FOR OPENERS

- No. 13 Virginia meets Savannah State for the first time.
- As of Dec. 17, the Cavaliers rank first nationally in scoring defense (53.3 ppg), fourth in turnovers per game (9.1), 15th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.52), 18th in field goal percentage defense (37.8%) and fouls per game (15.3), 21st in scoring margin (17.2) and 22nd in free throw percentage (77.5%).
- Devon Hall is averaging 16.8 points and shooting 54.4 percent during his five-game double-figure scoring streak.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA has limited its opponents to 53.3 points per game (2nd best in school history) and has held four of its 2017-18 foes to fewer than 50 points (UNCG, Austin Peay, Vanderbilt and Wisconsin).
- UVA has held each of its 10 foes to less than 50 percent shooting.
- The Cavaliers are 68-2 when limiting their opponents to fewer than 50 points under head coach Tony Bennett.
- In 2016-17, Virginia led the nation in scoring defense (56.4 ppg) for the third time under Bennett.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense four times (2008-09, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2016-17) and finished in the top-five nationally in eight of 11 seasons.
- Bennett-coached teams are 93-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 12-year coaching career.

UVA VS. THE MEAC

- UVA meets its first of two Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference opponents in 2017-18 and first MEAC foe since posting an 81-45 win over Hampton in the 2016 NCAA Tournament.
- Virginia is 26-0 all-time vs. the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (8-0 vs. Hampton, 4-0 vs. Howard and Norfolk State, 3-0 vs. Morgan State, 2-0 vs. Maryland Eastern Shore and South Carolina State, 1-0 vs. Bethune-Cookman, Coppin State and North Carolina A&T).
- Tony Bennett is 14-0 all-time vs. the MEAC as head coach at Virginia.

LAST TIME OUT

- Nigel Johnson scored 22 points and Devon Hall had a career-high 20 on Dec. 16 for No. 16 Virginia, which returned from a break for final exams to beat Davidson 80-60.
- Kyle Guy added 19 points for the Cavaliers (9-1), who were playing for the first time since losing 68-61 to No. 11 West Virginia on Dec. 5.
- The Wildcats (4-4) got 20 points from Peyton Aldridge and 12 from Oskar Michelsen. They made only 8 of 26 3-point attempts.
- Davidson led 18-11 with nine minutes left in the first half, but Guy hit a 3-pointer as Virginia started to shake off its rust. Guy's basket sparked a 26-11 burst to end the half. Johnson scored 11 of his points in the run, and Hall hit a pair of 3-pointers.

UVA IN KEN POM EFFICIENCY RATINGS

- As of Dec. 18, UVA ranks Nos. 1, 3 and 30 in the KenPom.com adjusted defense, overall and adjusted offense efficiency ratings.
- UVA is shooting 48.6 percent, 39.1 percent from 3-point range (2nd best in school history) and school-best 77.5 percent from the free throw line.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better in six games.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 197-84 (.701) mark in nine seasons at Virginia and 266-117 (.695) career mark in 12 seasons overall.
- Bennett has guided UVA to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances and has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to six consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 109-34 (.762) in non-conference action, 88-50 (.638) in ACC play and 118-24 (.831) at home under Tony Bennett.

ABOUT THE CAVALIERS

- UVA is led by tri-captains Devon Hall, Isaiah Wilkins and Jack Salt.
- The announcement of Hall, Wilkins and Salt marked the first time in Bennett's 12-year head coaching career where he officially named team captains.
- UVA has averaged 70.5 points per game (second most under Bennett) on offense, while yielding a nation-leading 53.3 ppg (second lowest in school history) on defense.
- UVA has started Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, Hall, Wilkins and Salt in each of its first 10 games.
- Guy leads the team in scoring at 17 points per game and has scored 13 or more points in nine of 10 games, including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) and 21 vs. Lehigh (12/2/17).
- Hall has averaged 13.3 points on 52.9 percent shooting and team-leading 92.6 percent (23 of 25) from the charity stripe and 47.1 percent (16 of 34) from 3-point range.
- Wilkins, who has averaged 7.9 points and a team-high 6.7 rebounds, has a team-high 11 blocked shots and 13 steals.
- Jerome is averaging 6.8 points and Salt is averaging 2.8 points and career-best 4.7 rebounds.
- Graduate transfer Nigel Johnson is averaging 7.2 points after averaging 11.3 points for Rutgers last season. Johnson has reached double figures in three contests off the bench.
- Mamadi Diakite (6.3 ppg & 4.1 rpg) and redshirt freshmen De'Andre Hunter (5.5 ppg) and Jay Huff (4.2 ppg) are key role players.
- Marco Anthony provides depth and fellow rookie Francesco Badocchi is expected to redshirt the 2017-18 season.

ZAY PAVES THE WAY

- Senior forward Isaiah Wilkins is one of the top utility players in college basketball.
- Wilkins has averaged 7.9 points, 6.7 rebounds, 1.8 assists, 1.1 blocked shots and 1.3 steals in 2017-18.
- Wilkins was named the MVP of the NIT Season Tip-Off after scoring a career-high 19 points against Rhode Island (11/24/17) and blocking four shots and scoring eight points against Vanderbilt (11/23/17).
- He tallied eight points, eight rebounds, two assists, one steal and took a team-high three charges at VCU (11/17/17).
- Wilkins added 14 points, six rebounds and three steals vs. Lehigh (12/2/17).
- Wilkins ranks eighth at UVA with 103 career blocked shots.
- In 2016-17, the All-ACC Defensive team honoree led the team in rebounding (6.0 rpg), blocked shots (43) and steals (33), becoming the first Cavalier since Travis Watson in 2002-03 to lead the team in those three categories.
- Wilkins recorded a pair of double-doubles in 2016-17 (13 points, 11 rebounds and career-high tying five blocks vs. Louisville and 10 points, 10 rebounds and four steals vs. Miami).

HALL OF A PLAYER

- Redshirt senior Devon Hall is averaging a career-best 13.3 points, 4.1 rebounds and 2.8 assists in 27.9 minutes per game.
- Hall is shooting 52.9 percent from the floor, 47.1 percent from 3-point range and 92.6 percent (25 of 27) from the free throw line.
- He scored a career-high 20 points vs. Davidson and 19 points against UNCG (11/10/17) and West Virginia (12/5/17).
- Hall, who has started 64 consecutive games dating back to last season, has scored in double figures in 26 career games including seven games this season.
- In 2016-17, Hall averaged 8.4 points and 4.4 rebounds in 27.4 minutes per game.
- He was named to the 2016-17 All-ACC Academic Team after earning his degree in media studies and is currently enrolled in the Professional Development Program at the Curry School of Education.

THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- Sophomore Kyle Guy is having a breakout season for Virginia.
- Guy leads Virginia in scoring (17 ppg) and made 3-pointers per game (2.9).
- Guy's career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) were the most for a Virginia player since Joe Harris' 36 points vs. Duke in 2012-13.
- Guy has led the Cavaliers in scoring in six contests and has scored 13 or more points in nine games this season.
- Guy is shooting 48.5 percent (80 of 165) from 3-point range during his two-year career and has made five or more 3-pointers in six games.
- Guy needs 20 more 3-pointers to qualify for UVA's career 3-point percentage record set at 42.1 percent set by Keith Freel (107 3-pointers from 2000-01).
- Guy's 7.5 points per game average in his rookie season under head coach Tony Bennett ranked higher than former UVA standouts Malcolm Brogdon (6.7 ppg) and London Perrantes (5.5 ppg).
- Guy has scored 10+ points in 20 games, including a pair of 20-point efforts last season against Pitt and Grambling State.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia is 68-2 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era (4-0 in 2017-18).
- Bennett-coached teams are 93-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA held Wisconsin under 40 points and is 19-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

GUY AND HALL AMONG ACC LEADERS

- As of Dec. 18, Kyle Guy ranks second in the ACC in 3-pointers per game (2.9), fifth in 3-point percentage (46.8%) and sixth in scoring (17 ppg).
- Devon Hall ranks third in the ACC in free throw percentage (92.6%).
- Isaiah Wilkins ranks 18th in the ACC in rebounding (6.7 rpg).

RECORDS WATCH

- Isaiah Wilkins ranks eighth on UVA's career blocked shots list with 103.
- Wilkins needs six blocked shots to pass Steve Castellan (108 blocks, 1976-79) and Assane Sene (2009-12) for sixth on the list.
- Wilkins has blocked at least one shot in five games this season.

ABOUT THE 2017-18 SCHEDULE

- Five of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the AP Top-25 preseason poll (Duke, North Carolina, Miami, West Virginia and Florida State), while Notre Dame, Clemson, Louisville, Virginia Tech, Rhode Island and Syracuse received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 17 games against 2017 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against North Carolina, Notre Dame, Louisville, Virginia Tech and Wisconsin; road contests at Duke, North Carolina, West Virginia, Louisville, Florida State, Wake Forest and VCU; and neutral-site tilts against Vanderbilt and either Seton Hall or Rhode Island in the NIT Season Tip-Off in Brooklyn, N.Y.
- Four opponents (Clemson, Georgia Tech, Monmouth, UNC Greensboro and Syracuse) participated in the 2017 National Invitation Tournament.

VIRGINIA PICKED 6TH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish sixth in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked third and finished tied for fifth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in eight of the last nine seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Notre Dame, Miami, Louisville, Virginia, Virginia Tech, Florida State, Georgia Tech, Syracuse, Wake Forest, NC State, Clemson, Boston College and Pittsburgh.

CAVALIERS IN THE NBA

- Justin Anderson (Philadelphia), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn), Mike Scott (Washington) and London Perrantes (Cleveland) are former Cavaliers playing in the NBA this season.
- Brogdon earned 2017 NBA Rookie of the Year honors.
- Scott is in his sixth season (first with Washington) and Harris is in his fourth NBA season (second with Brooklyn), while Anderson is in his third season (second with Philadelphia).
- Perrantes signed a two-way contract with Cleveland and made his NBA debut vs. Atlanta on Dec. 12.
- In addition, Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle is a Virginia alum who helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984. Carlisle gained his 700th NBA victory on Saturday, Dec. 2.
