TODAY'S GAME

- Virginia continues a season-long four-game homestand by hosting Longwood
- The Cavaliers look to remain undefeated at home this season
- UVa seeks its first 7-1 start to a season since 2004-05

SERIES HISTORY

- Virginia leads 5-0 (all previous games in Charlottesville)
- The Cavaliers have won each of the previous five meetings by double figures
- The last meeting was an 85-72 Cavalier win in 2009-10, the closest game in the series

AGAINST THE COMMONWEALTH

- Since the 1999-2000 season, Virginia has a 39-9 record against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia
- The Cavaliers are 30-3 at home against in-state foes during that time
- UVa has an 18-3 record against in-state opponents at John Paul Jones Arena
- Virginia was 5-0 vs. in-state opponents last season

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia defeated No. 14 Michigan 70-58 on Tuesday at John Paul Jones Arena
- UVa's highest ranked win since topping No. 12 Clemson 85-81 (ot) on Feb. 15, 2009
- Mike Scott had 18 pts and 11 rebs for his third double-double of the season
- Joe Harris had 18 points and Malcolm Brogdon had 16 points, marking the first time this season UVa has had three players score at least 15 points each in a game (also first time this season UVa had four players in double figures in a game)

CAVALIERS TOP MICHIGAN

- UVa's 70-58 win over No. 14 Michigan was its highest ranked win of the Bennett era
- It was the Cavaliers' first double-digit win over a top-15 opponent since a 72-58 win over No. 11 Boston College on Feb. 21, 2006 at University Hall

2011-12 Opponents in Bold

CAVALIERS GET DEFENSIVE

- Virginia is second in the nation in scoring defense at 47.1 ppg (as of 12/1)
- The Cavaliers have held each of their first seven opponents under 60 points, the first time they have held seven straight opponents under 60 points since 1948-49
- UVa held four of its first seven opponents to under 50 points, a feat it has done 11 times in the Tony Bennett era
- Virginia held Drexel to 35 points, the second lowest scoring total by a UVa opponent in the shot clock era
- South Carolina State's 25.5% shooting (13-51) was the lowest percentage allowed by UVa since Liberty shot 22.6% percent (12-53) against UVa in the 2005-06 season opener
- Virginia has held two opponents under 30% shooting this season (only accomplished the feat twice in the previous three seasons combined)
- It is the first time UVa has held multiple opponents under 30% shooting in the same season since 2005-06 (three times)

FREE THROW PRODUCTION

- Virginia leads the ACC and ranks sixth nationally with a 78.3 free throw percentage
- UVa has scored 29.1 percent of its points this season from the free throw line
- The Cavaliers are going to the line 7.1 more times a game this season and scoring 7.1 more points from the line per game this season

THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- UVa set a school record by going 19-for-19 from the free throw line against Winthrop
- The previous school record was 16-for-16 against South Carolina on Jan. 8, 1965
- It was the best free throw performance by an ACC team since Wake Forest shot an ACC-record 32-for-32 against North Carolina in 2005

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVa has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons
- North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College

SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball
- He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 20-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 17-30 over the past three seasons when scoring under 70 points

'HOOS BACK

- 10 players return from last season's team that went 16-15 (7-9 ACC)
- The Cavaliers return 69.0% of scoring and 79.4% of rebounding from last season

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 64-28 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers went 11-6 at home last season
- Virginia is 4-0 at home this season

CAVALIER DEBUTS

- Malcolm Brogdon and James Johnson, along with walk-ons Rob Vozenilek and Angus Mitchell made their collegiate debuts in the season opener vs. SC State
- Brogdon had nine points, four assists and two rebounds in his debut
- Johnson had six points (6-8 FT) and three rebounds in his debut

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP

- Mike Scott enters the game with 27 career double-doubles (4th in UVa history)
- He had six double-doubles in his 10 games last season before suffering a season-ending injury
- His 27 career double-doubles leads all active ACC players
- Scott had his first double-double of the season against Drexel (21 pts, 10 rebs)
- It was his fifth "20-10" game of his career (at least 20 points and 10 rebounds)

SCOTT LEADS THE ACC

- Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (1,070), rebounds (750) and double-doubles (27)

SCOTT JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB

- Mike Scott became the 43rd Cavalier to score 1,000 career points, reaching the milestone against TCU in the Virgin Islands
- He enters the game with 1,070 career points, 40th in Virginia history

RETURN TO SENE-DER

- Assane Sene ranks seventh in school history with 100 career blocks
- He led the Cavaliers last season with 39 blocks

ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE

- Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 147 career 3-pointers, which ranks 10th in school history

EVANS SHINES AGAINST WINTHROP

- Jontel Evans scored a career-high 17 points against Winthrop
- He was 5-6 from the field, made a career-high two 3-pointers, and went 5-5 from the free throw line
- His previous career high was 11 points

JESPERSON TO REDSHIRT

- Freshman guard Paul Jespersen is expected to redshirt this season
- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett indicated that after Virginia's game with South Carolina State on Nov. 13

FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA

- UVa signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class
- The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.

- Virginia will have almost every game this season broadcast either on television or online
- All 16 ACC games and all 16 home games will be broadcast
- 13 games will be televised nationally by ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU or FSN

McKAY PARTICIPATING IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

- Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay is participating in "Shots from the Heart", a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease
- College basketball coaches are competing against one another in a free throw shooting tournament, which benefits the American Heart Association
- The event also pays tribute to the late Skip Prosser who passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack
- Last year, McKay reached the quarterfinals of the assistant coach bracket in the inaugural event
- McKay faces Ricky Yahn of Longwood in the round of 64 of this year's event

UP NEXT

- Virginia will host George Mason on Tuesday in the final game before a 12-day break for exams
- Game time at John Paul Jones Arena is 7 p.m. and the game will be broadcast online by ESPN3
- The Cavaliers are 6-0 all-time against George Mason, but the teams haven't met since the 1997-98 season

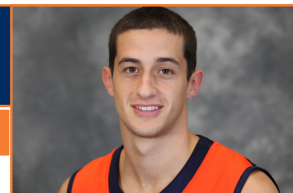
