FOR OPENERS

- No. 1 seed Virginia plays No. 3 seed Duke (26-7) in the 61st Annual ACC Tournament final on Saturday, March 15 at 1 p.m.
- The Cavaliers are playing in their seventh ACC Tournament final and first since 1994 (73-66 loss to North Carolina).
- Virginia went 0-1 vs. No. 3 seed Duke in the regular season.
- The Cavaliers rank No. 1 nationally in scoring defense at 55.1 ppg.
- UVa's 27-6 record is its best through 33 games since 1982-83 (29-4).

A WIN VS. DUKE WOULD...

- Give UVa its second ACC Tournament championship and first since 1976 (67-62 win vs. North Carolina in Landover, Md.).
- Give Virginia 28 wins for the first time since winning 29 in 1982-83.
- Give Virginia 13 combined road/neutral wins for the first time since 18 in 1982-83.
- Give Virginia its fourth ACC Tournament win over Duke (1973, 1983 and 1994).
- Give Virginia a win over all 14 other ACC teams this season.
- Give Virginia 74 wins over the last three seasons, its most in a three-year period since 80 wins from 1982-84.

2013-14 TEAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Virginia won its sixth ACC regular-season title (second outright) and gained its second No. 1 seed for the ACC Tournament.
- Virginia's 16-2 ACC record is a program-best and ties the ACC record for most league wins in a season (1998-99 Duke).
- With 27 wins, Virginia is one of three teams (NC Central & Southeast Missouri State) in the nation to improve its win total in each of the past five seasons.
- Virginia secured its third consecutive ACC winning season (16-2, 11-7, 9-7) for the first time since 1981-83.
- Virginia secured its third straight 20-win season for the first time since 1991-93.
- UVa set a school record with 12 ACC wins by 10 or more points.
- With 16 ACC wins, Virginia became the second ACC school to improve its ACC record in five consecutive seasons (Georgia Tech under Bobby Cremins from 1982-86).
- UVa has won a school-record 18 straight ACC home games.
- UVa set a school record with 13 consecutive ACC wins.
- Virginia won a school-record seven ACC road contests.

ALL-TIME IN THE ACC TOURNAMENT

- Virginia is 33-59 all-time in the ACC Tournament.
- UVa has a two-game ACC Tournament winning streak after entering the tournament on a four-game losing streak.
- Virginia is 15-24 in ACC Tournament games in Greensboro.
- The Cavaliers are 1-5 all-time in the ACC Tournament final.

ALL-TIME AGAINST DUKE

- UVa meets Duke for the 166th time overall and 19th time in the ACC Tournament in a series that dates back to 1910-11.
- Virginia is 49-116 all-time vs. Duke, including a 69-65 loss at Cameron Indoor Stadium on Jan. 13.
- The Cavaliers are 1-4 in their last five games vs. Duke and 1-9 in their last 10.
- Virginia defeated Duke 73-68 last season in Charlottesville behind Joe Harris' career-high 36 points.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 1-6 all-time against Duke at UVa.

LAST TIME VS. DUKE

- The Cavaliers lost 69-65 at Duke on Jan. 13.
- Rasheed Sulaimon tallied 21 points off the bench, including the go-ahead 3-pointer with 18.8 seconds left, and Amile Jefferson (10 points and 15 rebounds) clinched the win with a pair of free throws with 6.8 seconds left after Virginia erased an 11-point deficit.
- Malcolm Brogdon had 17 points and Joe Harris added 15 for UVa.
- Virginia outrebounded Duke, 34-31, behind Akil Mitchell's team-high nine rebounds.

LAST TIME IN THE ACC TOURNAMENT FINAL

- Virginia suffered a 73-66 loss to North Carolina in the 1994 ACC Tournament final at the Charlotte Coliseum.
- Harold Deane led Virginia with a game-high 19 points and UVa assistant coach Jason Williford had six points and three assists.

LAST TIME OUT

- Anthony Gill hit two free throws with 8.5 seconds left to help Virginia hold off Pittsburgh 51-48 in Saturday's semifinals.
- Justin Anderson secured the win with a block on James Robinson's 3-point attempt with three seconds left.
- Joe Harris led UVa with 12 points, while Malcolm Brogdon and Anthony Gill each added 10 points.
- Akil Mitchell had eight points and eight rebounds for UVa.
- Talib Zanna and Lamar Patterson had 15 points apiece for Pitt.

TEAM NOTES

- Virginia is 5-0 at neutral sites this season.
- Virginia's 27 wins are its most since 29 in 1982-83.
- UVa has held 20 consecutive opponents under 50 percent shooting.

PLAYER NOTES

- Joe Harris (1,639 points) needs eight points to pass John Crotty (1988-91, 1,646 points) for 12th place on UVa's all-time scoring list.
- Akil Mitchell moved into ninth place on Virginia's all-time rebounding list with eight rebounds in the win over Pitt.
