TODAY'S GAME:

- The Cavaliers continue a three-game homestand by hosting Clemson
- Steve Swanson looks for his 200th victory at Virginia
- UVa has won its last eight games following a full week off

SERIES HISTORY:

- UVa leads 12-10-1 overall (UVa leads 5-3-1 in Charlottesville)
- The Cavaliers are unbeaten (9-0-1) vs. Clemson since 2004, their longest unbeaten streak against any ACC foe
- Virginia won last year's meeting 1-0 in Clemson

LOOK HOOS NO. 1:

- Virginia remained at No. 1 in all four major polls for the third straight week
- The only previous time UVa was No. 1 was in 1990 (three weeks)
- Only one current Cavalier was alive the last time UVa was No. 1, Morgan Stith, who was born during the last week UVa was No. 1 (Oct. 15-21, 1990)

ON A WINNING STREAK:

- Virginia is currently on a 11-game win streak, the second longest streak in school history
- The school record is a 16-game win streak, set at the start of the 1990 season
- The Cavaliers are the nation's only unbeaten and untied team this season

COMEBACK CAVALIERS:

- Virginia rallied from a deficit to win at BC, Pitt and Duke, the first time in school history with three consecutive come-from-behind wins
- UVa has four come-from-behind wins this season, tied for the most in school history for an entire season (1997 and 1998)
- The win at Duke marked the sixth time in school history that UVa rallied to win when trailing by two goals (first time since at PSU in 2009 NCAA 2nd rd)

PACK THE HOUSE:

- Virginia had a record women's soccer crowd of 2,540 for the Maryland game on Sept. 19
- The Cavaliers have drawn over 1,000 fans for every home game this season
- UVa is one of nine schools this season to have a crowd of over 2,500 for a game this season

GOALS, GOALS!!!:

- Virginia ranks second nationally at 3.36 goals per game and ranks fourth nationally with 37 total goals this season
- The Cavaliers scored at least three goals in each of the first seven games of the season, the longest streak of scoring 3+ goals in school history
- Of the 37 goals scored, the Cavaliers have 11 different goal scorers

SCORING STREAK:

- Virginia is one of 16 schools nationally to have scored a goal in every game this season
- Dating back to last year, UVa has scored in 19 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the nation

ACC SUCCESS:

- Dating back to last season, UVa has won 10 of its last 11 games against ACC opponents (only loss vs. Duke in NCAA Tournament)
- UVa has won its last five road games at ACC foes, the longest streak in school history
- The Cavaliers have won seven straight ACC regular season games, tying the school record set in 2004-05

LAST TIME OUT:

- The Cavaliers downed Maryland 1-0 on Sept. 29
- It was Virginia's school-record 28th all-time win over the Terps
- Brittany Ratcliffe scored her seventh goal of the season
- Morgan Stearns posted her fourth shutout of the season

SWANSON REACHES MILESTONE, LOOKS FOR ANOTHER:

- Virginia head coach Steve Swanson earned his 300th career win on Sept. 19 with the 2-1 victory at Boston College
- Swanson became the 16th Division I coach to join the 300 win club, and the 11th to accululate 300 wins at the Division I level
- He became the 31st NCAA coach (all divisions) to reach the milestone
- · Against Clemson, he looks for his 200th win at Virginia



CAVALIERS SHINE IN NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULE:

- The Cavaliers went undefeated (6-0-0) in non-conference play, outscoring opponents 25-3
- It marked Virginia's first undefeated non-conference slate since 2004 (9-0-0)

BRIAN SCORES FOR USWNT:

- Morgan Brian scored her first goal for the United States Women's National Team on Sept. 3 in the 7-0 victory over Mexico in Washington, D.C.
- She became the first active collegian to score for the USWNT since Alex Morgan in 2010 (as a senior at Cal)
- At age 20, Brian is the youngest USWNT goal-scorer since Christine Narin (at age 18) scored for the team in 2009
- She made her second USWNT appearance against Mexico and is one of three current collegians to have earned a cap (North Carolina's Crystal Dunn, Santa Clara's Julie Johnston)
- Brian has been called into camp for the Australia game on Oct. 20 in San Antonio, Texas and will miss the Cavaliers' game at North Carolina

BRIAN HONORED:

- Junior midfielder Morgan Brian was named ACC Co-Player of the Week on Aug. 27 after earning MVP honors at the Klöckner Classic
- Brian had one goal and three assists in the wins over VCU and Santa Clara
- It was her first career ACC Player of the Week honor
- She was also named to the TopDrawerSoccer.com Team of the Week

BRIAN RECEIVES PRESEASON ACCOLADES:

- Morgan Brian was named to the preseason Hermann Trophy Watch List
- Brian was also named a preseason All-American by Soccer America

BRIAN PASSING WITH FLYING COLORS:

- Morgan Brian is tied for the ACC lead in assists (8)
- She is ninth nationally in assists/game (0.73)
- Brian's 23 career assists already rank T-6th in school history
- Her 0.479 assts/gm over her career is the fourth best active mark nationally

RATCLIFFE, THE SUPER SUB:

- Brittany Ratcliffe has seven goals this season, all coming off the bench
- Her seven goals off the bench is a school record for goals as a substitute for a season, breaking the previous record of six

MENCHEL STEPS UP WHEN IT COUNTS:

- Defender Molly Menchel has scored 11 career goals, the most career goals by a Cavalier defender
- Seven of her 11 career goals have been game-winning goals, including three this season (VCU, Richmond, BC)

UP NEXT:

- UVa returns concludes the homestand on Oct. 10 as they host Notre Dame
- Game time is 7 p.m. and the match can be seen on the ACC Digital Network
- It will be Virginia's first head-to-head ACC contest against Notre Dame in any sport
