TODAY'S GAME:

- Virginia looks to win its first NCAA Championship in women's soccer
- A championship would be the 21st NCAA Championship for Virginia (last was men's tennis in 2013)
- It marks the fourth time conference foes have met in the NCAA Final (North Carolina vs. NC State in 1988, UNC vs. Duke in 1992, Portland vs. Santa Clara in 2002)
- Virginia looks to become the third consecutive NCAA Champion to down three No. 1 seeds to win the championship

SERIES HISTORY:

- UVa leads 18-5-4 overall (FSU leads 1-0-0 in NCAA Tournament)
- The Seminoles have won both meetings this season 1-0 (Sept. 28 in Tallahassee and Nov. 9 in the ACC Final in Greensboro, N.C.)
- Since 2009, the teams have split the last 11 meetings (5-5-1)

CAVALIER OFFENSE vs. SEMINOLE DEFENSE:

- In its last 86 games, UVa has been shutout only four times (all by Florida St.)
- In the other four UVa-FSU games since 2011, Virginia has scored 10 goals and is 3-1-0 in those contests

HIGH SCORING HOOS:

- The Cavaliers lead the nation in scoring at 3.52 goals per game
- Virginia led the nation in scoring in 2013 at 3.00 goals per game
- UVa has 16 different goal scorers this season, including 12 players with multiple goals and eight players with at least four goals
- Virginia has scored at least two goals in 23 of 25 games this season
- The Cavaliers' 88 goals this season are a school record and the most nationally since North Carolina scored 89 goals in 2008

• Virginia has 17 goals from defenders this season (Sonnett-5, Cox-4, McNabb-4, Iordanou-3, Reid), almost doubling the previous school record of nine set last year

BENCH PRODUCTION:

- Virginia has recorded 20 goals and 14 assists this season from substitutes
- The Cavaliers have gotten a goal off the bench in 15 of 25 games this year
- The UVa bench has scored more goals this season than 86 Division I teams

DONIAK TIES GOAL SCORING MARK:

- Makenzy Doniak tied the UVa school record with her 20th goal of the year against Texas A&M
- She became the fifth player in ACC history to have consecutive 20-goal seasons (UNC's Janet Rayfield, Kristine Lilly, Mia Hamm, Robin Confer)
- Doniak extended her single-season school record points to 51
- She's the first 50-pt scorer in the ACC since Casey Nogueira of UNC in 2008
- The goal was also her 50th career goal as she became the first ACC player to reach 50 career goals during her junior year since UNC's Robin Confer in 1996

BRIAN AND DONIAK SHINE IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

- Morgan Brian and Makenzy Doniak are the two highest scoring players in this year's NCAA Tournament
- Brian has 17 points on four goals and nine assists
- Doniak has 15 points on six goals and three assists

COLAPRICO SETS ASSIST RECORDS

- Danielle Colaprico leads the ACC with 19 assists this season, setting a school record for assists in a season
- She holds UVa career assist record with 44, one ahead of Morgan Brian
- She has an assist in 15 of 25 games this season
- Her 19 assists are most by an ACC player since 2005 (UNC's Kacey White 25)

WHILE YOU WERE DISTRACTED BY ALL THE GOALS:

- The Cavalier defense has allowed 15 goals this season, posting 12 shutouts
- Virginia's 0.60 goals against average is the third-lowest in school history
- The UVa defense has allowed multiple goals just once this season, in a 6-3 victory over Boston College on Oct. 9

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- Colaprico will become the first Cavalier to make 100 career appearances on Sunday
- Virginia is the first school to have two active 125-point career scorers (Brian and Doniak) since 2005 North Carolina (Lindsay Tarpley & Heather O'Reilly)
