FOR OPENERS

- No. 18 UVA meets its first ranked opponent in No. 19 West Virginia.
- UVA has started 8-0 for the second season under head coach Tony Bennett and first since starting 19-0 in 2014-15.
- UVA is ranked first nationally in scoring defense (50.6 ppg), fourth in turnovers per game (8.9), eighth in field goal percentage defense (36%), 10th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.59), 15th in free throw percentage (78.8%), 16th in scoring margin (19.9) and 20th in 3-point field goal percentage defense (27.6%) and fouls per game (15.3).

LAST TIME VS. THE MOUNTAINEERS

- Esa Ahmad hit a tie-breaking 3-pointer with 1:28 remaining and then-No. 25 West Virginia scored 11 of the game's final 13 points to top then-No. 6 Virginia 66-57 on Dec. 3, 2016.
- West Virginia forced Virginia into a season-high 14 turnovers.
- Jevon Carter led the Mountaineers (6-1) with 11 points and Nathan Adrian had 10.
- Darius Thompson scored 14 points to lead Virginia (7-1), while Marial Shayok added nine points and London Perrantes chipped in six points, four rebounds and seven assists, respectively.
- Isaiah Wilkins had a game-high eight rebounds.
- UVA shot 45.8 percent from the field, 31.6 percent from 3-point range and 53.8 percent from the charity stripe in its first loss.

ALL-TIME VS. WEST VIRGINIA

- Virginia is 9-9 all-time vs. West Virginia in the series that dates back to the 1915-16 season.
- UVA meets the Mountaineers for the third consecutive season.
- West Virginia defeated Virginia 66-57 last season in Charlottesville and the Cavaliers topped the Mountaineers 70-54 during the 2015 Jimmy V Classic at Madison Square Garden in New York.
- UVA is 2-3 against West Virginia in Morgantown, including wins in 1970-71 (94-91 in overtime) and 1984-85 (56-55).
- The Cavaliers are 3-2 in their last five games vs. West Virginia and 6-4 in their last 10.

AGAINST THE BIG 12 CONFERENCE

- West Virginia is the lone Big 12 Conference opponent on Virginia's 2017-18 schedule.
- UVA is 14-17 all-time against current Big 12 Conference members (0-1 vs. Baylor, 2-2 vs. Iowa State, 1-2 vs. Kansas, 2-1 vs. Oklahoma, 0-1 vs. Oklahoma State, 0-1 vs. TCU and 9-9 vs. West Virginia).
- UVA went 0-1 against the Big 12 last season and 2-0 against the Big 12 in 2015-16, including an 84-71 win over Iowa State in the NCAA Sweet 16 at the United Center in Chicago, Ill.

LAST TIME OUT

- Kyle Guy scored a game-high 21 points and No. 18 Virginia never trailed in a 75-54 victory against Lehigh on Saturday, Dec. 2.
- Isaiah Wilkins added 14 points and Devon Hall had 11 for the Cavaliers (8-0).
- Lance Tejada made five of Lehigh's 10 3-pointers and scored 22 points as the Mountain Hawks (4-4) shot just 40 percent (19-47).
- The Cavaliers led 22-16 before using a 15-3 run to gain some separation late in the first half. Hall finished the burst with a 3-pointer, making it 37-19.

UVA RANKED NO. 18 IN AP POLL

- UVA is ranked No. 18 in the latest AP poll and No. 15 in the USA Today Coaches' poll.
- The Cavaliers received votes in the first three AP polls, snapping a streak of 64 consecutive weeks in the AP rankings since Feb. 3, 2014.
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in each of the past three seasons (2014-16).

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 26-30 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era and 141-326 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- In 2016-17, Virginia was 4-6 vs. ranked opponents, including wins against then-No. 6 Louisville, then-No. 14 Notre Dame, then-No. 4 Louisville and then-No. 5 North Carolina.
- UVA is 1-29 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 196-83 (.703) mark in nine seasons at Virginia and 265-116 (.696) career mark in 12 seasons overall.
- Bennett has guided UVA to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances and has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to six consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 108-33 (.766) in non-conference action, 88-50 (.638) in ACC play and 117-24 (.830) at home under Tony Bennett.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA has limited its opponents to a school-record 50.6 points per game and has held four of its 2017-18 foes to fewer than 50 points (UNCG, Austin Peay, Vanderbilt and Wisconsin).
- UVA has held each of its eight foes to less than 50 percent shooting.
- The Cavaliers are 68-2 when limiting their opponents to fewer than 50 points under head coach Tony Bennett.
- In 2016-17, Virginia led the nation in scoring defense (56.4 ppg) for the third time under Bennett.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense four times (2008-09, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2016-17) and finished in the top-five nationally in eight of 11 seasons.
- Bennett-coached teams are 93-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 12-year coaching career.

ABOUT THE CAVALIERS

- UVA is led by tri-captains Devon Hall, Isaiah Wilkins and Jack Salt.
- The announcement of Hall, Wilkins and Salt marked the first time in Bennett's 12-year head coaching career where he officially named team captains.
- UVA has averaged 70.5 points per game (second most under Bennett) on offense, while yielding a nation-leading 50.6 ppg (lowest in school history) on defense.
- UVA has started Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, Hall, Wilkins and Salt in each of its first eight games.
- Guy leads the team in scoring at 16.6 points per game and has scored 13 or more points in seven of eight games, including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) and 21 vs. Lehigh (12/2/17).
- Hall has averaged 11.8 points on 50.8 percent shooting and a team-leading 95.2 percent (20 of 21) from the charity stripe.
- Wilkins, who has averaged 8.6 points and a team-high 6.8 rebounds, leads UVA in field goal percentage (64.3%) and has a team-high nine blocked shots and 11 steals.
- Jerome is averaging 7.1 points and a team-high 21 assists.
- Salt is averaging 3.1 points and career-best 5.0 rebounds, while graduate transfer Nigel Johnson is averaging 6.1 points after averaging 11.3 points for Rutgers last season.
- Mamadi Diakite (6.3 ppg & 4.0 rpg) and redshirt freshmen De'Andre Hunter (6.3 ppg) and Jay Huff (5.0 ppg) are contributors off the bench.
- Marco Anthony provides depth and fellow rookie Francesco Badocchi is expected to redshirt the 2017-18 season.

ZAY PAVES THE WAY

- Senior forward Isaiah Wilkins is one of the top utility players in college basketball.
- Wilkins has averaged 8.6 points, 6.8 rebounds, 1.9 assists, 1.1 blocked shots and 1.4 steals in 2017-18.

- Wilkins was named the MVP of the NIT Season Tip-Off after scoring a career-high 19 points against Rhode Island (11/24/17) and blocking four shots and scoring eight points against Vanderbilt (11/23/17).
- He tallied eight points, eight rebounds, two assists, one steal and took a team-high three charges at VCU (11/17/17).
- Wilkins added 14 points, six rebounds and three steals vs. Lehigh (12/2/17).
- Wilkins is tied for ninth at UVA with 101 career blocked shots.
- In 2016-17, the All-ACC Defensive team honoree led the team in rebounding (6.0 rpg), blocked shots (43) and steals (33), becoming the first Cavalier since Travis Watson in 2002-03 to lead the team in those three categories.
- Wilkins recorded a pair of double-doubles in 2016-17 (13 points, 11 rebounds and career-high tying five blocks vs. Louisville and 10 points, 10 rebounds and four steals vs. Miami).

HALL OF A PLAYER

- Redshirt senior Devon Hall is averaging 11.8 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.1 assists in 26.3 minutes per game.
- Hall is shooting 50.8 percent from the floor, 43.5 percent from 3-point range and 95.2 percent (20 of 21) from the free throw line.
- He scored a career-high 19 points against UNCG (11/10/17) and added 18 against Rhode Island (11/24/17).
- Hall, who has started 61 consecutive games dating back to last season, has scored in double figures in 24 career games including four games this season.
- In 2016-17, Hall averaged career highs in points (8.4), rebounds (4.4), 3-point percentage (37.2%), free throw percentage (77.6%) and minutes (27.4).
- He was named to the 2016-17 All-ACC Academic Team after earning his degree in media studies and is currently enrolled in the Professional Development Program at the Curry School of Education.

THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- Sophomore Kyle Guy is having a breakout season for Virginia.
- Guy leads Virginia in scoring (16.6 ppg), steals (1.6 spg) and 3-point percentage (45.5%).
- Guy's career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) were the most for a Virginia player since Joe Harris' 36 points vs. Duke in 2012-13.
- Guy has led the Cavaliers in scoring in five contests and has scored 13 or more points in seven games this season.
- Guy is shooting 48.3 percent (71 of 147) from 3-point range during his two-year career and has made five 3-pointers in five games.
- Guy needs 29 more 3-pointers to qualify for UVA's career 3-point percentage record set at 42.1 percent set by Keith Freeland (107 3-pointers from 2000-01).
- Guy's 7.5 points per game average in his rookie season under head coach Tony Bennett ranked higher than former UVA standouts Malcolm Brogdon (6.7 ppg) and London Perrantes (5.5 ppg).
- Guy has scored 10+ points in 18 games, including a pair of 20-point efforts last season against Pitt (3/8/17) and Grambling State (11/22/16).

THE ELECTRIC 70s

- Virginia has scored 70 or more points in five games and is 100-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett. UVA is 96-77 when scoring under 70 points under Bennett.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia is 68-2 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era (4-0 in 2017-18).
- Bennett-coached teams are 93-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA held Wisconsin under 40 points and is 19-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 155-40 (.795), including a 5-0 mark in 2017-18, in 12 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- The Cavaliers have a seven-game home winning streak dating back to Feb. 27, 2017.
- The Cavaliers finished undefeated at home (15-0) in 2015-16.
- UVA is 117-24 (.830), including an 82-9 (.901) mark the past six seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 41-4 in ACC home games over the past five seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for eight straight seasons.

ABOUT THE 2017-18 SCHEDULE

- Six of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the AP Top-25 preseason poll (Duke, Notre Dame, Miami, North Carolina, Louisville and West Virginia), while Rhode Island received votes.

- Four opponents (Clemson, Georgia Tech, Monmouth, UNC Greensboro and Syracuse) participated in the 2017 National Invitation Tournament.

VIRGINIA PICKED 6TH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish sixth in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked third and finished tied for fifth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in eight of the last nine seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Notre Dame, Miami, Louisville, Virginia, Virginia Tech, Florida State, Georgia Tech, Syracuse, Wake Forest, NC State, Clemson, Boston College and Pittsburgh.

RECORDS WATCH

- Isaiah Wilkins is tied ninth with Mike Tobey (2013-16) on UVA's career blocked shots list with 101.

CAVALIERS IN THE NBA

- Justin Anderson (Philadelphia), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn) and Mike Scott (Washington) are former Cavaliers who are playing in the NBA this season.
- Brogdon earned NBA Rookie of the Year honors for Milwaukee last season.
- Scott is in his sixth season (first with Washington) and Harris is in his fourth NBA season (second with Brooklyn), while Anderson is in his third season (second with Philadelphia).
- In addition, Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle is a Virginia alum who helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984. Carlisle gained his 700th NBA victory on Saturday, Dec. 2.
- London Perrantes (2014-17) signed a two-way contract with Cleveland and is currently playing in the G-League for the Canton Charge.
