VIRGINIA AND VIRGINIA TECH MEET AGAIN

- Virginia holds a 98-82 advantage in the all-time series with the Hokies.
- UVA swept Virginia Tech in a three-game series in Charlottesville to conclude the 2016 regular season.
- UVA has lost three of its last four series in Blacksburg.
- UVA head coach Brian O'Connor is 25-10 against Virginia Tech.
- Adam Haseley has hit .360 (9-25) in six career games against the Hokies, while Ernie Clement has gone 8-for-24 (.333).

HASELEY, SMITH NAMED TO MIDSEASON GOLDEN SPIKES WATCH LIST

- Virginia's junior duo of Adam Haseley and Pavin Smith has been named to the 40-man midseason watch list for the Golden Spikes Award.
- UVA is one of six schools to have two players on the list.
- Haseley was named to the midseason watch list for the second year in a row.
- The semifinalists will be named May 31, with the finalists unveiled on June 14. The trophy will be presented June 29 in Los Angeles.

CAVALIERS PUSH THE RUNNING GAME

- Virginia is 56-for-63 in stolen-base attempts this year (second in ACC to Louisville, 57).
- UVA ranks 17th nationally in stolen bases.
- Four Cavaliers already have at least seven stolen bases. UVA's leader in 2016 was Ernie Clement with six.
- Jake McCarthy has an ACC-best 20 steals in 21 tries. He ranks fourth nationally.
- It marks the most steals for a UVA player since Phil Gosselin had 24 in 2009.
- UVA stole 27 bases in 60 games last year, its fewest stolen bases during the Brian O'Connor era.

PAVIN SMITH: NOT YOUR PROTOTYPICAL POWER HITTER

- Pavin Smith has put up some big numbers in the first half of the season, hitting for power as well as contact.
- The reigning ACC Player of the Week, Smith ranks as the fourth toughest to strike out of any player in Division I, with five strikeouts in 139 official at bats (160 plate appearances).
- He is tied for 22nd nationally with 10 home runs.
- Only one other player among the top 40 nationally in home runs has fewer than 14 strikeouts – UVA's Adam Haseley with 13.

THINGS TO KNOW

- UVA is 127-28-1, including 6-0 this year, against in-state opponents under O'Connor (since 2004).
- UVA is playing for the second time this year on FieldTurf (George Washington, March 7).
- Robbie Coman and Cameron Simmons each are sporting eight-game hit streaks.
- UVA is No. 7 in the latest RPI (VT is No. 107).
- Virginia ranks second nationally in hits (395).
- UVA leads the ACC in batting in all games (.325) and ACC games (.302) and is seventh nationally.
- Adam Haseley tops the ACC in batting (.402) and runs (43).
- UVA has faced four of the ACC's top five teams in ERA (Louisville, UNC, Clemson, Pitt).

POWER PLAY

- After racking up 10 home runs in five games last week, Virginia has hit 40 home runs, which already ranks as the fifth most in the Brian O'Connor era.
- The Cavaliers hit 42 home runs in 2016 (60 games).
- The top home run seasons under O'Connor: 2010 (61), 2009 (59) and 2013 (43).
- Ten Cavaliers have gone deep this year, and UVA is fourth in the ACC in home runs.
- Pavin Smith and Adam Haseley are tied for sixth in the ACC with 10 long balls.

HASELEY CONTINUES STRONG 2017

- Adam Haseley is putting up team highs in batting (.402), extra-base hits (18) and on base percentage (.503) while hitting in the 3-hole.
- Haseley owns 10 home runs – seven of which have gone to the opposite field.
- He leads the ACC in batting and runs, is second in total bases, OBP and slugging, third in hits, fifth in walks and sixth in home runs.
- Haseley also is 5-1 with a 3.54 ERA in 48 1/3 innings on the mound. He is eighth in the ACC in innings.

TIME TO ... GO TO WORK!

- Pavin Smith and Adam Haseley are the first UVA teammates to each record at least 10 homers in a season since Phil Gosselin (11), Jarrett Parker (10) and Steven Proscia (10) in 2010.
- They are tied for sixth in the ACC in home runs.
- With 25 career homers, Smith is one round-tripper from reaching the top 10 in program history. He also has cracked the top 10 in RBI at 150.

NOTING THE PITT SERIES

- Virginia limited Pitt to six runs and 11 hits in sweeping the series.
- Cameron Simmons was 7-for-12 (.583) with three straight multi-hit games, while Robbie Coman was 5-for-11 with a homer and four RBI.
- UVA trailed for just one half inning in three games.
- Caleb Knight homered in the Saturday and Sunday wins.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

- Virginia hits the road for just the second time since its March 17-19 series at Clemson.
- UVA is 7-4 away from home this year (2-0 neutral).
- UVA finished 11-8 in true road games in 2016 and was 14-10 away from home.

OFFENSE LOOKS TO KEEP HUMMING

- Virginia tops the ACC in batting in all games (.325) as well as ACC games (.296), despite facing four of the conference's top five teams in ERA in the first half of ACC play (Louisville, North Carolina, Clemson, Pitt).
- In ranking ninth nationally in scoring at 8.0 runs per game, UVA is second among all Division I teams in hits (395) and seventh in batting.

WHATEVER IT TAKES

- A key part of Virginia's scoring numbers has come from execution.
- UVA is tied for No. 3 nationally in sacrifice flies with 23 and ninth in sacrifice bunts with 32.
- UVA also has been hit by 42 pitches, which is fourth most in the conference and 31st nationally.

AGGRESSIVE CAVALIERS PUT BALL IN PLAY

- Virginia batters have struck out an ACC-low 128 times in 35 games (3.6 strikeouts per game).
- That total by far the fewest among ACC teams (Louisville, 184), and less than half the total of seven teams.
- UVA is the only ACC team to walk more than it has struck out (138 BB).
- The Cavaliers have struck out five or fewer times in 30 of 34 games.
- Ernie Clement (third), Pavin Smith (fourth) and Robbie Coman (10th) all rank among the top 10 nationally in toughest to strike out and are the three toughest in the ACC.

BIG INNINGS PLAGUE CAVALIERS

- Virginia has given up 13 innings of four or more runs this year, including eight in ACC play.
- In five of UVA's six ACC defeats, the Cavaliers have given up at least one inning of four-plus runs.
- UVA allowed 12 innings of four or more runs in 2016 and 16 in 2015.

WEBER GIVES LINEUP BOOST AT SECOND BASE

- Andy Weber has started each of the last 22 games and 25 of the last 26 at second base, allowing Ernie Clement to shift to shortstop.
- He has hits in 18 of the 22 starts, with 25 RBI (second on the team) in that stretch of 25 games.
- Weber is tied for third on the team with 28 RBI despite having 101 at-bats, which is seventh on the team.

O'CONNOR REACHES 600 WINS

- Brian O'Connor won his 600th career game on Feb. 21 against VMI. He was the 10th coach in ACC history to reach the 600-win plateau and, in 825 games, was the second-fastest in league history to reach 600 wins (Mike Martin, 802 games).

- Now with 623 career wins, O'Connor ranks ninth in league history.
- The winningest coach in program history, O'Connor also holds the UVA record for career ACC wins (252) and NCAA tournament wins (47).

IN THE POLLS

- Virginia is ranked as high as No. 12 in the latest polls (USA Today Coaches poll).
- UVA is 3-6 against ranked teams this year, all of whom currently are ranked in the top five.
- UVA has 12 games scheduled against teams currently ranked in the USA Today poll: Louisville (2), Clemson (4), North Carolina (5), Florida State (25).
- The Cavaliers do not play Wake Forest (22) in league play this year.

RECORDS WATCH

- Having pitched in 73 career games, RHP Alec Bettinger has tied Matt Packer (2007-09) for 10th in UVA history.
- With 10 career saves, he needs two saves to reach the top 10 in UVA history.
- Adam Haseley stands 10th in school history with 160 runs scored and needs one to match No. 9 Jarrett Parker (2008-10) and two to pull even with No. 8 John Hicks (2009-11).
- Haseley is ninth in program history with 10 triples and will move into a fifth-place tie with his next triple.
- Pavin Smith (25 HR) is one long ball shy of the top 10 at UVA and with 150 RBI is 10th in program history (needs four for 9th).
- Ernie Clement (8 triples) is one triple shy of the top 10 at UVA.
- Jake McCarthy (20 SB) needs one stolen base to reach ninth in the single-season UVA annals.

CAVALIERS WRAP UP HOME STRETCH

- On Tuesday Virginia finished a stretch in which it played 14 of 15 games at home at Davenport Field.
- UVA was 11-3 during that span at home.
- The Cavaliers are 20-4 at home this season.
- UVA played three straight ACC series at home, the first time the Cavaliers hosted three straight home ACC series since the 2001 season.
- Virginia is 397-99 (.800) at Davenport Field since 2004.

HOOS IN THE PROS

- Virginia had seven alumni on MLB Opening Day rosters, most among ACC schools and tied for fifth most nationally.
- The three 2015 UVA draftees all have moved up: Matt Thaiss (high-A Island Empire 66ers), Connor Jones (high-A Palm Beach Cardinals) and Daniel Pinero (class-A West Michigan Whitecaps).
- Joe McCarthy opened 2017 with the double-A Montgomery Biscuits, while Stephen Bruno moved up to the triple-A Iowa Cubs.

TRIO OF PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

- Three Cavaliers were named to various All-America teams in the preseason: Ernie Clement (2B), Adam Haseley (UTL) and Pavin Smith (1B).
- Haseley and Smith also were named to the 55-man Golden Spikes Award Watch List.
- The Preseason All-America honors:
 - **Ernie Clement:** 1st team (D1Baseball), 2nd team (Baseball America)
 - **Adam Haseley:** 2nd team (Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball, D1Baseball)

O'CONNOR RANKS THIRD IN ACTIVE WIN PCT., 18TH ALL-TIME

- Virginia head coach Brian O'Connor is 623-231-2 (.729) in his 14th season as UVA's head coach.
- O'Connor surpassed Dennis Womack (594 wins, 1981-2003) as the winningest coach in program history on May 28, 2016, against Louisville.
- O'Connor's 72.7 percent winning percentage entering the season ranked No. 3 among active Division I head coaches.
- O'Connor also ranks 18th all-time in career winning percentage among all coaches with at least 10 years of head coaching experience.
- Virginia won at least 38 games in each of O'Connor's first 13 seasons, including 10 40-win seasons and four 50-win campaigns.

LONGEVITY, STABILITY IN COACHING STAFF

- Virginia's coaching trio of Brian O'Connor, Kevin McMullan and Karl Kuhn are in their 14th year together.
- No current coaching staff in Division I college baseball has been together longer.
- The staff has combined for 623 wins, an average of over 45 wins per season, and has reached the NCAA tournament in each of their first 13 seasons.

UVA SECOND NATIONALLY IN ERA SINCE 2005

- Entering the season, Virginia owned the second best ERA among all NCAA Division I teams over the past 12 seasons with a 3.17 team ERA since 2005.
- UVA finished second nationally in ERA (2.23) in 2014 and has ranked among the NCAA top 20 in nine of the 13 years under the current coaching staff.
- Virginia led the nation in ERA in 2011 (2.24) and posted No. 3 marks in 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2009.

DEFENSE TOPS ACC UNDER CURRENT STAFF

- Virginia has posted the ACC's best fielding percentage since the current coaching staff arrived in 2004.
- UVA has accrued a .973 fielding percentage over the last 13 seasons.
- UVA owns a .975 fielding percentage this year (fourth in ACC).

CAVALIERS TOP ACC IN BATTING SINCE 2009

- Virginia owns the ACC's top offense over the past eight years with a combined .303 average and is tops this year (.325).
- The Cavaliers led the conference in batting in 2009, 2010 and 2013 and were second in 2011, 2012 and 2014.
- UVA was third in the ACC in batting last year at .304.
