FOR OPENERS

- Virginia (18-0) is off to its best start since the 1980-81 season when that team led by legendary center Ralph Sampson started 23-0.
- UVA has started 6-0 in ACC play for the first time since the 1980-81 team started 12-0.
- UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense at 49.3 points per game.
- Virginia is first in the ACC at 6-0, while Virginia Tech is tied for 13th at 0-5.
- The Cavaliers have won 14 of their 18 games by 11 or more points.

COMMONWEALTH CLASH

- The Virginia-Virginia Tech game is part of the Virginia 529 Commonwealth Clash, which is a head-to-head, points-based competition between the athletic teams of the Hoos and Hokies.
- The competition includes the 21 sports in which the two schools compete against each other, plus one fan-decided point.
- Today's game is sponsored by Virginia529, the official college savings plan of University of Virginia Athletics.
- The UVA-VT game is worth a half point in the Virginia529 Commonwealth Clash.
- The score for the Clash is now Virginia 5.0 and Virginia Tech 1.5.

ALL-TIME AGAINST VIRGINIA TECH

- Virginia is 86-53 all-time vs. Virginia Tech in the series that dates back to 1914-15.
- The Cavaliers have won five straight games against Virginia Tech, including a pair of wins last season, and seven of the last eight contests in the series.
- The Cavaliers are 19-28, including a 6-14 mark at Cassell Coliseum, against the Hokies in Blacksburg.
- Virginia posted a 65-45 win in Charlottesville and 57-53 win in Blacksburg against the Hokies last season.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 7-3 all-time vs. Virginia Tech.

LAST TIME OUT

- Malcolm Brogdon led a balanced attack with 13 points as Virginia defeated Georgia Tech 57-28 in an historic win on Jan. 22.
- Georgia Tech's 28 points marked the lowest point total in an ACC regular-season game ever and marked the fewest allowed by Virginia to an ACC opponent in the shot clock era.
- Virginia extended its JPJ record home-winning streak to 21 games.
- The Cavaliers outrebounded Georgia Tech 36-33 and shut out the Yellow Jackets from 3-point range (0-12).

LAST TIME VS. VIRGINIA TECH

- Justin Anderson and Joe Harris made consecutive 3-pointers to cap Virginia's rally from an 11-point, second-half deficit in a 57-53 victory over Virginia Tech on Feb. 18, 2014.
- The Cavaliers outscored the Hokies 23-6 after falling behind 40-29 with just more than 14 minutes remaining.
- Malcolm Brogdon led Virginia with 12 points and London Perrantes had 11.
- The Hokies got 13 points each from Joey van Zegeren and Devin Wilson.

AGAINST THE COMMONWEALTH

- Since the 1999-2000 season, Virginia has a 54-13 record against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- UVA is 20-4 in its last 24 games vs. in-state opponents.
- Virginia is 3-0 vs. teams from Virginia this season, defeating James Madison, Norfolk State and VCU.

UVA RANKED NO. 2 FOR SECOND STRAIGHT WEEK

- UVA is ranked No. 2 in the AP poll for the second straight week.
- Prior to this year, the Cavaliers achieved their last No. 2 ranking on March 8, 1983.
- Virginia has delivered three of the nine home losses by teams currently ranked in the top 16 of this week's AP poll (Notre Dame, Maryland, VCU).
- The Cavaliers have been ranked in the top 10 for the first 11 weeks of the season for the first time since 1982-83.
- The No. 9 AP preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.
- UVA is one of three teams (Duke and Arizona) that have been ranked in the top 10 for 14 straight weeks dating back to last season.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Virginia has won its first six true road games of a season for the first time since 1980-81 (won first 10 road games).
- The Cavaliers are 8-0 away from home this season.
- Virginia is 10-2 in ACC road games over the past two seasons, the most road wins in the conference over that period.
- The Cavaliers have three true road wins over teams currently ranked in the AP poll, most in the nation.
- Virginia's six-game road winning streak is tied with Gonzaga for the longest active streak nationally.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Sixth-year head coach Tony Bennett sports a 124-60 mark at Virginia and 193-93 mark in nine seasons overall.
- Bennett was named 2014 ACC Coach of the Year after guiding the Cavaliers to their first ACC Tournament championship since 1976.
- In 2013-14, he guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has guided the Cavaliers to three consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012 and 2014 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett has increased UVA's win total in each of the last five seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12, 23 in 2013-13 and 30 in 2013-14).
- Bennett-coached teams are 68-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his nine-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have finished in the top five nationally in scoring defense in five of eight seasons (first in 2008-09 and 2013-14, second in 2007-08 and 2011-12, and fifth in 2012-13).
- Bennett is one of 24 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

EMBRACE THE PACE

- Virginia is averaging 69.3 points and yielding a nation-leading 49.3 points, marking its best averages under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVA has shot 48 percent from the field and 39.9 percent from 3-point range (18th nationally), while limiting its opponents to 33.6 percent from the field (2nd nationally) and 30.1 percent from 3-point range.
- As of Jan. 23, the Cavaliers rank in the top five nationally in 13 defensive categories: points per game (1st), assists per game (2nd), field goal percentage (2nd), possessions per 40 minutes (2nd), rebounds per game (2nd), true shooting percentage (2nd), defensive rebounds per game (4th), effective shooting percentage (4th), points per possession (4th), turnovers per game (5th), offensive rebound percentage (7th), rebound percentage (8th) and fouls per game (9th).
- As of Jan. 23, the Cavaliers rank in the top 10 nationally in four offensive categories: assist-to-turnover ratio (6th), defensive rebound percentage (7th), rebound percentage (9th) and defensive rebounds per game (10th).
- The Cavaliers have held 42 straight opponents and 43 straight ACC opponents under 50 percent shooting from the field.
- UVA has limited its opponents to 28 fast break points.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- Virginia has held their opponents scoreless for five or more minutes 18 times.
- Virginia held Tennessee State scoreless for 10:23 and Cleveland State scoreless for 10:03 during the non-conference season.
- Virginia has also limited its opponents without a field goal for eight or more minutes seven times, highlighted by Harvard for 19:53 on Dec. 21.

ALL-TIME VS. ACC OPPONENTS

- Virginia is 481-589 all-time against current ACC members (11-7 vs. Boston College, 71-52 vs. Clemson, 86-53 vs. Virginia Tech, 50-116 vs. Duke, 20-22 vs. Florida State, 38-39 vs. Georgia Tech, 5-3 vs. Louisville, 7-10 vs. Miami, 51-128 vs. UNC, 61-82 vs. NC State, 8-1 vs. Notre Dame, 9-3 vs. Pittsburgh, 3-3 vs. Syracuse and 61-70 vs. Wake Forest).

TWENTY-SOMETHINGS:

- NCAA Division I teams have been held under 30 points seven times this season, and Virginia is responsible for three of them (Rutgers-26, Harvard-27, Georgia Tech-28).
- Virginia is the first Division I team to hold multiple opponents under 30 in a season since Bucknell did it twice in 2003-04.
- The last Division I team to hold three opponents under 30 in a season was NC State in 1996-97 (Winthrop, Arkansas-Pine Bluff, Texas-Pan American).
- The last time Virginia held at least three opponents under 30 points in a season was in 1945-46 (five times).
- Georgia Tech's 28 points on Jan. 22 marked the lowest point total ever in an ACC regular season game.

BROGDON LEADS THE CAVALIERS

- Preseason All-ACC performer Malcolm Brogdon, who has led UVA in scoring in each of the last three games, ranks second on the team at 13.6 points per game.
- Brogdon had a season-high 20 points against Boston College and La Salle
- He is tied for third in the ACC in free throw percentage (84.3%).
- Brogdon has 10 or more points in 14 games.
- In 2013-14, Brogdon averaged a career-high 12.7 points and 5.4 rebounds en route to All-ACC honors.
- Brogdon scored a career-best 23 points in the 2014 ACC Tournament final win against Duke.

SIXTH MAN NO MORE

- 2014 ACC Sixth Man of the Year Justin Anderson has started and led the team in scoring in nine games this season.
- He was named to midseason watch lists for the the Wooden Award and USBWA Oscar Robertson Trophy.
- Anderson was named the USBWA's Oscar Robertson National Player of the Week and ACC Co-Player of the Week on Dec. 9 after averaging 18.5 points and seven rebounds in wins at Maryland and VCU.
- Anderson tallied a season-high 21 points at VCU and had 20 against Tennessee State.
- He is averaging career highs in points (14.1), rebounds (4.3), field goal percentage (50.3%), 3-point percentage (52.6%) and minutes (29.4).

PRESS CREDENTIALS

Media members interested in obtaining season or game credentials should contact Erich Bacher via email at bacher@virginia.edu, office phone (434) 982-5530 or cell phone (720) 318-5538. We would like to receive credential requests no later than seven (7) days prior to the game. Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the visiting coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after Coach Bennett is done with his postgame press conference.

RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.

GAME SERVICES

Information packets are available before each game at John Paul Jones Arena, and a full statistical summary and play-by-play sheets are distributed at halftime and after the game.
