FIVE THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

• Thursday's home game with Loyola kicks off the 85th season of Virginia lacrosse.

 Virginia has won 12 of its last 13 season openers, losing only to Drexel on the UHall Turf Field in 2007.

• Eleven of those 12 wins came against Drexel and 2014 marks the first time since the 2001 (Towson) season the Cavaliers have opened a season against someone other than the Dragons. • Thursday's home game marks the earliest game in program history by eight days. The previous mark was Feb. 14, 2009 when UVa hosted Drexel. • UVa and Loyola meet for the 17th time in program history in a series that was first played in 1938.

GAME OVERVIEW

Virginia opens up the 2014 men's lacrosse season in the earliest game in school history on Thursday against the Loyola Greyhounds at Klöckner Stadium. Faceoff is set for 7 p.m. UVa owns preseason rankings of No. 7 in the USILA coaches poll and No. 8 in the Warrior/Inside Lacrosse media poll. Thursday's game beats UVa's previous earliest game by eight days, when the Cavaliers opened the 2009 season on Feb. 14 against Drexel.

Loyola, also opening its season, is ranked No. 12 in the preseason USILA coaches poll and No. 16 in the preseason Warrior/Inside Lacrosse media poll.

THE SERIES VS. GREYHOUNDS

Thursday marks the 17th all-time meeting between the Cavaliers and Greyhounds in a series that began in 1938. The séries took a 23-year hiatus before being rekindled for the 2014 season. Thursday's game is the first meeting of the series to be played at historic Klöckner Stadium, which didn't exist during the 1991 meeting, a contest played at Scott Stadium.

Lovola head coach Charley Toomey is in his ninth season at the helm of his alma mater and returns 26 letterwinners from last year's 11-5 squad, a team that nearly upset eventual-national-champion Duke in the NCAA First Round, falling in double overtime, 12-11.

Widely regarded as one of the best teachers, motivators and tacticians in the game, Dom Starsia is in his 21st season at the helm of the Virginia men's lacrosse program.

Under Starsia's guidance, his Cavalier squads have won four

NCAA titles and reached the final four 13 times. He has won more games than any coach in Atlantic Coast Conference and Virginia history, sporting a 247-84 (.746) record since coming to Charlottesville in 1993. In 22 seasons with Virginia, Starsia has coached 331 games, fittingly his 300th game at Virginia was the 2011 NCAA title game against Maryland at Baltimore's M&T Bank Stadium.

HALL OF FAMER STARSIA TOPS NCAA DI WINS LIST

 Virginia head coach Dom Starsia is one of the most accomplished coaches in the history of the college game coaching at Brown (1983-92) and Virginia (1993-present)

 He passed Jack Emmer for most career wins by a head coach while coaching at a NCAA Division I school with UVa's quarterfinal win over Cornell in 2011

• He becomes the second UVa head coach to hold the record as Jim Adams retired with 284 career victories after the 1992 season, giving way to Starsia to take the Cavalier program over in 1993 - Adams retired as the record holder

• He was inducted into the Lacrosse Hall of Fame in November 2008

• He has led UVa to four national championships ('99, '03, '06, '11)

• His teams have made 24 NCAA Tournament appearanc-

es, the most by any Division I coach in history • His Cavalier squads have advanced to the final four 13 times

COVERING THE CAVALIERS

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVa's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

TEAM/POLLS/SERIES NOTES

THE SERIES VS. THE GREYHOUNDS

• Virginia leads the all-time series with Loyola by an 11-5 margin.

• The series between these programs began in 1938, and only five current Division I programs have an alltime series with UVa that began earlier: Johns Hopkins (1926), Maryland (1926), Yale (1927), Navy (1928) and Penn (1929).

• Thursday marks the first meeting between these programs since 1991 and the first-ever meeting at UVa's historic Klöckner Stadium.

• UVa and Loyola last met in 1991 at Scott Stadium in a matchup between the No. 2 Greyhounds and the No. 3 Cavaliers. Loyola started the game on a 6-1 run and it looked as if the Greyhounds would roll.

 After that lackluster first guarter, UVa jumped on the shoulders of sophomore attackman Kevin Pehlke for a 14-1 run and Virginia never looked back, winning 17-10. Pehlke scored seven goals and finished with 10 points.

• The win in 1991 snapped Loyola's three-game winning streak in the series, and coupled that week with a loss by No. 1 Syracuse, UVa ascended to the top of the polls. At the time it was the first time UVa had been No. 1 in the nation since the end of the 1980 regular season.

 Before Loyola's win in 1987, UVa had enjoyed a 10-game winning streak in the series that spanned from 1947-1986.

UVa and Loyola played every season from 1982-1988.

• UVa will open the 2015 season at Loyola.

LOYOLA'S CHARLEY TOOMEY AND VIRGINIA

 While Charley Toomey has never faced Virginia as a head coach, he has never lost to the Cavaliers as a player, going 3-0.

 The two-time All-American goalie made 13 saves for the Greyhounds in the 1990 meeting, a 14-8 Loyola win in Baltimore. Toomey did not play in the 1987 or 1988 meetings, but Loyola came away with wins during the Greyhounds' three-game win streak, the longest of the series for Loyola.

• Toomey served as the NCAA Charlottesville site rep during UVa's 2011 NCAA First Round game with Bucknell, a game that the Cavaliers won in overtime, 13-12, catapulting Virginia to its fifth NCAA title.

VIRGINIA IN SEASON OPENERS

• This is the first season in 13 years that Virginia has not opened a season against Drexel.

• UVa is 47-32-1 (.594) all-time in season openers.

• When the season opener is at home, the Cavaliers have compiled a 27-16-1 (.625) record throughout the years.

• This is the 10th time in the last 15 seasons the Cavaliers have opened at home.

MATT BARRETT MAKES COLLEGIATE DEBUT IN CAGE FOR CAVALIERS

• Matt Barrett will become only the seventh first-year at UVa to start a season-opening game in the cage since lacrosse became an NCAA Championship sport in 1971. • The other Cavalier rookies to start in goal at UVa are Scott Howe (1972), Brian Gregory (1979), Derek Kenney (1999), Tillman Johnson (2001), Adam Ghitelman (2008) and Dan Marino (2013).

• Rodney Rullman also as a first-year started games in 1972, including all three NCAA Tournament contests that led to UVa's first NCAA title. Barrett becomes the eighth first-year to start a game in goals for the Cavaliers.

 Howe, Rullman, Kenney, Johnson and Ghitelman all won NCAA titles during their careers at UVa. Rullman and Kenney did so as first-years, starting the NCAA title game.

• Gregory and Ghitelman lost NCAA semifinal games as first-years and Johnson lost in the first round. Gregory is the only one in the group to not win an NCAA title while on Grounds – which group will Barrett fall into during his UVa career?

VIRGINIA IS A GROUND BALL MACHINE

Accoriding to UVa head coach Dom Starsia - "If there's any single statistic that

speaks to your effort overall, then it's that one (ground balls)."

• UVa has the nation in ground balls two of the last four years.

Since the NCAA started including ground balls per game in their national rankings

• UVa cleared at a .907 rate in 2012, a .900 rate in 2011 and a .922 rate in 2010

• During that time UVa twice ranked No. 3 in the nation in scoring offense, scoring

13.44 goals per game in 2010 and 12.56 goals per game in 2011. UVa ranked No. 11 in 2012 with 11.5 goals per game.

 According to research in collaboration with all NCAA DI men's lacrosse SIDs, only 13 teams have cleared at over .900 in a season, four times its been done by UVa, dating back to 1971 - the first year lacrosse was an NCAA Championship sport

CLEARING - THE CHRIS LAPIERRE FACTOR - DEBATE

• While no team boasts a streak of four seasons in a row of clearing the ball at a .900 percent clip - the current four-year streak for UVa are also the only four years in Dom Starsia's 21 seasons at Virginia where the Cavaliers have had a season with a .900 percent or better clearing rate.

• The streak coincidently started with the matriculation at Virginia of M Chris LaPierre. The senior has been a one-man clear for the Cavaliers and arguably the nation's top defensive midfielder over the 2010-12 seasons. Begs the question with UVa's current success clearing the ball - is it a coincidence, or is it the Chris LaPierre factor?

• The 2010, 2011 and 2012 seasons also happen to be the only seasons a UVa team has cleared the ball at .900 or better since lacrosse became an NCAA Championship sport in 1971

 The LaPierre Factor becomes a debate because of his limited play in 2013 due to injury that resulted in a medical hardship and yet the Cavaliers are clearing at a .918 rate through 15 games.

 LaPierre is back in 2014 for his final year, where will UVa finish in clears? VIRGINIA IN OVERTIME UNDER DOM STARSIA

• UVa is 21-16 all-time in overtime under Dom Starsia. Seven of those losses came in NCAA Tournament action. UVa is 3-7 in OT games in the NCAA Tournament under Starsia.

• Since the start of the 2007 season, UVa is 11-4 in overtime games under Starsia. • The four losses since 2007 came at Duke (2007), Syracuse in the NCAA semifinal in 2008, Johns Hopkins (2012) in a regular season matchup and recently this season at Syracuse (2013). The Hopkins game in 2012 was the only OT loss since 2007 at

Klöckner Stadium. • Virginia is 12-2 all-time in OT games at Klöckner Stadium, which doubles as the record under Starsia.

• The first loss was the 2000 meeting with Syracuse and the second was the 2012 Hopkins game.

 Starsia is 12-3 all-time at home in OT games while at UVa - the 1998 Syracuse game was played at the Field Hockey Turf Field, resulting in a loss.

CHRIS LAPIERRE RETURNS TO THE FIELD IN 2014

 On March 20, 2013 Chris LaPierre was shut down for the remainder of the season with a lower extremity injury.

• LaPierre earned a medical hardship after appearing in only three games.

• At the time of LaPierre being shut down on March 20, he was No. 6 in the nation among active players in career ground balls with 209.

• LaPierre currently ranks No. 34 at UVa in career ground balls - He averages 3.9 ground balls per game for his career and in a full 2014 can position himself to finish career in the Top-5 all-time at UVa (271+).

• LaPierre enters 2014 No. 9 among active players in ground balls and No. 1 among non-faceoff specialists.

• The two-time DIII USILA All-American was the ODAC Player of the Year in 2012 with 89 ground balls and 41 caused turnovers. He was selected 41st overall in the 2013 MLL Draft by the Ohio Machine, who still hold his rights.

 Sophomore D Nate Menninger joins UVa after spending one season with DIII Hamilton College.

- Menninger took 201 faceoffs with a long pole, winning 94 times.
- He picked up a team-best 75 ground balls and caused 12 turnovers.

• Since Dom Starsia took over as head coach of the Virginia program in 1993, there
