FOR OPENERS

- Virginia has won 11 straight games and meets Miami for the lone regular-season game between the teams.
- Virginia ranks No. 1 nationally in scoring defense at 55.3 ppg.
- Virginia's 14-1 ACC record is a program-best, surpassing the 13-1 league record in 1980-81.
- UVa's 23-5 record is its best through 28 games since 1982-83 (25-3).
- As of Feb. 25, Virginia is first in the ACC at 14-1 and Miami is 10th at 5-9.

ALL-TIME AGAINST MIAMI

- Virginia is 5-10 all-time vs. Miami in the series that dates back to 1965-66.
- The Cavaliers meet the Hurricanes for the first time since losing 54-50 to then-No. 2 Miami in Coral Gables on Feb. 19, 2013.
- The Cavaliers are 4-3, including a three-game winning streak, against the Hurricanes in Charlottesville.
- UVa is 3-1 against Miami at John Paul Jones Arena.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 2-4 all-time against Miami.

A WIN VS. MIAMI WOULD...

- Extend Virginia's school-record ACC win total to 15 games.
- Clinch a top-two seed in the ACC Tournament.
- Give Virginia its first 12-game ACC winning streak since 1981-82.
- Give Virginia its first 12-game winning streak since 2011-12.
- Give Tony Bennett his 100th career win at Virginia.
- Set a school record of 17 straight home ACC wins (16 straight home wins from 1980-82).
- Give Virginia 24 wins for the first time since winning 25 in 1994-95.
- Give Virginia a record of 19 games above .500 for the first time since 1982-83.
- Increase UVa's win total in each of the last five seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12 and 23 in 2012-13).

MORE 2013-14 TEAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Virginia has clinched a top-four seed and a bye until the quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament.
- Virginia has clinched its third consecutive winning season (14-1, 11-7, 9-7) in ACC play for the first time since 1981-83.
- Virginia has secured its third straight 20-win season for the first time since 1991-93.
- Virginia has set a school record with 10 ACC wins by 10 or more points.
- With 14 ACC wins, Virginia has become the second ACC school to improve its ACC record in five consecutive seasons (Georgia Tech under Bobby Cremins from 1982-86).
- Virginia has a school-record seven ACC road wins.

LAST TIME VS. THE HURRICANES

- Reggie Johnson made a tie-breaking layup with 5.7 seconds left, to lift then-No. 2 Miami to a 54-50 win over Virginia on Feb. 19, 2013.
- Durand Scott added two clinching free throws with four seconds to go to give the Hurricanes their 14th consecutive victory.
- The Cavaliers led only once, at 29-28, but Evan Nolte tied the game at 50 by sinking a 3-pointer with 15 seconds left.
- Miami held the Cavaliers to 39-percent shooting and blocked seven shots.
- Shane Larkin had 11 points and six assists, and Rion Brown added 10 points off the bench for Miami.
- Joe Harris had 16 points and seven rebounds, and Akil Mitchell added six points and eight rebounds for UVa.

LAST TIME OUT

- Akil Mitchell and Anthony Gill both had 15 points as Virginia used a 30-2 second-half run to defeat Notre Dame 70-49 Saturday.
- UVa held a 48-43 lead when Justin Anderson blocked Zach Augustine's dunk attempt, sending the Cavaliers on a fast break that Gill finished with a two-hand dunk.
- Pat Connaughton led the Fighting Irish with 11 points.
- Brogdon added 13 points, seven rebounds and six assists for UVa, which shot a season-high 63.6 percent (28-of-44) from the field.

VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

- Virginia is ranked No. 12 in the latest AP poll, marking its highest ranking since a No. 10 ranking on Feb. 4, 2002.
- No. 12/11 UVa is ranked for the fourth straight week after not being ranked for 11 straight weeks.

- Virginia's No. 24 preseason AP ranking marked its first since being ranked No. 11 to start the 2001-02 season.
- The Cavaliers returned to the rankings this season for the first time since Feb. 27, 2012.

EMBRACE THE PACE

- As of Feb. 24, the Cavaliers rank in the top 10 nationally in seven defensive categories: points per game (1st), rebounds per game (3rd), points per possession (6th), true shooting percentage (7th), field goal percentage (8th), offensive rebound percentage (8th) and offensive rebounds per game (9th).
- Virginia has held 26 of its 28 opponents below 50 percent shooting from the floor and opponents are shooting 38.6 percent (8th nationally) from the floor and 32.8 percent from 3-point range overall.
- The Cavaliers have held 15 straight opponents and 31 straight ACC opponents under 50 percent shooting from the field.
- Virginia has limited its opponents to a combined 91 fast break points for an average of 3.3 per game.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 99-58 mark in five seasons at UVA and 168-91 record in eight seasons of coaching.
- Bennett has led Virginia to three consecutive winning seasons in ACC play for the first time since 1981-83.
- Under Bennett, Virginia has become the second ACC school to improve its ACC record in five consecutive seasons.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to the NCAA Tournament in 2012 and NIT in 2013.
- Bennett has increased UVA's win total in each of the last four seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12 and 23 in 2013-13).
- He has guided Virginia to 11 or more ACC wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time since back-to-back 12 ACC-win seasons in 1982-83.
- Bennett guided Washington State to a pair of NCAA Tournaments and the NIT in three seasons and was the National Coach of the Year in 2007.
- Bennett is 59-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his eight-year collegiate coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have finished in the top five nationally in scoring defense in four of seven seasons (1st in 2008-09; second in 2007-08 and 2011-12, and fifth in 2012-13). UVA ranks first this season at 55.2 points per game.
- Bennett is one of 23 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

HARRIS AND MITCHELL LEAD CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Returning All-ACC members Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell are Virginia's team leaders.
- Last season, Harris averaged a career-high 16.3 points and Mitchell added career bests with 13.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game.
- Harris is 14th on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,577 points and Mitchell ranks 11th with 730 career rebounds.
- In 2013-14 with a more balanced scoring attack, Harris is averaging 11.5 points, while Mitchell is averaging 7.2 points and 6.8 rebounds.
- In 15 ACC games, Harris ranks third in 3-point field goal percentage (44.3 percent) and tied for sixth in made 3-pointers per game (2.33), while Mitchell is second in defensive rebounds (5.8 per game) and fourth in rebounding (8.0 per game).

TEAM NOTES

- Virginia is 17-1 when leading at the half and 23-3 when opponents shoot less than 50 percent from the field.
- The Cavaliers lead the ACC in scoring defense (54.0 ppg), field goal percentage (45.7%), field goal percentage defense (39.1%), rebounding defense (29.2), defensive rebound percentage (73.9%), turnover margin (+3.53) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.63) during league play.
- UVA is fifth in the ACC in scoring offense at 66.9 points per game, marking its highest ACC average under Tony Bennett (63.9 ppg in 2012-13).
- Virginia is averaging 8.4 turnovers during league play compared to 12.9 during non-conference action
- UVA has committed nine or fewer turnovers in 11 of their last 13 games.

- Virginia has shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line in 11 of 28 games and its 65.3 percent free throw percentage is its lowest since shooting 65.3 percent in 1997-98.
- The Cavaliers are 18-1 with their current starting lineup of London Perrantes, Malcolm Brogdon, Joe Harris, Akil Mitchell and Mike Tobey.
- Virginia captured the Corpus Christi Challenge earlier this season with wins over Liberty, Hampton, SMU and Missouri State.

PLAYER NOTES

- Joe Harris leads all active ACC players with 245 career 3-pointers.
- Harris (1,577 career points) became the 17th Cavalier to reach 1,500 career points with 11 at Pittsburgh (2/2/14).
- Malcolm Brogdon's 12.3 scoring average leads the team and would be the lowest UVA team scoring leader in 61 seasons of ACC action.
- Brogdon (79-of-89, 88.8 percent) and London Perrantes (31-of-38, 81.6 percent) are a combined 110-of-127 (86.6 percent) from the free throw line, while the rest of the team is 286-for-479 (59.7 percent).
- Brogdon leads the ACC in free throw percentage (87.7 percent) and Perrantes leads the ACC with in assist-to-turnover ratio (5.17) in league action.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- Virginia has outrebounded its opponents in 21 of 28 games and is 18-3 when outrebounding its opponent.
- The Cavaliers rank 13th nationally in rebound percentage at 54.7 percent and have a +6.8 average rebound margin per game.
- Akil Mitchell (6.9), Malcolm Brogdon (5.7), Mike Tobey (4.1), Anthony Gill (3.9), Justin Anderson (3.5) and Joe Harris (3.0) are each averaging three or more rebounds per game.

PAINT IT ORANGE AND BLUE

- UVA has outscored its opponents in the paint in 23 of 28 games.
- Virginia, which is outscoring its opponents 814-584 in the paint, has scored 44.1 percent of its points in the paint.
- A post player has led UVA in scoring in seven of 28 games (Gill 13 vs. JMU, 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty, 19 vs. SMU and 15 vs. Notre Dame; Tobey 18 vs. Davidson and 16 at NC State; Mitchell 15 vs. Notre Dame).

OFF THE BENCH

- Virginia is outscoring opponents 651-449 in bench points, averaging 23.3 per game.
- A bench player has led the team in scoring in six games (Tobey 18 vs. Davidson, Gill 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty, 19 vs. SMU and 15 vs. Notre Dame, and Anderson 23 vs. Missouri State and 16 at Florida State).

MALCOLM BACK IN THE MIDDLE

- Redshirt sophomore guard Malcolm Brogdon returned to action against JMU (11/8/13) after missing the 2012-13 season and the last four games of 2011-12 with a foot injury.
- Brogdon is averaging team highs in points (12.3 ppg), steals (1.3 spg) and free throw percentage (88.8%), and is second in rebounding (5.7 rpg) and 3-point field goal percentage (39.8%).
- Brogdon has tallied a career-best 15 consecutive games of double figures scoring from Jan. 4-Feb. 22.

2013-14 Opponents in Bold

- Brogdon tallied career highs in points (18) and 3-pointers (4) vs. Virginia Tech (1/25/14).
- He tallied his first career double-double with 17 points, 11 rebounds (career high) and seven assists (career high) vs. Boston College (2/5/14).
- Brogdon had his second career double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds (career high) at Georgia Tech (2/8/14).
- In 15 ACC games, Brogdon ranks first in free throw percentage (87.7%), fourth in field goal percentage (45.5%), 11th in defensive rebounds (4.73 per game), 11th in scoring (14.7 ppg) and tied for 20th in rebounding (6.0 rpg).
- He averaged 6.7 points in 28 games as a freshman in 2011-12.

LONDON CALLING

- Freshman London Perrantes has made an immediate impact during his freshman campaign at UVA.
- Perrantes (103 assists) is the fourth Cavalier freshman to record 100 assists in a season (Cory Alexander, Jeff Jones and Sean Singletary).
- Perrantes, who has started 24 games, is averaging 4.4 points, 2.2 rebounds and a team-leading 3.7 assists per game.
- Perrantes had a career-high 14 points at Florida State (1/4/14), 11 points at Virginia Tech (2/18/14) and career-best nine assists vs. North Carolina (1/20/14).
- Perrantes, who ranks third in the ACC in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.68), has tallied five or more assists in 10 games.
- He leads the ACC action in assist-to-turnover ratio (5.17) and ranks sixth in assists (4.13 apg).

ANDERSON PROVING HIS WORTH AS A SIXTH MAN

- Justin Anderson, who hit a pair of key 3-pointers down the stretch at Virginia Tech, is a valuable sixth man for UVA.
- Anderson, who has led UVA in scoring in five games, is averaging 8.9 points and 3.5 rebounds per game.
- He reached double figures in six consecutive games (Dec. 7-Jan. 8) and has led the team in scoring in five games (23 points vs. Missouri State, 16 vs. Northern Iowa, 14 points vs. Norfolk State, 11 at Tennessee and 16 at Florida State).
- Anderson also earned Corpus Christi Challenge all-tournament honors after averaging 12 points in four wins during the tournament.
- He was one of two players in NCAA Division I to record 20 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in a game last season, joining South Alabama's Mychal Ammons who also accomplished the rare feat.

TOBEY, TOBEY, TOBEY...CAN DO IT AGAIN

- Mike Tobey has shown the ability to be Virginia's go-to man, averaging 6.8 points, 4.1 rebounds and a team-leading 1.3 blocks per game.



PRESS CREDENTIALS

We would like to receive credential requests no later than seven (7) days prior to the game. Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the visiting coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after Coach Bennett is done with his postgame press conference.

RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.

GAME SERVICES

Information packets are available before each game at John Paul Jones Arena, and a full statistical summary and play-by-play sheets are distributed at halftime and after the game. Quotes from both coaches and two or three players from each team will be available at the conclusion of the game. A pregame meal is served for working members of the media in the press room on the event level of John Paul Jones Arena.
