FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets Wake Forest in the lone meeting between the teams in 2015-16.
- UVA has a three-game winning streak against the Demon Deacons.
- The Cavaliers look to avoid their first four-game road losing streak since 2012-13.
- Anthony Gill needs five points to reach the 1,000 career points at UVA.
- As of Jan. 25, UVA is tied for 7th in the ACC at 4-3 and Wake Forest is tied for 13th at 1-6.
- As of Jan. 25, UVA ranks sixth nationally in scoring defense (61.4 ppg), eighth in field goal percentage (49.7%), 10th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.6), 13th in 3-point field goal percentage (40.5%) and 21st in free throw percentage (74.9%).

- Last season's 70-34 win snapped UVA's 10-game losing streak in Winston-Salem.
- Virginia is 4-1 in its last five games against Wake Forest and 4-6 in the last 10.
- Tony Bennett is 4-4 vs. Wake Forest as head coach at Virginia.
- Anthony Gill is Virginia's current career leading scorer against Wake Forest, averaging 13.3 points in three career games.
- Malcolm Brogdon is averaging 11 points and 5.3 rebounds in four games against Syracuse.
- Mike Tobey is averaging 8.8 points and 4.3 rebounds in four games against Wake Forest, while London Perrantes has chipped in seven points and 3.5 assists per game.

LAST TIME VS. WAKE FOREST

- Anthony Gill had 11 points and Darion Atkins added 10 as then No. 2 Virginia posted a 70-34 road win at Wake Forest on Feb. 25.
- UVA shot 50 percent (28-56) from the field and held the Demon Deacons to 21.8 percent (12-55).
- The Cavaliers owned a 45-29 advantage on the glass, led by Isaiah Wilkins' season-high nine rebounds.
- Virginia had a commanding 46-14 advantage on points in paint.
- London Perrantes did not play due to a broken nose and mild concussion.

LAST TIME OUT

- Malcolm Brogdon tallied 21 points to lead then-No. 13 Virginia to a 73-65 win over Syracuse on Jan. 24.
- London Perrantes added 16 points, seven assists and career-high four steals for the Cavaliers.
- Anthony Gill added 16 points for the Cavaliers, who out-rebounded the Orange 31-28 and shot 56.8 percent.
- Brogdon drilled a pair of 3-pointers to secure the win.
- Michael Gbiniji had 24 points for the Orange, while Malachi Richardson added 23.
- Syracuse went 13-30 from 3-point range and UVA was 8-18.

ALL-TIME AGAINST WAKE FOREST

- Virginia is 63-70 all-time vs. Wake Forest, including a 14-41 mark in Winston-Salem, in the series that dates back to 1910-11.
- UVA has won four of the last five meetings in the series, including a pair of wins (61-60 & 70-34) season.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett sports a 151-68 mark in seven seasons at Virginia and 220-101 career mark in 10 seasons overall.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett was also named ACC Coach of the Year, NABC District 2 Coach of the Year and USBWA District 3 Coach of the Year for the second consecutive year.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to four consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014 and 2015, and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett-coached teams are 76-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 10-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top five nationally in six of nine seasons.
- Bennett is one of 26 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 79-24 (.767) in non-conference action and 95-20 (.826) at home under Tony Bennett.

SECONDS ANYONE?

- Virginia has played its best basketball during the second half of games this season.
- The Cavaliers have scored more points in the second half than the first half in 16 of 19 games.
- UVA is averaging 40.5 points in the second half and 31.8 points in the first stanza.
- UVA is shooting 55.5 percent on its second-half shots, including 48.6 percent from 3-point range, but only 44.4 percent on its first-half shots and 31.6 percent from 3-point range.

ABOUT THE THREE-GAME ROAD LOSING STREAK

- Virginia has lost three straight ACC road games (Virginia Tech, Georgia Tech & Florida State) for the first time since losing four straight in 2012-13 (North Carolina, Miami, Boston College and Florida State).
- The two-game losing streak from Jan. 4-9, 2016 (Virginia Tech & Georgia Tech) was UVA's first since Dec. 4-7, 2013 (Wisconsin and Green Bay).
- UVA has allowed 69 points per game during its three-game road losing streak.
- The Cavaliers has allowed Virginia Tech, Georgia Tech and Florida State to shoot 51.1 percent (23-45) from 3-point range.
- UVA has been outscored 55-36 in bench points during the streak.

VIRGINIA RANKED NO. 11/12 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 11 in the latest Associated Press poll and No. 12 in the most recent USA Today Coaches' poll.
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in six consecutive polls from Nov. 30, 2015 to Jan. 4, 2016.
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in 25 consecutive AP polls from March 3, 2014 to Nov. 16, 2015, its longest span since 49 straight from 1980-83.
- The Cavaliers' No. 6 preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.
- Virginia has been ranked in the preseason top-10 in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1981-82 and 1982-83.

VIRGINIA BASKETBALL GETTING OFFENSIVE

- Virginia is averaging 72.9 points per game, its most since 76.8 ppg in 2007-08.
- As of Jan. 25, UVA ranks Nos. 8 and 9 in the KenPom.com overall and adjusted offensive efficiency ratings, respectively.
- UVA is shooting 49.7 percent from the field (best since 50.1% in 1985-86), 40.5 percent from 3-point range (best in school history) and 74.9 percent from the free throw line (best since 76.2% in 1978-79).
- Virginia has scored 80 or more points in six games, its most since 11 in 2007-08.

- UVA's 86 points against Villanova were its most scored against a top-25 opponent since tallying 87 in a road win at Minnesota in 2010-11.
- UVA has shot 55 percent or better in seven games in 2015-16 after achieving the feat three times in 34 games in 2014-15 and four times in 37 games in 2013-14.
- The Cavaliers scored 82 or more points in three straight games (Nov. 19-22 at Charleston Classic) for the first time since the first three games of the 2001-02 season.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better from 3-point range in six games.

'HOO ARE THESE WAHOOS?

- All-America candidate Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA in scoring for the third consecutive season at a career-best 17 points per game, while Anthony Gill is averaging a career-high 14.8 points.
- Brogdon has nine 20-point efforts, including a career-high 28 at George Washington, marking the most by a UVA player in a season since Joe Harris had nine 20-point games in 2012-13.
- Gill has reached double figures in scoring in all 19 games in 2015-16 and 22 straight dating back to 2014-15.
- London Perrantes is averaging career highs in points (11.9), field goal percentage (48.1%) and 3-point field goal percentage (54.9%).
- UVA has out-rebounded its opponents in 12 of its 15 wins.
- Eight players have each scored 11 or more points in a game.

ALL-AMERICAN BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Preseason co-ACC Player of the Year Malcolm Brogdon is aiming to become the first UVA player since Sean Singletary (2006-08) to lead UVA in scoring for three straight seasons.
- Brogdon's 17.0 scoring average is the highest for UVA since Mike Scott's 18.0 ppg in 2011-12.
- Brogdon was named a preseason All-American by The Sporting News (1st team), Blue Ribbon Yearbook (1st team), CBSSports.com (2nd team), NBCSports.com (2nd team), Bleacher Report (2nd team), USA Today (3rd team) and CollegeInsider.com.
- Brogdon and Gonzaga's Kyle Wiltjer are the first consensus All-Americans to return as fifth-year seniors since Vanderbilt's Billy McCaffrey in 1993-94.
- In 2014-15, Brogdon averaged 14.0 points and 3.9 rebounds en route to All-America second-team and All-ACC first-team accolades.
- The two-time All-ACC performer, who was a John Wooden Award finalist last season, ranks 20th on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,457 points in 118 career games (12.3 career ppg).
- Brogdon ranks second on UVA's career free-throw percentage list at 85.9% (348-for-405).
- Brogdon is a candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award and Wooden Citizen Cup Award.
- Brogdon helped Team USA to a bronze medal at the 2015 Pan American Games in Toronto.
- The redshirt senior earned a degree in history and is pursuing a master's degree in public policy from the Frank Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy.

LONDON CALLING THE SHOTS

- Guard London Perrantes is enjoying a breakout season in 2015-16.
- Perrantes has hit double figures in scoring in 11 games, including a season-high 22 points (career-best seven 3-pointers) at Virginia Tech.
- Perrantes leads the ACC in 3-point shooting at a career-best 54.9 percent and has a career 3.0 assist-to-turnover ratio (362 assists, 122 turnovers) in 85 games.
- He tallied his second career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 11 assists against George Mason en route to MVP honors at the Charleston Classic.
- Perrantes also tallied 19 points against Villanova and Florida State.
- He missed the Ohio State and William & Mary contests due to an appendectomy.
- Perrantes averaged 6.4 points and 4.6 assists en route to honorable mention All-ACC honors last season.
- He had a career-high 26 points, including five 3-pointers, at Miami (1/3/15).
- Perrantes earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.

GILL THRILLS

- Preseason All-ACC second-team selection Anthony Gill is averaging career highs in points (14.8) and field goal percentage (60.2%).
- Gill leads UVA in rebounding (6.2 rpg) and field goal percentage, and has led UVA in scoring in six games.
- Gill is the first UVA player to score in double figures in the first 19 games of a season since Sean Singletary scored 10 or more points in all 33 games during 2007-08.
- Gill earned ACC Player of the Week honors after tallying 20 points and 12 rebounds vs. West Virginia for his fourth career double-double.
- Gill averaged 11.6 points and 6.5 rebounds en route to All-ACC third-team (media) honors in 2014-15.
- Gill was named to the coaches' All-ACC Defensive Team in 2014-15.
- Gill, who has led UVA in field goal percentage in each of the past two seasons, is shooting 58.9 percent during his UVA career.
- Gill has amassed 1,231 career points in three seasons at UVA and one at South Carolina (995 at UVA).

DARIUS SHOWING VARIOUS SKILLS

- Darius Thompson has averaged 6.1 points, 1.9 rebounds, 1.8 assists and a team-leading 1.0 steals in his first season at UVA.
- Thompson is shooting 34.5 percent (10-29) from 3-point range after shooting 19.5 percent (8-41) from downtown at Tennessee in

2013-14.

- He had a five-game double figure scoring streak from Nov. 25-Dec. 19, and tallied 12 points in four games.
- Thompson sat out as a transfer last season after averaging 2.6 points and 2.4 assists in 37 games at Tennessee in 2013-14.
