#### FOR OPENERS

- Virginia and Lamar meet for the first time.
- Virginia posted its largest margin of victory (40 points) during the Tony Bennett era (2009-present) in its last game vs. Seattle.
- Lamar is coming off a 70-49 loss at Charlotte on Nov. 17.
- Virginia juniors Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell are both averaging career highs in scoring and rebounding, respectively.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia beat Seattle, 83-43, in nonconference action on Saturday, Nov. 17.
- Freshman forward/center Mike Tobey had a season-high 17 points and Akil Mitchell scored 14 points and grabbed a career-high 16 rebounds.
- Justin Anderson (11 points) and Evan Nolte (10 points) joined Tobey and Mitchell in double figures.
- Virginia shot a season-best 56 percent from the floor and 88 percent from the charity stripe.
- Redshirt freshman Teven Jones posted four points and three rebounds in his collegiate debut.
- Senior point guard Jontel Evans returned to the sideline after playing three minutes in his season debut on Nov. 13.

#### AGAINST THE SOUTHLAND CONFERENCE

- Virginia is 2-0 all-time vs. teams in the Southland Conference (1-0 vs. Nicholls State and 1-0 vs. Oral Roberts).

#### HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has posted a 55-43 mark in four seasons at UVA.
- Bennett is 34-16 vs. nonconference opponents at Virginia.
- Bennett has a 124-76 career record, including a 69-33 record at Washington State, in seven seasons of collegiate coaching.

#### 2012-13 Opponents in Bold

- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to their first NCAA Tournament since 2007 last season with a 22-10 record, and UVa's 22 wins were the most since 25 in 1994-95.
- UVa's nine ACC wins in 2011-12 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.
- Bennett is one of 18 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

#### NO ORDINARY JOE

- Joe Harris is averaging a career-high 15.3 points, 5.0 rebounds and 1.7 assists per game this season.
- Harris led UVa with 19 points at George Mason, 15 points vs. Fairfield and a Virginia season-high 20 vs. Delaware.
- Harris has led the team in scoring 15 times and scored in double figures 40 times in 67 career games at Virginia.
- Harris is also shooting a career-high 44 percent (8-18) from three-point range.

#### AKIL HAS A FEEL

- Akil Mitchell is averaging career highs in points (13.0) and rebounds (11).
- Mitchell has posted back-to-back double-doubles in his last two games.
- He had 15 points and 13 rebounds vs. Delaware (11/13) and 14 points and 16 rebounds vs. Seattle (11/17).
- Mitchell established a career high in scoring in each of the first three games.
- Mitchell has led UVa in rebounds in three games.

#### YOUTH MOVEMENT

- Four Virginia freshmen (Justin Anderson, Taylor Barnette, Evan Nolte and Mike Tobey) have started at least one game this season.
- Nolte leads the newcomers in scoring at 7.5 points per game, followed by Tobey (7.0), Anderson (5.3), Teven Jones (4.0) and Barnette (3.3).
- Anderson leads the team in assists at 3.3 per game.
- Freshmen Anderson (11), Barnette (8), Nolte (10), Tobey (17) and Jones (4) accounted for 60 percent of Virginia's scoring vs. Seattle (11/17/12).
- UVa started three freshmen (Anderson, Tobey and Barnette) in its season-opening game vs. George Mason for the first time in school history.

#### EVANS AND BROGDON HAVE BEEN MISSED

- Senior guard Jontel Evans, an ACC All-Defensive Team member last season, has missed three of Virginia's first four games.
- Sophomore Malcolm Brogdon has missed the first four games with an ankle injury.
- Evans tallied 7.3 points and 3.9 assists per game last season, while Brogdon averaged 6.7 points and 2.8 rebounds per game.

#### CLEANING THE GLASS

- Virginia, who is averaging 35 rebounds per game, has outrebounded its opponents in each of its first four games.
- The Cavaliers have grabbed nine or more offensive rebounds in each of their first four games.
- Akil Mitchell leads Virginia in offensive rebounds (17), defensive rebounds (27) and total rebounds (44).

#### LONG RANGE BOMBERS

- The Cavaliers, who have drilled 20 three-point shots, made a season-high eight three-pointers at George Mason (11/9/12).
- Joe Harris (8), Evan Nolte (6), Taylor Barnette (3), Paul Jespersen (2), Mike Tobey (1) and have each connected from long range.

**NIT SEASON TIP-OFF UPDATE**

- Virginia, Lehigh and Robert Morris are hosting the NIT Season Tip-Off consolation rounds on Nov. 19-20.
- Virginia defeated Fairfield, 54-45, and lost to Delaware, 59-53, in the preliminary rounds in Charlottesville on Nov. 12-13.
- Lamar lost to Kansas State, 79-55, and North Texas, 74-59, in the preliminary rounds in Manhattan, Kan., on Nov. 12-13.
- North Texas lost to Alabama-Huntsville, 78-75, and defeated Lamar, 74-59, in the preliminary rounds in Manhattan, Kan., on Nov. 12-13.
- IUPUI lost to Michigan, 91-54, and defeated Bowling Green, 80-66, in the preliminary rounds in Ann Arbor, Mich., on Nov. 12-13.

**PERRANTES AND HALL SIGN WITH VIRGINIA**

- Virginia signed standout guards London Perrantes (Woodland Hills, Calif.) and Devon Hall (Virginia Beach, Va.) to National Letters of Intent on Nov. 14.
- Perrantes is ranked No. 86 on ESPN's Top 100 recruiting list for 2013, while Hall is ranked No. 77 on Rivals.com's Prospect Ranking list.

**THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME AT JPJ**

- Virginia is 74-32 (.698) in seven seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- The Cavs are 2-1 this season at JPJ after posting a 13-3 record last season.
- Virginia is 37-16 (.698) at home under head coach Tony Bennett.

**NOTE WORTHY**

- The Cavs have shot 40 percent or less in three games of their first four games.
- Virginia has trailed at the half in three of four games.
- The Cavs held Seattle to 25.4 percent shooting in their last game.
- Opponents are shooting 34 percent from three-point range compared to 29 percent last season.

**HOLDING FOES UNDER 50**

- Virginia is 2-0 this season when holding opponents under 50 points.
- Virginia is 19-1 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era.
- Last season, Virginia set an ACC record during the shot clock era by holding 11 opponents under 50 points last season.
- The 11 games of holding opponents under 50 points were the most for the Cavaliers in a season since holding 16 opponents under 50 points in 1945-46.

**70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER**

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 26-2 when scoring at least 70 points.
- The Cavaliers are 29-41 over the past four seasons when scoring under 70 points.

**60 IS THE NEW 70**

- The Cavaliers have scored less than 60 points in three or their first four games.
- UVa is 1-2 when scoring under 60 points and was 4-8 last season when scoring under 60 points.
- Last season, Virginia was 18-2 when scoring at least 60 points.

**VIRGINIA PICKED 7TH IN THE ACC**

- Virginia was selected seventh in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked fourth and finished fourth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in each of the last four seasons.
- NC State is the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, North Carolina, Florida State, Miami, Maryland, Virginia, Clemson, Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College.

Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

**PHOTO CREDENTIALS**

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

**PRESS PARKING**

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

**INTERVIEWS**

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day, preferably longer, to arrange an interview.

**POSTGAME INTERVIEWS**

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. The first coach will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the second coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after home games.

**RADIO**

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.

**GAME SERVICES**

Information packets are available before each game at John Paul Jones Arena, and a full statistical summary and play-by-play sheets are distributed at halftime and after the game. Quotes from both coaches and two or three players from each team will be available at the conclusion of the game. A pregame meal is served for working members of the media in the press room on the event level of John Paul Jones Arena.

**TELEPHONES/WIRELESS**

The Virginia athletics media relations office will have a limited number of telephones available for postgame reporting. Should you require your own telephone for game coverage, please contact Darlene Craig or Jim Daves in the Virginia athletics media relations office. A wireless network is available at John Paul Jones Arena for visiting media. A UVa media relations representative will provide login directions.

**ABOUT THE 2012-13 SCHEDULE**

- Five of Virginia's opponents were ranked in the preseason polls (NC State, Duke, North Carolina, Wisconsin and Florida State), while another two received votes (Tennessee and Miami, Fla.).
- Six opponents earned 2012 NCAA Tournament berths, while three participated in the College Basketball Invitational and two in the National Invitation Tournament.

**EUROPEAN TOUR RECAP**

- The Cavaliers posted a 2-3 mark during their five-game European Tour this past August.
- UVa competed against teams from the Netherlands, Belgium and France. Joe Harris led Virginia in scoring in Europe, averaging 15.6 points per game, while Akil Mitchell averaged 13.4 ppg, Mike Tobey 11.2 ppg and Jontel Evans 9.6 ppg. • Evans averaged 7.8 assists per games, while Mitchell was UVa's top rebounder, pulling down 50 boards in the five games.

**SCOTT WILL BE TOUGH TO REPLACE**

- UVa will miss the 2011-12 third-team All-American Mike Scott, who is now a member of the NBA's Atlanta Hawks.
- Scott, who led Virginia in scoring and rebounding last season, was the first Cavalier to earn All-America honors since Ralph Sampson in 1983.
- Scott totaled 1,538 points and 944 rebounds in 130 career games at UVa.

**ON THE AIR THIS SEASON**

- Most all of Virginia's games this season will be broadcast either on television or online this season. The only games that will not be broadcast are the NIT Season Tip-Off consolation games on Nov. 19-20.
- All games will be broadcast on the Virginia Sports Radio Network with David Koehn (play-by-play) and Ted Jeffries (analyst) calling the action.

**RECORDS WATCH**

- Jontel Evans needs 25 assists and 25 steals to rank 10th on the UVa career lists. Joe Harris needs 33 three-pointers to rank 10th on the all-time career list.
