretty good game plan. It was the defense that kept us in the game.

"Offensively, we wanted to establish the run because we have a couple of guys that can run the ball. For maybe the first time in a long time we rushed for 200 yards. Passing game, we just have to keep working on it. We just have to keep moving along.

"I don't know what condition Steve Ingram is but if we lose him we are going to lose a big part of that offensive line. He has the chance to be an outstanding player and you just hate to see something like that happen.

"Jackson and Mason came up real big in the first half but they hung in and came back in the second half. Sandwisch byinlarge had a good game - first time under fire against a pretty good football team made a couple of mistakes but all in all he did more good than he did bad."

Lubo Zizakovic (#98)

QUESTION: What did you do to stop the running game?

"Same thing we have done for the last five years. We have experience in the front line when you get together a bunch of fifth-year seniors on the line and outside backers obviously we are going to do well. We were fired up to stop the running game. We shut them down.

Scott Rosen (#24)

"If a receiver gets a jump on the DB one thing you do is you don't look back. I just kept looking at his head and thankfully I got it."

Mike Jarmolowich (#40)

"We were getting ready for the run. They have two good running backs. Leading rushers and both all-ACC. We were planning on stopping the run and letting them beat us with the pass."

UVA COACHES QUOTES

COACH WELSH: Big difference today was the turnovers. It was a disappointing part for me. We had not turned the ball over in practice or in the scrimmages. But then again, we had not been hit that hard in 10 days. Maryland has got some good down linemen. We are usually better than that...We got off to a slow start in the first half. Maybe we were a little nervous, I don't know. Our concentration was not there. We looked slow and lacked a little bit of enthusiasm...We played better in the second half. Our defense hung in there and overall played a good game. They played well enough to win...Offensively, our pass protection wasn't good enough this game. We have to get better at that...~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ This was a typical first game. I thought Maryland was sharper however...Their punter DeArmas did a good job punting for them. We did not get a chance to return many kicks.
