FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets Syracuse in the lone meeting between the teams in 2015-16.
- UVA has a two-game winning streak against the Orange.
- Virginia is 29-1 in ACC home games over the past four seasons.
- As of Jan. 21, UVA is tied for 8th in the ACC at 3-3 and Syracuse is 10th at 3-4.
- As of Jan. 21, UVA ranks 10th nationally in scoring defense (61.2 ppg) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.61), 12th in field goal percentage (49.4%), 16th in 3-point field goal percentage (40.2%) and 19th in free throw percentage (75.2%).

ALL-TIME AGAINST SYRACUSE

- UVA is 3-3 all-time, including a 2-0 mark in ACC play, vs. Syracuse in the series that dates back to 1983-84.
- Virginia meets Syracuse in Charlottesville for the first time since then-No. 12 UVA defeated then-No. 4 Syracuse 75-56 on March 1, 2014. The win secured UVA's first outright ACC regular-season title since 1980-81.
- In 2014-15, then-No. 2 Virginia defeated Syracuse 59-47 at the Carrier Dome, which also clinched the ACC regular-season title.
- UVA is 1-1 against the Orange in Charlottesville, including a 70-68 loss on Dec. 5, 2007.
- The Cavaliers are 1-1 against the Orange in Syracuse and 1-1 at neutral sites.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 2-0 all-time against Syracuse.
- Malcolm Brogdon is Virginia's current career leading scorer against Syracuse, averaging 14.5 points in two career games.
- Anthony Gill is averaging 10.5 points and 10 rebounds in two games against Syracuse.
- Mike Tobey is averaging 10.5 points and eight rebounds in two games against Syracuse, while London Perrantes has chipped in eight points and 8.5 assists per game.

SECONDS ANYONE?

- Virginia has played its best basketball during the second half of games this season.
- The Cavaliers have scored more points in the second half than the first half in 16 of 18 games.
- UVA is averaging 40.8 points in the second half and 31.6 points in the first stanza.
- UVA is shooting 55.3 percent on its second-half shots, including 49.6 percent from 3-point range, but only 43.8 percent on its first-half shots and 29.8 percent from 3-point range.

LAST TIME VS. SYRACUSE

- Then-No. 2 Virginia overcame a sluggish start to defeat Syracuse 59-47 on March 2, 2015 at the Carrier Dome.
- The Cavaliers scored their first points at 11:46 and rallied to take a 23-20 halftime lead.
- Anthony Gill had game highs in points (17) and rebounds (9) and London Perrantes had his first career double-double with 10 points and 10 assists.
- Malcolm Brogdon added 10 points and Mike Tobey contributed 10 points and eight rebounds off the bench.
- Virginia dominated Syracuse with a 42-20 rebounding advantage.
- The Cavaliers shot 46.2 percent from the floor and limited the Orange to 38.3 percent, including 4-19 from 3-point range.

LAST TIME OUT

- Malcolm Brogdon tallied 20 points to lead No. 13 Virginia to a 69-62 win over Clemson on Jan. 19.
- Anthony Gill added 12 points and Devon Hall added 11 points in his second straight start for UVA.
- Virginia shot 54.3 percent from the field (25-46) and out-rebounded Clemson 32-21 in Tony Bennett's 150th win at UVA.
- Jaron Blossomgame had a game-high 23 points for the Tigers and Landry Nnoko added 15.

• VIRGINIA RANKED NO. 13 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 13 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls.
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in six consecutive polls from Nov. 30, 2015 to Jan. 4, 2016.
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in 25 consecutive AP polls from March 3, 2014 to Nov. 16, 2015, its longest span since 49 straight from 1980-83.
- The Cavaliers' No. 6 preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.
- Virginia has been ranked in the preseason top-10 in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1981-82 and 1982-83.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett sports a 150-68 mark in seven seasons at Virginia and 219-101 career mark in 10 seasons overall.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett was also named ACC Coach of the Year, NABC District 2 Coach of the Year and USBWA District 3 Coach of the Year for the second consecutive year.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to four consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014 and 2015, and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett-coached teams are 76-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 10-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top five nationally in six of nine seasons.
- Bennett is one of 26 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 79-24 (.767) in non-conference action and 94-20 (.825) at home under Tony Bennett.

VIRGINIA BASKETBALL GETTING OFFENSIVE

- Virginia is averaging 72.9 points per game, its most since 76.8 ppg in 2007-08.
- As of Jan. 21, UVA ranks Nos. 7 and 8 in the KenPom.com adjusted offensive and overall efficiency ratings, respectively.
- UVA is shooting 49.4 percent from the field (best since 49.6% in 1986-87), 40.2 percent from 3-point range (best in school history) and 75.2 percent from the free throw line (best since 76.2% in 1978-79).
- Virginia has scored 80 or more points in six games, its most since 11 in 2007-08.
- UVA's 86 points against Villanova were its most scored against a top-25 opponent since tallying 87 in a road win at Minnesota in 2010-11.
- UVA has shot 55 percent or better in six games in 2015-16 after achieving the feat three times in 34 games in 2014-15 and four times in 37 games in 2013-14.
- The Cavaliers scored 82 or more points in three straight games (Nov. 19-22 at Charleston Classic) for the first time since the first three games of the 2001-02 season.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better from 3-point range in six games.

'HOO ARE THESE WAHOOS?

- All-America candidate Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA in scoring for the third consecutive season at a career-best 16.8 points per game, while Anthony Gill is averaging a career-high 14.8 points.
- Brogdon has eight 20-point efforts, including a career-high 28 at George Washington, marking the most by a UVA player in a season since Joe Harris had nine 20-point games in 2012-13.
- Gill has reached double figures in scoring in all 18 games in 2015-16

- London Perrantes is averaging career highs in points (11.7), field goal percentage (47.6%) and 3-point field goal percentage (55.6%).
- UVA has out-rebounded its opponents in 11 of its 14 wins.
- Eight players have each scored 11 or more points in a game.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 132-36 (.786) in 10 seasons, including a 9-0 mark in 2015-16, at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA extended its home-winning streak to 14 games with its win over Clemson.
- UVA is 94-20 (.825), including a 59-5 (.922) mark the past four seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 29-1 in ACC home games over the past four seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for six straight seasons.
- UVA's 21-game home winning streak from Dec. 21, 2013-Jan. 22, 2015 set a JPJ record.

ALL-AMERICAN BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Preseason co-ACC Player of the Year Malcolm Brogdon is aiming to become the first UVA player since Sean Singletary (2006-08) to lead UVA in scoring for three straight seasons.
- Brogdon's 16.8 scoring average is the highest for UVA since Mike Scott's 18.0 ppg in 2011-12.
- Brogdon was named a preseason All-American by The Sporting News (1st team), Blue Ribbon Yearbook (1st team), CBSsports.com (2nd team), NBCsports.com (2nd team), Bleacher Report (2nd team), USA Today (3rd team) and Collegelinsider.com.
- Brogdon and Gonzaga's Kyle Wiltjer are the first consensus All-Americans to return as fifth-year seniors since Vanderbilt's Billy McCaffrey in 1993-94.
- In 2014-15, Brogdon averaged 14.0 points and 3.9 rebounds en route to All-America second-team and All-ACC first-team accolades.
- The two-time All-ACC performer, who was a John Wooden Award finalist last season, ranks 21st on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,436 points in 117 career games (12.3 career ppg).
- Brogdon ranks second on UVA's career free-throw percentage list at 85.9% (342-for-398).
- Brogdon is a candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award and Wooden Citizen Cup Award.
- Brogdon helped Team USA to a bronze medal at the 2015 Pan American Games in Toronto.
- The redshirt senior earned a degree in history and is pursuing a master's degree in public policy from the Frank Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy.

LONDON CALLING THE SHOTS

- Guard London Perrantes is enjoying a breakout season in 2015-16.
- Perrantes has hit double figures in scoring in 10 games, including a season-high 22 points (career-best seven 3-pointers) at Virginia Tech.
- Perrantes leads the ACC in 3-point shooting at a career-best 55.6 percent and has a career 3.0 assist-to-turnover ratio (355 assists, 118 turnovers) in 84 career games.
- He tallied his second career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 11 assists against George Mason en route to MVP honors at the Charleston Classic.

2015-16 Opponents in Bold

- Perrantes also tallied 19 points against Villanova and Florida State.
- He missed the Ohio State and William & Mary contests due to an appendectomy.
- Perrantes averaged 6.4 points and 4.6 assists en route to honorable mention All-ACC honors last season.
- He had a career-high 26 points, including five 3-pointers, at Miami (1/3/15).
- Perrantes earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.

GILL THRILLS

- Preseason All-ACC second-team selection Anthony Gill is averaging career highs in points (14.8) and field goal percentage (60%).
- Gill leads UVA in rebounding (6.1 rpg) and field goal percentage, and has led UVA in scoring in six games.
- Gill is the first UVA player to score in double figures in the first 18 games of a season since Sean Singletary scored 10 or more points in all 33 games during 2007-08.
- Gill earned ACC Player of the Week honors after tallying 20 points and 12 rebounds vs. West Virginia for his fourth career double-double.
- Gill averaged 11.6 points and 6.5 rebounds en route to All-ACC third-team (media) honors in 2014-15.
- Gill was named to the coaches' All-ACC Defensive Team in 2014-15.
- Gill, who has led UVA in field goal percentage in each of the past two seasons, is shooting 58.9 percent during his UVA career.
- Gill has amassed 1,215 career points in three seasons at UVA and one at South Carolina (979 at UVA).

DARIUS SHOWING VARIOUS SKILLS

- Darius Thompson has averaged 6.4 points, 2.0 rebounds, 1.9 assists and a team-leading 1.1 steals in his first season at UVA.
- Thompson is shooting 35.7 percent (10-28) from 3-point range after shooting 19.5 percent (8-41) from downtown at Tennessee in 2013-14.
- He had a five-game double figure scoring streak from Nov. 25-Dec. 19, and tallied 12 points in four games.
- Thompson sat out as a transfer last season after averaging 2.6 points and 2.4 assists in 37 games at Tennessee in 2013-14.
- Thompson had 12 points, six rebounds, four assists and three steals in his UVA debut as a starter vs. Morgan State.

HALL OF A SPARK

- Redshirt sophomore guard Devon Hall has started the past two games for Virginia.
- Hall has played in all 18 games this season and is averaging 18.5 minutes after averaging 10.6 minutes in 23 contests last season.
- Hall scored an ACC-high 11 points against Clemson and is averaging 8.5 points the past two games as a starter.
- Hall netted a career-high 13 points vs. Morgan State and drained a career-best four 3-pointers for 12 points vs. Long Beach State.
- Hall had five points, four assists and three rebounds in a solid all-around outing against Notre Dame.
- Hall made his first start of the season at Florida State, scoring six points and matching a season high with 26 minutes.

PERRANTES, GILL AND BROGDON LEAD UVA IN ACC RANKINGS
