#### **FOR OPENERS**

- Virginia (11-4) meets NC State (11-4) for the 142nd time.
- As of Jan. 9, Virginia is tied for first in the ACC with a 2-0 record, while NC State is tied for sixth at 1-1.
- The Cavaliers aim for their third straight win and first 3-0 ACC start since 2009-10.
- The Cavaliers rank fourth in the nation in scoring defense at 55.9 points per game.
- Cavaliers Akil Mitchell (Charlotte), Anthony Gill (High Point), Teven Jones (Kannapolis) and Caid Kirven (Raleigh) hail from North Carolina.

#### **ALL-TIME AGAINST NC STATE**

- Virginia is 59-82 all-time vs. NC State in the series that dates back to 1912-13.
- The Cavaliers are 3-2 in their last five games vs. the Wolfpack and 6-4 in their last 10.
- UVa went 1-1 against NC State last season, winning 58-55 in Charlottesville and losing 75-56 in the quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament in Greensboro, N.C.
- Virginia is 2-0 in its last two games against the Wolfpack in Raleigh, including wins on Jan. 28, 2012 (61-60) and Jan. 9, 2010 (70-62).

#### **LAST TIME VS. NC STATE**

- NC State defeated Virginia, 75-56, in the quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament in Greensboro, N.C.
- Scott Wood had 23 points and seven 3-pointers to lead NC State, while C.J. Leslie added 17 points and 11 rebounds with three blocks.
- Akil Mitchell scored 19 to lead Virginia and Joe Harris had 13.

#### **VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS**

- For the third straight week, UVa is neither ranked nor receiving votes in either national poll.
- Virginia's No. 24 preseason AP ranking marked its first since being ranked No. 11 to start the 2001-02 season.
- The Cavaliers, who were ranked for the first two weeks, returned to the rankings this season for the first time since Feb. 27, 2012, when they were No. 24 in the AP poll.

- The Cavaliers defeated Wake Forest 74-51 to improve to 4-1 in ACC home openers under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Malcolm Brogdon scored 14 points, Joe Harris and Justin Anderson each added 11 points and Anthony Gill had 10 points as four Cavaliers landed in double figures.
- Akil Mitchell had a game-high seven rebounds as the 'Hoos outrebounded Wake Forest, 38-25.
- Virginia shot 50 percent from the floor (26-of-52) and 50 percent from 3-point range (7-of-14).

#### NOTEWORTHY

- Virginia has won four its last five games.
- UVa's 62-50 win at Florida State ended a 10-game losing streak in Tallahassee and 17-game skid in the state of Florida.
- Virginia has shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line in five of 15 games, including a season-high 82.4 percent (14-of-17) at Tennessee (12/30/13)
- Malcolm Brogdon (34-of-38, 89.5 percent) and London Perrantes (24-of-29, 82.8 percent) are a combined 58-for-67 (86.6 percent) from the free throw line, while the rest of the team is 167-for-282 (59.2 percent).
- UVa's 64.5 percent free throw percentage is its lowest since shooting 63.3 percent in 1967-68.
- The Cavaliers have used seven different starting lineups, including four guards (London Perrantes, Joe Harris, Justin Anderson, Malcolm Brogdon) and forward Darion Atkins against Norfolk State (12/23/13).
- Joe Harris' 10.3 scoring average leads the team and would be the lowest UVa team scoring leader in 61 seasons of ACC action.
- The Cavaliers are 7-0 with their current starting lineup of London Perrantes, Malcolm Brogdon, Joe Harris, Akil Mitchell and Mike Tobey.

#### HARRIS AND MITCHELL LEAD CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Returning All-ACC members Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell are Virginia's team leaders.
- Last season, Harris averaged a career-high 16.3 points and Mitchell added career bests with 13.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game.
- Harris ranks 23rd on UVa's all-time scoring list with 1,410 points and Mitchell ranks 16th with 630 career rebounds.
- In 2013-14, Harris is averaging 10.3 points and 3.4 rebounds per game, while Mitchell is averaging 6.5 points and 6.1 rebounds.
- Harris is shooting 40 percent (22-of-55) from 3-point range this season.

#### **VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Head coach Tony Bennett has an 87-57 mark in five seasons at UVa and 156-90 record in eight seasons of coaching.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to the NCAA Tournament in 2012 and NIT in 2013.
- Bennett has increased UVa's win total in each of the last four seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12 and 23 in 2013-13).
- UVa's 11 ACC wins in 2012-13 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.
- Bennett is one of 23 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- He guided Washington State to a pair of NCAA Tournaments and the NIT in three seasons and was the National Coach of the Year in 2007.

#### **EMBRACE THE PACE**

• As of Jan. 9, the Cavaliers rank in the top 10 nationally in seven defensive categories: points per game (4th), rebounds per game (7th),

possessions per 40 minutes (7th), points per possession (8th), field goal percentage (10th), offensive rebounding percentage (10th) and offensive rebounds per game (10th).

- Virginia has held 13 of its 15 opponents below 50 percent shooting from the floor and opponents are shooting 37.4 percent (10th nationally) from the floor and 32.5 percent from 3-point range overall.
- Virginia has limited its opponents to a combined 59 fast break points for an average of 3.9 per game.

#### **CLEANING THE GLASS**

- Virginia has outrebounded its opponents in 12 of 15 games.
- $\bullet$  The Cavaliers rank 13th nationally in rebound percentage at 55.5 percent and are enjoying a +8.5 average rebound margin per game.
- Akil Mitchell (6.1), Malcolm Brogdon (5.5), Mike Tobey (4.5), Justin Anderson (4.3), Anthony Gill (3.9), Darion Atkins (3.7) and Joe Harris (3.4) are each averaging three or more rebounds per game.

#### PAINT IT ORANGE AND BLUE

- UVa has outscored its opponents in the paint in 11 of 15 games and 418-310 overall.
- Virginia has scored 42.7 percent of its points in the paint.
- A post player has led UVa in scoring in six of 15 games (Gill 13 vs. JMU, 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU, Tobey 18 vs. Davidson and Anderson 16 at Florida State).

#### **OFF THE BENCH**

- Virginia is outscoring opponents 400-229 in bench points, averaging 26.7 per game.
- A bench player has led the team in scoring in six games (Tobey 18 vs. Davidson, Gill 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU and Anderson 23 vs. Missouri State and 16 at Florida State).

#### ANDERSON PROVING HIS WORTH

- Sophomore Justin Anderson is proving to be a valuable all-around player for Virginia.
- Anderson, who has led UVa in scoring in four of the last five games, is averaging 9.9 points and 4.4 rebounds per game.
- He has reached double figures in six conscutive games and has led the team in scoring in five games (23 points vs. Missouri State, 16 vs. Northern lowa, 14 points vs. Norfolk State, 11 at Tennessee and 16 at Florida State).
- Anderson also earned Corpus Christi Challenge all-tournament honors after averaging 12 points in four wins during the tournament.
- He was one of two players in NCAA Divison I to record 20 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in a game last season, joining South Alabama's Mychal Ammons who also accomplished the rare feat.
- Anderson tallied 24 points, six rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in Virginia's season-ending 75-64 loss to lowa (3/27/13), while Ammons had 21 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers vs. FIU.

#### MALCOLM BACK IN THE MIDDLE

- Redshirt sophomore guard Malcolm Brogdon returned to action against JMU (11/8/13) after missing the 2012-13 season and last four games of 2011-12 with a foot injury.
- Brogdon is averaging 9.9 points, 5.5 rebounds and a team-leading 1.2 steals per game.
- Brogdon is shooting 36.0 percent (18-of-50) from 3-point range and a team-leading 89.5 percent (34-of-38) from the free throw line.
- Brogdon tallied a career-high 17 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and Green Bay (12/7/13) and matched his career high with three 3-pointers against JMU (11/8/13) and Green Bay.
- Brogdon tallied a career-best four consecutive games of double figures scoring from Nov. 12-23.
- He averaged 6.7 points in 28 games as a freshman in 2011-12.

#### TOBEY, TOBEY, TOBEY...CAN DO IT AGAIN

- Mike Tobey has shown the ability to be Virginia's go-to man, averaging 6.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and a team-leading 1.1 blocks per game.
- He tallied a season-high 18 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and had a career-high nine rebounds vs. VCU (11/12/13).
- Tobey, who has started six games, has scored in double figures in five games.

#### **AG MAKING SUCCESSFUL TRANSFER**

- Redshirt sophomore Anthony Gill made his UVa debut against JMU (11/8/13) after sitting out last season as a transfer from South Carolina.
- Gill has led UVa in scoring in four games, including 13 vs. JMU (11/8/13), 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting against Navy (11/19/13), 13 vs. Liberty (11/23/13) and a career-high 19 vs. SMU (11/29/13).
- Gill, who earned Corpus Christi Challenge All-Tournament honors, is shooting a sizzling 66.2 percent from the floor (47-of-71) and averaging 8.5 points and 3.9 rebounds per game this season.
- He has scored in double figures in six games.
- Gill averaged 7.6 points and 4.7 rebounds per game as a freshman for South Carolina in 2011-12.

#### **LONDON CALLING**

- Freshman London Perrantes has made an immediate impact during his freshman campaign at UVa.
- Perrantes, who has started 11 games, is averaging 4.4 points, 2.1 rebounds and a team-leading 3.3 assists per game.
- Perrantes had a career-high 14 points at Florida State (1/4/14).
- Perrantes, who ranks eighth in the ACC with a 2.45 assists to turnover ratio, tallied a season-high six assists against Liberty (11/23/13) and Missouri State (11/30/13).

#### **ABOUT THE 2013-14 SCHEDULE**

- Three of Virginia's opponents are currently ranked in both national polls (Syracuse, Wisconsin and Duke), while four (North Carolina, Pittsburgh, SMU and Notre Dame) received votes.
- Twelve opponents (JMU, VCU, Davidson, Liberty, Wisconsin, NC State, Duke, North Carolina, Pittsburgh, Notre Dame, Miami and Syracuse) earned 2013 NCAA Tournament berths, while four (Norfolk State, Tennessee, Florida State and Maryland) participated in the National Invitation Tournament and two (Northern Iowa and Green Bay) in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament.

#### **VIRGINIA PICKED 4TH IN THE ACC**

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball.
- UVa, who was picked seventh and tied for fourth last season, has finished at or higher than its predicted finish in each of the last four seasons.

#### **TOBEY AND BENNETT STRIKE GOLD**



We would like to receive credential requests no later than seven (7) days prior to the game. Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

#### **PHOTO CREDENTIALS**

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

#### PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

#### **INTERVIEWS**

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

#### **POSTGAME INTERVIEWS**

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the visiting coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after Coach Bennett is done with his postgame press conference.

#### **RADIO**

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.
