FOR OPENERS

- Virginia has won nine straight games and meets Virginia Tech for the second time this season.
- Virginia ranks No. 1 nationally in scoring defense at 55.6 ppg.
- Virginia's 12-1 start in the ACC is its best since starting 12-1 in 1981-82.
- Virginia's 21-5 record is its best through 26 games since 1982-83 (23-3).
- As of Feb. 17, Virginia is second in the ACC at 12-1 and Virginia Tech is tied for 14th at 2-10.

- The Cavaliers are 18-28, including a 5-14 mark at Cassell Coliseum, against the Hokies in Blacksburg.
- The Cavaliers have won four straight games against Virginia Tech, including a 65-45 decision on Jan. 25, and six of the last seven contests in the series.
- Virginia posted a 74-58 win in Blacksburg last season behind Evan Nolte's career-high 18 points.
- Virginia is 4-1 against Virginia Tech in its last five games.

A WIN AT VIRGINIA TECH WOULD GIVE...

- Virginia its first 10-game ACC winning streak since 1981-82.
- Virginia a school-record seven ACC road wins.
- Virginia its first 13-1 start in the ACC since going 13-1 in 1980-81.
- Virginia 13 ACC wins for the second time in school history (13-1 in 1980-81).
- Virginia 10 combined road/neutral wins for the first time since 1994-95 (11).
- Virginia its fifth straight win vs. Virginia Tech.
- Virginia its fourth straight win vs. the Hokies at Cassell Coliseum and second straight two-game regular-season series sweep.

MORE 2013-14 TEAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Virginia has clinched its third consecutive winning season (12-1, 11-7, 9-7) in ACC play for the first time since 1981-83.
- Virginia has secured its third straight 20-win season for the first time since 1991-93.
- Nine of Virginia's ACC wins are by 10 or more points, tying the school record for ACC double-digit wins (nine, 1982-83).
- With 12 ACC wins, Virginia became the second ACC school to improve its ACC record in five consecutive seasons (Georgia Tech under Bobby Cremins from 1982-86).
- Virginia has six ACC road wins for the first time since 1982-83.

ALL-TIME AGAINST VIRGINIA TECH

- Virginia is 85-53 all-time vs. Virginia Tech in the series that dates back to 1914-15.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 6-3 all-time vs. Virginia Tech.

EMBRACE THE PACE

- As of Feb. 16, the Cavaliers rank in the top 10 nationally in seven defensive categories: points per game (1st), points per possession (4th), offensive rebound percentage (4th), offensive rebounds per game (6th), rebounds per game (6th), true shooting percentage (7th) and field goal percentage (8th).
- Virginia has held 24 of its 26 opponents below 50 percent shooting from the floor and opponents are shooting 38.4 percent (8th nationally) from the floor and 32.0 percent from 3-point range overall.
- The Cavaliers have held 29 straight ACC opponents under 50 percent shooting from the field.
- Virginia has limited its opponents to a combined 90 fast break points for an average of 3.5 per game.

TEAM NOTES

- Virginia is 17-1 when leading at the half and 21-3 when opponents shoot less than 50 percent from the field.
- The Cavaliers lead the ACC in scoring defense (54.5 ppg), scoring margin (+13.0), field goal percentage defense (38.8%), rebounding defense (29.7), defensive rebound percentage (74.5%) and turnover margin (+3.69) during league play.
- UVa is sixth in the ACC in scoring offense at 67.5 points per game, marking its highest ACC average under Tony Bennett (63.9 ppg in 2012-13).
- Virginia is averaging 8.5 turnovers during league play compared to 12.9 during non-conference action
- The Cavaliers have committed nine or fewer turnovers in nine of their last 11 games.
- Virginia has shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line in 10 of 26 games and its 65.5 percent free throw percentage is its lowest since shooting 65.3 percent in 1997-98.
- The Cavaliers are 16-1 with their current starting lineup of London Perrantes, Malcolm Brogdon, Joe Harris, Akil Mitchell and Mike Tobey.
- Virginia captured the Corpus Christi Challenge earlier this season with wins over Liberty, Hampton, SMU and Missouri State.

PLAYER NOTES

- Joe Harris leads all active ACC players with 241 career 3-pointers.
- Harris (1,562 career points) became the 17th Cavalier to reach 1,500 career points with 11 at Pittsburgh (2/2/14).
- Malcolm Brogdon's 12.3 scoring average leads the team and would be the lowest UVa team scoring leader in 61 seasons of ACC action.
- Brogdon (74-of-82, 90.2 percent) and London Perrantes (31-of-38, 81.6 percent) are a combined 105-of-120 (87.5 percent) from the free throw line, while the rest of the team is 276-for-462 (59.7 percent).
- Brogdon leads the ACC in free throw percentage (90.0 percent) and Perrantes leads the ACC with in assist/turnover ratio (4.67) in league action.

HARRIS AND MITCHELL LEAD CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Returning All-ACC members Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell are Virginia's team leaders.
- Last season, Harris averaged a career-high 16.3 points and Mitchell added career bests with 13.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game.
- Harris is 14th on UVa's all-time scoring list with 1,562 points and Mitchell ranks 12th with 716 career rebounds.
- In 2013-14 with a balanced attack, Harris is averaging 11.8 points, while Mitchell is averaging 6.9 points and 6.8 rebounds.
- In 13 ACC games, Harris ranks second in 3-point field goal percentage (47.0 percent) and fifth in made 3-pointers per game (2.38), while Mitchell is second in defensive rebounds (5.77 per game) and seventh in rebounding (8.2 per game).

CLEANING THE GLASS

- Virginia has outrebounded its opponents in 20 of 26 games and is 17-3 when outrebounding its opponent.
- The Cavaliers rank 13th nationally in rebound percentage at 55.0 percent and have a +7.1 average rebound margin per game.
- Akil Mitchell (6.8), Malcolm Brogdon (5.8), Mike Tobey (4.2), Anthony Gill (4.0), Justin Anderson (3.5) and Joe Harris (3.1) are each averaging three or more rebounds per game.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 97-58 mark in five seasons at UVA and 166-91 record in eight seasons of coaching.
- Bennett has led Virginia to three consecutive winning seasons in ACC play for the first time since 1981-83.
- Under Bennett, Virginia has become the second ACC school to improve its ACC record in five consecutive seasons.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to the NCAA Tournament in 2012 and NIT in 2013.
- Bennett has increased UVa's win total in each of the last four seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12 and 23 in 2013-13).
- He has guided Virginia to 11 or more ACC wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time since back-to-back 12 ACC-win seasons in 1982-83.
- Bennett guided Washington State to a pair of NCAA Tournaments and the NIT in three seasons and was the National Coach of the Year in 2007.
- Bennett is 58-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his eight-year collegiate coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have finished in the top five nationally in scoring defense in four of seven seasons (1st in 2008-09; second in 2007-08 and 2011-12, and fifth in 2012-13). UVa ranks first this season at 55.6 points per game.
- Bennett is one of 23 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

PAINT IT ORANGE AND BLUE

- UVa has outscored its opponents in the paint in 21 of 26 games.
- Virginia, which is outscoring its opponents 756-540 in the paint, has scored 44.0 percent of its points in the paint.
- A post player has led UVa in scoring in six of 23 games (Gill 13 vs. JMU, 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU; Tobey 18 vs. Davidson and 16 at NC State).

OFF THE BENCH

- Virginia is outscoring opponents 606-421 in bench points, averaging 23.3 per game.
- A bench player has led the team in scoring in six games (Tobey 18 vs. Davidson, Gill 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU and Anderson 23 vs. Missouri State and 16 at Florida State).

MALCOLM BACK IN THE MIDDLE

- Redshirt sophomore guard Malcolm Brogdon returned to action against JMU (11/8/13) after missing the 2012-13 season and the last four games of 2011-12 with a foot injury.
- Brogdon is averaging team highs in points (12.3 ppg), steals (1.4 spg) and free throw percentage (90.2%), and is second in rebounding (5.8 rpg) and 3-point field goal percentage (39.3%).
- Brogdon has tallied a career-best 13 consecutive games of double figures scoring from Jan. 4-Feb. 15.
- Brogdon tallied career highs in points (18) and 3-pointers (4) vs. Virginia Tech (1/25/14).
- He tallied his first career double-double with 17 points, 11 rebounds (career high) and seven assists (career high) vs. Boston College (2/5/14).
- Brogdon had his second career double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds (career high) at Georgia Tech (2/8/14).
- In 13 ACC games, Brogdon ranks first in free throw percentage (90.0%), sixth in field goal percentage (46.2%), ninth in steals (1.46

• He averaged 6.7 points in 28 games as a freshman in 2011-12.

LONDON CALLING

- Freshman London Parrantes has made an immediate impact during his freshman campaign at UVa.
- Parrantes is three assists shy of becoming the fourth Cavalier freshman to record 100 assists in a season (Cory Alexander, Jeff Jones and Sean Singletary).
- Parrantes, who has started 22 games, is averaging 4.1 points, 2.2 rebounds and a team-leading 3.7 assists per game.
- Parrantes had a career-high 14 points at Florida State (1/4/14) and career-best nine assists vs. North Carolina (1/20/14).
- Parrantes, who ranks third in the ACC in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.45), has tallied five or more assists in 10 games.
- He leads the ACC action in assist-to-turnover ratio (4.67) and ranks fifth in assists (4.31 apg).

ANDERSON PROVING HIS WORTH AS A SIXTH MAN

- Justin Anderson, who has reached double figures in 13 games, is a valuable sixth man for UVa.
- Anderson, who has led UVa in scoring in five games, is averaging 9.0 points and 3.5 rebounds per game.
- He reached double figures in six consecutive games (Dec. 7-Jan. 8) and has led the team in scoring in five games (23 points vs. Missouri State, 16 vs. Northern Iowa, 14 points vs. Norfolk State, 11 at Tennessee and 16 at Florida State).
- Anderson also earned Corpus Christi Challenge all-tournament honors after averaging 12 points in four wins during the tournament.
- He was one of two players in NCAA Division I to record 20 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in a game last season, joining South Alabama's Mychal Ammons who also accomplished the rare feat.

TOBEY, TOBEY, TOBEY...CAN DO IT AGAIN

- Mike Tobey has shown the ability to be Virginia's go-to man, averaging 7.2 points, 4.2 rebounds and a team-leading 1.1 blocks per game.
- He tallied a season-high 18 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and ACC-high 16 at NC State (1/11/14) and had a career-high nine rebounds vs. VCU (11/12/13).
- Tobey has started 17 games and scored in double figures nine times.

A.G. MAKING SUCCESSFUL TRANSFER

- Redshirt sophomore Anthony Gill made his UVa debut against JMU (11/8/13) after sitting out last season as a transfer from South Carolina.

- Gill has led UVa in scoring in four games, including 13 vs. JMU (11/8/13), 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting against Navy (11/19/13), 13 vs. Liberty (11/23/13) and a career-high 19 vs. SMU (11/29/13).
- Gill, who earned Corpus Christi Challenge All-Tournament honors, is shooting a team-leading 62.1 percent from the floor (72-of-116) and averaging 7.7 points and 4.0 rebounds per game this season.
- He has scored in double figures in nine games, including an ACC-high 13 points vs. Boston College (2/5/14).
- Gill averaged 7.6 points and 4.7 rebounds per game as a freshman for South Carolina in 2011-12.

ABOUT THE 2013-14 SCHEDULE

- Three of Virginia's opponents are currently ranked in the national polls (Syracuse, Duke and Wisconsin), while North Carolina, SMU, Pittsburgh, VCU and Green Bay received votes.
- Twelve opponents (JMU, VCU, Davidson, Liberty, Wisconsin, NC State, Duke, North Carolina, Pittsburgh, Notre Dame, Miami and Syracuse) earned 2013 NCAA Tournament berths, while four (Norfolk State, Tennessee, Florida State and Maryland) participated in the National Invitation Tournament and two (Northern Iowa and Green Bay) in the CollegenInsider.com Tournament.

VIRGINIA PICKED 4TH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball.
- UVa, who was picked seventh and tied for fourth last season, has finished at or higher than its predicted finish in each of the last four seasons.

PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the visiting coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after Coach Bennett is done with his postgame press conference.
