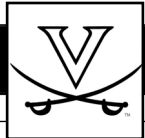

#### 2009-10 SEASON:

- Virginia finished the 2009-10 season with an overall record of 15-16
- The Cavaliers compiled a 5-11 record in the Atlantic Coast Conference and finished tied for ninth in the ACC regular season standings

#### 2010 ACC TOURNAMENT:

- Virginia defeated Boston College 68-62 in the first round of the 2010 ACC Tournament as five players scored in double figures, led by Sammy Zeglinski's 21 points and a double-double by Mike Scott who had 11 points and 13 rebounds
- The Cavaliers' 2009-10 season ended with a 57-46 loss to Duke in the ACC Tournament quarterfinals
- Jeff Jones scored 15 points and Mike Scott had his second consecutive double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds against Duke

#### 70 WAS A MAGIC NUMBER:

- Scoring 70 points was the magic number for the Cavaliers in 2009-10
- Virginia was 11-1 when scoring at least 70 points and 4-15 when scoring less than 70 points

#### MEYINSSE AND SHERRILL NAMED TO ALL-ACADEMIC TEAM:

- Senior forward/center Jerome Meyinsse and junior forward Will Sherrill were named to the All-ACC Men's Basketball Academic Team
- It is the third consecutive year Meyinsse has been named to the team
- Meyinsse also was one of 36 ACC student-athletes to receive a Weaver-James-Corrigan scholarship

#### CAVALIERS SURPASS WIN TOTALS:

- Virginia surpassed its win total of 10 from the 2008-09 season with 15 during the 2009-10 season
- UVa had five ACC wins in 2009-10, one more than the previous season (four)

#### TAKING CARE OF THE BALL:

- Virginia ranked 13th nationally in fewest turnovers a game at 10.7 turnovers per game in 2009-10
- In 2008-09, the Cavaliers averaged 14.8 tpg, ranking 242nd nationally
- Virginia had 10 or fewer turnovers in 15 games in 2009-10
- UVa ranked 32nd nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.21
- The previous season, UVa ranked 245th nationally with a 0.84 A/TO ratio

- Received one of UVa's ACC Scholar-Athlete Awards for academic excellence and performance with distinction as a member of a varsity team
- Co-recipient of the Susan J. Grossman Memorial Award in recognition of outstanding service to student-athletes and contributions to the Student-Athlete Mentor Program
- Received the Ernest H. Ern, Jr., Award for outstanding contributions to student life at Virginia by an intercollegiate athlete
- Received one of Virginia's Top VI Awards which are presented to six student-athletes who have given the most in terms of service to the University and Charlottesville communities

**Will Sherrill – Junior – Forward**

- Named to the All-Atlantic Coast Conference Men's Basketball Academic Team

**THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON:**

- Virginia ranked second in the ACC and 18th nationally in free throw percentage at 74.8 percent (386-516)
- It was Virginia's highest FT% for a season since the 1978-79 team led the ACC that year at 76.2 percent
- UVa shot 75.8 percent from the line (194-256) in ACC play in 2009-10, best in the conference
- Virginia shot at least 80 percent from the line in 10 games during the 2009-10 season and at least 90 percent in three games
- From the 12:57 mark of the second half at NC State (1/9) to the 5:56 mark of the first half vs. Georgia Tech (1/13), the Cavaliers made 22 consecutive free throws as a team
- Four different Cavaliers had a free throw streak of at least 10 makes in 2009-10

**AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA:**

- Virginia is 49-22 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers were 11-6 at JPJA during the 2009-10 season

**PASS THE ROCK:**

- Virginia had four players in 2009-10 with at least 50 assists (Sammy Zeglinski, Sylvan Landesberg, Jontel Evans, Mustapha Farrakhan), the first time the Cavaliers have had that many players accumulate 50 assists since four players accomplished the feat in 1997-98 (Willie Dersch, Donald Hand, Chezley Watson, Curtis Staples)
- The Cavaliers had assists on 55.0 percent of their field goals in 2009-10, their highest percentage since 2003-04 (55.8 percent)

**DEFENSE!!! ... DEFENSE!!! ... DEFENSE!!!:**

- Virginia ranked third in the ACC and 54th nationally in points allowed per game at 63.6 ppg
- It is an 8.9 ppg improvement from the previous season when UVa allowed 72.5 ppg, which ranked 294th nationally

**SHARP SHOOTING 'HOOS:**

- Against Maryland on Mar. 6 the Cavaliers shot 53.1 percent from the floor, the eighth time in 2009-10 they shot at least 50.0 percent from the field
- In 2008-09, UVa shot 50.0 percent just four times all season (28 games)

**LONG RANGE FIRING:**

- Against both Penn State and Cleveland State, the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent from 3-point range
- Against Penn State, Virginia shot 53.3 percent (8-15) from 3-point range
- Against Cleveland State, Virginia shot 58.8 percent (10-17) from 3-point range
- It was the first time the Cavaliers shot over 50.0 percent from long range in consecutive games since doing it against Ohio and Tennessee in 2000-01
- Virginia also shot over 50.0 percent from 3-point range vs. Texas-Pan American (7-12, 58.3 percent)

### **PARTY LIKE IT'S 1995:**

- The 2009-10 team accomplished several feats that haven't been done at Virginia since the 1994-95 season
- Virginia's first 3-0 start in the ACC since 1994-95
- UVa was the last unbeaten team in ACC play for the first time since 1994-95
- The last time UVa had three ranked wins 15 games into a season was in 1994-95
- That 1994-95 team included UVa assistant coach Jason Williford, UVa strength and conditioning coach Mike Curtis and UVa radio analyst Cory Alexander

### **'HOOS HONORED BY ANDY KATZ:**

- Virginia was honored as the ESPN.com Weekly Watch Team of the Week on Jan. 18 in Andy Katz's weekly column
- The Cavaliers defeated #20 Georgia Tech and #23 Miami the previous week

### **HISTORIC NIGHT IN THE DEAN DOME:**

- Virginia set several marks in its 75-60 win at North Carolina on Jan. 31
- The 15-point margin was UVa's largest ever in Chapel Hill
- It was the most lopsided home loss of the Roy Williams' era at UNC

### **MEYINSSE SHINES:**

- Jerome Meyinsse developed into a strong inside presence for the Cavaliers in ACC play during the 2009-10 season
- In ACC play, he averaged 8.1 points and 4.6 rebounds per game in 2009-10, after averaging 0.9 point and 1.0 rebound per game in ACC play over his first three seasons
- He had a career-high 21 points and tied an ACC career high with seven rebounds vs. Duke on Feb. 28
- At Boston College on Mar. 3 he had 12 points on 6-6 FGs
- Against Maryland on Mar. 6 he had 17 points on 7-8 FGs
- Meyinsse scored in double figures in five of the last six games of the season

### **MEYINSSE'S BIG GAME AGAINST DUKE:**

- Jerome Meyinsse had a career-high 21 points vs. Duke on Feb. 28
- His 21 points were more than he had his entire freshman season (17)
- His 21 points were one shy of the 22 points he scored in ACC play during his first three seasons combined

### **SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP:**

- Mike Scott had double-doubles in both of Virginia's games in the 2010 ACC Tournament and now has 18 in his collegiate career
- He scored 11 points and tied his season high with 13 rebounds vs. Boston College in the first round
- He scored 14 points and had 11 rebounds in the ACC quarterfinal game against Duke
- His 18 double-doubles rank 12th in school history

### **EVANS A PROTECTOR AND THIEF:**

- Jontel Evans had 34 steals in 2009-10 to just 27 turnovers
- His +7 steals-to-turnovers comparison was best in the ACC in 2009-10
- He was the only player in the ACC with a minimum of 20 steals in 2009-10 to have more steals than turnovers

### **ZEGLINSKI FROM DEEP:**

- Sammy Zeglinski led Virginia in three-point field goals during the 2009-10 season for the second consecutive season
- Zeglinski made 61 three-point field goals in 2009-10 and shot 37.7 percent (61-162) from three-point range
- In 2008-09 Zeglinski led the team with 33 three-point field goals.
- Zeglinski shot 31.4 percent (33-105) from three-point range during the 2008-09 season

### **FARRAKHAN AND SHERRILL PLAY MANY MORE MINUTES:**

- Mustapha Farrakhan and Will Sherrill played significantly more minutes in 2009-10 than they did during the 2008-09 season
- Farrakhan played in 30 games, starting 10, in 2009-10 and averaged 21.0 minutes played and 6.5 points a game
- Farrakhan played in 23 games, starting two, in 2008-09 and averaged 10.4 minutes and 4.3 points a game
- Sherrill played in 30 games in 2009-10, starting seven, and averaged 15.4 minutes and 3.0 points a game
- Sherrill played in 10 games in 2008-09 and averaged 1.9 minutes and 0.1 points a game

### **SCOTT LEADING REBOUNDER AGAIN:**

- Mike Scott was Virginia's leading rebounder for the second consecutive season in 2009-10
- Scott averaged 7.2 rebounds a game to lead the team in 2009-10
- Scott led the team with an average of 7.4 rebounds a game in 2008-09

### **CAVALIERS SHOOT WELL AGAINST LONGWOOD:**

- The Cavaliers shot 60.0% (30-50) from the field vs. Longwood
- It marked the first time Virginia shot 60.0% or higher since shooting 61.0% (36-59) against Long Island on Nov. 17, 2000

### **DEFENSE SHINES AGAINST NJIT:**

- The UVa defense put up a strong performance in the 68-37 win over NJIT
- NJIT's 37 points were the fewest allowed by the Cavaliers since 1996-97 (34 vs. UMBC) and is tied for the second fewest allowed in the shot clock era
- NJIT's 13 made FGs is tied for the fourth lowest total allowed by the Cavaliers since 1953
- NJIT's 27.1% shooting (13-48) was the lowest percentage allowed by the Cavaliers since Longwood shot 25.8% (16-62) against the Cavaliers on Feb. 13, 2007

### **SHERRILL EN FUEGO SOUTH OF THE BORDER:**

- Against Cleveland State in Cancun, junior forward Will Sherrill had his career game
- He set career highs with 18 points, seven FGs, four 3FGs, two assists, three steals and tied a career high with six rebounds
- Prior to the game, Sherrill had scored just 15 points in his career, and his career high in a game was three points

- Two-time Mid-Continent Conference Player of the Year
- Finished career as the all-time leading scorer in conference history with 2,285 points
- Still the NCAA career 3-point percentage leader at 49.7 percent
- 1992 Frances Pomeroy Naismith Award (best senior player under six-feet tall)
- 1992 GTE Academic All-American of the Year
- Played three seasons in the NBA with Charlotte Hornets (1992-95)

#### **JPJA RECOGNIZED:**

- John Paul Jones Arena was named the best new college basketball arena of the decade by SI.com
- The arena was recognized in Seth Davis' story about the highlights of the decade

#### **SIX SIGN WITH VIRGINIA:**

- UVa signed six players to National Letters of Intent for the 2010 recruiting class
- The six players are 6-1 guard Billy Baron of E. Greenwich, R.I.; 6-4 guard K.T. Harrell of Montgomery, Ala.; 6-6 guard Joe Harris from Chelan, Wash.; 6-9 forward James Johnson of Wildomar, Calif.; 6-7 wing Akil Mitchell of Charlotte, N.C.; and 6-8 forward Will Regan of Williamsville, N.Y.

#### **LANDESBERG NOT RETURNING TO VIRGINIA:**

- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett announced on March 23 that guard Sylven Landesberg was leaving the University of Virginia
- Landesberg left to pursue his professional aspirations
- Landesberg scored 930 points (16.9 ppg.), had 301 rebounds (5.5 rpg.) and 155 assists (2.8 apg.) during his two seasons in the Virginia program
- He was the ACC Rookie of the Year in 2008-09 and a second-team All-ACC selection in 2009-10

#### **SPURLOCK LEAVING VIRGINIA PROGRAM:**

- Guard/forward Tristan Spurlock is leaving the Virginia program
- Spurlock and UVa head coach Tony Bennett mutually agreed on the decision
- Spurlock played in 13 games for the Cavaliers in 2009-10, scoring 31 points and grabbing 10 rebounds

#### **JONES LEAVING VIRGINIA PROGRAM:**

- Guard Jeff Jones is leaving the Virginia program
- UVa head coach Tony Bennett announced Jones' departure on April 6
- Jones played in all 31 of the Cavaliers' games in 2009-10, starting seven, and averaged 7.3 points and 1.3 rebounds a game while shooting 43.5 percent (40-92) from three-point range and 78.9 percent (45-57) from the free throw line
- During his three years in the Virginia program, Jones played in 90 games, starting 41, and averaged 6.2 points and 1.6 rebounds a game
