- Virginia is 3-1 in ACC home openers under head coach Tony Bennett.
- The Cavaliers look for their first 2-0 start in the ACC since starting 3-0 in 2009-10.
- The Cavaliers rank fifth in the nation in scoring defense at 56.2 points per game.
- Senior guard Joe Harris is day-to-day after suffering a concussion at Florida State on Jan. 4.

ALL-TIME AGAINST WAKE FOREST

- Virginia is 60-70 all-time vs. Wake Forest in the series that dates back to 1910-11.
- The Cavaliers are 1-7 in their last eight games vs. the Demon Deacons and are 37-21 against Wake Forest in Charlottesville.
- The Cavaliers dropped a 55-52 decision at Wake Forest last season.

LAST TIME VS. WAKE FOREST

- Wake Forest edged Virginia, 55-52, in Winston-Salem on Jan. 9, 2013.
- C.J. Harris scored 16 points and Travis McKie added 14 points for the Demon Deacons, who led by 14 points midway through the second half before holding off a rally by the Cavaliers in the final six minutes.
- Wake Forest won despite shooting just 26 percent after halftime and going the final 10 minutes without a field goal.
- Mike Tobey led Virginia with 14 points and Joe Harris added 13.

VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

- For the third straight week, UVa is neither ranked nor receiving votes in either national poll.
- Virginia's No. 24 preseason AP ranking marked its first since being ranked No. 11 to start the 2001-02 season.
- The Cavaliers, who were ranked for the first two weeks, returned to the rankings this season for the first time since Feb. 27, 2012, when they were No. 24 in the AP poll.

LAST TIME OUT

- UVa ended a 10-game losing streak at Florida State and 17-game skid in the state of Florida with a 62-50 win over the Seminoles on Jan. 4.
- The Cavaliers improved to 5-0 in ACC openers under head coach Tony Bennett and 26-35 all-time.
- Justin Anderson led the Cavaliers in scoring for the fourth straight game with 16 points.
- London Perrantes tallied a career-high 14 points with no turnovers.
- Akil Mitchell added 11 points and 13 rebounds for his first double double (14th career) of the season.
- Joe Harris left the game at the 17:37 mark of the first half and didn't return.
- The 'Hoos committed a season-low six turnovers and outrebounded FSU, 41-38.

- Virginia is 525-691 all-time against current ACC members (9-7 vs. Boston College, 69-52 vs. Clemson, 84-53 vs. Virginia Tech, 49-115 vs. Duke, 19-22 vs. Florida State, 35-39 vs. Georgia Tech, 73-106 vs. Maryland, 5-10 vs. Miami, 50-128 vs. UNC, 59-82 vs. NC State, 5-1 vs. Notre Dame, 7-3 vs. Pittsburgh, 1-3 vs. Syracuse and 60-70 vs. Wake Forest.)

NOTEWORTHY

- Virginia posted its first true road win of the season at Florida State (62-50).
- Virginia has shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line in five of 14 games, including a season-high 82.4 percent (14-of-17) at Tennessee (12/30/13).
- Malcolm Brogdon (34-of-38, 89.5 percent) and London Perrantes (21-of-25, 84.0 percent) are a combined 55-for-63 (87.3 percent) from the free throw line, while the rest of the team is 155-for-273 (56.8 percent).
- UVA's 64.4 percent free throw percentage is its lowest since shooting 63.3 percent in 1967-68.
- The Cavaliers have used seven different starting lineups, including four guards (London Perrantes, Joe Harris, Justin Anderson, Malcolm Brogdon) and forward Darion Atkins against Norfolk State (12/23/13).

HARRIS AND MITCHELL LEAD CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Returning All-ACC members Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell are Virginia's team leaders.
- Last season, Harris averaged a career-high 16.3 points and Mitchell added career bests with 13.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game.
- Harris ranks 23rd on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,399 points and Mitchell ranks 18th with 610 career rebounds.
- In 2013-14, Harris is averaging 10.3 points and 3.6 rebounds per game, while Mitchell is averaging 6.4 points and 6.0 rebounds.
- Harris is shooting 38.8 percent (19-of-49) from 3-point range this season.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has an 85-57 mark in five seasons at UVA and 154-90 record in eight seasons of coaching.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to the NCAA Tournament in 2012 and NIT in 2013.
- Bennett has increased UVA's win total in each of the last four seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12 and 23 in 2013-13).
- UVA's 11 ACC wins in 2012-13 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.
- Bennett is one of 23 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- He guided Washington State to a pair of NCAA Tournaments and the NIT in three seasons and was the National Coach of the Year in 2007.

EMBRACE THE PACE

- As of Jan. 6, the Cavaliers rank in the top 15 nationally in seven defensive categories: points per game (5th), rebounds per game (7th), possessions per 40 minutes (7th), points per possession (10th), field goal percentage (10th), offensive rebounding percentage (13th), and rebound percentage (14th).
- Virginia has held 12 of its 14 opponents below 50 percent shooting from the floor and opponents are shooting 37.5 percent (10th nationally) from the floor and 33.1 percent from 3-point range overall.
- Virginia has limited its opponents to a combined 53 fast break points for an average of 3.8 per game.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- Virginia has outrebounded its opponents in 11 of 14 games.
- The Cavaliers rank 14th nationally in rebound percentage at 55.3 percent and are enjoying a +8.2 average rebound margin per game.
- Akil Mitchell (6.0), Malcolm Brogdon (5.4), Mike Tobey (4.6), Justin Anderson (4.4), Anthony Gill (3.9), Joe Harris (3.6) and Darion Atkins (3.6) are each averaging three or more rebounds per game.

PAINT IT ORANGE AND BLUE

- UVA has outscored its opponents in the paint in 10 of 14 games and 384-288 overall.
- Virginia has scored 42.5 percent of its points in the paint.
- A post player has led UVA in scoring in five of 13 games (Gill 13 vs. JMU, 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU and Tobey 18 vs. Davidson).

OFF THE BENCH

- Virginia is outscoring opponents 367-201 in bench points, averaging 26.2 per game.
- A bench player has led the team in scoring in five games (Tobey 18 vs. Davidson, Gill 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU and Anderson 23 vs. Missouri State).

ANDERSON PROVING HIS WORTH

- Sophomore Justin Anderson is proving to be a valuable all-around player for Virginia.
- Anderson, who has started and led UVA in scoring in each of the last four games, is averaging 9.8 points and 4.4 rebounds per game in 24.3 minutes of action.
- He has reached double figures in scoring in eight games, including a season-high 23 points vs. Missouri State (11/30/13) and a team-leading 16 vs. Northern Iowa (12/21/13), 14 points vs. Norfolk State (12/23/13), 11 at Tennessee (12/30/13) and 16 at Florida State (1/4/14).
- Anderson also earned Corpus Christi Challenge all-tournament honors after averaging 12 points in four wins during the tournament.
- He was one of two players in NCAA Division I to record 20 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in a game last season, joining South Alabama's Mychal Ammons who also accomplished the rare feat.
- Anderson tallied 24 points, six rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in Virginia's season-ending 75-64 loss to Iowa (3/27/13), while Ammons had 21 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers vs. FIU.

MALCOLM BACK IN THE MIDDLE

- Redshirt sophomore guard Malcolm Brogdon returned to action against JMU (11/8/13) after missing the 2012-13 season and last four games of 2011-12 with a foot injury.
- Brogdon is averaging 9.6 points, 5.4 rebounds and a team-leading 1.2 steals per game.
- Brogdon is shooting 33.3 percent (16-of-48) from 3-point range and a team-leading 89.5 percent (34-of-38) from the free throw line.
- Brogdon tallied a career-high 17 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and Green Bay (12/7/13) and matched his career high with three 3-pointers against JMU (11/8/13) and Green Bay.
- Brogdon tallied a career-best four consecutive games of double figures scoring from Nov. 12-23.
- He averaged 6.7 points in 28 games as a freshman in 2011-12.

TOBEY, TOBEY, TOBEY...CAN DO IT AGAIN

- Mike Tobey has shown the ability to be Virginia's go-to man, averaging 6.6 points, 4.6 rebounds and a team-leading 1.2 blocks per game.
- He tallied a season-high 18 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and had a career-high nine rebounds vs. VCU (11/12/13).
- Tobey, who has started five games, has scored in double figures in five games.

AG MAKING SUCCESSFUL TRANSFER

- Redshirt sophomore Anthony Gill made his UVA debut against JMU (11/8/13) after sitting out last season as a transfer from South Carolina.
- Gill has led UVA in scoring in four games, including 13 vs. JMU (11/8/13), 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting against Navy (11/19/13), 13 vs. Liberty (11/23/13) and a career-high 19 vs. SMU (11/29/13).
- Gill, who earned Corpus Christi Challenge All-Tournament honors, is shooting a sizzling 65.7 percent from the floor (44-of-67) and averaging 8.4 points and 3.9 rebounds per game this season.
- Gill averaged 7.6 points and 4.7 rebounds per game as a freshman for South Carolina in 2011-12.

LONDON CALLING

- Freshman London Perrantes has made an immediate impact during his freshman campaign at UVA.
- Perrantes, who has started 10 games, is averaging 4.5 points, 2.3 rebounds and a team-leading 3.1 assists in 27.4 minutes per game.
- Perrantes had a career-high 14 points at Florida State (1/4/14).
- Perrantes, who ranks eighth in the ACC with a 2.75 assists to turnover ratio, tallied a season-high six assists against Liberty (11/23/13) and Missouri State (11/30/13).

You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the visiting coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after Coach Bennett is done with his postgame press conference.

RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena.
