FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets Boston College for the lone meeting between the teams in 2015-16.
- The Cavaliers have a 15-game home-winning streak and are 10-0 at John Paul Jones Arena in 2015-16.
- As of Feb. 2, UVA is tied for third in the ACC at 6-3 and Boston College is 15th at 0-8.
- As of Feb. 2, UVA ranks sixth nationally in scoring defense (61.2 ppg), seventh in field goal percentage (50%), 12th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.54), 17th in 3-point field goal percentage (39.8%) and 24th in free throw percentage (74.6%).

ALL-TIME AGAINST THE EAGLES

- Virginia is 11-7 all-time vs. Boston College, including an 8-7 ACC mark, in the series that dates back to 1971-72.
- The Cavaliers have a two-game winning streak against the Eagles and have won four of the last five games in the series.
- UVA recorded a 66-51 win at Boston College last season and a 77-67 win at John Paul Jones Arena in 2013-14.
- Virginia is 6-2 vs. Boston College in Charlottesville, including a 4-2 mark at JPI.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 5-4 all-time against Boston College.
- Malcolm Brogdon is averaging 14.3 points, 7.7 rebounds and 4.0 assists in three career games against Boston College, while Anthony Gill is averaging 12 points and 8.5 rebounds in two games.

LAST TIME VS. BOSTON COLLEGE

- Malcolm Brogdon matched a season high with 20 points and Anthony Gill had his third double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds as then-No. 2 Virginia posted a 66-51 road win at Boston College on Jan. 17, 2015.
- The Cavaliers trailed 38-33 in the second half, but closed the game on a 33-13 run to seal their second win at Boston College.
- London Perrantes had a solid all-around performance with eight points, six assists and three rebounds.
- The Cavaliers outrebounded the Eagles 35-20 and went 18-21 from the charity stripe.

LAST TIME OUT

- Malcolm Brogdon and Anthony Gill tallied 13 points each to lead then-No. 11 UVA to a 63-47 win at then-No. 16 Louisville on Jan. 30.
- The Cavaliers shot 57.8 percent (26-45) from the field and limited the Cardinals to 32.7 percent (16-49), including 21.1 percent (4-19) in the first half.
- The Virginia win marked the Cardinals' worst loss at KFC Yum! Center, surpassing Kentucky's 78-63 win over Louisville on Dec. 31, 2010.
- UVA led 29-14 at halftime, marking a season low for points for a Cavalier opponent in the opening stanza.
- The Cavaliers held Louisville scoreless for 7:34 of the first half as the Cardinals went 0-7 from the field and committed seven turnovers during that span.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 133-36 (.787) in 10 seasons, including a 10-0 mark in 2015-16, at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA extended its home-winning streak to 15 games with its win over Syracuse
- UVA is 95-20 (.826), including a 60-5 (.923) mark the past four seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 30-1 in ACC home games over the past four seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for six straight seasons.
- UVA's 21-game home winning streak from Dec. 21, 2013-Jan. 22, 2015 set a JPI record.

VIRGINIA RANKED NO. 9 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 9 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in the AP poll on three different occasions this season (7 weeks overall).
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in 25 consecutive AP polls from March 3, 2014 to Nov. 16, 2015, its longest span since 49 straight from 1980-83.
- The Cavaliers' No. 6 preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett sports a 153-68 mark in seven seasons at Virginia and 222-101 career mark in 10 seasons overall.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett was also named ACC Coach of the Year, NABC District 2 Coach of the Year and USBWA District 3 Coach of the Year for the second consecutive year.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to four consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014 and 2015, and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett-coached teams are 77-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 10-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top five nationally in six of nine seasons.
- Bennett is one of 26 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 79-24 (.767) in non-conference action and 95-20 (.826) at home under Tony Bennett.

VIRGINIA BASKETBALL GETTING OFFENSIVE

- Virginia is averaging 72.4 points per game, its most since 76.8 ppg in 2007-08.
- As of Feb. 1, UVA ranks Nos. 5 and 8 in the KenPom.com adjusted overall and offensive efficiency ratings, respectively.
- UVA is shooting 50 percent from the field (best since 50.1% in 1985-86), 39.8 percent from 3-point range (best in school history) and 74.6 percent from the free throw line (best since 74.8% in 2000-10).
- Virginia has scored 80 or more points in six games, its most since 11 in 2007-08.
- UVA's 86 points against Villanova were its most scored against a top-25 opponent since tallying 87 in a road win at Minnesota in 2010-11.
- UVA has shot 55 percent or better in eight games in 2015-16 after achieving the feat three times in 34 games in 2014-15 and four times in 37 games in 2013-14.
- The Cavaliers scored 82 or more points in three straight games (Nov. 19-22 at Charleston Classic) for the first time since the first three games of the 2001-02 season.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better from 3-point range in six games.

SECONDS ANYONE?

- Virginia has played its best basketball during the second half of games this season.
- The Cavaliers have scored more points in the second half than the first half in 18 of 21 games.
- UVA is averaging 40.6 points in the second half and 31.3 points in the first stanza.
- UVA is shooting 55.6 percent on its second-half shots, including 49 percent from 3-point range, but only 44.7 percent on its first-half shots and 30 percent from 3-point range.

HOO ARE THESE WAHOOS?

- All-America candidate Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA in scoring for the third consecutive season at a career-best 17.3 points per game, while Anthony Gill is averaging a career-high 14.9 points.
- Brogdon has 10 20-point efforts, including a career-high 28 at George Washington and Wake Forest, marking the most by a UVA player in a season since Mike Scott had 11 20-point games in 2012-13.
- Gill has reached double figures in scoring in all 21 games in 2015-16 and 23 straight dating back to 2014-15.
- London Perrantes is averaging career highs in points (11.6), field goal percentage (46.6%) and 3-point field goal percentage (51.9%).
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better from the field in 11 contests.
- UVA is 12-3 when committing nine or fewer turnovers.
- Eight players have each scored 11 or more points in a game.

ALL-AMERICAN BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Preseason co-ACC Player of the Year Malcolm Brogdon is aiming to become the first UVA player since Sean Singletary (2006-08) to lead UVA in scoring for three straight seasons.
- Brogdon's 17.3 scoring average is the highest for UVA since Mike Scott's 18.0 ppg in 2011-12.
- Brogdon's 18.9 scoring average in ACC action is the highest for UVA since Scott's 19.6 ppg in 2011-12.
- Brogdon was named a preseason All-American by The Sporting News (1st team), Blue Ribbon Yearbook (1st team), CBSSports.com (2nd team), NBCSports.com (2nd team), Bleacher Report (2nd team), USA Today (3rd team) and CollegeInsider.com.
- Brogdon and Gonzaga's Kyle Wiltjer are the first consensus All-Americans to return as fifth-year seniors since Vanderbilt's Billy McCaffrey in 1993-94.
- In 2014-15, Brogdon averaged 14.0 points and 3.9 rebounds en route to All-America second-team and All-ACC first-team accolades.
- The two-time All-ACC performer, who was a John Wooden Award finalist last season, ranks 18th on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,498 points in 120 career games (12.5 career ppg).
- Brogdon ranks second on UVA's career free-throw percentage list at 86.1% (354-for-411).
- Brogdon is a candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award and Wooden Citizen Cup Award.
- Brogdon helped Team USA to a bronze medal at the 2015 Pan American Games in Toronto.
- He earned a degree in history and is pursuing a master's degree from the Frank Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy.

GILL THRILLS

- Preseason All-ACC second-team selection Anthony Gill is averaging career highs in points (14.9) and field goal percentage (60.4%).
- Gill leads UVA in rebounding (6.0 rpg) and field goal percentage, and has led UVA in scoring in seven games.
- Gill is the first UVA player to score in double figures in the first 21 games of a season since Sean Singletary scored 10 or more points in all 33 games during 2007-08.
- Gill earned ACC Player of the Week honors after tallying 20 points and 12 rebounds vs. West Virginia for his fourth career double-double.
- Gill averaged 11.6 points and 6.5 rebounds en route to All-ACC third-team (media) honors in 2014-15.
- Gill was named to the coaches' All-ACC Defensive Team in 2014-15.
- Gill, who has led UVA in field goal percentage in each of the past two seasons, is shooting 59 percent during his UVA career.
- Gill has amassed 1,261 career points in three seasons at UVA and one at South Carolina (1,012 at UVA).

LONDON CALLING THE SHOTS

- Guard London Perrantes is enjoying a breakout season in 2015-16.
- Perrantes has hit double figures in scoring in 11 games, including a season-high 22 points (career-best seven 3-pointers) at Virginia Tech.
- Perrantes leads the ACC in 3-point shooting at a career-best 51.9 percent and has a career 3.0 assist-to-turnover ratio (372 assists, 126 turnovers) in 86 games.
- He tallied his second career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 11 assists against George Mason en route to MVP honors at the Charleston Classic.
- Perrantes also tallied 19 points against Villanova and Florida State.
- He missed the Ohio State and William & Mary contests due to an

- Perrantes averaged 6.4 points and 4.6 assists en route to honorable mention All-ACC honors last season.
- He had a career-high 26 points, including five 3-pointers, at Miami (1/3/15).
- Perrantes earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.

HALL OF A SPARK

- Redshirt sophomore guard Devon Hall has averaged 5.8 points as a starter during the past five games for Virginia.
- Hall has played in all 21 games this season and is averaging 19.2 minutes after averaging 10.6 minutes in 23 contests last season.
- Hall has just two turnovers in his last 139 minutes (six games).
- Hall scored an ACC-high 11 points against Clemson and is averaging eight points the past three games as a starter.
- Hall netted a career-high 13 points vs. Morgan State and drained a career-best four 3-pointers for 12 points vs. Long Beach State.
- Hall had five points, four assists and three rebounds in a solid all-around outing against Notre Dame.
- Hall made his first start of the season at Florida State, scoring six points and matching a season high with 26 minutes.

DARIUS SHOWING VARIOUS SKILLS

- Darius Thompson has averaged 5.9 points, 1.7 rebounds, 1.8 assists and 1.0 steals in his first season at UVA.
- Thompson is shooting 36.7 percent (11-30) from 3-point range after shooting 19.5 percent (8-41) from downtown at Tennessee in 2013-14.
- Thompson banked in the game-winning 3-pointer at Wake Forest.
- He had a five-game double figure scoring streak from Nov. 25-Dec. 19, and tallied 12 points in four games.
- Thompson sat out as a transfer last season after averaging 2.6 points and 2.4 assists in 37 games at Tennessee in 2013-14.
- Thompson had 12 points, six rebounds, four assists and three steals in his UVA debut as a starter vs. Morgan State.

PERRANTES & BROGDON LEAD UVA IN ACC OVERALL RANKINGS
