FOR OPENERS

- Virginia makes its second straight appearance on ESPN's ACC Big Monday after losing last Monday (Jan. 13) at Duke (69-65).
- Virginia meets North Carolina for the only regular-season meeting of 2013-14.
- Virginia's 4-1 start in the ACC is its best since starting 4-1 in 1994-95.
- As of Jan. 19, Virginia is tied for second in the ACC at 4-1 and North Carolina is tied for 10th at 1-3.
- The Cavaliers rank fourth in the nation in scoring defense at 56.6 points per game.

ALL-TIME AGAINST NORTH CAROLINA

- Virginia is 50-128 all-time vs. North Carolina in the series that dates back to 1910-11.
- The Cavaliers are 31-44, including a 1-4 mark at John Paul Jones Arena, against UNC in Charlottesville.
- The Cavaliers posted a 61-52 win (Jan. 6) and 93-81 (Feb. 16) loss against the Tar Heels last season.
- Virginia is 1-4 against North Carolina in its last five games and 2-8 in its last 10.

LAST TIME VS. NORTH CAROLINA

- Joe Harris scored 27 points, but Virginia fell 93-81 at North Carolina on Feb. 16, 2013.
- Former guard P.J. Hairston scored a career-high 29 points and Marcus Paige added 17 for the Tar Heels, who shot 49.2 percent (29-of-59) and hit 13 3-pointers.
- Virginia got off to a fast start by making 11 of 13 shots, with six of those coming from 3-point range for a 10-point lead in the first 11 minutes, but struggled to slow the Tar Heels after halftime.
- Jontel Evans added 12 points and Akil Mitchell had nine points and nine rebounds for the Cavaliers.

VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

- For the first time since Dec. 2, UVa is receiving votes in both national polls.
- Virginia's No. 24 preseason AP ranking marked its first since being ranked No. 11 to start the 2001-02 season.
- The Cavaliers, who were ranked for the first two weeks, returned to the rankings this season for the first time since Feb. 27, 2012, when they were No. 24 in the AP poll.

LAST TIME OUT

- Joe Harris scored 18 points and Virginia used an early 22-5 run to take command on its way to a 78-66 victory against Florida State on Saturday and first two-game series sweep against the Seminoles since 2000-01.
- Malcolm Brogdon added 16 points, Mike Tobey had 13 points and two blocks and Justin Anderson added 10 points for the Cavaliers.
- Virginia was outrebounded for just the fourth time this season, but committed only nine turnovers and had eight steals.
- The Cavaliers went 7-of-11 from 3-point range, led by Harris' 4-of-5 effort.

ALL-TIME VS. ACC OPPONENTS

- Virginia is 528-692 all-time against current ACC members (9-7 vs. Boston College, 69-52 vs. Clemson, 84-53 vs. Virginia Tech, 49-116 vs. Duke, 20-22 vs. Florida State, 35-39 vs. Georgia Tech, 73-106 vs. Maryland, 5-10 vs. Miami, 50-128 vs. UNC, 60-82 vs. NC State, 5-1 vs. Notre Dame, 7-3 vs. Pittsburgh, 1-3 vs. Syracuse and 61-70 vs. Wake Forest).

NOTEWORTHY

- Malcolm Brogdon, who has scored in double figures in all five ACC games, is averaging a team-high 14.2 points per game in ACC play.
- Akil Mitchell ranks fourth at 9.0 rebounds per game in ACC play.
- Joe Harris leads all active ACC players with 221 career 3-point field goals.
- Virginia posted double-digit victories in its first three ACC games for the first time in school history.
- The Cavaliers are 9-1 with their current starting lineup of London Perrantes, Malcolm Brogdon, Joe Harris, Akil Mitchell and Mike Tobey.
- Virginia captured the Corpus Christi Challenge earlier this season with wins over Liberty, Hampton, SMU and Missouri State.
- Virginia has shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line in eight of 18 games, including three straight.
- Malcolm Brogdon (44-of-48, 91.7 percent) and London Perrantes (26-of-31, 83.9 percent) are a combined 70-for-79 (88.6 percent) from the free throw line, while the rest of the team is 206-for-338 (60.9 percent).
- UVa's 66.3 percent free throw percentage is its lowest since shooting 65.8 percent in 2002-03.
- The Cavaliers have used seven different starting lineups, including four guards (London Perrantes, Joe Harris, Justin Anderson, Malcolm Brogdon) and forward Darion Atkins against Norfolk State (12/23/13).
- Joe Harris' 11.3 scoring average leads the team and would be the lowest UVa team scoring leader in 61 seasons of ACC action.

HARRIS AND MITCHELL LEAD CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Returning All-ACC members Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell are Virginia's team leaders.
- Last season, Harris averaged a career-high 16.3 points and Mitchell added career bests with 13.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game.
- Harris is 19th on UVa's all-time scoring list with 1,459 points and Mitchell ranks 16th with 655 career rebounds.
- In 2013-14, Harris is averaging 11.3 points and 3.6 rebounds per game, while Mitchell is averaging 6.7 points and 6.4 rebounds.
- Harris is shooting 44.1 percent (30-of-68) from 3-point range this season.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has an 89-58 mark in five seasons at UVa and 158-91 record in eight seasons of coaching.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to the NCAA Tournament in 2012 and NIT in 2013.
- Bennett has increased UVa's win total in each of the last four seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12 and 23 in 2013-13).
- UVa's 11 ACC wins in 2012-13 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.
- He guided Washington State to a pair of NCAA Tournaments and the NIT in three seasons and was the National Coach of the Year in 2007.
- Bennett is one of 23 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

EMBRACE THE PACE

- As of Jan. 19, the Cavaliers rank in the top 10 nationally in six defensive categories: points per game (4th), offensive rebound percentage (5th), rebounds per game (8th), offensive rebounds per game (8th), points per possession (8th) and field goal percentage (10th).
- Virginia has held 16 of its 18 opponents below 50 percent shooting from the floor and opponents are shooting 37.8 percent (10th nationally) from the floor and 33 percent from 3-point range overall.
- Virginia has limited its opponents to a combined 63 fast break points for an average of 3.7 per game.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- Virginia has outrebounded its opponents in 14 of 18 games.
- The Cavaliers rank 14th nationally in rebound percentage at 55.4 percent and are enjoying a +7.8 average rebound margin per game.
- Akil Mitchell (6.4), Malcolm Brogdon (5.2), Mike Tobey (4.6), Justin Anderson (4.1), Anthony Gill (3.7), Joe Harris (3.6) and Darion Atkins (3.3) are each averaging three or more rebounds per game.

PAINT IT ORANGE AND BLUE

- UVa has outscored its opponents in the paint in 14 of 18 games and 518-370 overall.
- Virginia has scored 43.3 percent of its points in the paint.
- A post player has led UVa in scoring in seven of 16 games (Gill 13 vs. JMU, 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU; Tobey 18 vs. Davidson and 16 at NC State; and Anderson 16 at Florida State).

OFF THE BENCH

- Virginia is outscoring opponents 451-308 in bench points, averaging 25.1 per game.
- A bench player has led the team in scoring in six games (Tobey 18 vs. Davidson, Gill 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU and Anderson 23 vs. Missouri State and 16 at Florida State).

ANDERSON PROVING HIS WORTH

- Sophomore Justin Anderson is proving to be a valuable all-around player for Virginia.
- Anderson, who has led UVa in scoring in five games, is averaging 9.7 points and 4.1 rebounds per game.
- He reached double figures in six consecutive games (Dec. 7-Jan. 8) and has led the team in scoring in five games (23 points vs. Missouri State, 16 vs. Northern Iowa, 14 points vs. Norfolk State, 11 at Tennessee and 16 at Florida State).
- Anderson also earned Corpus Christi Challenge all-tournament honors after averaging 12 points in four wins during the tournament.
- He was one of two players in NCAA Division I to record 20 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in a game last season, joining South Alabama's Mychal Ammons who also accomplished the rare feat.

MALCOLM BACK IN THE MIDDLE

- Redshirt sophomore guard Malcolm Brogdon returned to action against JMU (11/8/13) after missing the 2012-13 season and last four games of 2011-12 with a foot injury.
- Brogdon is averaging 10.8 points, 5.2 rebounds and a team-leading 1.3 steals per game.
- Brogdon is shooting 34.5 percent (20-of-58) from 3-point range and a team-leading 91.7 percent (44-of-48) from the free throw line.
- Brogdon tallied a career-high 17 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13), Green Bay (12/7/13) and Duke (1/13/14) and matched his career high with

- Brogdon has tallied a career-best five consecutive games of double figures scoring from Jan. 4-18.
- He averaged 6.7 points in 28 games as a freshman in 2011-12.

TOBEY, TOBEY, TOBEY...CAN DO IT AGAIN

- Mike Tobey has shown the ability to be Virginia's go-to man, averaging 7.5 points, 4.6 rebounds and a team-leading 1.2 blocks per game.
- He tallied a season-high 18 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and ACC high 16 at NC State (1/11/14) and had a career-high nine rebounds vs. VCU (11/12/13).
- Tobey, who has started nine games, has scored in double figures in seven games.

AG MAKING SUCCESSFUL TRANSFER

- Redshirt sophomore Anthony Gill made his UVa debut against JMU (11/8/13) after sitting out last season as a transfer from South Carolina.
- Gill has led UVa in scoring in four games, including 13 vs. JMU (11/8/13), 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting against Navy (11/19/13), 13 vs. Liberty (11/23/13) and a career-high 19 vs. SMU (11/29/13).
- Gill, who earned Corpus Christi Challenge All-Tournament honors, is shooting 62.2 percent from the floor (51-of-82) and averaging 7.8 points and 3.7 rebounds per game this season.
- He has scored in double figures in six games.
- Gill averaged 7.6 points and 4.7 rebounds per game as a freshman for South Carolina in 2011-12.

LONDON CALLING

- Freshman London Perrantes has made an immediate impact during his freshman campaign at UVa.
- Perrantes, who has started 14 games, is averaging 4.3 points, 2.1 rebounds and a team-leading 3.4 assists per game.
- Perrantes had a career-high 14 points at Florida State (1/4/14).
- Perrantes, who ranks fifth in the ACC with a 2.77 assists to turnover ratio, has tallied five or more assists in seven games.

ABOUT THE 2013-14 SCHEDULE

- Four of Virginia's opponents are currently ranked in both national polls (Syracuse, Wisconsin, Duke and Pittsburgh), while VCU received votes in the USA Today Coaches Poll.
- Twelve opponents (JMU, VCU, Davidson, Liberty, Wisconsin, NC State, Duke, North Carolina, Pittsburgh, Notre Dame, Miami and Syracuse) earned 2013 NCAA Tournament berths, while four (Norfolk State, Tennessee, Florida State and Maryland) participated in the National Invitation Tournament and two (Northern Iowa and Green Bay) in the CollegelInsider.com Tournament.

VIRGINIA PICKED 4TH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball.
- UVa, who was picked seventh and tied for fourth last season, has finished at or higher than its predicted finish in each of the last four seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by Syracuse, North Carolina, UVa, Notre Dame, Pitt, Maryland, Boston College, Florida State, NC State, Georgia Tech, Miami, Wake Forest, Clemson and Virginia Tech.

HARRIS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Joe Harris was one of five players named Preseason All-ACC.
- Joining Harris on the preseason All-ACC team were C.J. Fair (Syracuse), Rodney Hood (Duke), Jabari Parker (Duke) and Jerian Grant (Notre Dame). Fair was the pick for Preseason ACC Player of the Year and Parker was named Preseason ACC Rookie of the Year.

We would like to receive credential requests no later than seven (7) days prior to the game. Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the visiting coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after Coach Bennett is done with his postgame press conference.

RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.
