- Rocco has thrown for over 300 yards in two straight games, becoming the first UVa QB to do that since Jameel Sewell in 2009 - at Southern Miss (312) and vs. Indiana (308).
- Rocco has now tossed over 200 yards for the eighth time in his career, tying him for No. 10 in the UVa annals all-time.
- Rocco has reached 200 yards passing in four straight games.
- Zachary Swanson finished with two catches for seven yards, his first two collegiate catches.
- Jake McGee caught two passes for 23 yards, his first two collegiate receptions.
- Darius Jennings' 51-yard TD catch is the second longest reception of his career. He had a 53-yard TD reception in '11 at Miami. Both of his TD receptions have gone for over 50 yards.
- Jennings set career highs with five receptions and 84 yards receiving.
- Drew Jarrett attempted his first career FG, and his 45-yard make ranks as the fifth-longest initial FG by a UVa kicker.
- Khalek Shepherd returned his first career punt and returned two for nine yards.
- Shepherd's 59-yard kick return to start the second half was the longest return of his career.
- E.J. Scott caught three balls for 54 yards, the first catches of his career.
- Kevin Parks had two TDs and now has five career TDs in UVa season openers.

- UVa is now 3-5 all-time against Penn State and 2-2 in Charlottesville.
- Four Penn State drives following UVa's four turnovers, the Cavalier defense allowed minus-14 yards, resulting in just three points.
- The Cavaliers were 4-4 on third downs during the game-winning drive.
- With UVa's win over Penn State (17-16) today and Indiana (34-31) last season, it is only the fourth time an ACC team has defeated different Big Ten opponents in successive seasons - NC State (Indiana in '00 and Minnesota in '01), NC State (Iowa in '92 and Purdue in '93) and North Carolina (Michigan State in '64, Ohio State in '65 and Michigan in '66).
- It was only the fourth time in the Mike London era that UVa failed to reach 300 yards of total offense (295), but marked the first victory. The losses for UVa were: 2010 Virginia Tech (291), 2011 vs. Virginia Tech (241) and 2011 vs. NC State (249).
- With 32 rushing yards, UVa rushed for its fewest yards in a victory since rushing for two yards (20 carries) in a 27-22 victory at Duke on Oct. 5, 2002.
- Penn State's Sam Ficken missed four field goals against UVa, becoming the first opponent kicker to miss four field goals against the Cavaliers since Maryland's Bernardo Bramson went 1-for-5 in the 1964 meeting.
- The last time UVa was minus four in the turnover battle and won the game was on Sept. 17, 1994 against Clemson. UVa had four INTs and lost three fumbles, while Clemson won three INTs. UVa won the game 9-6.
- Michael Rocco was 6-of-6 passing for 97 yards and a touchdown on the game-winning drive.

- Virginia held Wake Forest to its second lowest number of total yards in a game this season with 213. Wake's 126 at Florida State is the only total lower.
- The 213 total yards by Wake Forest is the fewest allowed by UVa since William & Mary had 169 in the 2011 season opener. It's the fewest by a UVa ACC opponent since North Carolina's 174 in 2009.
- Wake Forest's 213 total yards is the fewest by a UVa opponent in a win against the Cavaliers since Clemson had 192 in a 13-3 Tigers' victory in 2008 — also played at Scott Stadium.
- UVa's defense has allowed a combined 448 yards in the last two games, an average of 224 yards per game.
- UVa held Wake Forest to 1-of-15 on third downs, including 0-of-11 to start the game.
- UVa came into the game averaging 4.0 three and outs per game (19th nationally) and forced Wake Forest into seven three and out situations.
- With 30 yards receiving, Perry Jones became 31st player in UVa history with 1,000 career receiving yards.
- Jones is now the fourth player in UVa history, and 12th player in ACC history, with 1,000 career receiving yards and 1,000 career rushing yards. Other UVa players are Frank Quayle, Terry Kirby and Alvin Pearman.
- Jones is also only the second active FBS player and only in the BCS to have 1,000 career rushing yards and 1,000 career receiving yards — Houston's Charles Sims is also part of the club.
- With five receptions, Jones passed Terry Kirby (105) and is now tied with Patrick Jeffers (108) for No. 11 all-time at UVa in career receptions.
- With 79 yards receiving, Tim Smith became the 32nd player in UVa history with 1,000 career receiving yards.
- Phillips Sims' 56-yard pass to Tim Smith was the longest completion of his career.
- Sims found Smith for a 13-yard TD pass in the second quarter, the first time the duo hooked up on a score since Dec. 6, 2008 when Sims threw four TDs to Smith in the 2008 Group AAA Division 6 state championship game at Virginia Tech's Lane Stadium.
- Sims had 253 yards passing, his second career game with at least 200 yards passing, become the 24th Cavalier to pass for over 200 yards at least twice in their career.
- Khalek Shepherd had UVa's longest punt return of the season for 25 yards. Entering today's game UVa had 14 punt returns that had netted 34 total yards (all by Shepherd).
- Ian Frye made a career long 30-yard field goal in the third quarter. Frye also had a miss of 44 yards, his first career miss and the longest attempt of his career.
- With 14 tackles, Steve Greer passed P.J. Killian (316) for sole possession of 11th all-time in the UVa annals for career tackles with 320. Greer, for the third week in a row, is the ACC active leader in career tackles.
- Chris Brathwaite's nine tackles and 2.0 tackles for a loss are both career highs.
