THE SERIES

- Saturday's meeting is the first between Oregon and Virginia.
- The Ducks have never played against an Atlantic Coast Conference team during the regular season. UO fell to Wake Forest in the 1992 Independence Bowl and 2002 Seattle Bowl.
- Charlottesville is the easternmost city the Ducks have traveled to since playing Army in West Point, NY in 1970. That game resulted in a 22-22 tie with **Bobby Moore** (Ahmad Rashad) running for a 59-yard touchdown and catching a 2-point PAT from **Dan Fouts** for the game's final score.

QUICK HITS

- The Ducks' 15-game winning streak in non-neutral site away games is the longest in the nation, which is six more than the next closest - Alabama and Northern Illinois (9). The Ducks' last road loss occurred on Nov. 7, 2009, at Stanford (51-42).
- Oregon set a school record with 772 yards of total offense vs. the Colonels despite possessing the ball for just 19:46 of the contest.
- UO's 63-point margin of victory vs. Nicholls was its third highest of the modern era. The previous two came in 2010: 72 vs. New Mexico and 69 vs. Portland State. Prior to that, you have to go all the way back to 1916, when Oregon defeated Willamette, 97-0.
- Oregon's string of five consecutive 10-win seasons (2008-present) is tied for eighth-most nationally in the modern era.
- The Ducks No. 2 ranking in the AP poll is their highest in that index this early in the season. Last year, Oregon moved up to the No. 2 spot on Sept. 23.
- UO and USC are the only teams ranked in the AP Top 25 playing at least 11 schools from AQ conferences.

HEAD COACH MARK HELFRICH

Mark Helfrich is in his first season as Oregon's head coach after serving as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach from 2009-12. During that span, he was directly involved in the success of a program that constructed a 46-7 record and appeared in four consecutive BCS bowl games, including the 2011 BCS National Championship game. Helfrich began his coaching career as a graduate assistant with the Ducks in 1997 and has since accumulated seven seasons as an offensive coordinator at two BCS schools and 15 years coaching quarterbacks. He was named Oregon's offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach on April 30, 2009 following three seasons in the same capacity at the University of Colorado (2006-08), five years as quarterbacks coach at Arizona State (2001-05) which included his final three campaigns in Tempe, Ariz., as passing game coordinator, and three seasons as quarterbacks coach at Boise State (1998-2000). Along the way, Helfrich was named National Quarterbacks Coach of the Year in 2010 and 2012 by FootballScoop, in addition to being one of three finalists as its national offensive coordinator of the year honor. Over the course of his last 13 seasons, Helfrich has played a role with offenses that have ranked among the nation's top-eight teams in scoring offense six times, the top six in rushing on four occasions, the top five in total offense four times as well as the top five in passing twice. As Oregon's OC he helped orchestrate attacks that were responsible for the top three total offense outputs in school history (2010-12) - including a school-record 7,319 yards in 2011 - as well as the only teams to account for more than 600 points in each of the last three seasons. Helfrich is the first native Oregonian to head the university's football program since John Warren in 1942.

RETURN MEN

The 2013 Oregon Ducks return 56 letterwinners, including 16 starters - nine on offense and seven on defense - from last season. By contrast, the 2012 squad, which finished the season ranked No. 2 nationally, had 52 returning lettermen and 12 starters, including only five on offense.

FIRST TIMERS

Four true freshmen saw action in the season-opener vs. Nicholls: OL **Cameron Hunt**, TE **Johnny Mundt**, DE **Torrodney Prevot** and K **Matt Wogan**.

SUPER MARIOTA

As the Ducks begin their quest for a fifth straight BCS bowl game appearance all eyes will be on second-year starting quarterback **Marcus Mariota**. The redshirt sophomore from Honolulu will attempt to follow up a campaign that saw him set the Pac-12 freshman record for touchdown passes (32) and lead the conference in passing efficiency (seventh nationally) en route to Pac-12 Offensive Freshman of the Year and All-Pac-12 first team QB honors. Considered by many national outlets as a Heisman Trophy candidate, Mariota is on four prestigious watch lists: Davey O'Brien Award (national quarterback award), Maxwell Award (most outstanding player), Walter Camp Award (most outstanding player) and Manning Award (top quarterback honor, including bowl game).

LIGHTNING STRIKES

Of Oregon's nine drives resulting in touchdowns this season, eight (89%) have lasted less than two minutes.

THOMAS CARRIES THE LOAD

JR RB **De'Anthony Thomas** had a team and career-high 18 carries in the opener vs. Nicholls (128 yards) - his debut as UO's featured running back. Of those 18 totes, nine were between the tackles.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Since 2000, Oregon is 35-6 (.854) in regular season, out-of-conference contests, earning notable victories against the likes of Oklahoma, Wisconsin and Michigan (x2). During that stretch, the Ducks are 3-1 against the SEC, 5-2 vs. the Big Ten, 1-1 vs. the Big 12, 4-0 against the Mountain West, 12-2 vs. the WAC, 2-0 against Conference USA and 7-0 vs. FCS sides.

COACHING CONTINUITY

An often overlooked facet of Oregon's run of success has been the continuity of its coaching staff. First-year head coach **Mark Helfrich** is in his fifth season on staff, but he is supported by several assistants who have served the last three UO head coaches. Running backs coach **Gary Campbell** is in his 31st year on the Oregon staff, which is the longest tenure of any Oregon assistant football coach in school history. In addition, offensive line coach and running game coordinator **Steve Greatwood** enters his 27th season at UO, linebackers coach **Don Pellum** is in his 21st campaign, while defensive coordinator **Nick Aliotti** has spent 21 full seasons at Oregon over three separate stints.

HOUSE OF LOUD

With a standing room only crowd of 57,769 at Autzen Stadium on Aug. 31 vs. Nicholls, the Ducks ran the nation's fourth-longest sellout streak to 90 consecutive games (cap. 54,000), dating to 1999.

ROAD WARRIORS

Oregon has won 15 straight road games, which leads the country. Alabama and Northern Illinois are tied for second with nine. The Ducks' last road loss occurred on Nov. 7, 2009, at Stanford (51-42) – the only conference road setback in the past four seasons.

RECORD RUNNERS

The Ducks' current roster features three players who have etched their names on a prestigious rushing list. SO QB **Marcus Mariota**, JR RB **De'Anthony Thomas** and SR WR **Josh Huff** own three of the longest runs in school history. Thomas' 91-yard touchdown run in the 2012 Rose Bowl Game is the second-longest at Oregon, Mariota ranks fifth with his 86-yard score at ASU - the longest rush in the Pac-12 during the 2012 season and Huff is tied for sixth with an 85-yard TD vs. Arizona in 2010.

EUGENE, Ore. (AP) - Marcus Mariota threw a touchdown pass and ran for two additional scores and the No. 3 Oregon Ducks made easy work of lower-

tier Nicholls with a 66-3 victory in the season opener on Saturday.

Mariota, who set an Oregon record with 38 touchdowns last season as a redshirt freshman, completed 12 of 21 passes for 234 yards before sitting after the third quarter when the Ducks had built a 45-3 lead.

Mariota also ran for 113 yards for his second career game with more than 100 yards rushing.

De'Anthony Thomas ran for 128 yards and two more touchdowns for Oregon in the debut of new head coach Mark Helfrich.

Nicholls' score came on Andrew Dolan's 35-yard field goal in the second quarter.

Quarterback Beaux Hebert made his first start for the Colonels, but was hit hard by Oregon cornerback Terrance Mitchell late in the first quarter and left the game. Mitchell was flagged for targeting and ejected.

The Ducks were only barely challenged by Nicholls, a Southland Conference program from Louisiana which has won just one game in each of the past two seasons. The Colonels had never played a team ranked in the top five.

On its first drive Oregon scored on a 4-yard run by Thomas. On its next, Mariota found Bralon Addison with a 27-yard scoring pass to make it 14-0.

Thomas added a 22-yard scoring run with 6:28 left in the first quarter and Alejandro Maldonado kicked a 29-yard field goal to make it 24-0.

Mitchell was ejected when he hit Hebert, who was sliding on the turf, and the replay showed helmet-to-helmet contact.

Under a new NCAA rule this season, players who "target" and contact defenseless players will receive a 15-yard penalty and be ejected.

Hebert, the son of former New Orleans Saints quarterback Bobby Hebert, did not return after the hit and was replaced by junior Kalen Henderson, a transfer from Tulsa.

Hebert, making his first career start, completed four of 10 passes for 42 yards before he left the game.

Mariota ran for a pair of touchdowns, the first from 12 yards and the second from 46, to put the Ducks up 38-3 at the half.

The sophomore quarterback, who was on several Heisman watch lists going into the season, was selected to the Pac-12 first team last season and earned conference Freshman of the Year honors.

Byron Marshall ran for a 49-yard touchdown for the only third-quarter score, and Oregon blocked Dolan's 42-yard field-goal attempt early in the fourth.

Colt Lyerla scored on a 3-yard run and quarterback Jeff Lockie - who took over for Mariota in the fourth quarter - added an 8-yard TD run before he was subbed out for quarterback Jake Rodrigues, who found Chance Allen in the end zone with a 23-yard pass for the final margin.

Thomas also sat out the final quarter. Last season, he ran for 701 yards and 11 touchdowns and caught 45 passes for 445 yards and five more scores. He also scored on a kickoff return and a punt return, becoming the first Oregon player in 47 years with a touchdown four different ways.

Marshall finished with 124 yards rushing, giving Oregon its first game to feature three players with more than 100 yards rushing.
