FOR OPENERS

- UVa has won its first two games by 28 or more points for the first time since the start of the 2000-01 season.
- Virginia has a 12-game home winning streak (11 of the 12 victories during the streak have been by double digits).
- The Cavaliers have held both of their opponents under 29 percent shooting from the floor.
- The Cavaliers are 1-0 all-time against South Carolina State in the series that began in 2011-12.
- UVa is shooting 53.6 percent (15-28) from 3-point range after two games.

SERIES HISTORY

- UVa is 1-0 all-time against South Carolina State, defeating the Bulldogs 75-38 in the 2011-12 season-opener at John Paul Jones Arena.
- Former Cavaliers Joe Harris and KT Harrell led the Cavaliers with 13 points apiece and Mike Scott grabbed a game-high 15 rebounds in the win.
- Virginia's defense stifled the Bulldogs to just 25.5 percent (13-51) shooting from the floor, including 18.8 percent (3-16) from 3-point range

VIRGINIA REMAINS NO. 9 IN LATEST ASSOCIATED PRESS POLL

- UVa is ranked No. 9 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today coaches' polls.
- The Cavaliers were ranked No. 9/8 in the AP and USA Today preseason coaches' polls.
- The No. 9 AP preseason ranking is UVa's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.
- Virginia was ranked in the preseason rankings in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2000-01 and 2001-02.
- UVa's No. 3 final AP ranking last season marked its highest final ranking since 1982.

ALL-TIME VS. MID-EASTERN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE OPPONENTS

- The Cavaliers play their second Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference opponent of the season.
- UVa defeated the MEAC's Norfolk State 67-39 in their home opener on Sunday, Nov. 16.
- Virginia is 22-0 all-time vs. the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (7-0 vs. Hampton, 4-0 vs. Howard, 2-0 vs. Maryland Eastern Shore, 2-0 vs. Morgan State, 4-0 vs. Norfolk State, 1-0 vs. Bethune-Cookman, 1-0 vs. Coppin State, 1-0 vs. North Carolina A&T and 1-0 vs. South Carolina State).

LAST TIME OUT

- Justin Anderson tallied a team-high 11 points to lead No. 9/8 Virginia to a 67-39 win over Norfolk State on Sunday, Nov. 16.
- Rookie Marial Shayok added a season-high eight points off the bench and Anthony Gill had a game-high eight rebounds and career-best three blocked shots
- London Perrantes (7 points, 4 assists) & Evan Nolte (5 points) returned to the lineup after missing the season-opener at James Madison.
- Virginia built a 33-point lead and limited Norfolk State to just 23.5 percent (12-51) shooting from the floor.
- UVa owned a 41-31 advantage on the glass and blocked 11 shots and had 19 assists in the win.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Sixth-year UVA head coach Tony Bennett sports a 108-60 mark in Charlottesville and 177-93 record in nine seasons.
- Bennett was named 2014 ACC Coach of the Year after guiding the Cavaliers to their first ACC Tournament championship since 1976.
- In 2013-14, he guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has guided the Cavaliers to three consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012 and 2014 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett has increased UVA's win total in each of the last five seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12, 23 in 2013-13 and 30 in 2013-14).
- Bennett-coached teams are 62-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his nine-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have finished in the top five nationally in scoring defense in five of eight seasons (first in 2008-09; second in 2007-08 and 2011-12, fifth in 2012-13 and first in 2013-14).
- Bennett is one of 24 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

EMBRACE THE PACE

- Virginia is averaging 73 points and allowing 45 points thus far in 2014-15.
- UVA has shot 50.5 percent (52-103) from the field and 53.6 percent from 3-point range after two games, while limiting its opponents to 26 percent (27-104) from the field and 34.9 percent from 3-point range.
- The Cavaliers have held 26 straight opponents and 37 straight ACC opponents under 50 percent shooting from the field.
- UVA has limited its opponents to a pair of fast break points.
- In 2013-14, the Cavaliers ranked in the top 10 nationally in seven defensive categories: points per game (1st), possessions per 40 minutes (3rd), rebounds per game (4th), offensive rebound percentage (5th), true shooting percentage (8th), field goal percentage (9th) and points per possession (9th).

BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Preseason All-ACC performer Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA into action this season.
- Brogdon had 14 points and a team-high four assists in the season-opener at JMU.
- Brogdon has scored in double figures in 24 of the last 26 games dating back to last season.
- In 2013-14, Brogdon averaged a career-high 12.7 points and 5.4 rebounds en route to All-ACC honors.
- Brogdon scored a career-best 23 points in the 2014 ACC Tournament final against Duke.

SIXTH MAN NO MORE

- Junior guard Justin Anderson has started at guard and led Virginia in scoring in each of the first two games.
- Anderson had 18 points at James Madison and 11 points against Norfolk State.
- He is averaging 14.5 points and shooting a career-high 47.4 percent from the field, including 70 percent (7-10) from 3-point range.
- Anderson was named 2014 ACC Sixth Man of the Year after averaging 7.8 points and 3.2 rebounds.
- In 2013-14, Anderson led the team in scoring in five games and had several game-changing defensive plays to ignite UVA.

LONDON CALLING

- Sophomore point guard London Perrantes returned to the lineup against Norfolk State and tallied seven points, four assists and no turnovers.
- Perrantes averaged 5.5 points and 3.8 assists to earn All-ACC Freshman Team honors last season.
- He ranked sixth nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.5.
- Perrantes (140 assists) became the fourth UVA freshman to record 100 assists in a season, joining Cory Alexander (144 in 1991-92), Jeff Jones (136 in 1978-79) and Sean Singletary (113 in 2004-05).

NOLTE KNOWS SHOOTING

- Junior forward Evan Nolte is one of Virginia's top 3-point shooting threats.
- Nolte, who keyed UVA's rally with a pair of 3-pointers against Coastal Carolina in the 2014 NCAA Tournament, has shot 37 percent from 3-point range during his career.
- Nolte returned to the lineup against Norfolk State and had five points, two rebounds and one steal.

ROOKIES OFF TO GOOD START

- Redshirt freshman Devon Hall and true freshmen Isaiah Wilkins and Marial Shayok have made strong impressions in 2014-15.
- Hall had five points and five steals in a starting role in place of London Perrantes at James Madison.
- Wilkins chipped in eight points, five rebounds, three assists, two steals and two blocks at James Madison.
- Freshman B.J. Stith has seen limited action in both games.
- Wilkins averaged 18.2 points, 10.3 rebounds and 3.4 blocks en route to Georgia Gatorade Player of the Year honors for Greater Atlantic Christian last season, while Shayok averaged 15 points and 6 rebounds per game for Blair Academy.
- Stith averaged 12.4 points and 4.3 rebounds for national runner-up Oak Hill Academy.
- Wilkins is the stepson of NBA Hall of Famer Dominique Wilkins, and Stith is the son of UVA all-time leading scorer Bryant Stith.

PAINT IT ORANGE AND BLUE

- Virginia has outscored its opponents 58-18 in the paint after two games.
- Frontcourt players Anthony Gill, Mike Tobey, Darion Atkins and Isaiah Wilkins have combined to shoot 62.5 percent (25-40) from the field and are averaging 20.5 rebounds as a unit.
- The foursome have led the team to a +10.5 rebounding margin as UVA is averaging 39.5 rebounds.
- Gill, Tobey, Atkins and Wilkins have also combined for 15 blocked shots in two games.

ABOUT THE 2014-15 SCHEDULE

- Five of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the latest AP poll (Duke, North Carolina, Louisville, VCU and Syracuse), while six (Pittsburgh, Notre Dame, NC State, Florida State, George Washington and Maryland) received votes.
- Nine opponents (Duke, Louisville, Pittsburgh, NC State, George Washington, Harvard, North Carolina, Syracuse and VCU) played in the 2014 NCAA Tournament, while three (Clemson, Davidson and Florida State) participated in the National Invitation Tournament and two (Norfolk State and Cleveland State) in the CollegenInsider.com Tournament.

VIRGINIA PICKED 4TH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball for the second consecutive season.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked fourth and finished first last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in each of the last five seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Louisville, Virginia, Syracuse, Pitt, Notre Dame, Florida State, NC State, Miami, Clemson, Wake Forest, Georgia Tech, Boston College and Virginia Tech.

BROGDON NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Malcolm Brogdon is one of five players named Preseason All-ACC.
- Joining Brogdon on the preseason All-ACC team were Marcus Paige (North Carolina), Montrezl Harrell (Louisville), Jahliel Okafor (Duke) and Jerian Grant (Notre Dame).
- Paige was the pick for Preseason ACC Player of the Year and Okafor was named Preseason ACC Rookie of the Year.

BROGDON ON PRESEASON WOODEN AWARD WATCH LIST

- Malcolm Brogdon is one of 50 players on the preseason John Wooden Award Watch List, honoring the nation's top player.
- Brogdon is averaging 10 points and three rebounds after two games this season.

Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.
