FOR OPENERS

- The Virginia-Virginia Tech game is part of the Commonwealth Clash presented by Virginia529, which is a head-to-head, points-based competition between the athletic teams of the Cavaliers and Hokies.
- UVA is 6-3 on the road, including a 4-2 road mark in ACC play.
- The Cavaliers have a two-game winning streak against Virginia Tech and have won nine of the last 10 games in the series, including a 71-48 victory on Feb. 1 at JPI.
- As of Feb. 10, UVA is tied for third in the ACC at 8-3.
- The Cavaliers rank first nationally in scoring defense (54 ppg) and second in turnovers per game (9.9).
- London Perrantes leads UVA in scoring at 12.2 points per game, marking the lowest scoring average to lead any UVA team in a single season (Malcolm Brogdon 12.7 ppg in 2013-14).
- Virginia is 23-10 in its last 33 ACC road contests since 2012-13.

ALL-TIME VS. VIRGINIA TECH

- Virginia is 90-54 all-time vs. Virginia Tech, including a 20-29 mark in Blacksburg, in the series that dates back to 1914-15.
- The Cavaliers are 5-1 in their last six games against the Hokies at Cassell Coliseum.
- UVA has held Virginia Tech to 49 or fewer points in each of the last two meetings.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 11-4 all-time vs. Virginia Tech.
- London Perrantes has averaged 10.6 points, 4.1 assists and 2.7 rebounds in seven career games against the Hokies.

LAST TIME VS. THE HOKIES

- Devon Hall tallied a career-high 17 points and Isaiah Wilkins scored a career-high 15 points to lead then-No. 9 Virginia to a 71-48 win over Virginia Tech in the Commonwealth Clash on Wednesday, Feb. 1.
- London Perrantes added 14 points as UVA posted its largest margin of victory in the series since a 25-point win over the Hokies in 1991.
- UVA started the game on a 10-0 run and out-rebounded Tech 37-22 in its ninth home win of 2016-17.
- The Hokies were held to a season-low 48 points and shot 35.7 percent in the loss.
- Seth Allen led Tech with 14 points and Zach LeDay added 12.
- Hall matched a career-best with nine rebounds for UVA.

MORE ON THE COMMONWEALTH CLASH

- The Commonwealth Clash encourages a friendly, statewide rivalry between the two schools across all school-sponsored sports with 22 individual event points on the line.
- The school that accumulates 11.5 points or more will be crowned the winner and take home the Virginia529 Commonwealth Clash trophy.
- The UVA-VT game is worth a half point in the Clash and the Hokies lead this year's Clash 4.5-3.5.
- UVA has captured the Clash in each of the past two seasons.

UVA RANKED NO. 12/13 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 12 in the latest AP poll and No. 13 in USA Today Coaches' poll.
- UVA has ranked in the top 15 in 57 of the last 59 AP polls.
- UVA was ranked in top 10 in the preseason rankings (No. 8/7) for the third straight season, matching a school-best from 1981-83.
- UVA has been ranked in 60 consecutive AP polls since Feb. 3, 2014.
- UVA has finished in the top 10 (No. 3 in 2014 & No. 6 in 2015 and No. 4 in 2016) in the final AP rankings in three consecutive seasons for the first time since 1981-83.

IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- As of Feb. 10, UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense (54 ppg), third in turnovers per game (10), sixth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.51), eighth in field goal percentage (49.5%), 11th in scoring margin (+15.0), 16th in field goal percentage defense (39.1%), 19th in fouls per game (16) and 22nd in 3-point field goal percentage (39.8%).
- UVA has held four opponents to fewer than 40 points and was the first team in Division I to hold three straight opponents (St. Francis Brooklyn, Yale and Grambling State) to fewer than 40 points in the last 20 years.
- UVA was also the first team in ACC history (1953-present) to hold three straight opponents to fewer than 40 points.
- The Cavaliers have held 15 of their opponents to 55 or fewer points and seven opponents to 50 or fewer points.

UVA IN KEN POM EFFICIENCY RATINGS

- As of Feb. 10, UVA ranks Nos. 2, 3 and 14 in the KenPom.com overall, adjusted defense and adjusted offense efficiency ratings, respectively.
- UVA is shooting 49.5 percent from the field (best since 49.6% in 1986-87), 39.8 percent from 3-point range (second in school history) and 71.7 percent from the free throw line.
- UVA scored a Tony Bennett era high 90 points vs. Grambling State.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better in 10 games.
- UVA has held its opponents below 40 percent shooting in 12 games.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 183-77 (.704) mark in eight seasons at Virginia and 252-110 (.696) career mark in 11 seasons overall.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top-five nationally in seven of 10 seasons.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to five consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2016, and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett-coached teams are 87-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 11-year coaching career.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

LAST TIME OUT

- London Perrantes scored 18 points and Isaiah Wilkins added his first career double-double with 13 points, 11 rebounds and five blocks Monday night as the Cavaliers beat No. 4 Louisville 71-55.
- Virginia trailed 34-32 at halftime, but took command with a 22-5 run that made it 54-39 midway through the half.
- V.J. King scored a career-high 24 points for the Cardinals.
- The Cardinals were without their second- and third-leading scorers, with guard Quentin Snider (12.1 ppg), forward Deng Adel (11.1 ppg) and center Mangok Mathiang (7.1 ppg, 6.2 rpg) all out.
- UVA was 18 of 20 from the free throw line and out-rebounded Louisville 38-19.

HOW ARE THESE WAHOOS?

- UVA is led by senior point guard London Perrantes, who is averaging team highs in points (11.9 ppg) and assists (4 apg).
- Isaiah Wilkins (7.7 ppg & 6.1 rpg) leads the team in rebounding, blocked shots (33) and steals (27).
- Devon Hall is averaging 8.5 points and 4.4 rebounds, while Darius Thompson has added 6.7 points per game.
- Marial Shayok is averaging 9.6 points and Kyle Guy is averaging 7.6 points to top all UVA rookies.
- Jack Salt is averaging 3.9 points and 3.7 rebounds in 18.7 minutes per game, while Ty Jerome, Mamadi Diakite and Jarred Reuter are key role players off the bench.

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- Virginia is 3-3 vs. ranked opponents, including wins against then-No. 6 Louisville, then-No. 14 Notre Dame and No. 4 Louisville.
- UVA's 61-53 road win at then-No. 6 Louisville marked the Cavaliers' first top-10 road win since the 2002-03 season (86-78 vs. then-No. 8 Maryland).
- UVA is 25-26 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVA is 140-322 vs. ranked opponents, including a 26-120 mark against top-5 foes, since 1953-54.
- UVA is 1-29 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).
- UVA tied a school mark with eight wins vs. ranked foes in 2015-16.

- UVA held Grambling State scoreless for 9:46 spanning halftime and Yale went scoreless for 8:48.

- Virginia has had scoring runs of 10 or more consecutive points in 13 games this season (16 total).
- UVA went on a 26-0 run to close the first half against Grambling State and tallied a 22-0 run at UCG spanning halftime.
- UVA's 13-0 run against Ohio State helped erase a 16-point deficit in the 63-61 win over the Buckeyes.

- Virginia is 148-38 (.796), including a 10-2 mark in 2016-17, in 11 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- West Virginia ended UVA's JJP-record, 24-game home winning streak on Dec. 3, 2015.
- The Cavaliers finished undefeated at home (15-0) in 2015-16 for the first time since 1981-82 (12-0).
- UVA is 110-22 (.833), including a 75-7 (.915) mark the past five seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 39-2 in ACC home games over the past five seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for seven straight seasons.

- Six of UVA's opponents are ranked in the latest AP poll (Villanova, Louisville, North Carolina, West Virginia, Florida State and Duke), while two opponents (Notre Dame & California) received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 13 games against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, North Carolina, West Virginia, Miami, Pitt and Yale; road contests at Villanova, North Carolina, Syracuse, California, Pitt and Notre Dame; and a neutral-site tilt against Iowa in the Emerald Coast Classic in Niceville, Fla.

LEAVING ITS BENCH(MARK)

- UVA has outscored its opponents 647-293 off the bench this season.
- The Cavaliers are averaging 28.1 points off the bench, while opponents are averaging 12.7 bench points.
- UVA scored a season-high 61 points off the bench against Grambling and had a 20-0 advantage over Providence off the bench.

- Preseason All-ACC first-team selection and ACC Player of the Year candidate London Perrantes is averaging 12.2 points, 3.9 assists and 3.1 rebounds in 2016-17.
- Perrantes had a season-high 25 points at Clemson (1/14/17), 24 points against Wake Forest (1/8/17) and 22 at Notre Dame (1/24/17).
- He enjoyed a breakout season in 2015-16, averaging career highs in points (11), field goal percentage (43.9%) and ACC-leading 3-point field goal percentage (48.8%).
- Perrantes has led UVA in assists in each of the last three seasons and has a career 2.8 assist-to-turnover ratio (532 assists, 193 turnovers) in 127 games (123 starts).
- He was named All-ACC Honorable Mention in each of the past two seasons and earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.

- Shayok is averaging 11.1 points as a starter the last nine games and has 10+ points in seven of the past 11 games.
- Shayok had a career-high 19 points vs. Georgia Tech and added 17 points against Wake Forest (1/8/17) and Clemson (1/14/17).

ZAY PAVES THE WAY

- Wilkins has averaged 12.4 points and 8.2 rebounds in the last five games.

- Kyle Guy is averaging 7.6 points, 1.5 rebounds and 17.4 minutes in his first year at UVA.
- Guy's 7.6 points per game average in his rookie season under head coach Tony Bennett ranks higher than former UVA great Malcolm Brogdon (6.7 ppg) and current UVA guard London Perrantes (5.5 ppg).
- Guy has scored 10+ points in seven games and scored a career-high 20 points against Grambling State, 17 points at Cal (12/21/16) and 14 at Syracuse (2/4/17).
- Guy is shooting 48.4 percent from 3-point range and 76.7 percent from the charity stripe.

ACC STATISTICALLY SPEAKING

- As of Feb. 10, Isaiah Wilkins ranks seventh in blocked shots (1.43 bpg) and 19th in rebounding (6.1 rpg) in all games. London Perrantes ranks fifth in 3-point percentage (41.4%) and seventh in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.28), while Mamadi Diakite ranks 10th in blocked shots (1.24 bpg).
- In ACC league games, Perrantes ranks third in 3-point percentage (50%), eighth in free throw percentage (83.3%), ninth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.65) and 22nd in scoring (15.1 ppg). BROGDON'S NO. 15 TO BE RETIRED ON FEB. 20

- Virginia will retire Malcolm Brogdon's No. 15 on Monday, Feb. 20 when the Cavaliers host Miami at John Paul Jones Arena.
- Brogdon finished his career ranked ninth on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,809 points. He also ranks first in free throw percentage (87.6%), second in games played (136), fifth in minutes played (4,157), sixth in 3-point field goal percentage (36.5%), seventh in 3-pointers (185) and ninth in free throws (422).
- Brogdon earned consensus first-team All-America and NABC Defensive Player of the Year honors in 2016 after becoming the first player to be named ACC Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year in the same season. The three-time All-ACC first-team performer earned consensus second-team All-America honors in 2015.
- He helped Virginia to 111 wins, four NCAA tournaments, two ACC regular-season titles and one ACC Tournament championship during his career.
- The other former Virginia men's basketball players whose numbers have been retired are Jeff Lamp (3), Barry Parkhill (40), Ralph Sampson (50), Sean Singletary (44), Bryant Stith (20), Wally Walker (41), and Buzzy Wilkinson (14).
- Brogdon, who is averaging 9.2 points and 4.2 assists for the NBA's Milwaukee Bucks, will compete in the BBVA Compass Rising Stars Challenge at All-Star Weekend on Feb. 17 in New Orleans.

- He earned unanimous first-team all-conference honors during his sophomore season in 2014-15 after averaging 19.3 points.

HOO ARE THE NEW GUY(S)?

- Virginia welcomes freshmen Kyle Guy, Ty Jerome, Jay Huff and De'Andre Hunter to this year's team.
- Guy averaged 23.5 points, 5.6 rebounds and 3.7 assists en route to Mr. Basketball for Indiana and McDonald's All-America honors in 2015-16.
- Jerome tallied 24.7 points, 8 rebounds and 5 assists per game before season-ending hip surgery last season.
- Huff averaged 16.3 points, 10.1 rebounds and 5.5 assists in 2015-16, while Hunter recorded 23.5 points and 9.8 rebounds per game.
- UVA head coach Tony Bennett announced on Nov. 11 he plans to redshirt Huff and Hunter.

- Virginia posted a school-record 89 wins from 2014-16 (30-7 in 2013-14, 30-4 in 2014-15 and 29-8 in 2015-16).
- The Cavaliers captured two ACC regular-season championships and one ACC Tournament title from 2014-16.
- In 2015-16, UVA advanced to its first NCAA Elite Eight since 1995.
- UVA has earned a pair of No. 1 NCAA Tournament seeds (2014 & 2016) and a No. 2 NCAA Tournament seed (2015).
- UVA was 45-3 at John Paul Jones Arena from 2014-16, and owned the seventh-longest home-winning streak in Division I at 20 games entering the 2016-17 season.
- The Cavaliers led the nation in scoring defense in 2014 and 2015, and finished second in 2016.

CAVALIERS IN THE NBA

- Justin Anderson (Dallas), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn), Mike Scott (Atlanta) and Mike Tobey (Charlotte) are former Cavaliers who are playing in the NBA this season.
- Scott is in his fifth season and Harris is in his third NBA season (first with Brooklyn), while Anderson is in his second season and Brogdon is in his rookie season.
- Tobey signed a 10-day contract with Charlotte on Feb. 3, 2017.
- Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle is a Virginia alum who helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984.
